Parade Walking Cane: Designed specifically for back-beating.

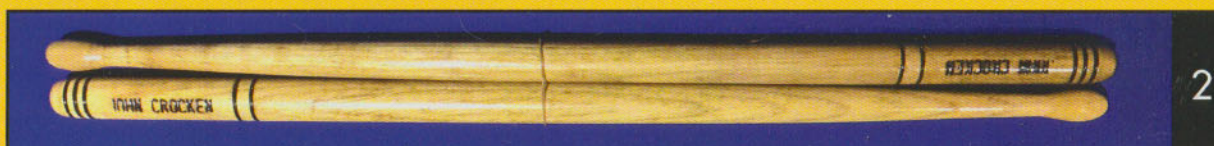
Knob Butt: .890 / Shaft: .775 / Bead: .610 / Overall Length: 17"

Parade A.F. Model: Designed with an elongated bead which measures one inch in length.

Shaft: .707 / Bead: .560 / Overall Length: 17.25"

Parade Rudimental: A drumstick for the "Nobility of Ancients".

Shaft: .725 / Bead: .705 "round" w/collar / Overall Length: 17"

Concert Stick: Ideally suited for concert work and general practice. Recommended and used by Fred Begun, Timpanist, National Symphony and George Gaber, Professor of Percussion, Indiana University.

Shaft: .625 / Bead: .490 / Overall Length: 16"

Drum Set Stick: Used and recommended by professionals including the immortal Max Roach and Jim Chapin.

Shaft: .590 / Bead: .400 / Overall Length: 15.75"

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5Z Model: The best version of a 5B type you'll ever use. Designed for performance and practice.
Knob Butt: .660 / Acorn Bead: .429 / Overall Length: 16.25"

Civil War Stick: is patterned after a pair that accompanied a Civil War drum of the 1st Maryland N/G Band owned by Charles "Buck" Soistman. Great for junior players—remember, the oldest survivors of the Civil War were drummers because they were "drummer boys" during the war.
Butt: .700 / Bead: .430 / Overall Length: 16.5"

Moeller Stick: Sanford Augustus (Gus) Moeller--George M. Cohan's Drummer. Teacher of Gene Krupa and Jim Chapin. Author of "Instructor in the Art of Snare Drumming" published by Ludwig & Ludwig 1925. This drumstick is a duplication of his original design and specifications 17 1/4" length with a 5/8" shaft hence: Moeller's perfect Drumstick. Available in Persimmon and Brazilian Cherry (Jatoba).

Bass Beater: Following the tradition of Buck Soistman. Made from one piece of solid wood.
.910 Handle at the widest grip & 1 3/4" Beater Ball
