



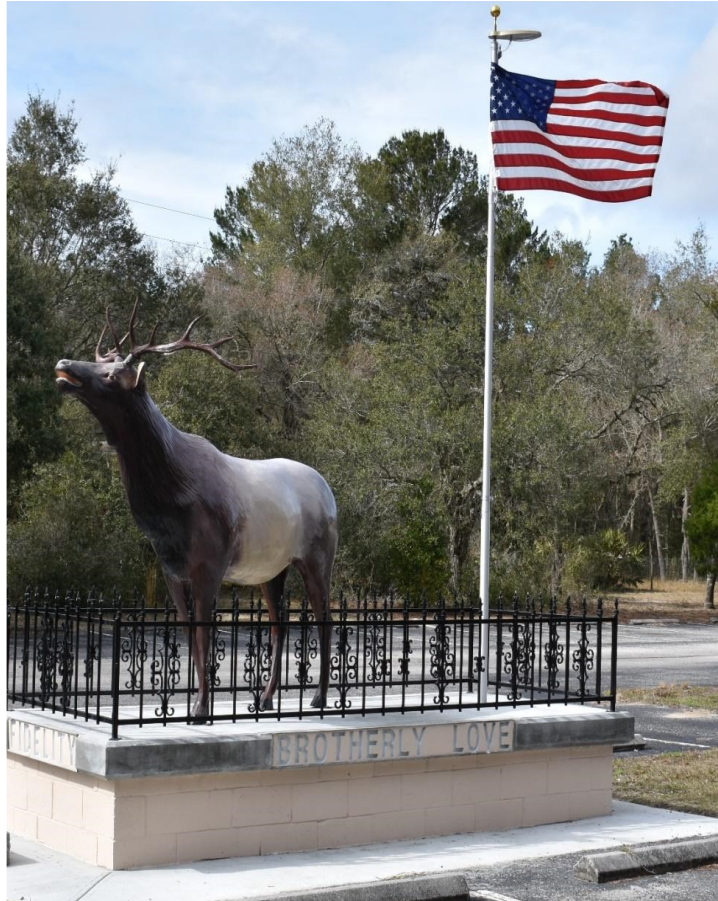

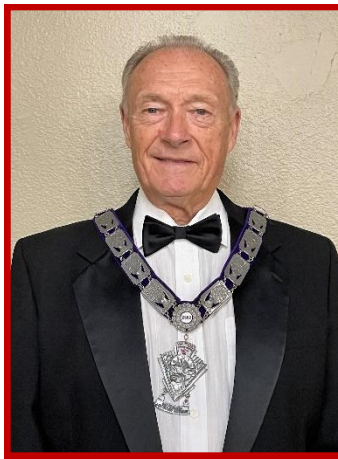

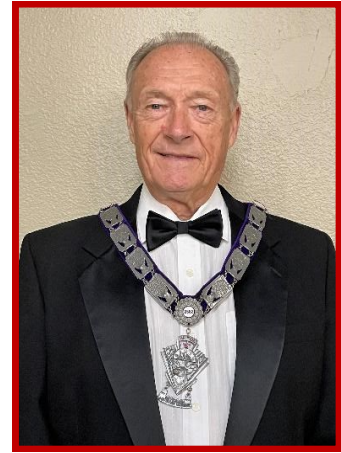
The line dancers have also continued to be very sportive of the lodge with many of them helping in the kitchen and on the house committee. Thank you all.
