

7 Questions To Ask Your CIO In January

A one page guide for CEOs, Presidents, CFOs and COOs to have a clear, honest year start conversation about technology, risk and value.

Use this page in a 30 minute conversation with your CIO or technology leader early in the new year. Pick 3 questions if time is tight. The goal is clarity, not perfection.

The 7 questions

- 1. If we do nothing different with technology in 2026, where are we most at risk as a business?
- 2. What are the 3 most important technology or data moves that would really help the business this year?
- 3. Where are we overspending or overcomplicating things, and what could we simplify or retire?
- 4. Which systems or processes quietly keep you up at night because of fragility, cyber risk or single points of failure?
- 5. How is our team really doing - in terms of workload, burnout, and the skills we will need next?
- 6. Where do you see AI and automation helping us in practical ways in the next 6 to 12 months, not abstract ways?
- 7. What support do you need from me and the rest of the leadership team to make progress on these items?
