- City of Highmore Zoning Ordinance-Delivered and awaiting final adoption
- City of Timber Lake Ordinance revision
- City of Philip Ordinance revision-building codes
- City of Kadoka Ordinance Revision-Delivered and awaiting draft comments

Project Administration Commitments

- City of Pierre Boys & Girls Club- Ongoing project with Davis Bacon report monitoring and CDBG administration active.
- City of Pierre EDA Disaster Recovery Grant Application- The District submitted an application to EDA for a COVID-19 Recovery Grant award on behalf of the City of Pierre for an unanticipated sewer main break and ongoing damages being experienced related to significant Missouri River water levels.
- City of Eagle Butte Water & Sewer Project- The District is working with the City of Eagle Butte on the project now that Eagle Butte has joined the District as a dues paying member. An application to DENR was submitted by the City prior to their joining the District and we are working with the City and engineering firm to address application needs cited by DENR.
- City of Onida Phase I drinking water and sewer project- final project work on Phase I of the project is completed and a final DENR closeout meeting occurred November 20th.
- City of Onida Phase II drinking water and sewer project-SRF loan applications were approved at the July DENR Water & Natural Resources board meeting. Both USDA-RD and DENR-SRF funds will be used to complete this phase of the project, currently awaiting project engineering and bid book.
- City of Blunt lagoon project- CDBG and SRF loan administration is ongoing, ground water levels and repeated heavy rains prevented substantive work on the project from beginning on schedule. The contractor has been working on this project since mid-July and is awaiting execution of final construction works. Final project reseeding and closeout is anticipated in Summer 2020.
- City of Blunt Drinking Water Improvements- The City received a SRF loan award on January 3rd to fund a water meter and water pit installation project slated to begin next summer. The District will provide administration services for the project.
- City of Ft. Pierre Bulldoze, Beautify, Build project-ongoing CDBG allocation without use of funds to date.
- City of Ft. Pierre Lagoon Project- The District is worked with City staff to complete a DENR-SRF application to rehab and improve processing capacity at the City's lagoons. This project is projected for next summer and will in involve District administration.
- City of Ft. Pierre Drinking Water System Improvements Project- The City of Ft. Pierre has expressed interest in completing a drinking water system improvement project which the District will assist in funding applications and administration services. This project is

likely on hold until certainty of municipal budgets are known in light of COVID-19 impacts.

- City of McIntosh Drinking Water Improvements- The District is providing administration services for a city water meter and water pit installation project slated to begin in summer 2020. The District assisted the City to reapply to USDA-RD for additional funding following bid openings which came in substantially over original project cost estimates. The City accepted new USDA-RD funding and bid book is being completed by the project engineer currently
- City of Kadoka- the District has participated in 2 meetings discussing the City's intention to develop a municipal wastewater and drinking water update plan to include District assistance in obtaining project financing. Decision to move forward is needed from the City to proceed.
- City of Philip- the District is working with the City to apply for an extension on the State Water Plan for a water meter/water pit update project. The City will be applying for the project in the next year & ½.
- City of Murdo- the District is awaiting new project changes to apply for USDA-RD funding and resubmitting a CDBG application to GOED.
- City of Timber Lake- the District is working with City staff and the city board to develop a city-wide water & sewer rehab project. The City received a small community planning grant from DENR for the drinking water design and assessment and has contracted with Clarke Engineering to complete the prelim assessment and design.
- Trail City & Glencross Water Distribution Project- the CDBG funding has been completely drawn. This project is effectively complete sans a disagreement between the City and engineer on engineering fees.
- Jones County PDM Emergency Management Plan update project-CSDED is contracted to produce the County's pre-disaster mitigation plan update. District staff traveled to Murdo for the PDM Development Team kickoff meeting on January 15th and the first public input meeting is scheduled for February 12th.
- Mellette County PDM Emergency Management Plan update project- CSDED submitted a PDM plan funding application to SD-OEM and will complete the County's plan when funding is acquired.
- Hughes/Stanley County PDM Emergency Management Plan update project- CSDED has been asked to conduct the next PDM plan update of the Hughes & Stanley County joint plan. The plan is due for completion in 2022.
- Hyde County PDM Emergency Management Plan update project- CSDED has been asked to conduct the next PDM plan update for Hyde County. The plan is due for completion in 2022.
- Haakon County PDM Emergency Management Plan update project- CSDED has been asked to conduct the next PDM plan update for Haakon County. The plan is due for completion in 2022.
- Sully County PDM Emergency Management Plan update project- CSDED has been asked to conduct the next PDM plan update for Sully County. The plan is due for completion in 2022.
- Stanley County landslide PDM Project- CSDED produced an application on behalf of Stanley County which has been approved. Funding was received in the end of March and

substantive work removing the structure was completed in April. Final project closeout is anticipated in June/July 2020.
