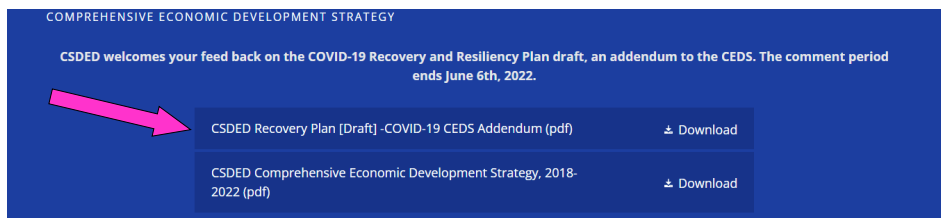

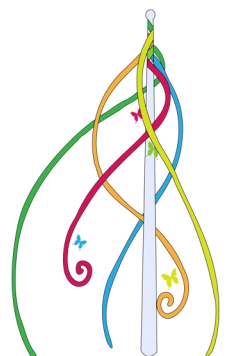
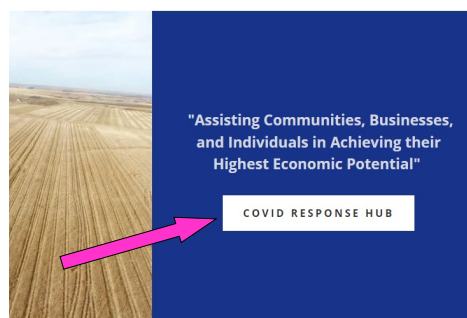

Did you know that West Nile Virus originates from birds? Most birds can be infected with the West Nile Virus (WNV). It is the mosquito that transmits the disease from birds to humans and other mammals. It is important to note that the WNV cannot be transmitted from animals to people. However, it is important to protect both humans and animals from this virus as it can be devastating to the health of both.

The SD Department of Health opened its application period on May 2nd for funding assistance for mosquito control. Applications are due at SDDOH by **June 1st**. The WNV Grant application process will be the same as 2021 as well as the award system of reimbursement. A Temporary Design

A temporary updated design came out at the beginning of April to alleviate production delays due to material shortages. These design changes are mostly cosmetic and only affect the exterior of the 3-bedroom traditional orientations of the Governor’s Houses. These temporary changes went into effect mid-April and affect those customers who have houses on order as well as future houses. The changes, however, do not affect the narrow lot orientations or the 2-bedroom houses. While these changes are temporary, it is unknown when or if the changes will revert to the 2018 design on the outside of the house.

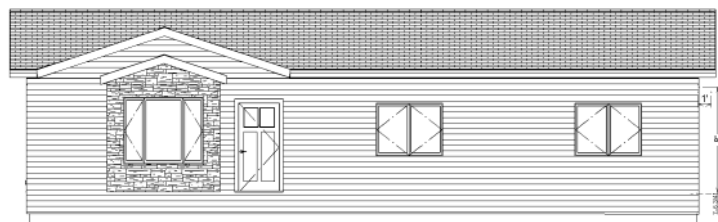
Every year, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development releases a Statewide Median Income for various housing programs that utilize funding from HUD. Based on the reported Statewide Median income, SD Housing Development Authority utilizes this information to calculate the income limits for qualification for the Governor’s House Program. The new Governor’s House Program Income Guidelines for 2022 are:

For households of 2 or less \$59,780

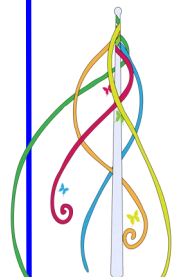
For households of 3 or more \$68,320

These guidelines are effective as of May 2, 2022.
