



Just for clarification, before I continue: In my studies I use YHVH (Yod, Yay, Vav, Hay in Hebrew, which I like to pronounce as Yahuah) instead of LORD, which is a title - not a name. I also use Yahusha instead of Jesus, which is not a translation but a transliteration. The name Jesus really has no meaning, in Hebrew nor in English! YHVH and Yahusha are the actual original Hebrew names that speak of our Savior's true nature and character. For that reason, I prefer to use their Hebrew names.

Back to our presentations with the title "According to many Christians Yahuah's Feasts areJewish"....



Is that Correct?

What does Scripture say in? Leviticus 23:1,2 "And יהוה (YHVH) spoke to Mosheh, saying, Speak to the children of Yisra'ĕl, and say to them, 'The appointed times of יהוה (YHVH) which you are to proclaim as setapart gatherings, My appointed times, are these."

Who's appointed times (feasts) are these?

Non other than the Great I AM, YHVH, Yahuah, the Aleph Tav, the King of kings!

Let's look at Leviticus 23:3 "Speak to the children of Yisra'ĕl, and say to them, 'The appointed times of יהוה (YHVH) which you are to proclaim as set-apart gatherings, My appointed times, are these: 'Six days work is done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of rest, a set-apart gathering. You do no work; it is a Sabbath to יהוה (YHVH) n all your dwellings."



The appointed feast days According to Scripture Are NOT Jewish, they do not Belong to any man, they Belong to the Wost-High Elohim!

According to Leviticus 23:3 it is, lets look at it again.

"Six days work is done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of rest, a set-apart gathering. You do no work; it is a Sabbath to יהוה (YHVH) in all your dwellings."



Num 28,9-10 "And on the sabbath day two lambs of the first year without spot, and two tenth deals of flour for a meat offering, mingled with oil, and the drink offering thereof: 10 This is the burnt offering of every sabbath, beside the continual burnt offering, and his drink offering." **KJV**





Strangely, today we still keep the Sabbath without the burnt offerings so why not the feasts?

LET'S MOVE ON

Leviticus 23:21 "And ye shall proclaim on the selfsame day, that it may be an holy convocation unto you: ye shall do no servile work therein: it shall be a statute for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations." KJV




Leviticus 23:41 "And ye shall keep it a feast unto YHVH seven days in the year. It shall be a statute for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month."

KJV

We also notice that these set apart days are called statutes, is this important? let's have a look at what Scripture has to say

Psalms 119:155

"Salvation is far from the wicked, for they do not seek Your Statutes." ESV



Now let's have a look at Colossians 2:14-17



Colossians 2:14-17

...and, by his mandates, he cancelled the legal contract of our sins, which existed against us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to His torture stake. And by putting off His mortal body, He exposed the powers of evil, and through His person put them openly to shame......



Therefore, do not let anyone (outside the body) judge among you about eating, or drinking, or in how you keep the feast days, or the new month, or the Sabbath day, which remain shadows of coming things, but the body of Messiah."

Scripture does not mention SUBSTANCE but body of Messiah.

•Let us look at some Translations ...



Colossians 2:14 KJ21 (21st Century King James Version)

"blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us. He took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross."

Colossians 2:14 ASV (American Standard Version)

"having blotted out the bond written in ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us: and he hath taken it out of the way, nailing it to the cross."

Colossians 2:14 AMP (Amplified Bible)

"having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of legal demands [which were in force] against us and which were hostile to us. And this certificate He has set aside and completely removed by nailing it to the cross."

Colossians 2:14 CEB (Common English Bible)


"He destroyed the record of the debt we owed, with its requirements that worked against us. He canceled it by nailing it to the cross."

Colossians 2:14 CEV (Contemporary English Version)

"YHVH wiped out the charges that were against us for disobeying the Law of Moses. He took them away and nailed them to the cross."

Colossians 2:14 ERV (Easy to Read Version)

"Because we broke Elohim's laws, we owed a debt — a debt that listed all the rules we failed to follow. But Elohim forgave us of that debt. He took it away and nailed it to the cross."





What was nailed to the stake (cross)?

None other than our sins which existed against us.

Let's read it again ...

"and, by his mandates, he cancelled the legal contract of our sins, which existed against us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to His torture stake."



In Colossians 2:14 I see no mention of any Law whatsoever, just a legal contract of our sins.

Colossians 2:13

"And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses." KJV



Let us read the previous verse to see what it actually says.

Colossians 2:13

ASV (American Standard Version) - "And you, being dead through your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, you, I say, did he make alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses."

BBE (Bible in Basic English) - "And you, being dead through your sins and the evil condition of your flesh, to you, I say, he gave life together with him, and forgiveness of all our sins."

CEV (Contemporary English Version) - "You were dead, because you were sinful and were not Yahuah's people. But Elohim let Messiah make you alive, when he forgave all our sins."

Colossians 2:13

DRB (Douay-Rheims Bible) - "And you, when you were dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, he hath quickened together with him, forgiving you all offences."

ERV (Easy To Read Version) - "You were spiritually dead because of your sins and because you were not free from the power of your sinful self. But God gave you new life together with Messiah. He forgave all our sins."

ESV (English Standard Version) - "And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, Elohim made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses."

28

No mention of any Law whatsoever, just a legal contract of our sins!

There is also a mention of Sabbath Day's plural in verse 16, pointing to the feast days seeing that there are eight feast days, and they are also called Sabbaths!

Let's look at these verses again ...



"Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new month, or of the sabbath days 17 Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Messiah." Colossians 2:16-17 KJV



Paul was not speaking to the world in general. Paul is speaking to an obedient assembly. The truth is, this letter is to an assembly of believers at Colosse.

We see that it is the body of Messiah that should do the judging. "Man" in verse 16 refers to any person, including outsiders. "Don't let any outsider judge you in what you eat, but only the Body of Messiah."





The question we need to ask is "What Part of the Law was done away with, if any?"

Hebrews 13:8 tells us that "Yahshua Messiah, the same yesterday and today and forever."



"Do not think that I came to destroy the Torah or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to complete."

Malachi 4:4

"Remember the Torah of My servant Moses which I commanded him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments."

"Truly I say to you, until the heaven and the earth pass away, in no way shall one yod or one stroke pass away from the Torah until all comes to pass." These are the Messiah's words!

Here we can clearly see that no part, a yod or a stroke of the Torah will be removed. If that is the case how can any instruction or law be removed from Torah.

According to many Christians, NOT Scripture, the law is divided into the MORAL LAW and CEREMONIAL LAW. The Moral Law, they mean the Ten Commandments, was written with the finger of YHVH on 2 tables of stone!

First let's make one point clear, neither the word "moral" law nor the word "ceremonial" law is found in the whole Bible. There is no place in Scripture where two colossal divisions of Law are displayed. These terms (ceremonial and moral) were invented by man. The Bible defines the Law as being divided into Commandments, Statutes, and Judgments, but in no case moral or ceremonial.



One source claims that Thomas Aguinas from the Catholic Church invented the idea that there was a ceremonial law. He said that the Sabbath commandment was moral as to resting one day a week, ... but was ceremonial as regards to time. Therefore, it has been transferred to Sunday in the new covenant since Jesus rose on the first day of the week.

Since the word "ceremonial law" is not in the Bible it would be less misleading and less confusing if we purged this word from our vocabulary!

This term "ceremonial" is only confusing and not biblical. What we should be talking about are the ordinances of the altar (Ezekiel 43:18), that makes more sense. The Bible talks about a sacrificial system, the animal sacrifices and the oblations (grain and wine offerings) that were offered at the same time as the animal sacrifices were offered.

According to Scripture what is being called the Law of Moses, is not the Law of Moses but Yahuah's Law, called the Torah!

Here is the proof in Exodus 20:1-2 (The Scriptures 2009)

"And Elohim spoke all these Words, saying, 2 "lam יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim, who brought you out of the land of Mitsrayim, out of the house of slavery."

• So, the Torah, or instruction was given to Moses to teach the people. We also note that Moses wrote them in a book.



Deuteronomy 31:24

"And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book, until they were finished." KJV





 We have been told by many people that only the Ten
 Commandments were written on stone ... But the Scriptures tell us a different story....



 "And YHVH said unto Moses, Come up to me into the mount, and be there: and I will give thee tables of stone, and a law, and commandments which I have written; that thou mayest teach them." KJV






 Wow what a revelation, YHVH Himself told Moses to come up that He, Yahweh, had written the Torah, (Instructions) and Commandments on Stone!



Let's also look at what Exodus 24:7,8 have to say

"And he took the book of the covenant and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that YHVH hath said will we do, and be obedient. 8 And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which YHVH hath made with you concerning all these words." KJV





We urge you to follow the council of the Scriptures as recommended in **2Timothy 2:15** And study to present yourself approved to YHVH, a workman unashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth.

"And Yahusha answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you." KJV




We are always told that Rome changed the Sabbath day to Sunday, the full statement is never read to the end It reads as follows from these pages....

Q. Has the [Catholic] church power to make any alterations in the commandments of Yahuah?




Father T. Enright wrote this letter in June 1905, stating clearly that the Catholic Church was the power who had not only abolished the 7th Day Sabbath but also the Feasts of Yahuah Elohim.



The Sabbath keeping Church I was a member of for 50 years, used that letter frequently in their evangelistic meetings, but they conveniently never mentioned that "also the **Feasts of Yahuah Elohim** were removed." I WONDER WHY?



> Yahusha kept the feasts



Luke 2:41-42

"Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the Passover. 42 And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast." KJV



John 4:45 "Then when he was come into Galilee, the Galileans received him, having seen all the things that he did at Jerusalem at the feast: for they also went unto the feast." KJV

John 7:14 "Now about the midst of the feast Yahusha went up into the temple and taught." KJV

John 7:37 "In the last day, that great day of the feast, Yahusha stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink." KJV



Matthew 26:17 "Now the first day of the feast of unleavened bread the disciples came to Yahusha, saying unto him, where wilt thou that we prepare for thee to eat the Passover?" KJV



Luke 22:11 "And ye shall say unto the goodman of the house, the Master saith unto thee, where is the guest chamber, where I shall eat the Passover with my disciples?" KJV





"But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus." Acts 18:21 KJV

1Corinthians 5:8 "Therefore, let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth." (See also Acts2:1-2, 20:16, 27:9, 1 Cor.5:7-8) KJV





The True Believers kept the Feasts!

Yahuah's Feasts were kept by Believers for hundreds of Years after the death of Yahusha.

Yahuah's feasts were kept by all the faithful until, under the influence of the Church of Rome, paganism entered and began to corrupt the once pure faith. Under the guise of "converting the pagans," Victor, the Bishop of Rome, compromised with paganism, adopting pagan celebrations such as Christmas and Easter while setting aside the feasts of the Elohim.

Yahusha Messiah replaced the ordinances of the Altar by His death on the cross, thus forever removing all animal sacrifices, NOT the Feast Days. Many Christians try to make us believe that all the Feasts are fulfilled in Messiah! Of course, people are referring to Jesus, who is a mask for Tammuz, an image of the true Messiah but NOT Yahusha that died for us. This false Messiah has different teachings that were made up by man.



Now the question, were the yearly appointed feasts fulfilled by the true Messiah as people try to make us believe? •Let us look at the facts...







PAST FULFILLMENT!

Israelites put blood on the door posts before they left Egypt!

Fulfilled the second time!

It was fulfilled the second time when Yahusha became the True Passover Lamb of YHVH and placed His Blood upon the stake.



The Feast of Passover WILL BE FULFILLED THE THIRD TIME

THEN PASSOVER POINTS TO
THE FINAL DELIVERY OF HIS PEOPLE AT THE
2ND COMING, WHEN HE WILL EAT THE
PASSOVER MEAL WITH THEM IN HEAVEN!

"And He said unto them, with desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer: For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, UNTIL it be fulfilled in the kingdom of Elohim." Luke 22:15-16 KJV





PAST FULFILLMENT

• It was fulfilled the first time when YHVH removed His People from their bondage of the Egyptians.





Fulfilled the second time!

It was fulfilled the second time when Yahusha paid the Price to purchase His People back from the bondage of Death in Sin.



The Feast of Unleavened Bread WILL BE FULFILLED THE THIRD TIME

The third fulfillment is when the saints will be raised incorruptible without sin at the 2nd Coming of our Messiah!





 The 2nd fulfillment of the Feast of First Fruits was by Yahusha in His overcoming death seen at His resurrection. He was indeed the "First Fruits from the dead". This feast is a feast of First Fruits and was fulfilled when the graves were opened on Sabbath at His resurrection (Mat 27:50-53)



• The Feast of the Wave Sheaf WILL BE FULFILLED THE THIRD TIME!

• The third fulfillment points to just before His 2nd Coming, when the 144,000 are chosen, the first fruits of all the living!

This is talking about the 144,000 as stated in Revelation 14:1!

Let's also read more of the 144,000 in Rev 14:4.

"These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth.

These were redeemed from among men, [being] the first fruits unto Elohim and to the Lamb." KJV



The Feast of Pentecost also known as Feast of Weeks!

PAST FULFILLMENT

It was fulfilled the first time when YHVH poured out His Spirit upon His People during the Sinai Experience on the Day of Pentecost at the giving of the law (Torah).



FULFILLED THE SECOND TIME

It was fulfilled the second time, as the Early Rain, in the book of Acts on the Day of Pentecost, again.





The Feast of Pentecost also known as Feast of Weeks WILL BE FULFILLED THE THIRD TIME near the close of earth harvest!




We are told in Joel 2:28 (KJV): "And it shall come to pass afterward, [that] I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions."



 The Feast of Trumpets was a warning that announced the Day of Atonement or the Day of Judgment and to remind the people to search their hearts and to afflict their souls during the next 10 days.

The Feast of Trumpets reflects the Father's desire to summon His people to repentance, so that He can vindicate them on the day of His judgment.



 The second fulfillment was the announcement of the birth of the Messiah by angels to the shepherds!



The Feast of Trumpets FUTURE FULFILLMENT

One year, on a future Day of Trumpets, the shofars will begin to sound on a day like no other. The ultimate epic future Feast of Trumpets will burst onto the world stage and into holy history. This will be an awesome day of mixed celebration and alarm.



 Yahusha is coming soon, the signs of the times are clearly pointing that way. This time HE is not coming as a suffering servant but as a conquering King.



It is the time now to get serious and to humble ourselves before YHVH, to afflict our souls before the judgment day to make sure that our hearts are right before our great King of kings, the Great I AM, to accept Yahusha the Messiah and to obey His words, not the doctrines and traditions of man!



 This day is known as Yom Kippur. It is the holiest day of the year. It was a day of cleansing and purification. On this day the accumulated sins of YAH's people were cleansed from the earthly sanctuary.

• But He will do it at the final time in the Earth made New. Yahusha will tabernacle with us by becoming one of us.



• THE LAST GREAT DAY – FUTURE FULFILLMENT


This is the eighth day of the Feast of Tabernacles. The Marriage Supper of the Lamb will take place on the Last Great Day of YHVH — as prophesied to us.

The Seven Feasts of Yahuah found in Leviticus 23 1-44 are a SIGN that you are His Bride



- ☐ Eating Clean Food only according to Deuteronomy 14.




