Baptism in the Name of Yahusha is Necessary For Salvation!



Now back to our presentation with the title:



Q1, Why is water Baptism necessary for salvation?

Yahusha said, "Unless you are born again of water and spirit you cannot see the kingdom of heaven." John 3:3 to 5.

Obedience by being Baptized shows faith in Yahusha as your Savior. If you ignore Baptism, you are willingly disobedient.

Water Baptism going fully under the water is necessary for salvation. It demonstrates faith in Yahusha who washes away all your sins by His blood. When you go under the water, your sins are washed away and when you take a new breadth as you go out the water you become a new creation in Yahusha.



Q2, Did you know that Matthew 28:19, "Go ye and baptize in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit", was not in the original Hebrew manuscripts, that it was a later insertion by Catholic translators?

Scholars believe that the original text of Matthew 28:19, written in Koine Greek, read, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in my name."

Passages such as Acts 2:38 and 8:6 are evidence that at

Passages such as Acts 2:38 and 8:6 are evidence that at the end of the first century, Believers were being baptized in the name of Yahusha only, NOT IN A TRINITY!



Acts 2:38, "Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Yahusha Messiah, for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost."

Acts 8:6, "For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Master Yahusha."

Matthew 28:19 was altered after the fourth century and the adoption of the Holy Trinity as Christian doctrine, but that is something few Christians know.

Q3, What should you do now that you know that you should be baptized in the Name of Yahusha Messiah for the forgiveness of your sins?.

Many of you have been baptized into "the father, the son and the Holy Spirit" Matthew 28:18 to 20. These are titles and not Names. Scripture tells us we can only be saved if we are baptized in the Name of Yahusha Messiah, as there is no other Name by which we can be saved! We need to be obedient to the Scriptures, now that you know the truth.

Q4, Who should baptize you into the Name of Yahusha?

Yahusha is your Melchisedek High priest who is interceding for you in the Heavenly Sanctuary. We no longer look to pastors or priests who are teaching a mixture of pagan doctrines and traditions of men. We are now called OUT of all denominations to follow and obey Yahusha. You can go into the sea, river or lake or even a swimming pool and in faith, stand where the water is deep enough for you to bend you knees and go straight down into the water and then come straight up out of the water. This is the correct way to be baptized not flipped over backwards.



Q5, Why is it important to be Baptized in the correct name?

We accept Yahusha Messiah as our Savior, because we read in Acts 4:12, There is no other name under heaven given among men whereby we must be saved. When we go to Acts 2:38, we read, Be baptized every one of you for the remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the set-apart Spirit. Jesus is the anti-Messiah, he never really existed, nor did he die for your sins. Now that you know the truth it is important to be Baptized in the true Name of Yahusha Messiah, as He is the one who died for your sins not Jesus...



Q6, What does it mean to really believe in Yahusha Messiah?

To believe in Yahusha Messiah means, we believe in the things He said and obeyed. Yahusha said things like: Unless you repent of your sins, you will perish. (Luke 13:3, 5). After Repentance you obey all the Commandments, statutes and Judgments which include the Seventh Day Sabbath, the Seven Annual Feasts of Yahuah (Leviticus 23) and the Dietary laws of eating clean foods (Deuteronomy 14).





Q7, Does Repentance save us?

Repentance is a heart felt sorrow of our sinful life and a desire to change. It is not, however, what saves us. It is only the shed blood of Yahusha Messiah that can wash away our sins. But without being baptized for the remission of sins, that precious blood would not apply to us.



Q8, What happens when you go under the water at Baptism? **NEWNESS OF LIFE** SHOULD BE WITHIN EVERY **BELIEVER!**

Romans 6:3, Paul tells us, "Know you not, that so many of us that were baptized into Yahusha Messiah were baptized into His death." Who was it that died on the tree for our sins? We know that He was Yahusha the Messiah. That is why we declare unto the world that all must be baptized into the Name of Yahusha for the remission of sins. Romans 6:4 goes on to say that, as we are buried with Yahusha by baptism into death, as Messiah was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. Does that sound as if we should be baptized merely because of a ritual?



Q9, How do we demonstrate true faith in Yahusha?

Baptism is an act of faith in our willingness to be at one with Yahusha and His resurrection, as well as in His death. Jesus never existed he was an invention of Emperor Constantine who revived the pagan religion of Christianity. No other Name, but Yahusha Messiah can save us. Therefore, we are commanded to put off the things of the flesh to become a new creation. We must be born of Spirit through the only Name by which we can be saved which is Yahusha Messiah. 17



Q10, What happened when Philip preached the Good News to the Ethiopian Eunuch?

Philip preached the Good News first, so that the Ethiopian Eunuch understood that it required repentance and turning away from your sins as well as obedience to the Torah, to which the Eunuch responded by expressing a desire to be baptized. Baptism was only administered after an expressed confession of a belief in the things which Philip had taught which is obedience to the Commandments, statutes and judgments.



Q11, How do we become part of the body of Yahusha?

It is at baptism that we enter into the Body of the Messiah. 1 Corinthians 12:13 says, "For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body." Notice we are NOT Baptized into a church denomination. We are Baptized into the Body of Yahusha. He is the root of the tree; we are the branches. We receive Yahusha's Spirit at baptism (Acts 2:38).

Galatians 3:27, "For all of you who were baptized into Messiah have clothed yourselves with Messiah." (Not a church denomination).



Q12, What Must I Do To Be Saved?

When asked what they should do, Peter responded, Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Yahusha Messiah for the remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the set-apart Spirit. Baptism is the acknowledgement of a previous sinful life unacceptable to our Heavenly Father, and the desire to become a "new man" of righteousness.



Q13, Was the Scripture in Matthew 28:19 changed?

"Therefore' go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit." The Catholic Encyclopedia, II, page 263: "The baptismal formula was changed from the name of Jesus Christ to the words Father, Son, and Holy Spirit by the Catholic Church in the second century." The phrase in the text "In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" was inserted later, by Emperor Constantine who wanted to promote the pagan Trinity doctrine at the First Nicaean Council of AD 325.



Q14, What is the correct reading of Matthew 28:19?

The correct reading of Matthew 28:19 appears to be in Luke 24:47, "and repentance for the forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in his name (Yahusha) to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem."

Here is the Cepher translation, "And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name (Yahusha) among all nations, beginning at Yerushalayim."



Q15, What happened at the first sermon preached by Peter?

The first sermon preached by Peter was so moving and powerful, 3,000 people were baptized. Notice: They were not baptized in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, as Matthew 28:19 says. Rather, Acts 2:38 reveals that Peter told them to be baptized in the Name of Yahusha Messiah. Throughout the Book of Acts, the practice was to be immersed only into Yahusha's Name, not into the triune (Trinitarian) doctrine of the "Father, Son, and Holy Ghost."

John 14:8-9 8 Philip said, "Master, show us the Father and that will be enough for us." 9 Yahusha

answered: "Don't you know me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, '

Show us the Father'?

YAHUAH = YAHUSHA



Q16, What do we acknowledge when we are baptized into Yahusha's Name?

Deuteronomy 6:4, "Hear O Israel Yahuah is ONE. You shall love Yahuah your Elohim with all your heart and soul." When you are baptized in the Name of Yahusha, you are acknowledging the fact that "Yahuah is Salvation," the purpose of the entire Book. Yahusha said I and the Father are ONE. If you have seen me, you have seen the Father. Yahusha is the Father in bodily form. Yahuah is invisible. You acknowledge Deuteronomy 6:4 which proves that Yahuah is ONE, not 2 or 3 beings. Colossians 1:15 to 18 "He (Yahusha (is the image of the invisible Elohim, the firstborn of all creation. For by him all things were created. And he (Yahusha, is the head of the body, the assembly."



Q17, Does being baptized as a baby by sprinkling equal the Biblical Baptism?

The answer is No. This is a Roman Catholic tradition and is not Biblical. You need to be old enough to understand the Good News Message and then you can be Baptized according to the Scriptures. Baby Sprinkling comes from ancient Babylon where the new birth was conferred by 'baptism.' (Water baptism without personal faith in Yahusha is a mockery of Yahuah's Word and a great sin.) In the Chaldean mysteries, before any instruction could be received, it was required first that the person to be initiated by submitting to 'baptism of sprinkling.' In certain sacred rites of the heathen," says (Roman church 'father') Tertullian, especially referring to the worship of Isis and Mithra, "the mode of initiation is baptism by sprinkling."



Q18 Do you have to be baptized by a church denomination by a pastor or priest?

The Great Commission, with its command to go teach and then and baptize all nations, was given to the apostles and anyone who has been Baptized, is then an apostle and is told to go teach and make disciples of all nations. You cannot be baptized by a church pastor because he will baptize you into that church denomination which is not what Scripture teaches. We are Baptized into Yahusha Messiah our Melchisedek High Priest. One faith, one Baptism and by One **Spirit**. We are not to be baptized into any church denomination because all church denominations are part of Roman Catholicism pagan doctrines. We need to be baptized into Yahusha Messiah our High Priest only, so that we belong to Him.



Q19, How can you compare Baptism to being engaged to Yahusha our Bridegroom?

By being baptized into the Name of Yahusha Messiah, we show others that we commit our life to Him fully and others can see we now belong to Yahusha. Satan is not happy as he wants to see you deceived and lost for all eternity.





Q20, Why do most churches baptize people by flipping them backwards into the water? Is this Biblical?

Baptisms (on behalf of the dead) at the Mormon temple. Mormons, as well as many other Protestants, typically lean the person backwards making the person rely on the priest or pastor to hold and flip them backwards into the water. Also in adult Catholic baptism, an adult woman was baptized by immersion as she held onto the priest and another person and flipped backwards into the water. Many Christian denominations do the same. This is Not Biblical but comes from Babylonian pagan traditions. 29



Q21, What is the Correct way to be Baptized according to Scripture using Yahusha as our example?

"And when Yahusha was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of Yahuah descending like a dove and coming to rest on him." Matthew 3:16. Notice John the Baptist was not holding Yahusha or flipping him backwards into the water. Yahusha simply bent his knees and went straight down under the water and then went straight up out of the water. This is the correct way to be Baptized. How do you think it was possible for Peter to Baptize 3000 people in one day? By using the same example as Yahusha, the people simply stood in the water deep enough to be able to go under the water by bending their knees and then coming straight up out of the water.



Q22, What does it mean to die a Spiritual Death?

Baptism represents a death of our old sinful nature. Paul in Romans 6:3 states, "Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Yahusha Messiah were baptized into his death?" (you die to your old life of sin when we are buried and go under the water). Paul explains that baptism represents a type of burial. The death that it represents is something special; it symbolizes the death of Yahusha the Messiah. When we're immersed into Yahusha's Name we symbolically take part in His death. By dying to Yahusha through baptism we put to death our old man and essentially become part of Yahusha and His righteousness. We come out a new creation wanting to be like Yahusha and hating sin.



Q23, What will happen if I do not get baptized in the Name of Yahusha as I was already baptized in the name of the father, the son and the holy spirit? Surely Yahuah knows my heart and will understand?

Scripture says, "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?" Jeremiah 17:9. We cannot trust our heart, or our thoughts and opinions. We need to be obedient to the Scriptures.





Q24, What will happen if we choose to ignore being baptized into the Name of Yahusha Messiah?

It should be remembered that a sinner cannot enter into Yahuah's Kingdom, Romans 6:9-11, and that only those in Messiah through Baptism will be resurrected at His Second Coming, (1Corinthians 15:23). Paul goes on to say in Romans 6:4-5, "Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Mashiach was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. 5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection," (Cepher)

Q25, What does it mean to have newness of life?

"Therefore, if anyone is in Yahusha, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!"

Yahuah was reconciling the world to himself in Yahusha, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. (in right standing). 2 Corinthians 5;17. Newness of life means we turn away from all our sins and evil ways to live a righteous life of obedience to the Commandments, statutes and judgements. Paul confirms here that baptism represents a death; the death of Yahusha Messiah. He also explains that after baptism we are to walk in newness of life. The word "newness" comes from the Greek kainotes and refers to a "renewal."



• At baptism, we start over as a new person with a new life hating sin and evil and goals that make Yahuah and His Word the center of our lives. We become dead to our old man and walk in a new and better way. This is what it means to walk in newness of life in obedience.

Q26, Who do we belong to if we do not get baptized in the Name of Yahusha Messiah?

We belong to Satan because we choose to be rebellious even though we know what Scriptures says. Without baptism in Yahusha's Name, we don't belong to Him and cannot partake in His resurrection. v6, Paul explains the need of removing sin: "Knowing this, that our old man is impaled with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin.... Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto Elohim, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto Elohim," verses 6-7, 12-13.

Q27, What does it mean, when Paul stated that at Baptism our old man is impaled with Yahusha the Messiah?

We impale the flesh so that our carnal, sinful nature might be destroyed. After Baptism we can no longer justifiably live a life of sin. Therefore, Scripture describes baptism as a death to our old sinful nature. If something is dead, it no longer exists. For example, Scripture says that the dead cannot praise Yahuah. Baptism works the same way regarding sin. Those immersed into Yahusha's Name turn away from sin and the breaking of Yahuah's commandments, 1John 3:4. We obey the Torah and all the Scriptures, and we walk in this truth.



Q28, Should you postpone being baptized in the name of Yahusha because you feel you are not ready?

If we are committed to our Heavenly Father, Yahuah, and to our Savior, Yahusha the Messiah, there's no reason to wait. After the basic teachings of Scripture is understood, a person does not need to be perfect for baptism but only possess a resolute faith and a humble heart to faithfully obey the One they worship.


Baptism is only the start of the process of change, it is one step at the time when we understand new truth in the Scriptures, we obey this truth so that more wisdom and understanding can be given to you. When we sin Yahusha's Spirit living in us convicts us of our sins and we are to immediately listen to that still small voice and repent.



Q29, How do you get more faith?

More faith comes when you understand a new thing in Scripture and then start to obey it. If you want more faith you need to spend more time in the Scriptures each day, reading, meditating on the Scriptures and praying. Also take time to be quiet so you can hear Yahusha speak to you. When you are weak and feel tempted to go and sin, call out to Yahusha and He will empower you to not be tempted. Stay away from friends, family members who will take you back to your sinful life.

Q30, What should you do when you go under the water?

Prepare for baptism beforehand by repenting of all the sins that you can remember and ask Yahuah to forgive you. When you go under the water pray to Yahusha to forgive you of all your sins, confess your sins that you can remember to Him and ask Him to give you a new heart and mind to love to do His will.



Q31, Can you be part of the New Covenant if you are not baptized in Yahusha Messiah?

Your sins cannot be washed away without water Baptism in the name of Yahusha. Do not delay, if you love Yahusha be baptized so that you come in New Covenant with Him, and you then become grafted into the Vine which is Yahusha Messiah, and you then are part of Israel (An overcomer of sins).



Q32, What does it mean to be in Covenant with Yahuah?

Being in covenant with Yahuah is the same as saying to Him, "I will do everything that you have commanded." This is what happened at Mount Sinai. The Israelites and the mixed multitude that came out of Egypt made a Covenant promise to Yahuah after hearing Him speak all the Torah Commandments to them. They said, "All that You say we will do." Exodus 24:3. This is what happened at Mount Sinai and when they agreed to do all that Yahuah commanded, that is when they became "Israel" until the Golden Calf when they broke the Covenant.



Q33, What does Yahuah's Covenant consist of?

A Covenant consists of 4 Important Things

1 PROPOSAL .. "Come unto me and be righteous and obey my voice."

2 ACCEPTANCE ... When we say "All that you say we will do."

3 BLOOD RATIFICATION ...Making it official through Baptism and partaking of the Passover of bread, wine and foot washing. Ratification meaning: Acceptance or confirmation of an act or agreement that was agreed upon by the confirming party or person.

4 COVENANT CONFIRMING MEAL ... which we do at Passover in remembrance of the death of Yahusha. The marriage supper of the Lamb will take place in the New Jerusalem when we become His Bride and live with Him for all eternity.



Q34, What happens if you do not have a believer living near you as a witness and you desire to be baptized?

You can baptize yourself because in reality you are showing obedience and faith in Yahusha Messiah your Savior and High Priest. You can say the prayer showing at a later slide before you go under the water and be confident that Yahusha acknowledges your faithfulness as all of heaven as well as Yahusha will be celebrating this wonderful day when you are Baptized into the Name of Yahusha Messiah so that you can enjoy eternal life. No other Name can save you. Yahusha is the door to the Father. Yahusha is the Way, the Truth and the Life. No-one comes to the Father but through Him.

You can go to a river, lake or ocean to be Baptized. If you do not have any of these near you, you can baptize yourself in a swimming pool. Make sure to wear clothing that is not see through when you come out of the water. If you have a white top or shirt that is also good with a pair of pants (not short shorts).





BAPTISM PRAYER

Yahusha, My Savior and My High Priest, I confess all my sins to you today (name them in your mind). I Repent and turn away from these sins and I ask you to forgive me and help me to love you with all my heart and all my soul. I confess that Yahuah is One according to Deuteronomy 6;4 and I believe in One Elohim, the invisible Father revealed bodily in His Son Yahusha and by One Spirit I ask You to dwell in me, lead me and guide me each and every day. AMEIN.

You are now ready to go and teach and baptize and make disciples of all nations in the Name of Yahusha. This is the Great Commission that is for all Believers in Yahusha Messiah.

We have been wrongly taught that it is the job of the priest or pastor of the church to do these things only. What deception. It is time for Yahuah's people to wake up and obey the Scriptures Alone. We need to Come OUT of all church denominations and religions to follow Yahusha Messiah.


