

## Q1 What is the foundation of being in Covenant and having an intimate relationship with Yahuah?

You can have all the knowledge of the Scriptures but if you don't have **love for others**, you are like an empty vessel deceiving yourself.

### Q3 What are spiritual slaughter offerings (sacrifices) that are acceptable to Yahuah?

1. Surrendering our will to Yahuah by obeying His Covenant. **“Yet not My will but let Yours be done.”** Luke 22:42.
2. To remain strong in the faith, even through persecution. **“And after you have suffered a little while, the Elohim of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Yahusha, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.”** 1 Peter 5:10.
3. Spiritual sacrifices replace the animal sacrifices and Aaronic priesthood of the Book of the Law. **We are a kingdom of priests under the order of Melchizedek with Yahusha as our Melchizedek High priest.**

4. Prayer is a spiritual sacrifice. **“May my prayer be set before you like incense.”** (Psalm 141:2). We are to pray **without ceasing** believing that Yahuah hears our prayers.

Thessalonians 5:17 to 19.

Spiritual sacrifices is living as an example to others by showing love, kindness, patience and crucifying our flesh by getting rid of our pride, stubbornness and all the things that are not pleasing to Yahuah.



## **Punishment for Disobedience and ignoring the Covenant of Yahuah.**




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**Q5 Are the Ten Commandments the only law found in the Blood Covenant of Yahuah?**

The answer is **NO**. All the Everlasting Commandments, statutes and judgments are found in the Blood Covenant which was sealed with Yahusha's blood therefore we cannot remove any laws from Yahuah's Covenant.

**Q6 How many times did Moses go up and down the mountain to get all the Covenant laws from Yahuah?**

**Moses had **TEN encounters** at Mt Sinai. Eight of them were “up and down” the mountain. Two encounters were:**

- 1) at the burning bush;**
- 2) when Moses moved the Tent of Meeting outside the camp. (Exodus). Request full study on this topic. Three of the ten encounters were connected to Yahuah’s laws:**


**Trip #5: (Exo 20:21) Moses receives the judgments for the rest of the Book of Covenant Laws after the 10 Commandments were spoken.**

**Trip #6: (Exo 24:9-18) Moses at the top of Mt Sinai 40 days & 40 nights – receives the Commandments engraved upon the tables of stone including the judgments in Exo 21-23 (Exo 34:15).**

**Trip #10 (Exo 34:4) Moses returns to the top of Mt Sinai to have receive the 2nd set of Tablets on stone to replace the broken set.**

**Q7 Who was chosen as Mediator of Yah's people in the wilderness as the people did not want to allow Yahuah to continue speaking to them directly?**

Exodus 3:10 **“And now, come, I am sending you to Pharaoh, to bring My people, the children of Yisra'ěl, out of Mitsrayim.”** Moses was chosen by Yahuah as mediator between Israel and Yah in the role of the last earthly order of the Melchizedek Priest until the Messiah. Moses told the people Israel, **“(YHVH) יהוה your Elohim shall raise up for you a Prophet like me from your midst, from your brothers. Listen to Him.”** Deuteronomy 18:15. This is referring to Yahusha who is our eternal Melchizedek High Priest.

**Q8 What are the 4 requirements to seal Covenant between Yahuah and His people?**

**The 4 requirements to seal the Book of the Covenant between Yah and His people Israel are as follows:**

## 1. Proposal from Yahuah.

Exodus 19:5,6, 'And now, if you diligently obey My voice, and shall guard My covenant, then you shall be My treasured possession above all the peoples – for all the earth is Mine 'and you shall be to Me a reign of priests and a set-apart nation.' Those are the words which you are to speak to the children of Yisra'ël."



2. **Acceptance by the people.** Exodus 19:8, “All the words which Yah has said we will do.” (There were 2 more acceptances in Exodus 24:5 & 7.)

3. **Blood Ratification of the Book of the Covenant and of the people.**

Hebrews 9:19-22

Exodus 24:8, “And Mosheh took the blood and sprinkled it on the people, and said, “See, the blood of the covenant which יהוה has made with you concerning all these Words.”



- 4. **Sealed with a covenant confirming meal.** The covenant meal was eaten by the 75 leaders of Israel in the presence of Yahuah, as the final act of ratification that nothing shall be added or taken away from these covenant words. Exodus 24:9 to 11  
And Mosheh went up, also Aharon, Naḏab, and Aḇihu, and seventy of the elders, and they saw the Elohim of Yisra'ěl, and under His feet like a paved work of sapphire stone, and like the heavens for brightness. Yet He did not stretch out His hand against the chiefs of the children of Yisra'ěl! And they saw Elohim, and they ate and drank.



- All 4 requirements for the Book of the Covenant were definitely made with Israel. This covenant was also for the great multitude that came out of Egypt. **The same principle applies today: upon acceptance of the everlasting covenant, anyone can be grafted in (adopted) at any time.**

## Q9 Who spoke the first part of the Covenant to the people Israel?

The 10 Commandments [as 1st part of the Covenant] was spoken by Yahuah from Mt Sinai. (He was just getting started; not done yet, but ...) The people were fearful of the voice of Yahuah and backed away from the mountain. Exodus 20:18 to 21 **“And all the people saw the thunders, the lightning flashes, the sound of the ram’s horn, and the mountain smoking. And the people saw it, and they trembled and stood at a distance and said to Mosheh, “You speak with us, and we hear, but let not Elohim speak with us, lest we die.”**”

And Mosheh said to the people, “Do not fear, for Elohim has come to prove you, and in order that His fear be before you, so that you do not sin.” So, the people stood at a distance, but Mosheh drew near the thick darkness where Elohim was.” So, Moses went back up the mountain to get the rest of the statutes and judgments which are part of the Covenant. Yahuah then said to Moses, **“But as for thee, stand thou here by me, and I will speak unto thee all the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which thou shalt teach them, that they may do them in the land which I give them to possess it.”** Deuteronomy 5:31 (KJV) **These Scriptures show us clearly that the statutes and judgments were all part of the Covenant not just the Ten Commandments.**

## Q10 What other laws that are part of the Covenant did Moses receive on his 5th trip up Mount Sinai?

Mt Sinai trip 5 in Exodus 20:21 – Moses to Receive 2nd Part of the Covenant listed in Ex 20:22-Ex 23:33. [The words of this covenant are about 3000 words – laws to govern a whole nation for all time.] While he's up there he receives the rest of the Words of Yah [as noted in the list below].

The remaining “Laws of the Covenant” are recorded in 105 verses from Exodus 20:22 to Exodus 23:33.



# Q10

1. Law of the Altar (specifically not to make any molten idols of silver or gold.)
2. Law concerning Servants (those that had a debt to pay off): Exodus 21:1 to 32).
3. Laws of Restitution, (restoration of something lost or stolen to its proper owner), violence and animal control and Responsibility for Property: Exodus 21:33 to 22:15.
4. Moral and Ceremonial Principles: Exodus 22:16-31. [Note Exodus 22:20: worship no other gods on penalty of death! This command is listed 5-6 times in this everlasting covenant.]

5. Laws about Social Justice for All: Exodus 23:1-9. (Note again: No Mention of Other gods upon your Lips. Exodus 23:13, **“And in all that I have said to you take heed. And make no mention of the name of other mighty ones, let it not be heard from your mouth.”**)
6. The Law of the Sabbatical Years (Exodus 23:10-11) & Weekly Sabbath (vs. 12).
7. Laws About the Sabbath and Festivals of Yahuah. Exodus 23:10 to 23:19.

## Q11 What Feast Days are mentioned in the Blood Ratified Covenant?

**ALL of Yahuah's Feast Days are in the blood ratified Covenant and cannot be removed. They are forever and teach us the plan of salvation. If we ignore Yahuah's Feast days, we are breaking His Covenant.**

Exodus 23:14 to 19, "Three times in the year you are to observe a festival to Me: The Festivals of יהוה are grouped in three, for three different times of the year. Exo 23:15, "Guard the Festival of Unleavened Bread. Seven days you eat unleavened bread, as I commanded you, at the time appointed in the month of Abib – for in it you came out of Mitsrayim – and do not appear before Me empty-handed.

Exo 23:16, “And the Festival of the Harvest, the Firstfruits of your labors which you have sown in the field; and the Festival of the Ingathering (Tabernacles) at the outgoing of the year, when you have gathered in the fruit of your labors from the field.

Exo 23:17, “Three times in the year all your males are to appear before the Master יהוה (YHVH)

Exo 23:18, “Do not offer the blood of My slaughtering with leavened bread, and the fat of My offering shall not remain until morning.

Exo 23:19, “Bring the first of the Firstfruits of your land into the House of יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim. Do not cook a young goat in its mother’s milk.”

Q12 Is the Covenant of Yahuah also part of following the correct calendar at the correct times and days?

**Yes**, Yahuah's Covenant Calendar is part of the everlasting Covenant therefore, we need to keep it on the correct times and days as He is saying in Deuteronomy 5:33 "And you shall guard to do as יהוה your Elohim has commanded you – do not turn aside to the right or to the left. Walk in all the way which יהוה your Elohim has commanded you, so that you live, and it be well with you. And you shall prolong your days in the land which you possess."

The Covenant Calendar is part of the Blood-Ratified Covenant that is found completely between the pages of Genesis 1:1 to Exodus 24:11 and stands in complete alignment with Yahusha Ha Mashiach's everlasting Blood-ratified Book of the Covenant under the highest order of the Melchizedek Priesthood. The requirements for the six calendar components are also found between Genesis 1:1 to Exodus 24:11. These are discussed next.

## **Yahuah HAS A BLOOD RATIFIED COVENANT WITH THE DAY AND THE NIGHT**

“This is what Yahuah says: ‘If you can break my covenant with the day and my covenant with the night, so that day and night no longer come at their appointed time, then My covenant may also be broken with David My servant and with My ministers the Levites who are priests, so that David will not have a son to reign on his throne. Jeremiah 33;20.

If you begin your day at sunset, then you are breaking the blood Covenant of Yahuah as Creation began with LIGHT and **we are children of the LIGHT not darkness.**

## Q13 When is the DAY START of the Covenant Calendar?

**DAY-START:** Genesis 1:3 “And Elohim said, “Let LIGHT come to be,” and light came to be.” Genesis 1:5 “And Elohim called the LIGHT ‘DAY’ and the DARKNESS He called ‘NIGHT.’ And there came to be evening and there came to be morning, the first day.” Every day begins with the first LIGHT in the “dawn” sky called twilight. Everything on Day 1 of Creation began with LIGHT ... and do remember there was no sunrise “or” sunset until the 4th day of creation. (Remember: today, while the sunrise may follow shortly after the dawn daybreak, the day does NOT begin with sunrise, but with light.)

## Q14 How many hours in a Biblical day?

**DAY-LENGTH: It is the conviction of Life-Line to Yahusha Ministries, not of the presenter**, that every day of creation (including the weekly Shabbat) has a full 24 hours including morning twilight, the Daylight Season; the evening twilight and then the Night Season – in this order. Yahusha said, John 11:9, “**Are there not twelve hours in the day?** If anyone walks in the day, he does not stumble, because he sees the light of this world.” There is also 12 hours of night. They conclude that every Sabbath, whether weekly or an annual Sabbath, has a commanded full 24 hours (day and night) for rest, worship, praise, prayer, fellowship, and feasting.

It is **their** conclusion that the Shabbat, the set-apart hours, begin at “dawn twilight” and ends at “dawn twilight” on what the Roman calendar calls Sunday. Yahuah’s calendar is not a Roman calendar that begins any day at midnight. It simply is Shabbat until the next dawn begins to illuminate the sky with light ... then the day (the 24-hour cycle) turns to the 1st cycle of the week. (Matthew 28:1). “Now after the Sabbath, toward dawn on the first day of the week.”

## Q15 How do you calculate the start of the Biblical year?

**YEAR-START:** (The following is for the northern hemisphere explanation. The southern folk will make the necessary adjustments.) When the sun finishes its circuit in the heavens after a year of travel, (through the twelve constellations) and changes the “winter season” to the “spring season,” this “equinox” event is what determines the END of the old year, and the START of the new year, on the next day.

(Psalm 19:1-6) “The heavens are proclaiming the esteem of Ėl; And the expanse is declaring the work of His hand. Day to day pours forth speech, And night to night reveals knowledge. There is no speech, and there are no words, their voice is not heard. Their line has gone out through all the earth, And their words to the end of the world. In them He set up a tent for the sun and it is like a bridegroom coming out of his room, it rejoices like a strong man to run the path. Its rising is from one end of the heavens, and its CIRCUIT (Tekufah) to the other end; And naught is hidden from its heat.” Circuit is a circular line, route, or movement that starts and finishes at the same place.


- **HOW TO FIND THE EQUINOX**

- Measure the angle of rise or fall of the path. The day on which this angle is the same in the forenoon and afternoon is the day of the equinox. This fixes the date of the equinox, even if the blackboard is not due east and west since it fixes the date on which the path is a straight line.

- **SPRING EQUINOX**

- In the Northern Hemisphere,
- the March equinox (aka spring y
- quinox or vernal equinox) occurs
- when the Sun crosses the equator
- line, from south to north.


- In the Northern Hemisphere the vernal equinox falls about March 20 or 21, as the Sun crosses the celestial equator going north. In the Southern Hemisphere the equinox occurs on September 22 or 23, when the Sun moves south across the celestial equator.



**In the Northern Hemisphere the day after the equinox is always listed as the first day of spring, and rightly so.** This is the time of the “greening” (or Abib) when the land comes back to life. “This month is the beginning of months for you, it is the first month of the year for you.” Exodus 12:2 is noticeably clear the start of the year, and the beginning of the first month were when **the crops were “in Abib”** ... and we know from the plagues the barley had just been destroyed while in the head. This is the springtime in the northern hemisphere. (Note: the **year start** is not determined by “looking at the sun” but by **a combination of 4 components** that are needed to produce an equinox, namely: 1. The Mazzaroth (12 constellations) 2. the Sun’s circuit ending at the same place each year in the Mazzaroth; 3. **LIGHT** is needed to cast a shadow; 4. the Earth is needed to receive the Light & Shadows.)

## AUTUMN OR SEPTEMBER EQUINOX

The equinox occurs precisely when the Sun's center passes through this line. When the Sun crosses the equator from north to south, this marks the autumnal equinox; when it crosses from south to north, this marks the vernal equinox.



## Q16 How many days in a Biblical year?

**YEAR-LENGTH:** For the first 3300 years from creation, Yahuah's year was composed of 360 days and that was all. From the flood account in Gen 7 and 8 ... 5 months were equal to 150 days. The flood occurred approximately 2000 BC. Following the footsteps of Moses from Egypt to Mt Sinai around 1500 BC, the calendar still had 30-day months from Passover in the 1st month, to the Quail/Manna in the 2nd month, to Pentecost (and giving of the Everlasting Book of the Covenant Laws) in the 3rd month.

The *3.5 years* are 3.5 Biblical years of 360 days and the 42 months are 42 Biblical months of 30 days. All seven verses are speaking of 1260 days.

## Q17 When did the earth's year length change to 365 days?

The earth's year length did change **with a huge shift at Hezekiah's sundial miracle** (Isaiah 38), where Hezekiah asked Yahuah to make the sun go backwards, which added 5+ days to the 360 days of the creation year. However, this does not change the length of Yahuah's Festal Calendar ... it is still 360 days, and that is all. Inevitably, until He changes the earth's year length back to 360 days, the extra waiting days from count 361-365/366 are exactly "that" ... they are days that are "waited out" watching for the equinox "sign" or "shadow" on the ground to determine the day of the "turning of the year" has arrived, just as the great pyramids with Joseph in Egypt still determine today.

Acts 7:22, “And Moses was instructed in all the wisdom of the Egyptians and was mighty in words and works. Moses knew when the year start was, and he knew the equinox calculation of those pyramids was also in alignment with Yahuah’s instructions for the year-start. It all started with Joseph being sent to Egypt where a lot of calendar truths were preserved for His people over that prophetic time frame of 400 years from Abraham to the departure from Egypt. Do this interesting math ...  
 $360 \text{ days/year} \times 400 \text{ years} = 144,000 \text{ days}$  from Abraham to Moses’ deliverance of Yah’s people from Egypt! Amazing!

- **YEAR-START:**

(The following is for the northern hemisphere explanation. The southern folk will make the necessary adjustments.) When the sun finishes its circuit in the heavens after a year of travel and changes the “winter season” to the “spring season” this “equinox” event is what determines the END of the old year, and the START of the new year, the next day. (Psalm 19:1-6).



- **Why is it called Equinox?**

On the days of the equinoxes, the Earth's axis is perpendicular to the sun's rays, meaning that all regions on Earth receive about the same number of hours of sunlight. In other words, night and day are, in principle, close to the same length all over the world. In the Northern Hemisphere the day after the equinox is always listed as the first day of spring, and rightly so. This is the time of the "greening" (or Abib) when the land comes back to life.

# How long is a year?

- ▶ The Bible supports a 360 day year in Genesis, Daniel and Revelation
  - ▶ The Flood
    - ▶ 5 months = 150 days
      - ▶ 30 days/month = 360 days/year

## Q18 How do you work out when the Biblical month starts?

**MONTH-START:** Covenant Calendar does not use any of the moon's cycles to determine the 1st day of any month. Gazing at the sun or the moon for the purpose of setting time frames of any worship statutes is strictly forbidden by Moses in two very clear commands found in Deuteronomy 4:19, **“and lest you lift up your eyes to the heavens, and shall see the sun, and the moon, and the stars – all the host of the heavens – and you be drawn away into bowing down to them and serving them, which יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim has allotted to all the peoples under all the heavens.”**

**Deuteronomy 17:2-5, “When there is found in your midst, in any of your cities which יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim is giving you, a man or a woman who does what is evil in the eyes of יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim, in transgressing His covenant, and has gone and served other mighty ones and bowed down to them, or to the sun or to the moon or to any of the host of the heavens, which I have not commanded and it has been made known to you and you have heard, and has searched diligently. Then see, if true: the matter is confirmed that such an abomination has been done in Yisra’ěl, then you shall bring out to your gates that man or woman who has done this evil matter, and you shall stone to death that man or woman with stones.”**

**Gazing at the sun and moon is an abomination to Yahuah and for disobedience the penalty was death by stoning.** The moon is not given for worship commands, but for ordinances to bless the earth and mankind with bountiful blessings of harvests; Deuteronomy 33:14 “with the choice fruits of the sun, with the choice yield of the months.” (Do note in Jeremiah 31:35 “Thus said יהוה (YHVH) who gives the sun for a light by day, and the laws (Ordinances) of the moon and the stars for a light by night, who stirs up the sea, and its waves roar – יהוה of hosts is His Name. “

# The Biblical Calendar

## Month of the Year in Exodus 12

### Month of the Year:

*“This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.” Exodus 12: 2.*

The time of the 10th plague of Egypt was in the spring around the month of **March - April**. The religious year started around that time. **Abib** means: Barley is Ripe.



The “light” of the sun rules the day ...



**The “constant light” of the stars  
rule the night ...**



... and **the moon is given for ordinances**. As an example of “one” of these ordinances, the tides of the sea is mentioned. The moon is never the “ruler” of the night, being found in the day sky more than half of every month.

The moon is simply incapable of fulfilling Yahuah's command to "divide the day from the night" Genesis 1:14 "And Elohim said, "Let lights come to be in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be for signs and appointed times, and for days and years." Because the moon has a prevalent lunar presence during the light of the Day Season, it is easy to see the moon has no authority over the division of day and night. Neither does the moon have any divine authority to commence the festal months, or the weekly/annual Shabbats as was practiced by many pagans over 1000s of years.) Jeremiah 31:35 "Thus saith Yahuah, which giveth the sun for a light by day, and the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for a light by night, which divideth the sea when the waves thereof roar; Yahuah of hosts is his name."

## Q19 How many days in a Biblical month?

**MONTH-LENGTH:** As already mentioned, Yahuah's month consists of 30 days each (Genesis 7-8 ... 5 months had 150 days). There are 12 months in the year – we find provision by wise King Solomon for his court by designating certain officers to be in charge for one month of every year. He made provisions for only 12 months in a year, never was there provision for a 13th month (1 Chronicles 27:1-15).

The number “12” can be found in 187 places in the Scriptures. Revelation alone has twenty-two occurrences of this number; one extremely important example being the tree of life (Revelation 22:2) bearing twelve fruits, one every month. The meaning of “12” (which is considered a perfect number), **symbolizes Yahuah’s power and authority, as well as serving as a perfect governmental foundation.** The number “13” never has a place in naming anything in Yahuah’s Covenant Calendar. The New Jerusalem has twelve gates named after the twelve tribes of Israel.

## Q20 What do we look to for Yahuah's Covenant Calendar if we do not look to the sun or the moon?

**Yahuah's Covenant Calendar is simply designed by "LOOKING TO THE LIGHT" and "learning to count."** It is a "Covenant Count." All He asks is that we look to the "light" to begin the day; watch for the equinox shadow to know when to commence the year, and then learn to count: 1-30 for each month; 1-12 for 12 months of the year; or 1-360 counting each day in His calendar. Because He knows the "end from the beginning" (Isa 46:9-10) and promises that we too can know the "end from the beginning" He has shown by many timeline prophecies in Revelation that His calendar will be re-instated before the end of time. 1260 days (in Rev 11, 12 and 13) is equal to 42 months of 30 days each. .



**Q20**

In Scripture, there is no provision for any year, (in those 3½ years), to have an additional 13th month. These timelines are specifically given for the Bride to know how to walk out her steps in the last days of an urgent message to the world to repent before it is too late. If you are following the wrong Calendar, you will miss the Wedding date as the Bride of Yahusha! If you miss that date, you will lose your salvation. What an incredible “sign” from our Master of the Covenant Calendar to provide for His Bride and His people everywhere that when our current year goes back to the way it was in the beginning – back to only 360 days/year; a huge sign to His people that indeed He is still in control.

Q21 What happened to the city of Jericho who worshipped the lunar-based calendar which added a thirteenth month?

There is however one brilliant instance when the number 13 provides a very strong example for calendar considerations. It was upon the 13th march around the central center of moon worship – Jericho – that Yahuah felled the walls (foundation) of the city and its lunar based system of worship. The chosen people of Yahuah then walked into the city with the lunar foundation for worship under their feet as seen prophetically in Revelation 12:1 – Bethula, Yahuah’s chosen Bride, seen with the moon (lunar-based worship) under her feet. ...

Ephesians 1:22, “**And He (Yahuah) put all things in subjection under His (Yahusha’s) feet and gave Him as head over all things to the assembly.**” Matthew 22:44, יהוה (YHVH) said to my Master, “**Sit at My right hand, until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet**” Under her feet therefore shows that the Bride of Yahusha will not follow lunar moon calendars which are all pagan worship and an abomination to Yahuah.

## Q22 What is the best part about Yahuah's Covenant Calendar?

THE BEST PART ABOUT YAHUAH'S COVENANT CALENDAR: Everything that has been lightly explained here about the six different components included in any/every calendar is this: All six of these components with accurate description and instructions for fulfillment are found within the pages between GENESIS 1:1 TO EXODUS 24:11. Imagine that! The basic foundation of the whole Covenant Calendar is found in these few pages.

But even more exciting is this: from Genesis 1:1 to Exodus 24:11 is exactly where Yahuah's Blood-Ratified, Everlasting Book of the Covenant is found. The Words of this book are found in the four chapters of Exodus 20-23 ... **in Exodus 24:1-11 is where you will find these words are blood-ratified – not to be changed, added to, or subtracted from.**

## Q23 What was written on the two tablets of stone by Yahuah?

This blood ratified Book of the Covenant was taken by Moses to the top of Mt Sinai – and Yahuah Himself engraved these Words, (Exodus 20-21-22-23 – the Covenant Commands), onto the two tables of stone, front and back Exodus 32:15,16 “And Mosheh turned and went down from the mountain, and in his hand were the TWO TABLETS OF THE WITNESS, TABLETS WRITTEN ON BOTH THEIR SIDES, written on the one and on the other. And the tablets were the work of Elohim, and THE WRITING WAS THE WRITING OF ELOHIM ENGRAVED ON THE TABLETS.” These are the Words that still stand today. They are the perfect instructions from our Highest Melchizedek Priest, re-established and ratified by His blood at Calvary.

Q24 Is the Old Covenant Commandments, statutes, and judgments the same in the New Covenant?



Yahuah is the same yesterday,  
today and forever. Hebrews 13:8.  
My covenant I will not break, nor  
alter the word that has gone out of  
My lips. Psalm 89:34.

## Q25 Who broke Yahuah's Covenant?

Israel broke Yahuah's Covenant at the golden calf breach. Deuteronomy 29:25, "Because they (Israel) forsook the covenant of Yahuah their Elohim of their fathers, which He made with them when He brought them out of the land of Egypt. Hebrews 8:7 to 10 "**because THEY DID NOT CONTINUE IN MY COVENANT**, and I disregarded them," says YHVH **Because this is the covenant that I shall make with the house of Yisra'el after those days, says יהוה (YHVH), giving My laws in their mind, and I shall write them on their hearts, and I shall be their Elohim, and they shall be My people.**"

**Isaiah 24:5, “The earth is also polluted by its inhabitants, for they transgressed laws, violated statutes, broke the everlasting covenant.”**

## Q26 What is the difference between the Old and New Covenant?

The same Commandments, statutes and judgments are in both the old and new Covenant. Yahusha is the mediator and Melchizedek high priest of the New Covenant which is able to take away the sins of the world by His precious blood when He died on the tree for us. The Aaronic priesthood, temple and animal sacrifices are no longer needed as it was there to be a school master to Israel till Messiah comes. Hebrews 8:6, **“But now He (Yahusha) has obtained a more excellent service, in as much as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was constituted on better promises.”**

**Hebrews 7:1,12, “Truly, then, if perfection were through the Levitical priesthood – for under it the people were given the Torah – why was there still need for another priest to arise according to the order of Melchizedek, and not be called according to the order of Aharon?” For the priesthood being changed, of necessity there takes place a change of law (temple, Aaronic priesthood and animal sacrifices done away) also. “The better promises are from the New Covenant compared to the Book of the Law that could not save you.”**



**Q26**

**The only difference** between the Old and New Covenant **is the date**, just like a will has a date. An 1892 will might be re-written with identical contents in 1922 but it is still a new will because of the date. Also note, that with the New Covenant, it also is blood ratified with Yahusha's blood - the better blood than that of sacrificed animals.

Q27 Why is it important to partake of the New Covenant Passover and what does it represent?




Yahusha our Bridegroom has made an offer of Betrothal to us, to be His Bride. He has given her the Covenant promises, and He is now waiting for the Bride, to accept — or not accept — His Betrothal offer. When we do not celebrate the Passover, we reject the Passover Betrothal of Yahusha.

## Q28 According to Scripture, how does the prospective Bride accept the Bridegroom's offer?

The Bride's acceptance of the Bridegroom's offer of Betrothal is to be made by drinking of the same Covenant cup from which the Bridegroom drank, both literally and figuratively. Let us look at the Scriptures, to see what this Covenant Cup is. "Take, eat, this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me. After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the New Covenant in my blood: do this, as often as you drink it, (at Passover) in remembrance of me. For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, you do shew the Master's death till he comes." (1Corinthians 11:23-26).<sup>83</sup>

**Q29 What does foot washing at Passover represent?**



Yahusha humbled Himself when He washed the feet of the disciples, and we are to follow His example. **Humbling ourselves to be a servant for Yahusha is what foot washing represents.** Anyone who wants to be a true believer must humble themselves and serve others in humility. Matthew 23:1,12 “But the greatest among you shall be your servant. And whoever exalts himself shall be humbled, and whoever humbles himself shall be exalted.” We are His people, and we are also now in the Tabernacle of this fleshly body, the dwelling-place of Yahuah. (1Corinthians 6:19).

Thus, we are required to be 'sprinkled' by the physical Blood of the Covenant, by that which represents Messiah's Blood. This covenant sprinkling is done when we participate in the Body (bread) and Blood (grape juice) of the Passover meal. It requires us to be in Covenant with Yahusha agreeing and doing all His Commandments, statutes, and judgements. This includes keeping the seventh day Sabbath and Yahuah's Feast days as well as eating only "clean" food according to the dietary laws in Leviticus 11. We cannot partake of the New Covenant Betrothal Meal if we are not obeying His terms and conditions for His bride. (Covenant Torah).

## Q30 In closing, what does His blood have to do with Covenant Calendar?

Well, first the Covenant Calendar is found between those precious pages of Genesis 1:1 to Exodus 24:11, where for 2500 years the patriarchs and prophets lived out these covenant instructions – of which Calendar was a huge part for the weekly and annual worship statutes. This Covenant Calendar is also blood ratified by the precious blood of our Saviour Yahusha on HIS Passover day. Yahusha died on the Passover day of His Covenant Calendar. **You see, if Yahusha dies on any other calendar, He is automatically disqualified as the true Messiah.**

These are a few of the highlights of Covenant Calendar that make it divinely unique, special, simple, and elegant – so simple that children can actually calculate this calendar when they know how to count. The “key” to the knowledge and understanding of Yahuah’s true calendar has again been found. With just one divine swipe the Covenant Calendar can detect any counterfeit calendar that lingers to have dominance! Of utmost importance, Covenant Calendar upholds, re-establishes, supports, fulfills and exonerates each statute written in the Scriptures without exception. This statement is proven time and time again with each examination of the many different facets of calendar examples from the Scriptures.

This very fact is one that separates this blood ratified calendar from every other [counterfeit] calendar known to man. “Choose ye this day who you will serve” which calendar will be in alignment with the Creator’s design from the first day of creation – and also lived out in His life through the four Gospels with the final determined and sure witness in His death, burial, resurrection and two ascensions. That, my friend, will be the true calendar – with blessings galore.
