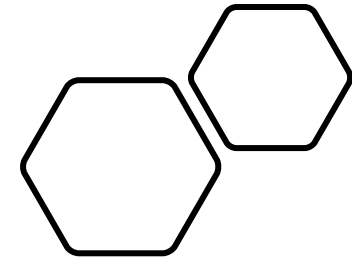




**Commandments,

Yahuah's instructions to His people are usually summarized under the three broad categories of Laws, Statutes and Judgments. All are binding and eternal. If we break one of them, we have sinned and are in rebellion to Yahuah. These laws are there for our protection and well-being to give us a blessed life and to keep us from danger, pain and suffering.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?**

**What is the whole duty of man?**

We are to fear (respect) Yahuah and guard (keep) His Commandments for this is the whole duty of man. Ecclesiastes 12:13.

Leviticus 18:4,5

4 'Do My right-rulings and guard My laws, to walk in them. I am יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim.

5 'And you shall guard My laws and My right-rulings,(My Commandments, statutes and judgements) which a man does and lives by them. I am Yahuah.

Contrary to what Christianity teaches, Yahuah's law was never "done away with," "nailed to the cross" or cancelled. Yah's law still applies to you today. "But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does" (James 1:25).

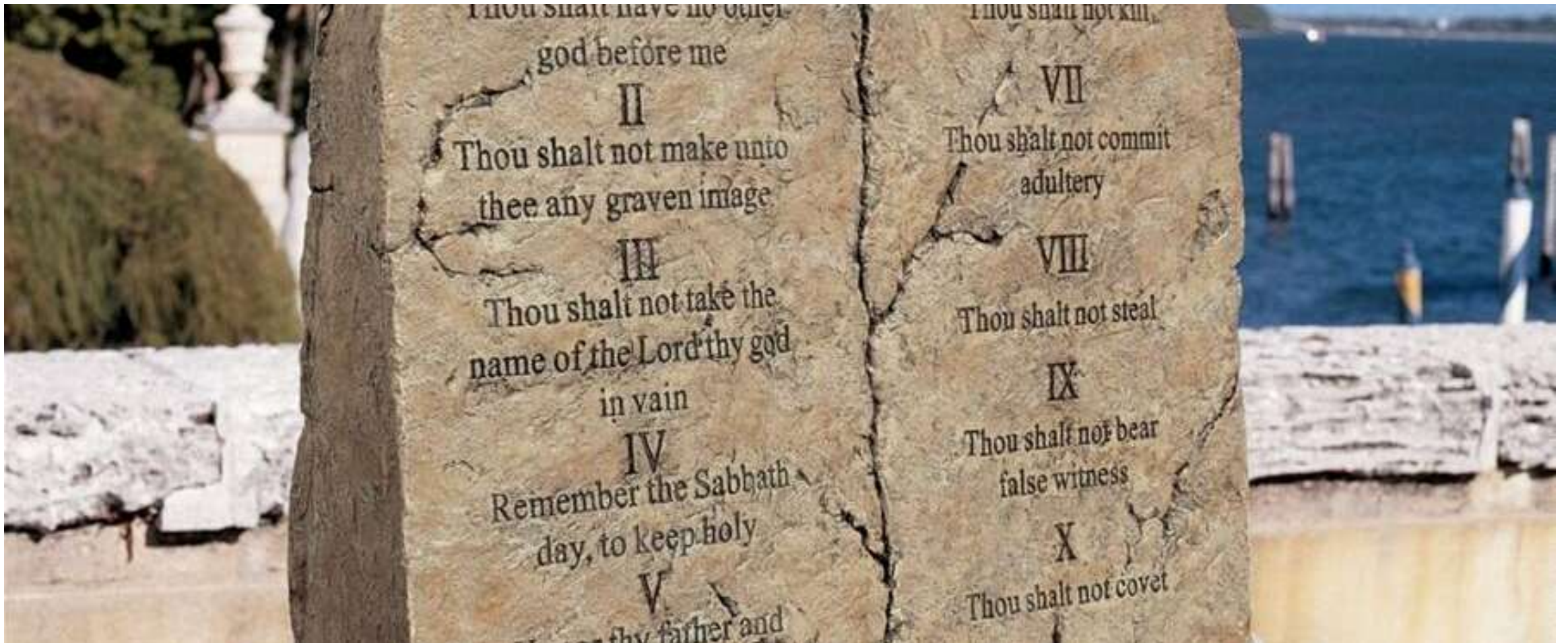
When Yahuah organized the people of Israel into a nation under the leadership of Moses, He authorized an administrative system that included not only priests but also judges to keep them on the path of righteousness (Deuteronomy 1:16-17). These judges were to perform their assigned duties according to the laws, statutes and judgments that Yahuah would reveal to them, either directly (as with the Ten Commandments) or through His messengers.



Taken together, Yahuah's laws, statutes and judgments lay the foundation for a righteous society and the administrative procedures needed to govern it. They all contain principles that are applicable to all peoples and are broad enough to be adapted to new situations.



# THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

And Yahuah spoke all these words, saying,

**# 1** I am Yahuah YOUR ELOHIM, which have brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. You shall have no other Elohims before ME. (no following of pagan worship and traditions).

**# 2** You shall not make unto you any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, ...





... or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: You shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them: for I Yahuah your ABBA am a jealous Almighty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate ME; And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love ME, and keep MY Commandments.





**# 3** You shall not take the NAME of Yahuah your ABBA in vain; for Yahuah will not hold him guiltless that take HIS NAME in vain.

**# 4** Remember the Shabbat day, to keep it Set Apart (holy). Six days shall you labour, and do all your work: But the seventh day is the Shabbat of Yahuah your Elohim, in it you shall not do any work, ...



... you, nor your son, nor your daughter, your manservant, nor your maidservant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger that is within your gates: For in six days Yahuah made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore Yahuah blessed the Shabbat day, and Set Apart (hallowed) it.



**# 5** Honor your father and your mother:  
that your days may be long upon the  
land which Yahuah your ABBA gives  
you.

**# 6** You shall not murder.

**# 7** You shall not commit adultery.

**# 8** You shall not steal.





**# 9** You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

**# 10** You shall not covet your neighbor's house, you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is your neighbour's.

# TEACH ME THY STATUTES



**The word “statutes” refers to a specific type of laws.** The word “statute” refers to an authoritative enactment, decree or ordinance.

Biblical statutes may set appointed times, such as sacred festivals, define important customs and even establish the manner or procedure by which certain vital matters are to be handled. Because they reveal Yahuah’s thinking and reflect His priorities, **they are crucially instructive as divine guidelines for righteous behavior.**




Statutes are similar to “sub commandments”  
...for example, we are commanded to “love  
others” ... One way to “love others” is to not  
“steal” from others and one way we are to not  
“steal” is to have “equal weights and  
measures.” A judgment would be the  
punishment prescribed in the Torah for theft.

Another example...we are commanded to “love Yahuah” ... One way to “love Yahuah” is to not “commit idolatry” and one way we are to not “commit idolatry” is to “not sacrifice to false Elohims” ...not sacrificing to false Elohims would be the statute. A judgment would be the punishment prescribed in the Torah for idolatry.

# Pertaining to Clean and Unclean Foods







Leviticus 11:2-47 “Speak to the children of Yisra’ěl, saying, ‘These are the living creatures which you do eat among all the beasts that are on the earth:

‘Whatever has a split hoof completely divided, chewing the cud, among the beasts, that you do eat.

‘But all that have not fins and scales in the seas and in the rivers, all that move in the waters or any living being which is in the waters, they are an abomination to you. ...





... 'And these you do abominate among the birds, they are not eaten, they are an abomination: the eagle, and the vulture, and the black vulture, and the hawk, and the falcon after its kind, every raven after its kind, and the ostrich, and the nighthawk, and the seagull, and the hawk after its kind, and the little owl, and the fisher owl, and the great owl, and the white owl, and the pelican, and the carrion vulture, and the stork, the heron after its kind, and the hoopoe, and the bat.



‘All flying insects that creep on all fours is an abomination to you.  
‘Whatever crawls on its stomach, and whatever goes on all fours, and whatever has many feet among all swarming creatures – the ones swarming on the earth, these you do not eat, for they are an abomination.




‘For I am יהוה (Yahuah) who is bringing you up out of the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt), to be your Elohim. And you shall be set apart, for I am set-apart. ‘Thou shalt not eat of the beasts that die, and of every living creature that creepeth upon the earth, and of every being that swarms on the earth, to make a distinction between the unclean and the clean, and between the living creature that is eaten and the living creature that is not eaten.’ ”

# **The Judgements**



Yahuah's judgments illustrate how righteous decisions should be made according to the principles revealed in His laws and statutes. He instructs all judges who are responsible for making judgments not specifically covered in the Torah: **“In controversy they shall stand as judges and judge it according to My Judgments . They shall keep My laws and My Statutes.”** (Ezekiel 44:24) Yahuah also tells them: **“You shall do no injustice in judgment. You shall not be partial to the poor, nor honor the person of the mighty. In righteousness you shall judge your neighbor”** (Leviticus 19:15).



By following Yahuah's judgments, the innocent are vindicated and the guilty are responsible for the appropriate restitution afforded to the wronged party.

**All their thousands of laws have not made this world a better place but have protected the evil people in this world and true justice is not done to the innocent. There is a clear difference between a commandment (an order or charge to be followed and observed) and a judgment (the way to handle situations between His people). Both are important but sadly because we have trusted in man that we have lost the true meaning of justice and love for our fellow man.**

If we disobey any of the Commandments, statutes and judgments it will be held against us on judgment day.

**Yahusha can only cover the sins that we repent of.**

The other sins that we choose to continue committing because we like them will be held against us on judgment day and we will lose our eternal life. **Yahuah is not mocked.** He wants total obedience to Him not out of fear but because we love Him and understand what sin has done to this world. It is so evil and innocent people are suffering daily.



Yahusha said “**Man shall not live by bread alone but by EVERY WORD that proceeds out of the mouth of Yahuah.**” Matthew 4:4



**If you read the whole of Malachi 4 you will see that this chapter refers to end time destruction of the earth and just before that YHVH once again says REMEMBER ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments. Malachi 4:4. These are Yahuah's laws given to Moses because the Israelites were terrified to hear Yahuah speaking to them directly.**



**Why would Yahuah put this into the very end time prophecy and says just before the message of Elijah will be preached, we must remember his statutes and judgements which includes the feasts of the Yahuah. There were always animal sacrifices on Yahuah's feast days but also there were twice as many animal sacrifices on the Seventh day Sabbath. So how is it that people will keep the Sabbath without the need of doing animal sacrifices but will not celebrate Yahuah's Seven annual Feast days but would rather continue in pagan holidays like Christmas, Easter, Valentine's day, Mother's day etc.**



**Yahusha is our perfect “Lamb” that was sacrificed for our sins therefore the Levitical priesthood, temple rituals and animal sacrifices are no longer necessary as the sacrifice of these animals could never take away our sins but were simply pointing to our Savior Yahusha who replaced the Levitical Priesthood with the Melkitzadeq Priesthood.**

**Yahusha is now our High Priest and King of righteousness therefore the temple rituals, Levitical priesthood and animal sacrifices are no longer necessary.**

**However, we cannot mistake this for ignoring Yahuah’s annual feast days (statues) which are eternal, to teach us**

**His wonderful plan of redemption.**

No difference is made in Scripture between the yearly Feasts and the Weekly feasts as they are all appointed times of worship to Yahuah. These set-apart Sabbaths are eternally binding.

Obedience establishes Yahuah's laws all of them. Romans 3:31.

**“The law of Yahuah is perfect converting the soul. The TESTIMONY of Yahuah is sure making wise the simple. The STATUTES of Yahuah are right rejoicing the heart. The COMMANDMENT of Yahuah is pure enlightening the eyes. The JUDGMENTS of Yahuah are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired than gold, Yea than much fine gold. Moreover by them your servant is warned and in KEEPING them there is GREAT REWARD.” Psalm 19:7 to 11**



**Yahuah says “I gave them my statutes and showed them My judgments, which if a man does, he shall LIVE BY THEM. Moreover, I also gave them MY SABBATHS TO BE A SIGN between ME and YOU that they might KNOW that I am Yahuah that SANCTIFIES THEM. I am Yahuah your Elohim, walk in my statutes, keep my judgments and do them. ...**



**...Hallow MY SABBATHS (including the 7 Annual Sabbaths of Yahuah) and THEY WILL BE A SIGN between you and me, that you may know that I am Yahuah your Elohim.” Ezekiel 20:11 to 13 and Ezekiel 18:20. (KJV) Scripture is clear, we cannot ignore Yahuah’s SABBATHS ALL 7 OF THEM PLUS THE WEEKLY SABBATH.**

We are a rebellious stiff-necked people who like to do things our way Yahuah hates the things we do. He told us not to worship Him in the same way as the pagan nations worship their Elohims. Still we refuse to obey Yahuah and think we are saved. What deception. Adam and Eve only disobeyed Yahuah in one Command and look at the consequences of their sin which has affected the entire planet. Yahuah does not change His Laws. **“He is the same yesterday, today and forever.”** Malachi 3:6  
(KJV)



Yahusha told us that **unless** we are willing to forsake **ALL** to follow and obey Him, we cannot be His disciple and we are not His people. **True faith is OBEDIENCE to the Torah (whole Bible). This includes keeping all His Commandments, statutes and judgments.**
