Or are we dealing with something much more serious?



Jews and the Moon

- Most Christians that know anything about the Scriptures, or Jewish beliefs, do know the Jews follow the moon to calculate their Biblical month.
- Because of this, most make the assumption (and believe) the Biblical month really is based on the moon.

Job 31:26-28

(New Living Translation)

 Have I looked at the sun shining in the skies, or the moon walking down its silver pathway,
 27 and been secretly enticed in my heart to worship them?

28 If so, I should be punished by the judges, for it would mean I had denied the God of heaven.

Questions that Need Answers for this Study

- 1. Where did sun and moon worship really begin?
- 2. Did this happen somewhere between the generations of Adam and Noah?
- 3. Do the sun god and moon goddess represent the major "no gods" or are there other more important pagan gods?
- 4. If the sun god and moon goddess are the dominant pagan gods, which one of the two takes the #1 position?
- 5. If sacred regard is given to the sun and moon for any reason, is this classed as worship?
- 6. If the sighting of the sun and moon are part of the worship calendar, is that action regarded as worship?
- 7. Will this study be able to conclude which is more deceptive? Sun worship, or moon worship?



Job & the Moon ... Was it a Mystery?

- Job lived around the time of Abraham long before the 12 tribes of Israel, or any Jews.
- At the time of Abraham, Yahuah's people were known as Hebrews.
- This study will begin to examine the history beginning with Adam to Noah.
- Then we will examine the history from Shem to Abraham, words of Job, the Torah commands of Moses, and the Old Testament history of the northern tribes of Israel and the tribe of Judah.
- The mystery will be solved through understanding the history.

Jews & their Moon -Are we dealing with a Mystery?

Most people believe the Jews (today) are correct in following certain phases of the moon in connection with their feast and festival worship statutes. In fact it is a mystery why their "moon" isn't even questioned!



This mystery will be solved through:

- 1. Understanding exactly what happened after the flood (from Shem to Abraham) and when the worship of "other gods" actually became a strong practice among pagans.
- 2. Understanding the history of Terah, Abraham coming out of Ur of the Chaldees and how they were affected by pagan gods.
- 3. Understanding that we are to follow the examples of Job and Abraham.
- 4. Understanding exactly what Moses taught through Torah on the worship of "the created" rather than "the Creator."
- 5. Understanding the history of both the northern tribes of Israel before they were scattered, and then the history of Judah from that point onward. What gods were the 12 tribes mesmerized by?
- 6. Finally, we'll see what the non-Torah books teach on the "this mysterious moon." Will it agree with our Jewish friends?

- 3. Out of these two, which "god" earns 1st place?




- Satan, as fallen Lucifer, posed as one that knew more than the Creator.

Adam had the privilege and responsibility to instruct 8 generations after him to Lamech for almost 1000 years. He would have cautioned as many as possible to stay away from other 'gods.'

Thought to Ponder:

- There is <u>no</u> record in Genesis 1-6 of these righteous patriarchs serving other gods!
- Where did the worship of other gods begin?

"no gods" Before the Flood

- Today there are 1000s of "no gods," but this wasn't always so.
- Before the flood, it is now believed pagan gods were actually mortal men.
 They were born, waged war, had children, and died, whereupon they were deified as gods by their descendants. This is not wild speculation.
 On the contrary, this is a position taken by nearly all historians of antiquity including: Isaac Newton; Augustine of Hippo; Eusebius; Justin Martyr; Josephus, etc.
- It was commonly believed that <u>if a man was good enough,</u> <u>he could become a god too</u>. This carried on down to the Roman Caesars and the Roman Pontiffs today.
- The mythologies were real stories of real men, embellished as gods in their afterlife.

Humans Worshipped as Pagan "gods"

- <u>Augustine</u> (~400 AD wrote): ".... those deities who are reckoned gods of the higher orders have gone from us into heaven. Ask whose sepulchres are pointed out in Greece."
- To simplify it, the pagan gods of the higher order were simply men; their graves in Greece.
- They started life as men and were deified and "dressed up" by those who survived them.
- This was a pagan practice common enough to be captured in the pages of scripture.



Acts 12:21-23 "On the appointed day Herod, wearing his royal robes, sat on his throne and delivered a public address to the people. They shouted, 'This is the voice of a god, not of a man.' Immediately, because Herod did not give praise to God, an angel of Yahuah struck him down, and he was eaten by worms and died." (NIV)

Gen 7-9 ~2350 BC - After the Flood

Gen 7-9 ~2350 BC Only 8 people were saved at the time of the flood.

- Noah's families grew and became dispersed/estranged from one another in the land of Ur of the Chaldees.
- Ham: idolatry/heathenism changes the glory of Yahuah into images like man, birds, beasts and creeping things. (Rom 1:23)
- Yahuah had to separate a people for himself from the next rising heathen kingdom.
- <u>Shem</u>: preserved the pure knowledge and worship of Yahuah down to his descendants of Terah and sons Haran, Abram and Nahor.

Note: All dates are approximate calculations.

Gen 10:8-9 ~2250 BC - Nimrod/Babel

Gen 10:8-9

~2250 BC

"And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth.

9 He was a mighty hunter before YHVH (Yahuah)."

- When Nimrod died, he was the first human that became deified as the "sun god" eventually named Baal.
- His wife, Semiramis, became the "moon goddess" [named Ashtoreth].
- Tammuz, the illegitimate son, became the "false messiah."
- Many new languages confused the construction on the Tower of Babel.
- Therefore, the "sun god," "moon goddess" and Tammuz were given many new names with each culture.
- These are the 3 main false deities of the Scriptures.

Gen 11 ~1925 BC - Terah's Family


 Even though the family of Shem, through Terah, had a knowledge of the proper worship of Yahuah, their worship was corrupted by idolatry, serving other gods in Ur of the Chaldees.

 Gen 11:31 Terah took Abram, Lot and Sarai "... and they went forth with them from Ur of the Chaldees ..."

 Josh 24:2 And Joshua said unto all the people, <u>Thus saith Yahuah Elohim</u> of Israel,
 <u>Your fathers</u> dwelt on the other side of the flood in old time, even Terah, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: and they <u>served other gods</u>.



Gen 11:31 ~1925 BC And Terah took Abram his son, and Lot the son of Haran his son's son, and Sarai his daughter in law, his son Abram's wife; and they went forth with them from Ur of the Chaldees, to go into the land of Canaan; and they came unto Haran, and dwelt there.




- Yahuah needed to separate out "a people" for Himself that would not serve "other gods."
- Haran was a leading settlement with a temple dedicated to moon worship!
- Abram was "called out of Haran" to Canaan. He continued to be righteous and faithful never turning to pagan worship.




Abram Searches out Canaan (Gen 12:1-4)



- It was in Haran that Abram received the divine call to continue to Canaan (Gen 12:1-4).
- Question: Was Abram an idolater before his call?
- Although Abram was not entirely free from idolatry in his father's house, there is no indication in the Scriptures that idol worship was part of his life.
- Gen 26:5 Abraham <u>obeyed my voice</u>, and kept my <u>charge</u>, my <u>commandments</u>, my <u>statutes</u>, and my laws.
- This may be the reason why Abram was "called out" to Canaan. Lot went with him.
- What about the rest of Terah's family Nahor?



Laban Remains in Haran



- Laban was born about 1890 BC.
- About 1740 BC Rachel stole Laban's images (Gen 31:19).
- Images and idols were still in Terah's [H8646] family 200 years later.
- images H8655; teraphim; a family idol.

It's time to make the connection between: "teraphim" images and Great-grandfather "Terah"!

Commentary for "Terah" and "teraphim"


Gen 31:25-35 "Why hast thou stolen my gods?"

- (The Wycliffe Bible Commentary) Here he [Laban] referred to his (teraphim) (v. 30; cf. 19).
 Evidently Laban was more concerned over losing his images than over losing Jacob's family.
 His search failed to discover these little "gods."
- (Barnes' Notes) Teraphim; (OT:8655). This word occurs three times in this chapter, and nowhere else in the Pentateuch. It is always in the plural number.


The teraphim were symbols or representatives of the Deity, as Laban calls them his gods. They seem to have been busts of the human form, sometimes as large as life (1 Sam 19:13).

Those of full size were probably of wood; the smaller ones may

have been of metal. They have been worn on an ephod for the purposes of divination (Gen. 30:27). The employment of them in the worship of God, which Laban seems to have inherited from his fathers (Josh 24:2), is denounced as idolatry (1 Sam 15:23); and hence, they are classed with the idols and other abominations [eventually] put away by Josiah (2 Kings 23:24).







Investigation on the Hebrew Name Laban

Gen 31:30, 34 And [Laban said], yet wherefore hast thou stolen my gods?

34 Now Rachel had taken the images ... and sat upon them. And Laban searched all the tent, but found them not.



Comparing "Terah & Laban" to "Images and the Moon"

- There is very strong indication now that Terah did have an occupation in Haran of making idols for distribution.
- Remember, Terah came out of Ur, the first center for major idol worship and Haran was also a moon worshipping center.
- There is no <u>Scripture stating those words</u>, but the connection can be proven through the name Terah, and the "teraphim" family idols that were in Laban's possession about 200 years later – only to be coveted and stolen by Rachel.

The Family Business of Terah

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Terah (H8646)	"teraphim" Images (H8655) "Family Idols"	Spelling, Pronunciation and Word Numbers Connect to Idols



- Terah's business of manufacturing idols would have been passed down through the generations, thus having a line of precious family idols.
- Everything is pointing back to these "family idols" as being connected to moon worship (Laban/Lebanah). These were very likely moon idols - straight from Semiramis in Babylon.





Egypt & Moon Worship

- Abraham was told his descendants would be in bondage to Egypt, not returning to Canaan for 430 years.
- Egypt had their own sun gods and moon gods.
- It's very likely these two major gods were a snare to Yahuah's people while in bondage.
- "Ra" was Egypt's sun god, challenged with the 10th plague of Egypt and the death of the first born of each family.
- At Passover, all firstborn "under the blood" were delivered from death.
- There are 42 campsites on the journey to Canaan. Let's examine Campsite #11.

~1490 BC Mt Sinai: 11th Campsite

- The #11 connects with reproof, warning and disorder.
- The root word for "Sinai" means "tares, thorns and demons" [neg. form].
- In the Syric language, "Sinai" means "to shine" as the "moon" which was an object of worship in the area.
- This campsite, found in an area of moon worship, is the very place where the enemy planned to again exalt his throne over Yahuah's.
- Only 40 days after the everlasting covenant was spoken, Yahuah's people had broken their covenant agreement, and found dancing before the image of the Egyptian false trinity.
- This action was clearly a case of blasphemously mixing worship to Yahuah with idolatry.






In this image 2 gods are seen.

Egypt's Unholy Trinity

- The golden Egyptian calf "god does NOT depict a single "god."
- The solar disk represents the serpent/sun "god," as the "father" of the calf "god," shown on the head of the golden calf.
- The 3rd deity is the female component. It is not part of the golden calf itself, but rather was part of the altar base.
- Upon the stones are petroglyphs depicting the Egyptian "god."
- These deities were also known as the "sun god," with the "moon goddess" being his wife. Their son was the false messiah.
- (Called to Canaan, Bk 1, Davis & Manfredine.)

Yahuah's Calendar

- The pagans began their days with looking to the sun.
- They also began their months by looking to the moon.
- Yahuah's calendar commencements do not follow the ways of the pagans by looking to the sun or the moon for calculation of His worship times.
- Therefore, there is nothing more offensive to Yahuah than the mixing of these profane, idolatrous practices with His sacred worship.
- This would be the ultimate blasphemy and an act tantamount to the highest level of spiritual rebellion – it's an abomination.
- It was these pagan roots that were found at the base of Mt Sinai of Yahuah's holy mountain!
- Beware of falling into idolatry while professing to worship your Creator.

What About the Christian Churches Today?

- Sunday Christians: all honour their day of worship on "Sunday" – giving homage to the "sun god" from ages past.
- Sabbath Keepers: all honour the beginning of their worship days beginning with the sunset the night before Sabbath, paying homage to the "sun god" from ages past.
- Sabbath Keepers/most Feast Keepers:
 In addition to honouring sunset,
 most also honour the moon for
 the Biblical month-start, thus
 paying homage to the "goddess
 of the moon."

Which of the 3 groups is most deceived?

~1450 BC Joshua Follows Moses' Leadership

 Joshua's 1st campaign before entering the land of Canaan was to destroy Jericho, a moon worshipping city.



• ~1430 BC: For 20 years he fought to rid the land of Canaan of pagan people and practices.

Before Joshua died, he gave them strict warnings NOT to run after and serve other gods. The people promised to be obedient ...

But, the pagan gods were still a problem!


• ~1425 BC: Josh 24:22-23 appeal is given. "And Joshua said unto the people, Ye are witnesses against yourselves that ye have chosen Yahuah, to serve him. And they said, We are witnesses. 23 Now therefore put away, said he, the strange gods which are among you, and incline your heart unto Yahuah Elohim of Israel."



Joshua said "Shout! The walls will come down!"

Shechem - Place of Decision for Yahuah

- Gen 12:6-7 <u>Abram</u> built an altar to Yahuah at Shechem; the everlasting covenant was confirmed with him there.
- Gen 33:18-20 <u>Jacob's</u> altar was at Shechem, his 1st dwelling place in Canaan.
- 3. Gen 35:4 <u>Jacob</u> hides the family idols under the oak tree at Shechem.
- 4. Josh 24:32 Joseph's tomb is at Shechem.
- Josh 24:1-15 <u>Joshua</u> assembled Israel at Shechem to choose the "Elohim" they are planning to serve.
- Josh 24:14-15 Now therefore fear Yahuah ... and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt ... 15 ... choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve Yahuah.



Josh 24:25 Shechem was the place where Joshua renewed the covenant with the people just before he died.

History from Judges to Malachi

The history of the apostasy in the Old Testament magnifies considerably after Moses dies.

Beginning with Judges is where the Scriptures <u>FIRST</u> mention Baal and Ashtoreth.




Common Terms in the Old Testament

<u>Ashtoreth</u> = moon goddess



Definitions for this Study

Name	Definition
Baal	The chief male deity of the Phoenicians and Canaanites; Ashtoreth was their principle female deity. The worship of Baal, together with that of Astarte, was common among the Hebrews. Human sacrifices were also offered to Baal by the Jews (Jer 19:5).
Ashtoreth Ashtaroth	A Syrian goddess/idol whose worship was very ancient and common among the Israelites. She is generally mentioned in connection with Baal, and is commonly identified with Astarte, the goddess of the moon.
Queen of Heaven	The moon was called the "queen of heaven." There are 3 rebukes from Jeremiah to Judah for this abomination (Jer 7:18; 44:7-19, 25).

Name	Definition
Groves	"Tree image(s)" for worship of the goddess Ashtaroth. It was forbidden by Yahuah for "groves" to be established for worship. (11 references in the OT for Israel's worship of groves.)
	 Isa 40:20 He that is so impoverished that he hath no oblation chooseth a tree that will not rot; he seeketh unto him a cunning workman to prepare a graven image, that shall not be moved. 2 Kings 17:16 And they left all the commandments of Yahuah their, and made them molten images, even two calves, and made a grove, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served Baal.
High Places	A term used to describe places of worship for Yahuah in groves (13 in OT); idolatrous worship (9 in OT); idolatrous high places to be destroyed (5 in OT).

Chiun	An idol made and worshipped by the Israelites in the wilderness.
Molech Moloch Milcom	An idol of the Ammonites; worshipped by Solomon and his wives. Israel sacrificed their children to Molech's molten arms (12 in OT).

Please note one more def.:

Haran: A city of the main trade routes between Babylonia and the Mediterranean Sea. Like the Chaldeans, Haran's inhabitants worshipped Sin, the moon-god from very ancient times. It was a natural stopping place for Terah to settle on his departure from Ur. The cult of moon worship persisted far into the Christian era after the 4th century AD.

For the listed phrases there are at least 887 **Old Testament** references linking to pagan worship.



The Snares of the "no gods"



Right from the Garden of Eden, where "another god" was honoured, the whole Old Testament history is tainted with roots that link to paganism.



Israel (and all pagan nations) worshipped many, many gods. Was every pagan god a snare to Israel, or was something else going on in the background?

The Snares of Baal & Ashtoreth

- This study will show the many times Israel and Judah fell back into apostasy.
- The main gods that were a snare to Israel and keep coming to the forefront are:
 1) the sun god (Baal/Baalim) and 2) the moon goddess (Ashtoreth).
- Right from Mt Sinai these are the first two gods that Moses commanded NOT to be worshipped. Moses told the people to not even think about "looking to the sun or moon" as they would soon be enticed to worship them as the pagans do.
- Moses was right! It will become clear, and very obvious, very quickly ... that Israel
 and Judah were both inflicted with this terrible sickness to seek other gods, even
 after they were delivered so mightily by Yahuah (from Ur, Egypt & Babylon).
- Judah is most responsible, as Israel was scattered, and did not have anything to do
 with the reform that was supposed to happen once the Babylonian exile was
 completed.

Who is Baal? Do we really know?



Baal the most significant male deity of the Canaanites, with his consort Asherah, were the most alluring deities confronting Israel in the promised land.

Numerous references to Baal in the Old Testament indicate his attractiveness and influence on the Israelites.

The Book of Judges chronicles the numerous times the people fell to the temptation of Baal worship.

Ahab and Jezebel made <u>Baal worship the royal religion of</u> the northern kingdom (1 Kings 16:29-31) with a Baal temple in Samaria.

Baal, like Asherah, was also worshipped at high places (also known as "groves") and required child sacrifices.



The sun-god (Baal, Tammuz, Ra / Horus) was worshiped in ancient times. It was sometimes depicted with one eye (the all-seeing-eye).



Baal's Consort ~ Who is it?



 Because of Israel's incomplete conquest of the land of Canaan, the roots of <u>Asherah-worship</u> from <u>Semiramis</u> survived and plagued Israel, starting as soon as Joshua was dead (Judg 2:13).

 Considered as the moongoddess, Ashtoreth/Asherah was often presented as a consort of Baal, the sun-god.

(See Judg 3:7; 6:28; 10:6; 1 Sam 7:4; 12:10.)

The Groves of Ashtoreth/Asherah



- This moon-goddess was represented by a limbless tree trunk planted in the ground.
- The trunk was usually carved into a symbolic representation of the goddess.
- Because of the association with carved trees, the places of Ashtoreth, or Asherah worship, were commonly called "groves."



The Hebrew family words of "Asherah" (plural, "asherim") could refer either to the moon goddess or to a grove of trees. 50

Asherah Worship Forbidden

- Yahuah, through Moses, forbade the worship of Asherah.
- The Law specified that a grove of trees was NOT to be near the altar of Yahuah (Deut 16:21).
- Despite these clear instructions, <u>Asherah-worship was a perennial problem in Israel</u>.
- As Solomon slipped into idolatry, one of the pagan deities he brought into the kingdom was Asherah, called "the goddess of the Sidonians" (1 Kings 11:5, 33).

Names & Symbols of Ashtoreth



 Ashtoreth, Asheroth, Asherim, Athirat – all are plural forms of the moon goddess name.

 Imaged as a full-breasted earth mother, both symbols speak to regeneration, sustenance and fruitfulness.

- She was the goddess of the woods.
- Groves of trees were her temples.
- This goddess is often referred to as a tree or pole.

The "May Pole" is attributed to this goddess!



Ashtoreth - the Moon Goddess




In Babylon the moon was a god, but after the rise of the solar theology, when the larger number of the Babylonian gods were resolved

into forms of the sun-god, their wives also became solar, <u>Ishtar</u>, "the daughter of Sin" the moon-god.

In Canaan, Ashtoreth, as distinguished from the male Ashtar, dropped her warlike attributes and became a moon-goddess.




The "Queen of Heaven"



In Canaan, Baal passed into a sun-god.

The goddess who stood at his side became the representative of the moon – or the pale reflection of the sun.

In about 628 BC Jeremiah refers to Asherah when he uses the title "Queen of Heaven" referring to the moon goddess (Jer 7:16-18; 44:17-19, 25).



Jezebel & Moon Goddess Worship



Along with Baal, Jezebel made Asherahworship even more prevalent, with 400 prophets of Asherah on the royal payroll (1 Kings 18:19).

Throughout history the Jews were constantly tempted to worship this pagan goddess and

attend her rituals.

It was this forbidden practice which finally led to Judah's captivity and the seventy years in Babylon even though many good kings destroyed the Asherah groves.

Stay Away from the Groves!

Yahuah absolutely detested the worship of His people to visit the tree poles in the high places and groves - paying tribute to the moon goddess!

- Deut 16:21-22 Thou shalt not plant thee a grove of any trees near unto the altar of Yahuah thy Elohim ... 22 Neither shalt thou set thee up any image.
- 1 Kings 11:5 Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites.
- 1 Kings 11:33 They have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do that which is right in mine eyes, and to keep my statutes and my judgments, as did David his father.
- It was an abomination to Yahuah. Why?

This is the tree pole of Ashtoreth moon worship.


Compare the Ashtoreth tree pole with The Garden Tree Pole.




Did the abomination of worship "at the tree" start here?

It is now time to review the Old Testament records of Israel's sacred regard for pagan gods and what they stand for!

Baal - the sun god







High Places of Worship

1425 - 1250 BC Book of Judges

The following tables chart a brief review of the worship of pagan gods and apostasy in the 12 tribes.

Please take special note of the dates, as we travel through Israel's history to 400 BC.

Ref.	Date	Description
Judg 2:3	~1425 BC	Israel did not drive out the pagans. They would be constantly snared by false gods.
Judg 2:11-13 1st mention	~1425 BC	Israel served Baalim (sun god), the most important god; & Ashtoreth (moon goddess).
Judg 2:17, 19	~1425 BC	Israel would not hearken to judges but whored after other gods bowing down to them.
Judg 3:6, 7	~1405 BC	Intermarried the sons/daughters with pagan nations and served their Baalim gods.

Remember: 200 years earlier Moses had given very strict commands to Israel so the people would be kept free from the worship of pagan gods.



Did Israel have troubles with running after the sun gods and moon gods in the remainder of the history of the Old Testament?

Judges 10:6 "The children of Israel did evil again in the sight of Yahuah." This apostasy seems to have exceeded every former one in the grossness and universality of the idolatry practiced. The Hebrews adopted the objects of worship among the several pagan countries contiguous to the district of Palestine in which they lived. Some scholars feel Israel may have actually erected a Pantheon. It's hard to believe Israel became universal idolaters, adopting every god of the surrounding nations. Baalim and Ashtaroth signify gods and goddesses in general reckoned as:

- 1. The gods of Syria; Bel and Saturn, or Jupiter and Astarte
- 2. Gods of Zidon; Ashtoreth, Astarte or Venus
- 3. The gods of Moab; Chemosh
- 4. Gods of the children of Ammon; Milcom
- 5. Gods of the Philistines; Dagon.

Yahuah gave up Israel to be in bondage to the Philistines & Ammonites.

Approximately 700 years before, both Moses and Joshua had given very firm, strict counsel to Israel to NOT be enticed by the pagans and their gods for sun worship and moon worship.

Ye shall eat this year [49th yr] such as groweth of itself; and the second year [50th yr] that which springeth of the same: and in the third [1st yr] year sow ye, and reap, and plant vineyards, and eat the fruit thereof.

Assuming the sundial miracle of Isaiah 38 is about 701 BC, then:

- a) this year [49th yr] = 701 BC
- b) the second year [50th yr] = 700 BC (Some say this is about the 66th Jubilee.)
- c) the third [1st yr] = 699 BC

"moon" component of the Covenant Calendar.


2nd Sign: Calendar Adjustment



The very last record verifies how deep this apostasy went, burning and eating their children, seeking the pagan feasts and the moon goddess.

- It was their sacred regard for the moon [goddess] that affected their feast calendar the most.
- The moon goddess is still given sacred regard today, by having the authority to appoint the moon as the commencement of the Biblical month or a weekly Sabbath.

- As the day closes on the 4000 years of history for Israel and Judah - it is a sad commentary to find them very unrepentant, continuing even faster on their path of abomination.

Is it really in charge of determining when Yahuah's Biblical month begins?






There's a lot of Feast Calendars to choose from.

Phases of the Moon

So, when does the Biblical month begin?



Some claim that the Biblical month begins with:

- 1. The first sliver of the moon!
- 2. At the full moon!
- 3. At the combination of the first sliver of the moon and the ripening of the barley!
- 4. The moon closest to the spring equinox, either before or after that event.

How many would be surprised to know the moon has absolutely nothing to do with the start of the Biblical month?



Can you explain this with a solid Scriptural teaching?

If you are following the lunar cycles to mark appointed times of worship, perhaps this study will challenge your beliefs to see if they really are based in the Torah. Look for the Blessings!

Here is something that concerned me personally. I have been reading several warnings in the Bible saying "NOT TO WORSHIP THE MOON."

There are <u>two</u> commands <u>in the Torah</u> stating this with clarity!







#1 Deut 4:19

"And lest thou lift up thine eyes unto heaven, and when thou seest the sun, and the MOON, and the stars, even all the host of heaven, shouldest be driven to worship them, and serve them,

which Yahuah thy Elohim hath divided unto all nations under the whole heaven." *KJV*



#2 Deut 17:3

"And hath gone and served other gods, and worshipped them, either the sun, or MOON, or any of the host of heaven, which I have not commanded." KJV

Before Moses died, he specifically gave these two commands in Deut.

as a safeguard from the pagan ways of worship.



"And he put down the idolatrous priests, whom the kings of Judah had ordained to burn incense in the high places in the cities of Judah, and in the places round about Jerusalem; them also that burned incense unto Baal, to the sun, and to the MOON, and to the planets, and to all the host of heaven." KJV



#4 Job 31:26-28

"If I beheld the sun when it shined, or the MOON walking in brightness;

27 And my heart hath been secretly enticed
... 28 This also were [would be] an iniquity to be punished by the Judge [Yahuah]:
for I should have denied
the God [Elohim] that is above." KJV

Note: These verses are talking about giving more regard to the sun and moon than what was ever allowed by Yahuah.

There are many other Scriptures giving the same warning.


Jeremiah's Wisdom in Chapter 8:1 & 2

"At that time," declares יהוה (YHVH), "they shall bring the bones of the sovereigns of Yehudah (Judah), and the bones of its heads, and the bones of the priests, and the bones of the prophets, and the bones of the inhabitants of Yerushalayim, out of their graves, 2 and shall spread them before the sun and the moon and all the host of the heavens, which they have loved and which they have served and after which they have walked, which they have sought, and to which they have bowed themselves. They shall not be gathered nor buried, they shall be for dung on the face of the earth." The Scriptures




Yahuah tells us explicitly that the moon is **NOT** TO BE FOLLOWED! He destroyed Jericho and placed a curse on the one who rebuilds it. The Hebrew language reveals a deeper understanding that the curse is placed upon the one who **REBUILDS THE WORSHIP** PRACTICES OF THE MOON!

That is why the moon of Revelation 12 is placed <u>UNDER</u> the feet of the Bride! What does this mean?



Rev 12:1 "And a great sign was seen in the heaven: a woman clad with the sun, with the moon <u>under her feet</u>, and on her head a crown of twelve stars."

The Bride is illuminated by the LIGHT of the sun! The LIGHT of the sun provides the glory. The moon has been trampled under foot. It is no longer of value because the Bride of Y'shua has **RISEN ABOVE and TRAMPLED the FALSE DECEPTION of the 'MOON DETERMINED' Feasts and Festivals BELOW HER FEET!**



Why is the moon, which has been deemed by man as the identity for determining time, located **under the feet** of the woman of Revelation 12?



For the answer of what this means, we need to look at some Bible verses:

Gen 24:2 "And Abraham said to the oldest servant of his house, who ruled over all that he had, "Please, put your hand <u>under my thigh</u>." The Scriptures

Gen 47:29 And the time for Yisra'el [Israel] to die drew near, and he called his son Yoseph [Joseph] and said to him, "Now if I have found favour in your eyes, please put your hand under my thigh, and show kindness and truth to me. Please do not bury me in Mitzrayim [Egypt]. The Scriptures



These "under" positions are not of power and strength. They are positions of submission to superior authority.

More Scriptures about being "under the feet."

2 Kings 9:33 "And he said, 'Throw her down.' And they threw her down, and some of her blood spattered on the wall and on the horses, and he <u>trampled her under foot</u>." The Scriptures




men in the midst of me: he hath called an assembly against me to crush my young men: Yahuah hath trodden the virgin, the daughter of Judah, as in a winepress." KJV

Matthew 5:13 "Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men." KJV

These are some very clear indications of the authority of being - under the feet. Under the feet is **NOT** a position of power and authority as man has taught pertaining to the moon being located under the feet of the Bride of Y'shua in Revelation 12. Quite the contrary! Being under the feet is a sign of non volunteered relinquishment of power and authority.



Again, the moon in Revelation 12:1 has no authority whatsoever.



One source claims that certain sects developed a procedure that involved the sighting by two witnesses. This is believed to be correct by many today. Today this sect is called the "Karaites."

The source of this practice is from the Mishna, **NOT THE TORAH!**

THE KARAITE CONNECTION

- Anan Ben Daud is widely believed to be the founder of the Karaite Sect.
- In the mid-8th century CE under Islamic rule, he started a movement which broke away from Rabbinical Judaism.
- It was Anan's hope to become the head Rabbi, but he was passed-over by his younger brother who held more closely to the Torah and "oral law," the traditions of the fathers.
- Still, Anan's followers installed him in the position of "exilarch."
- The Caliph Al-Mansur viewed this argument as rebellion, arrested Anan in 767, and set his execution date.
- While in prison, Anan met an Islamic teacher who gave him advice that saved his life. **Anan was to establish a new religious sect.**

The pre-Islamic moon deity called Allah is symbolized by a crescent moon and star. The origin comes from the Hindu culture and the worship on Shiva. The crescent moon was also venerated in the Egyptian culture with the moon below a solar disc. **Because Christianity sprang from Alexandria** Egypt, these objects in the sky were also adopted for veneration. (Emphasis supplied.)

Islam's most prominent symbol is the crescent moon, Shiva's symbol.

The pre-Islamic Arabs worshipped 360 sky-deities, one of which was the "greatest" called "Allah." Allah is represented by the crescent moon and was the most favored of all deities by Muhammad's clan. The 360 deities means the Kaaba was originally a Hindu shrine dedicated to the worship of the host of heaven.



Yahuah is <u>not</u> represented by any kind of symbol.

AND ... certainly He is not using the objects seen in the sky to determine His appointed times!

Study/research to show thyself approved.

- 1. By the Scriptures
- 2. By Secular History (Why?)
- > Pagan errors recorded in history are found to wrestle for prominence above Torah truth.
- > It's easier to make a good decision with an abundance of evidence.

(Scriptures will be provided as the study progresses.)

Rightly Dividing the Facts (10 Points)

- 1. There is no indication in any Old Testament Scriptures for a lunar month of 28-29.5 days, or 13 months in a year approximately every 3rd year, or seven times in a 19 year cycle.
- 2. At creation, the 12 months had 30 days each. The year had 360 days.
- 3. There are no Torah instructions for beginning any month with any phase of the moon.
 - The Torah books date to approximately 1450 BC.

 - This is 2550 years <u>after creation</u>. The covenant calendar in Exodus documents the 30 day month very well.

Rightly Dividing the Facts

- 4. Yahuah's divine calendar was compromised by <u>His</u> people when, in Canaan, they began to mix pagan worship practices with divine commands.
- 5. Yahuah's people were commanded many times not to look to the sun, moon, stars, planets or any heavenly host lest they worship them as the pagans do.
- 6. Of all the heavenly hosts, today's lunar cycle is closest to the Biblical 30 day month. The pagans were moon worshippers with their own feasts and festivals.

Rightly Dividing the Facts

- 7. Hezekiah's sundial miracle happened about 3300 years
 AFTER creation. It's seems as though Yahuah used the sundial event to change the lunar cycle significantly to draw the attention of His people away from the moon taking them back to the creation order for the annual count of the Festival Sabbaths according to His "month."
- 8. In a study of the Scriptural facts, with their dates, we will see: the sundial event was intended to permanently separate Yahuah's feast worship times from the pagan lunar cycle calculations.
 - However, one event did not change when the yearly cycle changed from 360 to $365\frac{1}{4}$ days/year.

THAT EVENT IS THE EQUINOX!

Rightly Dividing the Facts

- The flood account ushered in the earth's agricultural seasons.
 The moon is agriculturally involved with these seasons.
- 10. The equinox is the "one day" focal point each year that plays a part in marking the last day of Yahuah's Biblical year (or the last day of winter in the northern hemisphere).

The first day of the new year will be determined <u>after</u> the equinox is verified by a visual sign.

The moon has absolutely no involvement in the equinox event the way the earth, sun and stars do.

Light is also involved in the equinox, of which the moon has nothing to offer.

3300 Years: Creation to Hezekiah

- The moon's cycle for 3300 years was disrupted by the sundial miracle (701 BC).
- This was a permanent heavenly demarcation (or a SIGN to Yahuah's people) that the moon is not associated with the commencement of His months.
- Unfortunately, the apostasy of Yahuah's people, with regards to worship, was so deep and severe that:
- a. The northern 10 tribes were completely scattered by Assyria (721 BC just 5 years after Hezekiah's reformation);
- b. About 100 years later (606 BC) the southern kingdom tribes were exiled to Babylon for 70 years.

Yahuah's People & Pagan Worship

Upon return to Jerusalem (536 BC), Judah was to leave the pagan ways behind.

Did they? The "so called Jews" of today (Orthodox/Messianic/Kzar, etc.) are still gazing at the moon just as Babylon, Egypt and other pagan nations have been practicing for eons of time.

Again, if a person researches into <u>THE HEBREW TEXT</u>, the words – "new moon," as found in our present "received text" Scriptures, <u>CANNOT BE FOUND</u>. The words "new moon," promoting allegiance given to the moon, <u>simply do not exist in the ORIGINAL Hebrew script</u>.

The words "NEW MOON" have been infused into our modern Scriptures. The Masoretic Rabbis saturated their belief patterns into their version of the Scriptures which is where we have received many editions of the Scriptures today.




Main Point of This Study

- Pagan moon worship crept in early amongst Yahuah's people after Moses died.

If the moon is not ordained to commence Yahuah's worship statutes, then what is the moon's purpose in the sky?



What are the job descriptions of the moon?

Has "mankind" added job descriptions to the moon outside of what the Creator has given?

Does the moon have a prominent position which it does not deserve when it comes to observance of holy feasts and festivals?

Does an "Ordinance" of the Moon determine the commencement of appointed Feasts & Festivals (mo`eds)?

Let's examine Ps 104:19.



"He appointed the moon for seasons [H4150] ..."

This verse is often used to place the moon in a position to commence the months and related appointed worship times. Why? Let's examine the definition of "seasons."

1st Definition in Strong's H4150 (seasons): Gen 1:14

Seasons – Strong's **H4150**; moed'; ... properly, [1st def.] an appointment, i.e. a fixed time or [2nd def.] season; specifically, [more 1st defs.] a festival; conventionally a year; by implication, an assembly (as convened for a definite purpose); technically the congregation; by extension, the place of meeting; also a signal (as appointed beforehand).

- The term moed`, [1st defined as] appointment, a festival; an assembly, technically the congregation; the place of meeting, are rightly understood in the context of appointed festivals in Gen 1:14.
- However, the moon does not appoint these festival seasons.

2nd Definition in Strong's H4150 (season): Psalm 104:19

- The 2nd definition for H4150 is a season; rightly understood in the context of the four seasons of the year. These seasons are fixed; they do not vary.
- One of the ordinances of the moon is to maintain these
 - fixed seasons for agricultural purposes that happen to coincide with the harvests of the appointed festivals.



The Two Definitions of H4150 are NOT Interchangeable!

- When the moon is used to appoint the Biblical month commencement, the festivals are NEVER fixed, as they vary between 1-5 weeks dependent on the arrival of the crescent moon before/after the equinox.
- Lets remember Ps 104:19 is not a Torah verse.
 Yahuah appointed the moon for H4150
 agricultural seasons from spring to winter.
- These seasons are only <u>one</u> ordinance of the moon.

Ordinance of the Harvest Moon

Deut 33:14 ... and for the precious things [H4022] put forth by the moon [H3391].

[H4022] - something valuable; precious fruit [H3391] - lunation of the moon

Ordinance of the Tides



It also affects soil moisture, plant sap and the water table.



Ordinances of the Moon

- · This word "seasons" can mean:
 - 1) festival appointments
 - 2) agricultural seasons and
 - 3) the stork's "appointed times."
- The moon is <u>not</u> allotted to define the timing of the appointed mo-ed` festivals through Moses <u>in the Torah</u>.
- However, remember: the "appointed seasons" do align with the agricultural harvests appointed by the moon.

Ordinances of the Moon [H3394] Bless the Earth

Some Ordinances are:

The Moon Stabilizes the Tidal Activity and Sustains Life in the Ocean:

The gravitational pull causes the tidal flow in the ocean waters establishing a fresh supply of oxygen to the ocean plants and animals.

ii. The Moon Stabilizes the Earth's Seasons:

For the advancement of life to plants, animals and mankind, regular stable seasons are absolutely necessary.

Ordinances of the Moon [H3394] Bless Mankind

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Some Ordinances are:

- 1. The Moon is for <u>Agricultural Seasons</u>: This gives mankind yearly harvests of precious produce at the agricultural appointed time.
- The Moon is given for <u>Prophetic Utterances</u>: Eclipses, for instance, are like mileposts in human history, marking off certain dates. We can study events in ancient history because the eclipses have been recorded. The moon is involved in signs for great miracles and prophecy. (Note: the first use of "moon" in the Torah was Joseph's dream the moon being part of prophecy, not month-start.)
- 3. The Moon is given for <u>Warnings</u> Against "moon" worship: See Deut 4:19; 17:3; 2 Kings 23:5; Jer 8:2.
- 4. The Moon is given as a Reminder of Creation and our Creator:

See Ps 8:3; Ps 136:9; Ps 148:3.
