


Is Ellen G White, a true prophetess?
I used to think so, I believed it and taught it for 50 years!

What is my stand today In reference to her writings?

Scripture tells us to "Prove all things and to hold fast that which is good." (1Th 5:21 - KJV) This is a clear command for everyone to take the time to study and prove what is taught by the various churches and denominations. That clearly tells us that we should not sit idly by and be told what to believe. The word clearly states that we are to: "study to show thyself approved unto God... rightly dividing the word of truth." (II Tim. 2:15 - KJV) Are the teachings of the churches and denominations, in fact, Yahuah's (God's) truth or cunningly devised fables? He commands us to study His word to educate our minds in His principles, so we will know His true shepherds from the men who teach the doctrines and commandments of men.

Since some former SDA friends had asked about my stand on Ellen G White's writings, I humbly want to submit these without getting into arguments as we all have choices of what we want to believe according to what we have been taught and the available facts.

The topic of Ellen G White is dear to my heart, because so many people within the SDA denomination, accept her writings as the inspired word of God, equal to scripture and often above scripture as I used to believe, taught and preached it for over 50 years. Let me give you first some background!



I had been a member of the SDA denomination for over 50 years after coming out of the Lutheran Church. My parents and I accepted the message of Adventism basically because of the weekly Sabbath and also Ellen White was a very big influence. We valued her writings very highly, accepted her as the voice of God, but did not check everything out with Scripture at that time and for many years thereafter. The Bible studies given us were very convincing and why should we re-invent the wheel, because the people that taught us were kind, seemed to be knowledgeable and sincere.


It would be unfair and untrue, however, to say that all the years in the denomination were lost for us or wasted. We met very sincere people that wanted to serve the LORD GOD (Yahuah Elohim) and learned things from scripture, which were beneficial and changed our lives coming out of the Lutheran Church. Adventism was a good first step in my Christian Experience. However, we need to understand that "truth is progressive!" I do like a statement made by Ellen White on this thought, which says:

"The Word of God presents special truths for every age. The dealings of God with His people in the past should receive our careful attention. We should learn the lessons which they are designed to teach us. But we are not to rest content with them. God is leading out His people step by step. Truth is progressive. The earnest seeker will be constantly receiving light from heaven. 'What is truth should ever be our inquiry." (ST May 26, 1881). {2BC 1000.8}

This is an excellent advice, however one <u>cannot do that</u> as a member of the SDA denomination in regular and good standing.


Here is what is stated in the Seventh-day Adventist Church Adult Sabbath School Quarterly, Lesson 13, March 28, 1987, p 92, or p 153 in the Teacher's Edition. "It is our responsibility to study the Scriptures for ourselves, to ask for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, to submit our understandings to those in the church, who are able to judge our findings, and then to abide by the decisions of the church..."

What does that say to me as an individual? Only Church leadership can safely interpret the Bible. Or as it stated in Adventist Review, June 5, 1986, p 2 "Only a committee appointed by the General Conference can interpret prophecy."



What are the consequences for me, if I continue to be part of such a system, church or an organization? My salvation would definitely be at stake as I could not follow a "Thus saith YHVH". I would be forced to abide by the commandments and teachings of man, by their established creeds, making flesh my arm. I would be forced to teach whatever the particular denomination tells me, regardless of what Scripture may say. This would put my eternal salvation in jeopardy!

Because Yahusha said very plainly in Matthew 23:13 (KJV) "But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in yourselves, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in."





During the past few years because of being challenged by some people in reference to various beliefs and doctrines of Adventism, I personally took the time to prove these with Scripture, History and available research done by others. Ellen White's writings used to be my main authority as I used <a href="mailto:them

Here is one of the reasons: when I was a young man living in California, young in the church, I was told by well meaning, devout Seventhday Adventists that when reading Ellen White's writings, called the Spirit of Prophecy by the church, I am actually reading the Bible magnified.



So why spend much time in Scripture, when reading Ellen White's writings is doing the same or much more? I was reading and memorizing much of her writings. I believe, her books do contain some very good advice for Christian living, even though she copied 60 to 70% from other authors, but she copied many errors at the same time. One should think that she was sincere at the time and of course one additional problem is that much of her writings were edited and changed several times by the denomination during the past 100 plus years.






We have an individual responsibility to read every book from every author through the eyes of Scripture starting in Genesis 1:1. That includes also all the writings of Ellen White.

Even the New Testament must agree with the Old Testament. We cannot start in the middle of the Bible and ignore the Old Testament. We cannot separate these two; the God of the OT is the same God as the God of the NT. The New Testament can be considered a Commentary to the Old Testament. Remember, God does not change (Malachi 3:6). The New Testament does not teach a new gospel. People of the OT were saved by grace, the same as the people of the NT!

It is claimed that Ellen White had over 2,000 visions during her life time of which are 188 dated and 15 undated visions that have been published. Of course one could ask the question what happened to the other 1800? It is also claimed by her that she had over 100 personal visits from Jesus. If she had over 100 personal visits from Yahusha, the true Hebrew Messiah himself, then she would be the greatest prophet of all times, greater than Moses and Paul.




That is exactly what the denomination believes as I had for many years. Here are some examples: In the October 1981 issue of the SDA Ministry Magazine, the following statement was made about the writings of Ellen White: "We believe the revelation and inspiration of both the Bible and Ellen White's writings to be of equal quality. The superintendence of the Holy Spirit was just as careful and thorough in one case as in the other."


In 1928 the SDA Church issued an official position paper on the writings of Ellen G. White. It said, "As Samuel was a prophet of Israel for his day, as Jeremiah was a prophet of Israel in the days of captivity, as John the Baptist came as a special messenger of the Lord to prepare the way for Christ's Coming, so we believe that Mrs. White was a prophet to the Church of Christ today."

"She did one of the greatest works that I have ever known since John the Revelator. She's to me one of the greatest prophets that have ever lived. Why? Because she had the same gift that Daniel had..." — Stanley Harris, SDA pastor.

"I believe... Mrs. White's writings are the world's only inspired Bible commentary." — E. E. Cleveland, one time Secretary of the General Conference.

By the way, Paul the great apostle had only two encounters with Yahusha as far as we know. I think everyone must agree, if Ellen White truly had over 100 personal encounters with Yahusha (According to a presentation by Frederick G. Hoyt, Ph.D., Emeritus Professor of History La Sierra University, Riverside, CA 92515 at the San Diego Adventist Forum, November 8, 2003) , we would do well not to questions any of her statements even though some contradict Scripture.






When you do some research, you will find that some of the testimonies of those who had encounters with demons, this same phenomena took place. This has happened with apparitions of Mary. 




O.R.L. Crozier (or Crosier), formed the "sanctuary doctrine" and published it in the Day Star February 7, 1846, pp. 38-44. Ellen G. White heartily endorsed Crozier's meaning of the "cleansing of the sanctuary." Here are her words: "The Lord shew me in vision, more than one year ago, that Brother Crosier had the true light, on the cleansing of the Sanctuary, and that it was his will, that Brother C. should write out the view which he gave us in the Day-Star Extra, February 7, 1846. I feel fully authorized to recommend that Extra to every saint." A Word to the Little Flock, p. 12. April 21, 1847.

However, Crozier repudiated his early beliefs on the Shut Door and the Sanctuary and published its defects from 1847-1849. The reason Ellen G. White and others grasped Crozier's view is best described by Crozier himself. "On account of our ignorance of the scriptures my argument was more fully and more widely accepted than it deserved to be."

I don't have all the answers, probably no man has. As a member of the SDA church you will go out of your way to defend Ellen White, but in reality you are trying to defend a false prophetess, which I can understand as I did the same from my deep conviction. To understand and accept that Ellen White is not a true prophet was the most difficult thing for me in my life, but truth is truth, it will stand on its own.

I took the stand because it is a salvational issue even though I lost many so-called friends. It took a miracle for me to get out of this deception, as this was my life. Ellen White's writings, she called the little light, was supposed to lead us to the greater light, the Bible, but it's working the other way around. Seventh-Day Adventists are reading the Bible through the eyes of Ellen White.

On one hand Ellen White seems to encourage that one take the Bible as the final authority like in this statement: "I exalt the precious Word before you today. Do not repeat what I have said, saying, "Sister White said this," and "Sister White said that." Find out what the Lord God of Israel says, and then do what He commands."-- Manuscript 43, 1901. (From an address to church leaders the night before the opening of the General Conference session of 1901.) {3SM 33.1}

Then on the other hand, she says exactly the opposite, like "In ancient times God spoke to men by the mouth of prophets and apostles. In these days He speaks to them by the testimonies of His Spirit. (Meaning her writings, her testimony) There was never a time when God instructed His people more earnestly than He instructs them now concerning His will and the course that He would have them pursue." [VOL. 4, PP. 147, 148 (1876).] {5T 661.1}

Then we have another statement, saying "The very last deception of Satan will be to make of none effect the testimony of the Spirit of God. 'Where there is no vision, the people perish" (Proverbs 29:18). Satan will work ingeniously, in different ways and through different agencies, to unsettle the confidence of God's remnant people in the true testimony." -- 1SM 48 (1890). {LDE 177.5} By the true testimony she means her writings. Or the statement "If you lose confidence in the Testimonies (confidence in her writings) you will drift away from Bible truth."-- 5T 674. {PM 360.2}

These are very powerful, convincing statements for a good Seventh-day Adventist. Most of the independent ministries that separated from the main denomination are taking this one step further in taking her writings as the absolute and final authority without any question.



I personally was there and preached in one of the independent ministries several years as a lay preacher, also in Europe about 20 years ago.

I also wondered why we find in her writings the expressions "Vital Force" 120 times, "Holy Watcher" 32 times, "the All Seeing eye" 56 times, "the great Architect" 8 times or "the mystical body" 14 times, words that cannot be found even once in the entire Scripture? Where did she get these from? Did she copy them from other books without knowing what these mean and where they come from? These are freemasonry and occult terms.



I have come to the conviction that Seventh-day-Adventists, like people in any denomination, are in a box of manmade traditions and teachings and it is probably easier for a camel to go through the eyes of a needle than for a Seventh-day Adventist to come out of this box and maybe even entering heaven as they will take Ellen White's writings as the final say, ignoring some biblical truth!




Seventh-day-Adventists honor and exalt Ellen White and the 10 commandments, yet reject the parts of the Torah they don't want to follow such as the yearly appointed feast days and other commandments and statutes.



I was not called out of Israel to celebrate Egyptian holidays and to keep the doctrines and commandments of man, I was called out of Egypt to celebrate Yahuah's feast days listed in Leviticus 23 and to keep his commandments, statutes and judgments. Yahuah's true people have always been easily identified by the holidays it keeps, because whoever controls your calendar, controls your life.

I used to believe in the Sunday law doctrine, but that cannot be proven from Scripture without twisting it. If Sunday is part of the mark of the beast, so must all the pagan holidays and all man-made traditions and doctrines be part of it.



The Bible doesn't teach anything about a National Sunday Law in America or an International Sunday Law around the world. If there is such a Law, let's ask the question: What would trigger the enactment of a national Sunday law in communist countries like China, North Korea, and Russia? And what would cancel Sharia Law and trigger the enactment of Sunday laws in large Islamic populations found in Indonesia, Egypt, Iran, and Saudi Arabia? What would trigger a national Sunday law in the Jewish state of Israel where conservatives insist on observing the seventh day of the week, meaning the Sabbath? However, anything is possible, if Scripture says so.

What would cause seven hundred million Hindus in India to worship the God of the Christians on Sunday? How is the Catholic Church and the United States going to enforce Sunday on billions of devout Muslims, Hindus, Jews, Pagans, and Communists? However, that is the claim Seventh-day Adventists as an example dogmatic believe, even though it is not biblical. We do not have a "Thus saith YHVH" from Scripture.




As I had mentioned the 2300 year prophecy is **not biblical**. The 2300 days or better yet the 1150 days may have a future literal application, but 1844, the investigative judgment, and that Yahusha went into the Most Holy Place in 1844 is not Biblical. All we have to do is read Hebrews 8:1-2 and chapter 9:24 as examples which make it very clear that our Savior went into the Most Holy Place at his ascension. He didn't have to wait 1800 years.

The 3 1/2-year ministry, the Friday Crucifixion, the Sunday resurrection as well as the Trinity doctrine promoted also by Ellen White's writings is not scriptural. Seventh-day Adventists cleverly divide the law with the support of Ellen White into two parts: Moral and Ceremonial. The assumption is being made that Moses wrote the law on paper, in a book, and placed it in the side of the Ark. They call what Moses wrote down the mosaic or ceremonial law that was done away with or nailed to the cross. Neither the word "moral" nor the word "ceremonial" is found in scripture.

These words were first used by a Catholic Priest Tomas Aquinas, who claimed "that the weekly Sabbath was moral as to resting one day a week, but was ceremonial as regards to time. Therefore it has been transferred to Sunday in the new covenant since Jesus rose on the first day of the week."

(Thomas Aquinas, Summa Theologica, Part I-II, Q. 100, 5, p. 1042)




This term "ceremonial" is only confusing and not biblical. What we should be talking about are the ordinances of the altar that makes more sense (See Ezekiel 43:18). The Bible talks about a sacrificial system, the animal sacrifices and the oblations (grain and wine offerings) that were offered at the same time as the animal sacrifices were offered. In the Bible the Law (Torah) is divided into **three** sections "The commandments, statutes and judgments, but not into moral and ceremonial!" (See Deuteronomy 5:31; 6:1; 7:11 and 11:1).



Ellen White brought a lot of these erroneous teachings over from other churches, from other writers, from the Middle Ages by copying them. It is high time that we make Scripture and Scripture alone our foundation and starting in Genesis 1:1. We need a "Thus saith YHVH". In this respect I agree with Ellen White's statement that I quoted before, when she stated: "I exalt the precious Word before you today. Do not repeat what I have said, saying, "Sister White said this," and "Sister White said that." Find out what the Lord God of Israel says, and then do what He commands." -- Manuscript 43, 1901. (From an address to church leaders the night before the opening of the General Conference session of 1901.) {3SM 33.1}

However, that is not being done as I also had mentioned, I know by experience, as I did it myself. For me she was equal to Scripture and when in doubt above Scripture.



Seventh-day Adventists are <u>not</u> the true Remnant as I used to believe, actually <u>there</u> is <u>no</u> <u>established</u> denomination today that can make that claim. We are saved as individuals following the lamb according to Revelation 14. Ellen White claimed that pre-flood humans mated with animals and produced a sub-human species that was destroyed by the flood (1SP78 vs. Gen 1:24-25). She said once that angels (rather than ravens) **fed Elijah** (3T288 – 1873; in 1876 she changed her mind in 4T253 vs. 1. Kings 17:4&6); She said that Adam rather than Eve was deceived by Satan (Evangelism 598 vs. 1. Tim. 2:14) She said that while tempting esus, Satan claimed to be the angel who had saved Isaac from certain death (1SM273). She endorsed William Miller's prophecy that Jesus would return in 1844. She proclaimed that salvation for all sinners ended in 1844 when Yahusha supposedly entered the Heavenly sanctuary. This was called "the shut door" doctrine. It was abandoned in 1850. Jesus died for the angels (DA 758). Angels would have died for man (Early Writings 127)

Ellen White saw Enoch on Jupiter or Saturn (EW 39-40 & A Word to the Little Flock, page 22)

The Civil War is a sign that Jesus is about to return. (1T 260) In the 1850's Ellen White said that Jesus would return in a few months (EW 58, 64, 67)

She stated that her writings <u>never</u> contradict the Bible (3SM 32)

Satan was offered a pardon in Heaven (GC 495-496)
Adam censured Eve's folly in leaving his side, and being deceived by the serpent. (Spiritual Gifts Vol 3, page 44)

The Tower of Babel was built before the flood (SG vol 3, page 301

1864 edition) – This was later corrected in the 1870 edition –

She stated further, that .....

Satan bears the sins of the true penitent (GC 422, 485; 5T475 vs 1. Peter 2:24)

God sent an angel to converse with Cain (SG vol. 3, 48-49 vs. Genesis 4:6-7 – Yahuah himself talked to Cain according to Scripture)

That Jesus does not intercede for Non-Adventists (Early Writings page 261)

All the miracles of Christ were done through Angels - SOP Volume Two pg.76, Sec. Adv. Rev. and Sabbath Herald Jan. 1, 1873 p.16

It is a sin to be sick — Counsel on Health page 37 vs Job 2:7 (It is recorded that Ellen White was sick a lot, does it mean that she sinned a lot?)

**She saw children with wings on the new earth** - The Day-Star January 24, 1846, Early Writings of Ellen G. White pg.18, Spiritual Gifts Volume II, p.54

Children will be resurrected with wings -The Youth's Instr. 4/1/1858
Burning coal the cause of volcanic activity – SOP, Vol. One pg. 81

## She said that Paul learned the gospel from men in the church (3T430 vs. Gal. 1:11-12)

The Messiah was tempted for 40 days - (Redemption of the Temptation of Christ, p. 37 1874 Edition). Early Writings page 55; DA 118; 1SM 273;

The sins of the slave will be transferred to the slave master. (EW 276 vs Ezekiel 33:20)

Marriages are to be discouraged (5T 366 in 1885 – vs 1. Timothy 4:1-3) Jesus could not see through the portals of the tomb (DA 753 vs Luke 24:7; John 2:19; John 10:17 & 18 and Matt 26:64)

God requires a trespass offering before He pardons us (5 T 339 vs 1. John 1:9)

Samson disobeyed God when he married a Philistine (PP 562-563)

– vs Judges 14:3-4 - But Samson said to his father, "Get her for me. She's the right one for me." 4 (His parents did not know that this was from the LORD, who was seeking an occasion to confront the Philistines; for at that time they were ruling over Israel.)

She prophesied that some who were alive in 1856 would live to see the Lord's return (1T 131-132). She predicted that England would enter the Civil War and that the United States would be "..humbled into the dust" by England (1T259). She claimed she would be one of the 144,000 saints who would be living when Yahusha returned (EW 15-16). In 1850 she rebuked Bible scholars who were predicting an end time return of the Jews to Israel. She wrote that "drug medication... is a curse." She stated at one time that using medical doctors was a dishonor to God. She denounced the eating of eggs, milk, cream, and butter. In fact, she stated that eating eggs would make your prayer life useless!

She spent most of her life advocating a vegetarian diet even though at various times she ate meat herself. She forbade the eating of mustard, pepper, pickles and cinnamon. Picnics and parties were condemned. Tennis, cricket, baseball, and bike riding were labeled "species of idolatry."

There is Mormon and Jehovah's Witnesses link for the SDA's. As Ellen was rising to prominence, Joseph Smith had just died. Her writings contain many phrases used by Joseph Smith. He has also been accused of plagiarism. SDA's share their early history with the Jehovah's Witnesses. An early Adventist, N. H. Barbour copublished with Charles Taze Russell. They had a falling out over dates for the end of the world! (1844 and 1874), and parted company.

# Mrs. White not only contradicts the Bible at various times but also contradicted herself several times:

Deity "did" and "did not" sink and die (1898 7BC 907 vs 5BC 1129 in 1903)
God "does" and "does not" love children who do wrong (An Appeal to the Youth, Battle
Creek Mich. Steam Press, 1864, pp. 42,62 vs ST February 15, 1892)

The door of salvation "is" and "is not" forever shut (A word to the little Flock p. 22 (1847) by James White & Present Truth pp 21-22 August 1849 vs. 1 SM 63 and 1SM 74)

Pork "should" and "should not" be eaten (1T 206-207 vs 2SM 417; SG 4a p 124 and 2T 94)

There "is" and "is not" consciousness after death (EW 294 vs GC 545)

The plan of salvation existed before eternity and only since Adam's fall (1SM 231-232 vs DA 147)

The atonement "was" and "was not" complete (AA 29; DA758 vs. GC 623) We "are required" to kneel every time we pray and we are "not required" to kneel every time we pray (2SM 311 & 312 – required – 3SM 266-267 "not required". See Luke 18:13 and Mark 11:28)

As I mentioned before, some Adventists, like I did before, will go to any length trying to prove that Ellen White is genuine and a true prophet and her writings are equal to Scripture. Another example, the Bible does not teach the doctrine of the Trinity. Many SDA's try to prove that also Ellen White did **not** believe in the Trinity and they will write several pages of explanations to make that point. Here are some of her statements in reference to this topic, you be the judge: "The mighty agent of the Third person of the Godhead." DA 672 "We need to realize that the Holy Spirit, who is as much a person as God is a person, is walking through these grounds." MS 66, 1899 "The Holy Spirit is a person." Evangelism 617

"We are to co-operate with the three highest powers in heaven, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, and these powers will work through us, making us workers together with God." Special Testimonies, Series B, page 51 (1905)

"The prince of the power of evil can only be held in check by the power of God in the Third person of the Godhead, the Holy Spirit." Special Testimonies, Series A, # 10, page 37 (1897)

Did Ellen White support the doctrine of the Trinity, that there are 3 Persons in the Godhead with these statement or not? You decide!

Here is another example: It is said by some that Ellen White supported keeping the yearly feast days of Yahuah. In fact, she did make several positive statements that we need to keep the statutes, but to my knowledge, she never stated that the feast days are statutes as scripture states and are still binding. Here is one of her statements:

## "The National festival of the Jews was to pass away forever."

DA 653 (The quarterly communion Service took its place)
Ellen White meant exactly what she said, because she <u>never</u>
until her death in 1915 kept the feast days herself <u>at the</u>
<u>appointed times</u>, nor did she encourage others to do so, at least you can not read that in any of her published writings.

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Another interesting prophecy of Ellen White was that "Old Jerusalem <u>never</u> would be built up". In Early Writings p 75, she said, ".... <u>I ALSO SAW</u> THAT OLD JERUSALEM NEVER WOULD BE BUILT UP; and that Satan was doing his utmost to lead the minds of the children of the Lord into these things now, in the gathering time."


This prophecy did not come true. Since the nation of Israel's rebirth in 1948, "old Jerusalem" has been greatly built up. However, SDA believers will also take this prophecy and manipulate it, twist the meaning in order to show that Ellen White is correct!

As individuals, we are being warned by the 4th Angel in Revelation 18 to come out of the confusion of Babylon so we will not receive of her plagues. Each one of us has a choice, we can make flesh our arm or stick with a "Thus saith YHVH". I am not condemning or judging people, we are talking about doctrines and teachings of man. It is my desire to inspire people to make the word of YHVH their foundation and stand on His Word alone. We are to worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth, but we must know what His truth is.



On August 1, 1866 in the Health Reformer Ellen White made the following statement: "The present generation have trusted their bodies with the doctors, and their souls with the ministers." I believe she is 100% correct, because that applies the same to today. However, I feel from my personal experience that most Seventh-Day Adventists have trusted and are trusting their souls to the Writings of Ellen G White.

The denomination encourages their members to use Ellen White's writings for their Bible studies, they claim that she is an indispensable guide! In the following slide I inserted a clip that I found on the internet as an example of that!



We must under prayer and with an open mind study the word of Yahuah, from Genesis to Revelation learning its meaning and obeying its precepts, because that word is the truth and will judge us at the end.



It is nothing but the Torah with the Statutes and Judgments according to Malachi 4:4! Let's also be reminded of the words in Hosea 4:6 "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the Torah of thy God, I will also forget thy children."



Because of my position in reference to Ellen White, I am not using any statements made by her in order to prove or disprove any teachings. We should all stand on Scripture and Scripture alone as far as doctrines are concerned and especially the Hebrew Scriptures, BECAUSE THEY ARE THE ORIGINALS, even translations are corrupted, sometimes on purpose and sometimes unintentionally. 



A mistake many make is to follow tenaciously the instruction of Revelation 3:11 to "hold fast to what we have" while completely ignoring the additional instructions of I. Thessalonians 5:21 to test first.



Experience proves that not all that we believe is truth, even if we had it for 50 years. We have to test our beliefs continually and rigorously against the only standard that counts—the Scriptures, starting in Genesis 1:1! Because we have to follow YHVH, rather than man (Acts 5:29).

Let's be honest, human nature is lazy and takes the easy road at every opportunity. It will rely on human reasoning, the word of others, or tradition rather than do the hard work of studying Scripture and believing what it actually says. Human nature also will not naturally do the humbling work of



allowing the Bible and its plain unambiguous verses to prove matters rather than following humanly devised ideas. Let's no longer take any doctrines for granted but prove them with a "Thus saith YHVH!"
