The command issued by Paul to flee from idolatry must be a very serious matter in the eyes of our Creator and Savior!

It sounds like an urgent call! A matter of life and death!

WHY IS IT SO URGENT TO FLEE FROM IDOLATRY?

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Idolatry is nothing but devil-worship (Rev.9:20; cf. | Cor.10:19-22; Ex.20:4-6; Ps.106:34-41).



We are dealing in this case With eternal life in joy and peace and happiness, Versing eternal damnation! There is a heaven to gain And a hell to shun!

Here are the Creators own Words in Exodus 20:5, For I, הוה (YHVH) your Elohim (God) am a jealous Elohim! 10

For הוה (YHVH) vour) יהוה Elohim is a consuming fire, a jealous Elohim." Deut 4:24

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When most people think of jealousy, they think of a powerful human emotion that can do a great deal of harm unless harnessed and kept under control. Jealousy is not something that immediately comes to mind in connection with YHVH. He is saying that He tolerates no rivals, because there is none. When we read about His covenant relationship with the nation of Israel and then see how it is ultimately fulfilled in his relationship with His final remnant peoples, we discover that His jealousy is an important theme and a necessary aspect of His majestic, holy, and loving character.

The jealousy of Yahuah, the Creator, the Life giver, the only Savior according to Isaiah 44:6 and 44:24 is his commitment to his honor, glory, and love that manifests itself in the salvation of his people and the just condemnation of all who stand in opposition to him.




What is Idolatry? What does it look like?

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Most people today who have any concept of idolatry probably think of pagans bowing down and worshipping a strange-looking idol — a carved image or statue. That's part of what idolatry means, but most of us today don't do that. Idolatry is not just venerating a statue, carving or painting. Idolatry occurs when we begin to value anything more than we value the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. If we spend more time thinking about our hero than Elohim, that's idolatry. If our every thought is about the latest gadget or our personal appearance, that's idolatry. If the priority in our lives is our family, and to please ourselves, even that's idolatry.

When Yahuah said, "You shall have no other Elohim before Me" (Exodus 20:3 - Cepher), He wasn't just talking about the imaginary deities that seem so ridiculous to us today. He was talking about anything that usurps His place as number one in our hearts. The solution to this problem is as simple (and as difficult) as Yahushas admonition in Matthew 6:33, "But seek ye first the Kingdom of Elohiym and his righteousness." (Cepher) **Everything else must come later!**






Whatever divides the affections or takes away from the soul the supreme love of Yahuah or interposes to prevent unlimited confidence and entire trust in HIM, assumes the character and takes the form of an idol, it is idolatry!

Let's first begin with Deuteronomy 29:16-18 where YHVH says, ""For you know how we dwelt in the land of Mitsrayim and how we passed through the nations which you passed through, 17 and you saw their abominations and their idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, which were with them, 18 lest there should be among you a man or woman or clan or tribe, whose heart turns away today from יהוה (YHVH) our Elohim, to go and serve the mighty ones of these nations, lest there should be among you a root bearing bitterness or wormwood."

(Wormwood = La'anah, from an unused root means to curse, regarded as poisonous and therefore accursed, hemlock).


As an example, the cross used by Christians is <u>pagan idolatry</u> and has <u>nothing to do</u> with the Hebrew Savior Yahusha Messiah that gave His life.





Emperor Constantine introduced the pagan cross when He invented Christianity which is a mixture of paganism and true faith!







The cross and the "X" symbols (as in Xmas) both represent the sun and the zodiac, as does the circular communion wafer. Corresponding to Sumerian Utu. This cross was identified with a Sun god eight centuries before Yahusha and long before it was called the Maltese Cross by the Knights of Malta. 23

Rev. Alexander Hislop, The Two Babylon's, pp. 197-205, frankly calls the cross "this Pagan symbol ... the Tau, the sign of the cross, the indisputable sign of Tammuz, the false Messiah The mystic Tau of the Chaldeans (Babylonians) and Egyptians - the true original form of the letter T - the initial of the name of Tammuz ... the Babylonian cross was the recognized emblem of Tammuz." (Come out of her my people C.J. Koster – p.30). The cross is an abomination

In the Encyclopedia Britannica, 11th Edition, vol 14, p. 273, we read, "In the Egyptian churches the cross was a pagan symbol of life borrowed by the Christians and interpreted in the pagan manner." (Come out of her my people C.J. Koster – p.30).

That means the cross used By Christians is IDOLATRY! 25

Since we speak about the Christian cross, What about the Christian Messiah by the name of J. C. that was Nailed to a cross?

When you do some research, you will discover that what Christianity practices is rooted in paganism and is serving strange gods. Christianity does not serve the Most-High YHVH (Yahuah) the Scriptures speak of, and the one Abraham, Isaac, and Israel served neither do they follow Yahusha, the Son but a man-made Messiah, called Jesus, created by Constantine who was a sunworshipper till his death! 

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WHAT ABOUT EASTER? ANOTHER FORM OF IDOLATRY IN CHRISTIANITY!








The term "Easter" is derived from the name of an ancient pagan godess (Eostre, Ostara, Ishtar) and has **no relation whatsoever** to the events surrounding Yahusha's death.

100% PAGAN, AN ABOMINATION



There are many people in this world that practice idolatry. People of the Hindu religion have wooden and stone carvings and manifestations of their Elohims. Buddhists have Buddha statues which they give offerings, they even leave food for it, and rub its belly for good luck. Hindu's even have a special calf that they worship and even bow down to it. Idolatry is very much alive and well.

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The sin of idolatry is clearly defined in Scripture. Leviticus 19:4 states, "Do not turn to idols, and do not make for yourselves moulded mighty ones. I am יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim. ".

Leviticus 26:1 reads, "Do not make idols for yourselves, and do not set up a carved image or a pillar for yourselves, and do not place a stone image in your land, to bow down to it. For I am image in your Elohim. ".

Exodus 20:3-5 it states, "You have no other mighty ones against My face. 4 "You do not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of that which is in the heavens above, or which is in the earth beneath, or which is in the waters under the earth, 5 you do not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim am a jealous El, visiting the crookedness of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me."

As we had seen, even Christians are worshipping another Elohim called Jesus Christ.

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We can make Elohims (gods) out of the work of our hands, we can all make our very own Elohim. We can make this Elohim thru our own minds and make it say whatever we want. Whatever we think we can do. However, these images profit nothing. They are teachers of lies that come from our own thoughts.




Some people are so brainwashed by their pastor until they talk more about him, than about Yahusha. Their pastor can do no wrong, and if he does, they are the first to defend him, no matter what he has done or believes. He could be a liar or a believer of false teachings, or a perpetuator of carnal behavior, to them it does not matter. That means their pastor becomes their idol.



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Idolatry is a very serious sin; it attacks directly at Yahuah's character. Once His character has been adulterated, we lose our guidelines for moral judgment and morality is now whatever we think, whatever we want it to be. If we don't have a true perspective of Yahuah Elohim, then we are lost, along with everything else.



What does YHVH say about borrowing pagan symbols and holidays to worship Him? Syncretism means to attempt to be in union of diverse or opposite ideas. It is mixing things that are fundamentally different. From the very beginning YHVH has <u>not</u> accepted syncretism. The central theme in holiness is separation. As it reads in Genesis 12:1-, "And יהוה (YHVH) said to Abram, 'Go yourself out of your land, from your relatives and from your father's house, to a land which I show you."






There is no room for mix in Yahuah's economy. His laws show this. According to Torah, bringing pagan forms of worship of Elohim is prohibited. Yahuah hates syncretism, it goes against His very essence, for in Him is light and there is no darkness. Deuteronomy 18:9,12; and 20:17-18 are among verses that speak of not melting with pagan ideas and things.



You can not **Mix Truth** With Error And be accepted!



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
When we allow the things of Satan to come in, we open the door to his demons. Mixing things that are not of Elohim deadens the soul -- it takes the soul away from YHVH. It lulls it, soothes it.



It is like the frog in the slowly heated water...by the time the water is boiling its too late, the frog is a goner.

The Nation of Israel continued going down hill as they increased in syncretism. After 100s of years Yahuah finally punished them with exile. Its very sad that holidays such as Christmas and Easter have overshadowed the festivals which Yahuah gave to His people. Christianity has lost great edification and instruction; her Jewish and Torah roots. We need to shine as lights in this dark world. The professed people of YHVH and the world celebrate Christmas together as though they are one.

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If you celebrate things that displease the Father, you commit idolatry, an abomination!

Romans 1:21-23 (KJV) says, "Because that, when they knew Elohim, they glorified him not as Elohim, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. 22. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, 23. And changed the glory of the uncorruptible Elohim into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things!"

We humans seem to want to make Yahuah in our image, we want to bring Elohim down to be like what we want, turning Elohim into what we are. Let us stop humanizing the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. We are getting to the point of not seeing Him as He truly is. Don't let 00 Satan influence you, he is behind it!

As I had mentioned in the beginning idolatry is not just making an idol out of some material and bowing to it, it includes much more.



First John, 5:10 reads, "The one who believes in the Son of Elohim has the witness in himself, the one who does not believe Elohim has made Him a liar, because he has not believed the witness that Elohim has given concerning His Son." As believers in Yahusha, how many of us panic over a problem, worry over it and **do not trust YHVH for it**?

What we have just done is to doubt our Heavenly Father. By not believing in HIM, we have made Him something different then what He said He is. This is idolatry because we have just made YHVH less than what He is.



Another thought on idolatry we find in Exodus 32:3-5, "And all the people took off the golden earrings which were in their ears and brought them to Aharon 4 And he took this from their hand, and he formed it with an engraving tool and made a moulded calf. And they said.

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... 'This is your mighty one, O Yisra'ěl, that brought you out of the land of Mitsrayim!' 5 And Aharon saw and built a slaughterplace before it. And Aharon called out and said, 'Tomorrow is a festival to יהוה **(YHVH)**."




This golden calf was made to represent the true and living Elohim, the Elohim who brought them out of Egypt, **but** they were worshipping Him in the wrong way. There are many today who are also worshipping the true Elohim in the wrong way.



Aaron may have thought that a golden calf would adequately represent the majesty and power of YHVH, but the resulting worship quickly degenerated into a debauched pagan festival so loud that Joshua thought war had broken out! What was Elohim's response? The covenant was broken, the people were forced to drink the remains of the shattered idol, three thousand worshipers were put to the sword, and those who survived were struck with a plague.

YHVH did not view their sin lightly, neither will He look at it lightly today, because He has not changed according to Malachi 3:6!

Jeroboam revived the same idolatry for his own political purposes in a later age. Ahab would be the first king to introduce worship of false Elohims into the Northern Kingdom. The history of Baal worship demonstrates the distinction between the First and Second Commandments, while subsequent events show that even idolatry related to the one true Elohim is an abomination.




King Ahab built the temple of Baal, and the author of the KJV introduces this fact with the words, "And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam." (I Kings 16:31) Baal worship was a whole new category of sin, but we should not imagine that it was a "light thing" to worship YHVH through an idol! Thus Jehu, destroyed Baal out of Israel, Howbeit from the sins of Jeroboams the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, Jehu departed not, and he continued to worship the golden calves. (II Kings 10:28-29) Eventually this sin was one of the causes of the destruction of the Northern Kingdom. (II Kings 17:21-23) 60

Romans 1:23 reads, "In fact they have exchanged the glory of the immortal Elohim for mere images, like a mortal human being, or like birds, and animals or reptiles! Their hearts were foolish and darkened."

The wickedness of the heart clouds and darkens, it binds and perverts and corrupts. See Jeremiah 17:9, "The heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked." Romans 1:22 says, "claiming to be wise, they have become fools".

Now that we have a little better understanding of idolatry lets look at us. I know that we don't physically make statues or pictures and bow to them, worshipping them. Does this mean that we don't make idols? Let's look at other forms of idolatry.



Let's look at being covetous, is it idolatry?




Deut. 5:21, You do not covet your neighbor's wife, nor do you desire your neighbor's house, his field, nor his male servant, nor his female servant, his ox, nor his donkey, or whatever belongs to your neighbor.' Micah 2:2 reads, "And they coveted fields and seized them, also houses, and took them away. And they oppressed a man and his house, a man and his inheritance."

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Covetousness is Idolatry

Many don't realize how greed is impeding their spiritual growth and how necessary it is to overcome the deadly and deceitful sin of covetousness.

Humanity has long been afflicted by the curse of covetousness. Yahusha warned the people of His day, "And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consists not in the abundance of the things which he possesses." (Luke:12:15). (Cepher)



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We cannot worship Yahuah in the true way and be coveting or being greedy and selfish.

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This can only happen when you are born again through water and the spirit in the name of Yahusha!

Colossians 3:5-6 says, "Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: whoring, uncleanness, passion, evil desire and greed of gain, which is idolatry. 6 **Because of these the wrath** of Elohim is coming upon the sons of disobedience.

It doesn't matter if it's the gods of Egypt or money or anything else. Whatever that idol is, it has a defiling effect, and you must flee from it. A person who worships an idol will tend to tear down all who are around him. In Ezekiel 36:18 it reads. "So I poured out My wrath on them for the blood they had shed on the land, and for their idols they defiled it."



 Man was created to worship! If He doesn't worship YHVH, the one who created man, the one who sustains him, he will worship something else!

Every person on Earth does worship. Sad to say, we don't all worship the Creator of Heaven, but we all worship someone or something. It may be a sports figure, an entertainer, or someone else. It may be a possession. But everyone bows at some kind of altar. But if you are not worshiping the true and living Creator, then you will worship something of your own composition or some other false god. Even atheist's worship. Skeptics worship. Republicans and Democrats worship. Independents worship. Everyone, everywhere, worships. It's the fundamental drive of life and one of the unique distinctions of humanity. 000

I repeat, if you are not worshiping the true and living Creator, then you will worship something of your own composition, called an Idol. However, an Idol cannot help you in anyway, you cannot turn to your money, your big house, or your luxury car, they wont, nor can they help. They cannot speak, they cannot give you advice in times of tribulations, they are just there, giving no help at all.







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People may put their treasure in the things of this world and in the cares of this world. As stated, they may find their value in fancy cars, fancy houses, nice toys, and the like yet they must protect and preserve these items. How can we submit ourselves to these things that cannot help or save us. Yes, we need a place to live, we need transportation, a dependable vehicle to get around, but we must not make these things our idols. We must be good stewards and take good care of our homes, cars and other belongings, but not worship them. We must first seek the kingdom of Heaven and His righteousness, trust HIM that give us our breath.



Consider another idol, the idol of sex. People are giving themselves into pornography, sex before marriage, promiscuity, adultery, homosexuality, and the like. They are looking for true joy, pleasure, and escape. But the problem is the same. If it depends on you, then it cannot give you what you are looking for. The moment ends and now you are back to the same position what you were before. You are no better off for all your work and waste of time. If you must protect it, then it is not to be depended on. If you must save it, then it is not worth your life pursuit. If you must help it, then you should not treasure it.

People make vain and false imaginations of YHVH, they make Elohim, whatever they please. They govern themselves by their own minds, teachers of lies. They make YHVH and Scripture to mean whatever they want. They have dumb idols. We have the Living **Elohim, Yahuah, the Creator** and Savior. We have access to Him not by our own inventions but by what He has instituted.





Isaiah 65:2 reads, "I (YHVH) have held out My hands all day long to a stubborn people, who walk in a way that is not good, after their own thoughts." He spreads out His hands to embrace them, to accept them. When Yahusha was crucified, His hands were spread out and stretched as if He was preparing to receive us sinners, receive us unto His bosom. He was waiting and He was not weary of waiting.

Joshua 23:7-8 reads, "so as not to go in among these nations, these who remain among you. And make no mention of the name of their mighty ones, nor swear by them, nor serve them nor bow down to them. 8 But cling to יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim, as you have done to this day.


Idolatry is demonic and offensive to our Elohim; we are not even to mention their names. Let us remember that an idol does not have to be something that we have fashioned with our hands, but it can also be fashioned by our hearts.

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Beware of Idolatry in any shape or form! FLEE FROM IT!

Ezekiel 14:3-4 reads, "Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their hearts and have put the stumbling-block of their crookedness before their face. Should I let them inquire of Me at all? 4. "Therefore, speak to them, and you shall say to them, 'Thus said the Master יהוה (YHVH) **Everyone of the house of Yisra'ěl who sets** up his idols in his heart, and puts the stumbling-block of his crookedness before his face, and shall come to the prophet – I יהוה (YHVH) shall answer who comes, according to his many idols."

One day each of us will stand before our King in judgment, we will be standing before Him **alone**, not able to blame our wife, or husband, or mother, or father, or sister, or brother, or anyone. Will we stand there with a life full of idolatry, or will we stand before Him with a life full of good deeds? If anyone here today does not know the master Yahusha, repent of your sins, throw out your idols, follow Yahusha, for the Kingdom of heaven is now.



Another form of idol worship that we mold and make, is not with hands but with our wicked and evil hearts, When we take our eyes off of Yahuah and put them on ourselves, we have just made a new idol, ourselves. We comfort ourselves in vain, we become of ourselves, false Elohims, thus loosing favor with the true and living Elohim. We go our own way and because of it we are not in a fold, we are scattered from each other and from Yahuah Elohim.





Then we have no shepherd, no one to rule us, no one to guide and lead us. No priest to intercede for us, no one to take care of us and keep us together. The only truth we say we have is in ourselves, and comes from our small and puny minds, it is not the truth, it is lies, it is deception. We are polluting ourselves. We are dumb idols, with no understanding. Let us not take Elohim's throne out of our hearts and replace with ourselves or any idol.

The Living Elohim, the True Elohim, the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac sand Jacob, is the one who made us, who sent His Son Yahusha to redeem us. He pardoned our sins and gave us eternal life. Let us cleave, again I say, let us cleave to Him in faith, love, and obedience. Let us not separate our minds and hearts from the only Elohim.



TAKE HEED, DO NOT TRUST IN MAN!

Jeremiah 17:5-6 reads (KJV), "Thus saith YHVH; Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from YHVH 6. For he shall be like the heath in the desert and shall not see when good cometh; but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, in a salt land and not inhabited."

When it comes to where we will place our trust, there are basically only two choices: man or YHVH. This choice is a critical one, because one is a curse, and the other is a blessing. As we were just reading in Jeremiah, "Cursed is the man who trusts in man... **Blessed is the man who trusts** in Yahuah."



The curse that results from depending upon human resources (ours or others) is barrenness of life, spiritually speaking. **"For he shall be like a shrub in the desert."** A desert shrub represents the antithesis of abundant spiritual life. It is the picture of a plant that is barely surviving. Desert shrubs are typically sparse in growth and lacking in fruitfulness. **A person who trusts in flesh is like this shrub.**













Some trust in chariots, And some in horses, **But we will remember** The name of Yahuah Elohim.

Psalms 20:7 (Cepher)





A couple of questions to think about. Are we idolatrous in any way? Are there other pictures in our hearts that are next to or even in front of Yahuah? What is in our lives that would take us away from an obedient walk with Him? If there is, then pick it up and throw it away, commit to making Yahuah the only Elohim you serve. Remember Yahusha is the Master of all.

Let's be reminded,
