Many Christian denominations foolishly teach that Yahuah's laws have been abolished, done away with and replaced by a cheap grace, even though Yahusha Himself teaches that until heaven and earth pass away, not one jot or tittle of the Law will disappear. Throughout His life, Yahusha modeled for us how to live our lives, demonstrating that Yahuah's Torah (Law) should be living in us and be part of our second nature, deeply embedded in our heart and our mind through Yahushas Spirit living in us.





Can we now steal, murder, lie, fornicate, practice witchcraft and do evil deeds because according to the Christian church the law no longer applies?



 Most Christians will tell you that we now have the law in our hearts therefore we will no longer do these things. But if you ask them about why they are still going to church on Sunday which is not found in the Scriptures, they will make all sort of excuses and misquote Scripture. We cannot pick and choose what we like to do and not do and think that Yahuah will accept us.





How can there be sin if there is NO Law?

How did Adam and Eve know they had sinned if they did not have the law? If there was no Torah (law) written in their heart they would not know that they had sinned. Here is Scripture proof that there cannot be sin without the Law either written on your heart or written on stone. "For this reason, even as through one man sin did enter into the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned - for until the Torah, sin was in the world, but sin is not reckoned when there is no Torah (law)." Romans

5:12,13.

These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Deuteronomy 6:6-7





Is the Law sin?

What shall we say, then? **Is the law sin?**Certainly not! Nevertheless, I would not have known what sin was had it not been for the Torah (law.) For I would not have known what coveting really was if the law had not said, "You shall not covet."

Romans 7:7.





What is the Biblical definition of sin?

"So that the Torah truly is set-apart, and the command set-apart, and righteous, and good." Romans 7:12 (TS2009) "Whosoever commits sin transgresses also the Torah: for sin is the transgression of the Torah." 1John 3:4 (Cepher)



Are we sinners?

"For all have sinned and come short of the glory of Elohiym." Romans 3:23 (Cepher)



If one says they are not a sinner, they are deceived. 1John 1:8-10



Can we be saved by simply believing in Yahusha without repenting and turning away from our sin??



No, one cannot be saved and continue to sin which is the breaking of Yahuah's Torah (instructions).

"MY little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Yahusha Ha'Mashiach the righteous: 2 And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. 3 And hereby we do know



That we know him, if we guard his commandments. 4. He that says, I know him, and guards not his commandments, is a liar, and the Truth is not in him. 5 But whoso guards his word, in him truly is the love of Elohiym perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. 6 He that says he abides in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked." 1John2:1-6 (Cepher)

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'Whosoever is born of Elohiym does not commit sin; for his seed remains in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of Elohiym. 10 In this the children of Elohiym are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever does not righteousness is not of Elohiym, neither he that loves not his brother." 1 Johannes 3:9-10 (Cepher)



Satan and his evil angels also believe in Yahuah, and they are not saved because they continue to break Yahuah's law.

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What did Yahusha mean when He said "It is finished"?

Yahushas sacrifice enabled us to have forgiveness for our sins making us understand that sin caused His terrible suffering and death, He took the punishment we deserved so how can we now continue to live in sin? Yahusha paid the death penalty we deserved and reconciled us back to the Father through His sacrifice so that "When sins are forgiven, there is no more need to offer sacrifices." Hebrews 10:18.).

When do we remember the death of Yahusha and how we are eternally grateful to Him for dying on the tree in our place?





We remember His sacrifice annually on the eve of Passover and when we partake of the Passover Memorial meal. We remember that we are in Covenant with Yahusha through His atoning blood sacrifice, thus our sins are forgiven. Like Paul said, "What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? Elohim forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?" Romans 6:12 (KJV) Easter has nothing to do with Yahusha but is a pagan holiday to the fertility goddess Esther. (Astarte)

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Why is it very dangerous to continue in sin and breaking of Yahuah's Torah (law)?

Once knowing the truth, if one continues to sin which is the breaking of Yahuah's laws, there is no longer a sacrifice for your sin's, only the lake of fire. (Hebrews 10:26-31, Leviticus 5:5,16-17).

If one continues to sin willfully, you won't enter into the kingdom of Yahuah, and will die an eternal death in the lake of fire. (Hebrews10:26-27).





Where will you find Yahuah's Commandments, statutes and judgments?

You will find the laws in the first five books of the Scriptures from Genesis to Deuteronomy and repeated all over in the Scriptures including the New Testament. We have heard people say, Yahusha fulfilled the law for us, so we can keep sinning (breaking the Laws of Yahuah or the laws are for the Jews and not for everyone else.) This is a great deception that Satan uses! John 14:15 "If ye love me, keep my commandments." (KJV)





Are there different laws for the "Christens or Non-Jews" and Jews?

The answer is No. Once one is saved, filled with Yahuah's Spirit, there is no more Greek or Jew, bond or free, male or female. (Gal. 3:28-29). We all have been adopted, through Yahusha's blood and must obey every word of Yahuah in His Torah. Christianity teaches that the New Testament is for the Christians and the Old Testament was for ancient Israel.

They do not understand that over 85 percent of the New Testament comes from the Old Testament as that was the only Scriptures they had. "There is no longer Jew or Gentile, slave or free, male and female. For you are all one in Yahusha Messiah." Gal. 3:28. One body and one Spirit, as you also were called in one expectation of your calling, one Master, one belief, one immersion, one Elohim and Father of all, 1 who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:4- 6. Christianity is not of Yahuah it is a man-made religion revived by Emperor Constantine so as to unite all the different pagan religions into one religion, thus mixing a little Bible truth with lots of pagan traditions.





What happens if we continue in sin and ignoring Yahuah's Torah (law)?

If one continues to sin, they are still a sinner, and have made Yahusha sacrifice of none effect, and have taken it lightly, and the only thing that awaits us is the lake of fire. (Hebrews 10:26-27).





What is the greatest deception of Satan?

Satan wants you to follow his law of sin and death so you will miss eternal life. "Because through Yahusha Messiah, the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death, in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the Spirit." Yahusha came to save us from sin (breaking Yahuah's law), and to reconcile us back to our Father Yahuah. His Spirit gives us the power to overcome sin and to obey Torah. (Rom. 3:23-31, 2 Cor.5:18-19, 1 John 2:2,3-10).).





What laws ae no longer relevant today?

Because Yahusha is our Melkitzadeg High Priest, the Aaronic/Levitical priesthood with its temple and animal sacrifices no longer needed as the blood of bulls and goats cannot take away sin and was there to point forward to Yahusha the perfect Lamb who is the only One who can take our sins away IF we repent and turn away from our sins. (1 Cor. 5:7, Eph. 5:2, Heb. 9:26, 10:1-12, Titus 2:14, Heb. 9:13-14, 10:10, 21-22). (Heb. 5:1-10, 6:19-20, 7:17,21, 2:17-18, 4:15)





Is Yahuah's laws eternal??

"Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away." Matthew 24:35. Even on the new earth Yahuah's law will always be our standard of living so that sin and evil no longer enters the new earth. Here are a few Scriptures, that shows Yahuah has commanded us to keep His Laws forever, and what will happen if we don't: (Ex. 15:26, 12:24, 19:5, Lev. 18:4-5, Rev. 22:11-14, Num. 15:30-31, Deut. 4:39-40, 5:29, 8:11,19-20, 10:12-13, 11:1,26:17-19, Deut 28 and 30, Joshua 1:8,1 Samuel 12:14-15, 1 Kings 2:3, 3:14, 9:4-9, 11:34, 2 Kings 17:32-41, Psalm 119, Proverbs 7:1-3, 13:13-14). Yahuah shows us the blessings of keeping His laws and the curses of breaking His Laws.(Deuteronomy 28and 6:,28: and 30:).





Can you see the curse of breaking Yahuah's law today?

Just look at the evil world we are living in today. People call evil good and good evil. They are murdering unborn babies, stealing, murdering, killing babies, promoting homosexuality and witchcraft and all types of sexual sins. The curse of breaking Yahuah's Laws is what we see in the world today (sickness and disease, drug and alcohol addiction, food contamination, rape and murder, perversions, sufferings and poverty, injustice etc.)





Did Yahuah break His Father's Torah, and did He teach others to break the law?

The answer is No. Yahuah sent Yahusha His Son, our Savior, to take away mankind's sin, but mankind has been deceived by the devil who is the father of lies (John 8:44) to believe, that Yahusha came, so mankind can continue to break Yahuah's Laws (sin); by nailing them to the tree. Yahusha never told anyone not to keep the Laws of Yahuah, on the contrary, He kept the Laws of His Father and told others to do so. (Matt. 5:17,20, 7:12,21-23, 8:4, 11:13, 13:41, Mark 2:27, 3:35, 7:6-23,) Luke 1:6 the disciples also kept Yahuah's Laws, {Luke 2:21-23 Yahusha's parents kept Yahuah's Laws\,16:17,29, John 5:45-47, 7:19-21, 10:34-35, 13:15,25,


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
So, what was nailed to the tree in Colosians 2:13-14?

"And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; 14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross." (KJV)



Because we sinned, there was a death sentence against us. In other words, there was a written arrest warrant or bond, that charged you with the indictment of being a sinner. Yahusha cancelled the record of our debt, in the same way a legal pardon cancels the penalty for that crime.

It was a serious accusation because "the wages of sin is death" Romans 6:23 (KJV).




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The law (Torah) could **never** be cancelled because it is through Yahuah's law that we know when we have sinned and have a guideline as to what is right and what is wrong. Romans 7:7 "What, then, shall we say? Is the Torah sin? Let it not be! However, I did not know sin except through the Torah. For also the covetousness I knew not if the Torah had not said, "You shall not covet." (TS2009) Romans 2:13 "For not the hearers of the Torah are righteous in the sight of Elohim, but the doers of the Torah shall be declared right." (TS2009)

Faith is action which produces obedience to the Torah.







Did the prophets, disciples and new converts obey the Torah?

All the prophets and disciples and new converts obeyed the Torah so why would it be different today? The disciples kept the Torah (Laws) even after Yahusha died and rose. "Do we then make void the Torah by faith? Never: yea, we establish the Torah." Romans 3:31 (Cepher)

Paul said in Acts 24:14 "But this I confess unto you, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the Elohiym of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the Torah and in the prophets." (Cepher)



Romans 6:15-16 "What then? Shall we sin because we are not under Torah but under favor? Let it not be!16 Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves servants for obedience, you are servants of the one whom you obey, whether of sin to death, or of obedience (leading) to righteousness?" (TS2009)

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What about Peter's vision that says all foods are now declared clean?

We would like to explain Peter's vision (Acts 10:13-17). It proves Peter kept the Torah (Laws) of Yahuah; Yahuah was giving Peter a vision, that salvation had come to all mankind, not just Jews. Yahuah using a parable with the unclean meat (a law), that Peter could identify with, but the vision disturbed Peter (Acts 10:17) because he knew Yahuah was not telling Him to eat unclean meat, which is breaking the Torah. (Lev. 11). ...

... If the reader would read the rest of this chapter (Acts 10:18-38, and 11:1-18), they would see that the vision that Peter had was confirming that salvation has come to all mankind, not just Jews. This passage has nothing to do with declaring all foods clean. The dietary laws found in Deuteronomy 14 still apply. Pork, shellfish, calamari, oysters are all unclean and an abomination to Yahuah. We cannot expect Yahusha's Spirit to live inside a dirty temple defiled with unclean food, rebellion and sin.





What is the purpose of Yahuah's law as it cannot save us from our sins?

True faith produces good fruits of obedience to the Torah (Law). As stated earlier the Laws only show what sin is, the Laws can't save us as we are not saved by obedience but rather because we are saved we produce good fruits of obedience to the Torah. Mankind can only be saved through Yahusha Messiah, but once saved you will have the want to desire, to keep the Laws of Yahuah.

James 1:14–15 But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.



Romans 6:12-14 "Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, to obey it in its desires, 13 neither present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin but present yourselves to Elohim as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to Elohim. 14 For sin shall not rule over you, for you are not under the law but under favour." (TS2009)

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Some will say we are under a New Covenant, which many believe the New Covenant takes away the Old Covenant; New covenant being Yahusha, the Old covenant being the Torah of Yahuah. Is this true?



So lets address this deception: Yahusha came to take away our sins (1John 3:4) not the Torah (Laws) of Yahuah which are eternal and ratified in blood.

We read in Hebrews,"For if that first covenant had been faultless, then no place would have been sought for a second. For finding fault with them (the Israelites broke the Covenant), He says, "See, the days are coming," says " יהוה, (YHVH) when I shall conclude with the house of Yisra'el and with the house of Yehudah a New covenant." The disobedience of Israel is why the Covenant was broken.



There was nothing wrong with the Covenant Torah, but the people were disobedient and went into idolatry over and over again.

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


Hebrews 8:8-13. Yahuah says he will put His Torah (Laws) in their minds and their hearts, but nowhere did He say, He would take His Laws away. Notice verse "15-16" in Heb. 10:, that says the Holy Spirit is a witness to us, that Yahuah's Laws will be in our hearts and our minds. This is the new covenant, once you are saved, filled with Yahuah's Spirit, a born-again believer has a mind and a heart to keep the Laws of Yahuah because you have a love relationship with Him.



The only way you can have this mind and heart is through His Spirit which gives us the desire and power to obey. (Romans 8:6-9, 12:1-2); Being set free from sin through Yahusha, which is 'the new covenant", which takes away our sins (because we broke His laws and we have repented of our sins and choose to obey the Torah. The new covenant takes away law breaking, and in so doing takes away eternal death which we deserved, but Yahusha died in our place so we can be forgiven.



What is the key to eternal Life?

Obedience to all the Torah is faith in action which will give you eternal life. Revelation 22:14 Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life and may enter in through the gates into the city. Ecclesiastes 12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear Yahuah and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. Do not be deceived Yahuah does not change. He is the same yesterday, today and forever. Hebrews 13;8.
