This world is **NOT** my home!





WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

We are just passing through, therefore decide where to spend eternity, either in eternal life of happiness or eternal damnation!

Let me first say, do NOT follow religion, for all religions are man-made.

Stay away from religion, may it be Christianity, Judaism, Islam or others and all man-made teachings!

Accept Scripture only as your compass, starting in Genesis 1:1

Get a Bible that has not been changed or altered!
Accept the Elohim (God) of Abraham, Isaac and Israel,
whose name is YHVH (Yahuah)!

Accept the sacrifice of His Son Yahusha (NOT THE GREEK (Christian) JESUS CHRIST, who was created by Constantine in the third century and never lived and could not have died for you.

The Christian Jesus is an image, a copy of the Hebrew Messiah Yahusha BUT IS NOT Yahusha.

Acknowledge, confess your past sins, and be baptized in Yahusha's name ONLY.

Obey His instructions He Himself gave to Moses, called Torah, which is your seal according to Isaiah 8:16! That includes the weekly Sabbath, the yearly appointed feast days, the health laws and to keep yourself unspotted from the world.

Do it soon, it is salvational!

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
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Through my studies a few years ago I learned that God, LORD, and Jesus are fake names put into our Bibles to replace the Real Names of our Heavenly Father and His Beloved Son. The True Names have been removed over 7000 times from Scripture and replaced by God, LORD or Jesus which are not Names but titles like Mr. or Miss. Isn't it amazing if you ask a Muslim who he worships he will say Allah which is the name of his god and if you ask a Buddhist the name of his god, he will say Buddha. Yet we as professed believers in the only true Elohim, the Creator of the universe and Savior of mankind, do not even know the name of who we worship. Therefore, I use the four Hebrew letters yod, hey, vav, hey in English YHVH (and I pronounce it as Yahuah) instead of LORD, which is a title - not a name. I also use Yahusha instead of Jesus, which is not a translation but a transliteration from a Greek mistransliteration. The name Jesus has no meaning, in Hebrew nor in English! YHVH and Yahusha are the actual original Hebrew names that speak of our Savior's true nature and character. Since the Father has a Hebrew name, the Son cannot have a Greek name, because He came in the name of His Father (John 5:43)! The Father's name is contained in the Son's name as you can see in this example! The Father's name is YAH according to Psalms 68:4!

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of all of my presentations is to turn people from the commandments and doctrines of man to the written Torah (instructions) of Moses that were dictated to Him by the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Israel and to the living Torah, called Yahusha Ha Mashiach. The teachings and practices of today's Christianity that are divided into more than 41,000 churches, denominations and sects have in reality very little in common with the God of Abraham and Israel.

It Is and was my desire to examine their teachings, which have crept into the Christian Church and found that most of them are nothing but sun-worship. Many pagan practices, rooted in sun-worship that have absolutely no scriptural basis, have been accepted by Christianity. This falling away started already in the first Century. Christianity is a copycat religion and is mostly created by Emperor Constantine for political purposes.

What does Yahusha say about man-made, controlled religion? Here are his words to the leaders of His day, which applies the same to today's clergy:

Mark 12:38-40 (*The Scriptures*), "Beware of the scribes, who like to walk around in long robes, and like greetings in the marketplaces, 39 and the best seats in the congregations, and the best.

First, some Bible verses making the point that this world is not our home, we are just passing through.

1 John 2:15-17 ESV

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world — the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride in possessions — is not from the Father but is from the world. And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of Yahuah abides forever.

Revelation 21:4 ESV Talking about our NEW HOME!

He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."

James 4:4 ESV

You adulterous people! Do you not know that **friendship with the world is enmity with YHVH**? Therefore, whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of YHVH.

John 15:19 ESV

If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

1 Peter 2:11-12 ESV

Beloved, I urge you as **sojourners and exiles** to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul. Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify Yahuah on the day of visitation.

John 16:33 ESV

I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.

Hebrews 13:14 ESV

For here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city that is to come.

John 17:14-15 ESV

I have given them your word, and the world has hated them because **they are not of the world**, just as I am not of the world. I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one.

Chapter 1

"Seek ye first the kingdom of Elohim, and his righteousness..." Matthew 6:33



This is part of the Sermon on the Mount by Yahusha, the Messiah. Growing up in a Christian Church or denomination, we have all heard this statement. The question I want to ask is, what does it really mean and why is it necessary to seek <u>first</u> the kingdom of Elohim?" First, it means exactly what it says. The

reason being that He is the 'THE CREATOR" and is in charge. Therefore, we are to put His commandments, His desires, and His love in the center of our life. We are to make it our priority as nothing else would even make sense.

Secondly, the reason why we should be seeking first the kingdom of Elohim is, because this life of ours is transitory, it is short and will pass. We humans in our fallen nature keep on forgetting this fact and act like this is our permanent home and we think we are in charge instead of ELOHIM. In our fallen nature we cannot effectively rule ourselves without the help of the living Elohim, the one that created and sustains us.

When I speak of Elohim, I am speaking of the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Israel, whose name is YHVH in Hebrew letters or pronounced in English Yahuah. I am speaking about the eternal, GREAT I AM as He introduced himself to Abraham in Exodus 3:14. The one who was, who is and who is to come. He is the all-powerful, the all-knowing and the ever-present ELOHIM. He is the Aleph and Tav, the Alpha and Omega, the first and the last, the

beginning and the end. He is the only one, there is no other (Deuteronomy 4:35). I want to make that clear to begin with as there are many false, man-made Elohims in this world that are trying to deceive us.

When we go to the previous verses of Matthew 6 we are told by Yahusha how the Heavenly Father takes care of supplying the daily needs of His creation and in the same way He will take care of man's daily needs if he will trust HIM and follow His instructions. Therefore, He states in the verses 31 and 32 "take no thought, saying, what we shall eat? Or what shall we drink? Or Wherewithal shall we be clothed? 32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things." KJV

Then He continues in verse 33 with what we really should be concerned with and what should be our **first** priority: "**But seek ye** <u>first</u> the kingdom of Elohim, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."

Don't be pre-occupied or overcharged with the temporary needs of this world, like what will I eat? How will I pay the bills? How will I have a happy marriage? How will I have a successful career and what should I wear?

Man has a higher purpose, namely, to seek **first** the kingdom of Heaven and His righteousness, then YHVH will take care of the rest. That's His promise!

However, this passage does not indicate that if we first seek His kingdom all the things, we worry about will be automatically fixed. Some people see it this way, but it is far from reality and what Yahusha meant. The concept that seeking Elohim's kingdom is a means by which to promote earthly comfort is an erroneous preaching and is referred to as the <u>prosperity gospel</u>. Seeking

Elohim's kingdom does mean that we can have the surety necessary to keep in perspective the power of Elohim over our lives, reducing our need to worry.



We should always remember that this world is not our permanent home just like Yahusha said in John 18:36 to Pilate, "My kingdom is <u>not</u> of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence." KJV

There are two competing, completely different kingdoms in this universe. There is the Kingdom of the World, dominated by Satan, the Elohim of this world, and there is the Kingdom of Yahuah, the Creator and Savior. The Kingdom of the World is visible. It seems so real and substantial. The Kingdom of YHVH is invisible. To many it seems unreal and insubstantial. Each one has its own values, goals, loves, interests, and priorities. You are either a part of The Kingdom of the World, or a part of the Kingdom of Elohim. Whichever one you are part of will determine your destiny. (By Rabbi Loren Jacobs)

The world says, make as much money as you can. Get rich, since wealth equals a good and happy and successful life. One Pastor put it this way "the world system is committed to at least four major objectives, fortune, fame, power, and pleasure. The world system is driven by money; it feeds on materialism. It is driven by fame and popularity, a longing to be known, to be somebody in someone else's eyes. It is driven by having and maintaining control over individuals or groups or companies or whatever. It is the desire to manipulate and maneuver others to do something for one's own benefit.

Yahuah's kingdom is the opposite in every way.

The principle of HIS kingdom is not to be served but to serve

Some of these are outlined in the Beatitudes as follows:

- "Blessed are they that mourn for they shall be comforted.
- "Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
- "Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.
- "Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.
- "Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see Elohim.
- "Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of Elohim.
- "Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- "Blessed are ye, when *men* shall revile you, and persecute *you*, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.
- "Rejoice and be exceeding glad: for great *is* your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you." (Matthew 5:4-12 KJV)



We are to be content with what we have. When we have our basic necessities met, we are doing well, and we are to be grateful. This is Paul's advice in 1Timothy 6: 7-8, "For we brought nothing into [this]

world, [and it is] certain we can carry nothing out. 8 And having food and raiment let us be therewith content." KJV

We are not to store up for ourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal (see *Matthew 6:19*), and stock markets plunge, and currencies are devalued, and housing markets deflate.

We are to store up for ourselves treasures in Heaven, where the true wealth is, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where


thieves do not break in or steal. Because where our treasure is, there our heart will be also. We can't serve Yahuah and money at the same time. It is much better to serve only HIM, and not money, for we bring no material possessions into this world, and we can leave with none. Why strive for a life that is based on the acquisition of more and more material possessions, which at the end are completely worthless?



However, there are some things that we can take with us, and therefore those are the things worth pursuing, like your Salvation; your character; your sacrifices for others, your service, your love, and knowledge of His will and do not forget, the people that are saved because of your efforts and work. So, if that is

what you can take with you, it only makes sense that that is what you should direct your time, your energies, your mind, your thoughts, your efforts, your education, and your resources towards. This is what it means to seek His kingdom first.

Especially in these last days, there seems to be much carelessness among many professed followers of Elohim that try to be with one foot in the world and with the other one in the Faith. It doesn't work, when one eye is focused on the world and the other one is focused on the kingdom of Heaven. Yahusha called that being "lukewarm" in Revelation 3. These are people that are neither cold nor hot. They sit on the fence, and He will reject them. When the Spirit of Yahuah is truly in us and controlling us, this world looks very empty and will have no hold on us and it is easy then to let go of it.



This world is mostly filled with hopeless, unhappy, self-loathing people. This life is for most people full of disappointments, failures, setbacks, and a continual struggle just to survive. Facing our own fatality can be a radical awakening to turn to the one, who is the way, the truth and the life. Most of us have experienced the untimely death of a loved one. As painful as it may have been, it most likely changed the way we looked at his life and made us think of what is really most important.

Moses is given us individually the following advice in Psalm 90:12, "So teach [us] to number our days, that we may apply [our] hearts unto wisdom." KJV

It is true that we must make a living here and give our best in that respect, but the ultimate purpose is the life beyond. We are to follow in the footsteps of our Redeemer and imitate HIM. Here are a few Bible verses in reference to that, "Seek ye first the kingdom of Elohim, and his righteousness..." Matthew 6:33



Chapter 2

"The Lost or Forgotten Name."

Have you ever asked yourself the question "Why the Creator's name is missing from my Bible?" HIS name is YHVH (Yahuah) as I had mentioned in the very beginning.

Do we know? Do we care to know? Is it important? Does it make any difference? Could it be something salvational, because that is the question many people seem to ask when they hear something that is new to them!

We can use the letter "W" and follow Rome, or the letter "U" and follow the Greeks or we can use the "V" and follow the Hebrew consonant Vav as in YHVH.

Scripture tells us in Isaiah 52:6 "My people shall know my name."

If I want to be part of His people, I will know His name. Let us first examine the meaning of the word "name" in Scripture. It comes from the Hebrew word "Shem". Here is a definition of this word in the Strong's Lexicon: Strong's # 8034 Shem; a primitive word [perhaps rather from 7760 through the idea of definite and conspicuous position; compare 8064]; an appellation, as a mark or memorial of individuality; by implication honor, authority, character: - + base, [in-] fame[-ous], name[-d], renown, report.

As we can see from that definition, YHVH's name not only represents His "character" but the Name YHVH is also "His mark". Therefore, the word "Shem" (Name) refers to His literal

written or spoken name as well as His character. If it did not refer to His literal written and spoken name, then one could say that Yahuah does not have a written name at all. But we know that is not true.

In our twentieth century Western culture, personal names are little more than labels to distinguish one person from another. Sometimes nicknames are chosen, which tell something about a person, but even this is a poor reflection of the significance of names in the Bible.



When reading the scriptures, the Hebrew word "Shem" is much more than a label of identification. It means an expression of the essential nature of the name bearer! Let's look at some names that are found in the Bible, to learn if these names have meaning! For instance, the book of Genesis (Bereshit) is the book of "Beginnings."



In Genesis 16:11, we learn that Hagar was instructed to name their child Ishmael because "YHVH has heard your affliction."
In Genesis 15:5, we find that Abram

gets a new name, Abraham meaning "father of many nations!"

 Then in Genesis chapter 25, Esau gets His name because he is red and is like a hairy garment.

Esau's brother Jacob gets a new name. Genesis 32:28 states, "Your name is no longer called Jacob, <u>but Israel</u> because you have striven with Elohim and with men and have overcome." Israel means "to strive with El (*Elohim*), to overcome with El, and then to rule with El."

In Genesis 35:18 Rachel wanted to name her son **Ben-Oni** (**son of my pain or son of my sorrow**). She chose that name because her life was going out of her, but Jacob wanted his name to be **Benjamin** (**son of my right hand or son of the south**). If we go to Exodus chapter 2:10, we find a person by the name of Moses (*Mosheh*) meaning "I have drawn him out of the water."

In 1Samuel 1:20 Hannah called her son Samuel "because she asked YHVH for him." We find later in the Scriptures, four Hebrew boys that would not compromise their faith even to the point of death.



Sadly, the Babylonian king Nebuchadnezzar decided to change the names of these four Hebrew boys to Belshazzar, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. The King thought by changing their names, he would give them a name in honor of pagan deities, with hope that

they would change their beliefs, but of course we know they didn't as they remained faithful to YAHUAH (YHVH).

We can tell from these few examples that names had great significance to the person that bears that name! They meant something, they were an expression of what they expected that person to be like and to accomplish and to stand for.


Unfortunately, to many the titles <u>God or LORD</u> convey little more than designations of <u>a</u> supreme being, which are also applied to many pagan no-gods. It says little to them about YHVH's character, His ways, and what HE means to each of us as human beings. But in Scripture, the names of YHVH are like miniature portraits and promises.

In Scripture, a person's name identified them and stood for something specific. This is especially true of our Creator. Naming carried special significance. It was a sign of authority and power. This is evident in the fact that YHVH revealed His name to His people rather than allowing them to choose a name for Him.

The sacred name is given for the purpose of distinguishing the Creator of the Universe from the no-gods. The issue is TRUTH verses man made religions, called lies!

Why is there so much controversy, rage and division among believers when honest discussion arises about the Name of the very **One**, we worship and claim to serve? How can we separate His name from His word?

The name of the Messiah, which is a universal name to which every knee will bow, and every tongue will confess – has been marred, changed, confused, and watered down in order to make it common and insignificant.



The Psalmist David said, "I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy loving-kindness and for thy truth; for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name." Psalms 138:2

Why will we magnify His word while refusing to magnify His name? Can we truthfully separate one from the other?



Before we look closer at the name of our Creator and the Savior, let us go to the dictionary and see what he word "title" means.

Title: "an identifying appellation signifying status or function: e.g. Mr. or General: and

appellation signifying nobility."

A title is not a name, but a function or a status. Now that we know what a title is, let us look at the following:

QUESTION! Why do we have "LORD" or "The LORD", (which is a title) in our bibles rather than YHVH, His name?

This is a very common question! Actually, the word "Lord" in Scripture is "Baal" in Hebrew. The word "Baalim" is the plural for "Baal" and the term "baali" means "my lord".

In one place it states that after their conquest of Canaan, it was the common practice of the Israelites to use the title "Baal" in reference to all the pagan Elohims as well as YHVH. Gradually, the title "Baal" (lord) became known as a proper name of the Phoenician Elohim. To verify this, look in the Layman's Bible Encyclopedia and the Pictorial Bible Dictionary with Topical Index under "Baal."



Paul stated in 1. Corinthians 8:5 that there are **many** that are "called" lords and gods, which in reality do not exist but were created in the minds of man of course inspired by Satan!

It all began with a Jewish tradition called the "ineffable name" doctrine (meaning incapable of being expressed or described in words). Jews, for various reasons, started to substitute His name with the Hebrew title "Adonai". Adonai is the Hebrew word for "Lord". This information can be easily verified in many Bible dictionaries and various encyclopedias.

For instance, the Encyclopedia Britannica states: Yahuah, the Elohim of the Israelites, his name being revealed to Moses as four Hebrew CONSONANTS (YHVH) CALLED THE TETRAGRAM-MATON. AFTER THE EXILE (6TH CENTURY BC), and especially from the 3rd century BC on, Jews ceased to use the name Yahuah for two reasons. As Judaism became a universal religion through its proselytizing in the Greco-Roman world, the more common noun Elohim, meaning "God," tended to replace YHVH (Yahuah) to demonstrate the universal sovereignty of Israel's Elohim over all others. At the same time, the divine name was increasingly regarded as too sacred to be uttered; it was thus replaced vocally in the synagogue ritual by the Hebrew word Adonai ("My Lord"), which was translated as Kyrios ("Lord") in the Septuagint, the Greek version of the Old Testament.

We can see according to this foregoing quote that Jews started to vocally replace the name "YHVH" with "Adonai" (Lord) for two reasons:

- 1. It was beginning to be believed that His name was too sacred to be uttered.
- 2. They preferred to simply call Him "Elohim" rather than "YHVH" to demonstrate to the world that He is the only true Elohim (The Mighty One or the Most High).

While on the surface these reasons may seem honorable, they are **very unscriptural.** They were and are attempts to improve on YHVH's already perfect ways. **If YHVH really wanted a substitute, why would he have placed His name there to begin with and that almost 7000 times?**



It is foremost because of Jewish traditions that YHVH's name is forgotten or lost

Malachi 1:6 stated it was the leadership that despised Yahuah's name: Because of the "priests that despise My Name..."

We are told [Jeremiah 23:27] that they (leadership) would "cause My people to forget My Name for Baal".

Oxford Dictionary of World Mythology: Baal = Literal meaning "Lord" Baʿal (Biblical Hebrew בעל, pronounced [ˈbaʕal], usually spelled Baal in English) is a Northwest Semitic title and honorific meaning "master" or "lord"[1] that is used for various gods who patrons of cities in the Levant and Asia Minor were, cognate to Akkadian Bēlu.

A Baalist or Baalite means a worshipper of Baal. "Baʿal" can refer to any god (Elohim) and even to human officials; in some texts it is used as a substitute for Hadad, a god of the rain, thunder, fertility and agriculture, and the lord of Heaven. Since only priests were allowed to utter his divine name, Hadad, Baʿal was commonly used.

Nevertheless, few if any Biblical uses of "Baʿal" refer to Hadad, the lord over the assembly of gods on the holy mount of Heaven, but rather refer to any number of local spirit-deities worshipped as cult images, each called baʿal and regarded in the Hebrew Bible in that context as a false god (Elohim).



Lord is a title with various meanings: In religious contexts Lord can also refer to various gods or deities. The earliest uses of Lord in the English language in a religious context were by English Bible translators such as Bede. This reflected the Jewish practice of substituting the spoken Hebrew word Adonai (which means 'My Lord') for YHVH when read aloud. When we replace the name YHVH with a title is that adding and subtracting from scripture??????

Though Scripture says to follow YHVH rather than man, we find that 6,828 times the most important name in all the universe is replaced with another word that man has chosen!



Yahuah laid down the rule in Deuteronomy 12:32, "What thing so ever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it." Does that still apply?




Let's depart from man's traditions, be they ancient or modern and let's do what YHVH commanded, because out of love to Him and for our own salvation!

This tradition of <u>not</u> using YHVH's name was <u>not</u> practiced by the Messiah or the apostles, why should we? It was adopted by some of His professed followers during the early half of the 2nd Century CE/AD. By the 4th century, this practice was well established and widely practiced as it is today.

Jerome, a 4th century "Church Father" who authored the Latin Vulgate version, substituted the name "YHVH" throughout with the Latin word "Dominus" (meaning "Lord"). The tradition of

replacing Yahuah's name with "the LORD" continues to this day.

However, this is not our Father's will! He wants to be called by HIS name. That pleases Him as many texts will testify to that.



In the first English translation of the Bible, made by John Wycliffe, he followed the Jewish custom of avoiding the name of the Creator and used the phrase, "the LORD", wherever the name YHVH appeared in the Hebrew text. This practice of substituting the title, "the LORD", for the Name of the Creator, was followed by all other English versions of the Bible and translated into various other languages.

That shows how difficult it is to let go of traditions. We have the same problem today, because traditions have been so ingrained in our brain that we can't and don't want to let go.


LET'S CONTINUE WITH THE QUESTION! What is the Creator's true Name?

In Psalm 68:4 we read "Sing unto Elohim, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name YAH, and rejoice before him."

"Yah, Hebrew YAH is a short form for Yahuah (see Ex 6:3; Vol. 1 pp. 171-173; see on Ex 15:2). This is the only occurrence of the English short form "Jah" in the KJV

Of course, we should realize that the letter "J" was introduced during the Middle Ages somewhere, so the word "YAH" was changed to "Jah"!

If this verse is read in the <u>New</u> King James Version it says, "...extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name YAH..." This short form of the Heavenly Fathers Name is used about fifty times in the Bible, usually the KJV will translate it as "LORD" or "the LORD".



Hebrew) means "hidden of YAH".

Many Hebrew Names contain the short form of the Creator's Name in them, for example:

Elijah (Eliyah in Hebrew)
means "my Elohim is
YAH":

Jeremiah (Yirmeyahu in Hebrew) means "elevated of YAH";

Zephaniah (Tsefanyah in

YAH is the **Short** form Of the Creators Name! What is the **Full** Form of His Name?

We find the answer in Exodus 3:13-15 when Moses said unto Elohim, behold, when I come unto the children of Israel and shall say unto them, The Elohim of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me: "What is His name?" *Exodus 3:13* "What shall I say unto them?"

"And ELOHIM said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you. (Exodus 3:14)

"And ELOHIM said moreover unto Moses, thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, YHVH Elohim of your fathers, the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of

<u>Israel (Jacob)</u>, hath sent me unto you; this is my name <u>for ever</u>, and this is my memorial <u>unto all generations</u>." Exodus 3:15

Question: Would YHVH (Yahuah) declare that His Name is a memorial to all generations <u>forever</u> and then allow His Name to be lost? His name, neither the pronunciation of the Name of YHVH has ever really been lost, it is still a memorial for us today.

The Encyclopaedia Judaica Vol. 7 p. 680 states, "The true pronunciation of the name YHVH <u>was never lost</u>. Several early Greek writers of the Christian Church testify that the name was pronounced 'Yahuah some say Yahweh'".

In Isaiah 42:8 He says: "I am YHVH (Yahuah); that is my Name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images."



"Thy name, O YHVH, endureth forever; and thy memorial, O YHVH throughout all generations." Psalm 135:13
"Even YHVH Elohim of hosts; YHVH is his

memorial." Hosea 12:5 His name is a memorial name! Satan wanted to remove that memorial and he was and is successful for most people, but not by all.

Call upon HIS name! "And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call <u>on the name</u> of YHVH shall be delivered ..." *Joel* 2:32

This is being re-quoted in Acts 2:21 "And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of YHVH shall be saved."

Praise HIS Name, NOT His title! "From the rising of the sun to tis going down YHVH's name is to be praised." Psalm 113:3

Exalt HIS Name! "O, magnify YHVH with me, and let us <u>exalt</u> His Name together." *Psalm 34:3*

Think about HIS Name! "Then those who feared YHVH spoke to one another, and YHVH listened and heard them; So, a book of remembrance was written before Him for those who fear YHVH and who meditate on His name." Malachi 3:16 And there are many more like it, for example in Psalm 105:3; Psalm 86:9; Psalm 102:21; Psalm 22:22; Micah 4:5 etc.

There is an interesting verse in Proverbs 30:4, which asks the question: "Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who hath gathered the wind in his fists? Who hath bound the waters in a garment? Who hath established all the ends of the earth? What [is] his name, and what [is] his son's name, if thou canst tell?" KJV



through culture and time.


It may come as a surprise to many, but the name "Jesus" is far removed from the TRUE NAME of the Messiah given to Mary by the Angel Gabriel.

Let's remember His parents were Jews and spoke Hebrew. Also, the angel Gabriel was not subject to Babylonian corruption Furthermore, the name "Jesus" cannot even be called a translation. This is a man-made creation, a transliteration from a Greek mistransliteration.

We must emphasize His real Hebrew name, Yahusha, because as we have seen from His father's name, Hebrew names in the scriptures mean something. They are not just letters joined together in a line; they have a DEFINITION. They mean something.

Sadly, most of the world knows Yahusha by the name of "Jesus Christ", which besides being a very poor translation, completely lacks the intended meaning of the Hebrew name that is "YHVH saves." Every time we use the name "Yahusha", we proclaim to the whole world that "YHVH saves!" The Greek name Jesus has no such meaning, nor such testimony.

He himself said in John 5:43 "I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive."



Three times in Scripture the Messiah tells us that he has come in His father's name. The other two times are found in John 17:11 and 12 "...Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one as we are. 12. While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name...."Knowing this, how could the Father have a Hebrew name and His Son have a Greek name? It doesn't make sense!

Satan hates the name of the Father and of the Son in <u>Hebrew</u>. He has tried everything possible to keep these names hidden out of sight and away from the people. Because only in the Hebrew Language does a name mean anything!

One incident in the Book of Acts clearly tells us the language that the Messiah's Name was spoken in and that is in Acts 26:14-15. "And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, 'Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? [it is] hard for thee to kick against the pricks.' And I said, 'Who art thou, Master?' And he said, 'I am Yahusha whom thou persecutes.'"

What about the word "Christ?"

As for the name Christ, it is a modern word for the Greek word "Christos" which means "anointed one". This is not a name but a descriptive title. This title was used <u>for all</u> Greek gods. It was translated from the word "Anointed," which is "Mashiach" <u>in</u> Hebrew.

What about the word "Christian?"

"Christian" was a derogatory label placed on the followers of Messiah. As mentioned in the previous slide, the term "Christos" is Greek and had formerly a pagan usage.

Derogatory = belittling, uncomplimentary, denigrating!

What would a group of Israelites that practice the Torah of Yahusha and follow a Jewish or Hebrew Messiah be doing with a Greek term used by Pagans as a label for themselves?

Would the Creator's religion have a Greek name? Remember also, our Messiah's Name isn't the Greek "Jesus", but rather the Hebrew name "Yahusha or Yeshua."

What if the people of Antioch, at first, called the disciples of Yahusha "CRETINS", because they considered them retards, idiots?

The one verse most cling to in defense of the term "Christian" is at Acts 11:26, "And at first in Antioch the taught ones (the disciples) were called Kristianous." (This is the order of this sentence in the Greek). This sentence doesn't claim that the disciples called themselves this but were called this "at first". Also, as with the English language, the context determines what is meant.

The American Heritage Illustrated Encyclopedic Dictionary tells us the etymology for the word CRETIN: cre-tin (kre-tin, kret'n) n.

- 1. One afflicted with Cretinism.
- 2. A fool; an idiot

The word "Christianity" or "Christian" is **not** found in Scripture at all, so biblically, there is no such thing.


The word christianos (Latin Christianus) was used twice in the Greek text as **a device of scorn**, since in the ancient world it conveyed a much different sense than it does today. The use of the word christianos did not "name" the sect, but it was a <u>derisive</u>, scornful label that meant they were like gullible, dumb beasts, or "cretins." From the book fossilized customs

As early as 200 BCE, there were Pagan worshippers of Serapis that called themselves "Christians". So, there were people that called themselves Christians on Earth before Yahusha was born, but these were Pagans.

So, what great harm is there in abandoning the Greek title "Christos" or "Christ", and using the same Hebrew word Daniel wrote: **Mashiach**? The word "MESSIAH" is transliterated TWICE in the received Greek writings, in John 1:41 and 4:25 (it's used twice in Daniel, at 9:25,26).

Even the new age cult is awaiting their "Christ"; so why not give them their word back - maybe they'll stop laughing at believers behind their backs for having adopted so much of their philosophy. Give them their "Sun-day" too. Let's return to the Covenant, shall we? The Gentiles from the ends of the Earth will one day acknowledge that their forefathers have inherited nothing but lies. From the book Fossilized Customs

The correct name of the Messiah, Yahusha Ha Mashiach is the only name by which He was known to His disciples, though He has <u>several titles</u> such as Rabbi, Son of Man, Savior, Anointed and King of Kings!



If the argument is, I speak English therefore I use an English name for the one I worship, then please provide the English name for Satan, because that name is Hebrew and it never changed in our English Bibles. Can you supply the English form of Abraham? This is another Hebrew name right out of the Hebrew Scriptures and carried over virtually unaltered into our English translation.

What is the English equivalent for the Hebrew name Daniel? How about Sarah and Martha? These are all Hebrew names that are

unchanged in the English text because names are not translated. We have no trouble using these Hebrew names without an English equivalent because there is no English equivalent. Why should Yahuah's Name be any different?

By the way, God is not a name anyway but only a generic title. Calling on Him by this title is like calling out to your neighbor, "Hello human being!"

If I pray to a god, then according to Paul in 2Corinthians 4:4 I may be praying to Satan, because Satan is called the "god of this world." Myriads of other god deities have been worshiped by man throughout history.

James 4:17, "Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth [it] not, to him it is sin."

"And the times of this ignorance Elohim winked at; but now commandeth all men everywhere to repent." Acts 17:31

Soon after our Messiah ascended into the heavens, Peter declared, "And it shall come to pass, [that] whosoever shall call on the name (not on a title) of YHVH shall be saved. " Acts 2:21

This is a quotation from Joel 2:32, "And it shall come to pass, [that] whosoever shall call on the name (not on a title) of YHVH shall be delivered..."

In order to call on HIS name, I must know what that name is!



We are admonished to call upon a specific "Name", which is YHVH, the self-existing, eternal Elohim and not on a title, like Lord or God, which includes all the false gods (Elohims)!

Was the Apostle Peter alone in proclaiming this? No. The Apostle Paul also quotes Joel in Romans 10:13, "For whosoever shall upon the <u>name</u> of YHVH shall be saved."

"That if thou shalt <u>confess</u> with thy mouth the Savior Yahusha, and shalt <u>believe</u> in thine heart that YHVH hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt BE SAVED; for with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and <u>with the mouth CONFESSION</u> is made UNTO SALVATION." Roman 10:9-10

Paul says that we must call upon, that means speak, proclaim, say the name Yahusha and YHVH. And in order to call someone, we must know his name. To confess these names with the mouth is a step "unto" (toward) salvation.

In Psalm 96:10 we are commanded, "Say among the heathen [that] YHVH reigneth."

All religions have names of deities that they call upon and serve and they are very zealous to promote the names of these false gods. How much more zealous should we who know the one true Elohim be to promote and to proclaim His Name in all the earth.

Our Heavenly Father has made His name known in the Hebrew Scripture. The word YHVH appears in that pure language 6828 times and the word "YA" 49 times, that is a total of 6877 times!

What does that tell us? He wants us to use His name respectfully! His name is really not lost, if we want to know the name, it is there all over in Scripture, actually almost 7,000 times. An enemy wants us to forget that name and one very successful way is through the various uninspired Bible translations.



Moses said in
Deuteronomy 32:3,
"I will publish the
name of YHVH,
ascribe ye greatness
unto our Elohim."

Jeremiah 16:21, "...and they (the Gentiles) shall know that my name is YHVH." "Praise YHVH. Praise, O ye servants of YHVH, praise the name of YHVH." Psalm 113:1 KJV

"Blessed be the name of YHVH from this time forth and for evermore." Psalm 113:2 KJV

"From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same YHVH's name is to be praised." Psalm 113:3 KJV

"O give thanks unto YHVH; call upon HIS name; make known HIS deeds among the people." Psalm 105:1 KJV

"Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of YHVH our Elohim." Psalm 9:10 KJV

How shall we remember the name of the Heavenly Father if we never cared enough to learn it in the first place? Don't you find it

appalling when scholars, including ministers, tell us the name of our Creator has been lost while at the same time the name of Satan has been preserved throughout the world?

There is a prophecy for the last days in Zephaniah 3:9. It states there, "Then will I turn to the people a pure language,..."

For what purpose? "That they may all call upon the name of YHVH, to serve him with one consent."



What language should we consult to derive the true name and even the pronunciation of the sacred name? Certainly not Greek.


"Thus, saith YHVH of hosts; In those days it shall come to pass, that ten men shall take hold out of all the languages of the nations,

What would that name be?



It is certainly true that the word "name" includes more than pronunciation. The definition of the word "name" in the Scriptures includes authority, character, power, pronuncialtion, and spelling.

For in Revelation 14:5 it states, "And in their mouth was found no guile; for they are without fault before the throne of Elohim." Only then can HIS name be physically written in their foreheads!

If anyone doesn't like the original sacred name, perhaps that person would feel very uncomfortable in heaven, where the sacred name will be praised throughout all eternity.

One more question:

Does man have a moral right to change, or <u>make up</u> a name, to call His Creator by?

Does man have a moral right to cover up the Name of His Creator in the Holy Scriptures, with a title such as "LORD?"

When Peter and John stood before the council and were threatened not to speak in the name of Yahusha anymore, Peter boldly said, "There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among mortals by which we must be saved." Acts 4:12

Our hearts should naturally love the Savior's original name. Simply because it is HIS name! How can we say we love HIM, and have a bad attitude toward His real, original name? We ought to love Him for what He has done for us, and for who HE is, YHVH'S Salvation. Let's proclaim the name of YHVH and Yahusha in word and deed!

CHAPTER 3

The Lost Book!



Can truth be lost? Has truth been Lost? Can whole generations be in error because they have lost the truth?

We have many instances in Israel and in Judah when the people turned from the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel to serve the false gods (Elohims) of the nations around them.


They broke the covenant that He had made with them, and the results were naturally apostasy as the people had no guide lines, no instructions and everyone did that which seemed right in his own eyes. That happened over and over again. Today we want to look at one instance and that is during the time of King Josiah, which was the last good king of Judah, the last good thing that happened to the Israelites before their kingdom was destroyed.

Josiah became king as a child of only eight, and soon took an interest in YHVH, contrary to his father King Amon. Early in life he instituted reforms and took steps against idol worship. At 25 years of age, Josiah decided to rebuild the temple, deteriorated with age. As the workers were cleaning, they found an obscure book that no one had ever heard of, a forgotten book by previous generations!

What was the name of that forgotten or lost book?

The book of the law, the Torah also known as "the law of Moses!"

Where was it lost?



In the temple Of Jerusalem!

The book of the law was lost in a place one would least expect it to be lost, in the temple itself or as we could say it today, in the professed Church! How is that possible, one should ask?

We read about it in 2 Kings 22, verse 8, "And Hilkiah the high priest said unto Shaphan the scribe, I have found the book of the law in the house of Yahuah..." (Restoration Study Bible)

The Torah was lost by HIS own people in the temple of Jerusalem, in Judah through carelessness, neglect or lack of interest on the part of the priesthood who were the leaders at that time. Therefore, the people were deprived of its instruction, so they strayed from truth following their leaders! Everyone did that which was right in their own eyes.

Hilkiah found something that would effect a radical change of the nation. This book was something special and the king was deeply moved, actually he was struck with grief and terror, when he heard the words of the book of the Torah that YHVH was furious with Josiah and his people because of their disobedience and he tore his clothes.

Elohim so moved in his life that he immediately embarked upon a massive spiritual reform movement such as Judah had never seen. Idols and places of false worship were removed from both the Temple itself and all-around Jerusalem and Judah. Moreover, we are told that Israel celebrated Passover in a manner not seen since the days of the Judges, which were several hundred years before. In the end, YHVH said of Josiah, "before him there was no king like him who turned to YHVH with all his heart and with all his soul and with all his might, according to all the Torah of Moshe, nor did any like him arise after him." 2. Kings 22 and 23

The revival was wonderful. But as soon as Josiah died, the people returned to their evil ways, and before his sons reached middle age, Yahuah's judgment for centuries of evil practices came, and Judah was no more.



The question needs to be asked, has today's generation <u>lost or forgotten</u> the book of the law, the Torah, called the Law of Moses? Without these instructions, called the Torah, given by the Creator man is walking in the dark, in the light of his own kindling. The result is confusion, darkness and ignorance!

And that is exactly what we have. There are over 41,000 denominations, churches and groups, all claiming to have the truth, but in reality, they are confused and are teaching untruth!

As it states in Jeremiah 16:19: "Our fathers have inherited lies, vanity, and things wherein there is no profit."

And the fathers have passed these lies on to their offspring's! Could it be due to a conspiracy as we read in Jeremiah 11:9-10?

Here are the words in Jeremiah 11:9-10: "And YHVH said unto me, A conspiracy is found among the men of Judah, and among the inhabitants of Jerusalem. 10. They are turned back

to the iniquities of their forefathers, which <u>refused</u> to hear my words; and they <u>went after other gods (Elohims) to serve them</u>; the house of Israel and the house of Judah have <u>broken my covenant</u> which I made with their fathers."

Who only could be behind such a conspiracy to inspire the men of Judah? It was Satan himself!

As we know, it all started long time ago, of all places, namely in Heaven!

The Bible says in Revelation 12:7-9: "There was a war in Heaven!"


Revelation 12:7-9: "And there was war in heaven; Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels. 8. And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. 9. And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil and Satan, which deceiveth the whole word; he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him." *Revelation 12:7-9*

That's how it all started and these evil angels are behind the deceptions and lies we are dealing with in today's World.

That's why Paul tells us in Ephesians 6:12, "We wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places]."

So, the question: Has the Law of Moses (The Torah) been Lost and forgotten?

"What happened to the Law of Moses!"



The modern churches have made the "Law of Moses" into a terrible misnomer – in particular by claiming that it has been nailed to the cross!

What do we mean by the term "The

Law of Moses?"



It is these five books of the Bible, including the 10 Commandments, statutes and judgments, and the instructions for the Aaronic

priesthood, the sanctuary services, and ordinances of the altar, which were added after the golden calf apostasy. The added book of the law, ended at the cross. The book of the law was written by Moses into a book or maybe scroll.

However, in this respect we just can speculate, because the handwritten scrolls, which were put outside of the ark, we have seen are huge. They need 250 linings from the stomachs of lambs for the whole torah – they are about 4-5 feet long, heavy, and about 10 inches across when rolled up. The book of the covenant is only the instructions from Exo 20-21-22-23 – those were written on the tables of stone, INSIDE the ark. The Book of the Law (BoL)as just mentioned, was written in Exodus 25-31 ...containing the instructions of the Aaronic priesthood and sanctuary and probably the Levitical instructions for all the sacrifices and offerings that the priesthood had to follow.

Here is the verse in Deuteronomy 31:26, "Take this book of the law (#8451 - Torah) and put it in the side of the ark of the covenant of YHVH your Elohim."



What does that term "put in the side of the ark" actually mean? The Bible does not tell us that there was a pocket or another container or another piece of furniture in the Most Holy Place!

There is no mention made that there was something made to hang the book on the outside of the ark to put this book or scroll in.

Another point to consider is that the leaders of Israel were to use the written instructions to make day-to-day decisions accordingly and also, they were to read out of the book every seventh year to the entire congregation. They had to have more than the one copy stored somewhere, however, the Bible does not say so.


If there was only one copy kept in the Holy of Holies, it would have been accessible only on the Day of Atonement, but not during the rest of the year. (The high priest would have to get it out and put it back, and only on that one day of the year, which is not doable).

The Midrash (this is a commentary on the Hebrew Bible: a body of Rabbinic literature consisting of commentary on and clarification of biblical texts, first compiled before 500 AD) tells us: Before his death, Moses wrote 13 Torah Scrolls. Twelve of these were distributed to each of the 12 Tribes. The 13th was placed in the Ark of the Covenant (with the Tablets). If anyone would come and attempt to rewrite or falsify the Torah, the one in the Ark would "testify" against him. (Likewise, if he had access to the scroll in the Ark and tried to falsify it, the distributed copies would "testify" against him.)

How were the new scrolls verified? An authentic "proof text" was always kept in the Holy Temple in Jerusalem, against which all other scrolls would be checked. Following the destruction of the Second Temple in 70 CE, the Sages would periodically perform global checks to weed out any scribal errors.

If this is correct, we do not know, we can't prove it, however, it does make sense that each tribe would have their own copy of the Torah and that an original would be preserved in the temple!

Wherever this book of the law was put, one thing is sure, it is no less **the law of YHVH.** The distinction many churches and denominations make of this other law that Moses wrote down **are purely arbitrary and in no way supported by the Scripture.**




The assumption is being made that Moses wrote the law on paper, in a book, and placed it in the side of the Ark. Some people call what Moses wrote down the mosaic or ceremonial law that was done away with or nailed to the cross.

It is being claimed that since the Moral Law cannot be nailed to the cross, because it was written on stone by the Creator himself, it is therefore the ceremonial law, everything written in the book by Moses that was nailed to the cross. If that would be true than the health laws, the instructions about tithing etc. would have been nailed to the cross also. People are trying to save the Seventh-day Sabbath (which is part of the 10 Commandments) from being done away with.

In other words: The Moral Law written in Stone – is permanent and everlasting.

On the other hand: <u>The Ceremonial</u> Law written on Paper – is only temporary.

First let's make one point clear, neither the word "moral" law nor the word "ceremonial" law is found in Scripture. There is no place in the Bible where two colossal divisions of Law are displayed. These terms (ceremonial and moral) were invented by man.



One source claim that Thomas Aquinas from the Catholic Church invented the idea that there was a ceremonial law. He said that the Sabbath commandment was moral as to resting one day a week, but was ceremonial as regards to time. Therefore, it has been transferred to Sunday in the new covenant since Jesus rose on the first day of the week.

Since the word "<u>ceremonial law</u>" is not in the Bible it would be less misleading and less confusing if we purged this word from our vocabulary!

By using this term "ceremonial" we are adding to Scripture!

Let's talk about the Law of Moses! What do people mean by that term?

They usually don't mean the 2 tablets of stone but the book of the law! We should mention at this point that there is the book of the law and the book of the covenant. These are two completely different books. The book of the law took effect after the apostasy of the golden calf, which contained the instructions for the Aaronic priesthood, the instructions for the tabernacle and the sacrifices. This book ended at the cross. The other book, which was blood ratified, called the book of the Covenant contained instructions from Genesis 1:1 to Exodus 24:11 is still binding today.

The book of the covenant was written on two tables of sapphire stone written with the finger of Elohim meaning the 10 commandments and what we find in Exodus 21, 22 and 23, which includes the statutes and judgments, the yearly appointed feast days.

After YHVH spoke the 10 Commandments, the people were afraid and said in Ex 20:19 to Moses, "Speak thou with us, and we will hear: but <u>let not</u> Elohim speak with us, lest we die."

Note that YHVH intended to speak, not only the words of the Ten Commandments to the people, but also all of the words of the Statutes and the Judgments found in Exodus 21, 22 and 23. (Let it be noted here, that any further instructions that are given "after" the laws spoken at Mt Sinai- if they are statutes or judgments addressing the everlasting covenant, these laws are also considered as part of the Book of the Covenant.) The people, however, would not allow YHVH to continue (after the 10th commandment was spoken) and begged Moses to go up into the mountain.


This is being shown also in Deuteronomy 5:23-27, let's look at it,: Deuteronomy 5:23-27, "And it came to pass, when ye heard the voice out of the midst of the darkness, (for the mountain did burn with fire,) that ye came near unto me, even all the heads of your tribes, and your elders; 24. And ye said, behold, YHVH our Elohim hath shewed us his glory and his greatness, and we have heard his voice out of the midst of the fire; we have seen this day that Elohim doth talk with man, and he liveth. 25. Now therefore why should we die? For this great fire will consume us: if we hear the voice of YHVH our Elohim any more, then we shall die. 26. For who is there of all flesh, that hath heard the voice of the living Elohim speaking out of the midst of the fire, as we have and lived?"

Can we see that? The Israelites were afraid to listen any further to the voice of YHVH! They were concerned about their life! The feared that they would die!

Then we have verse 2, when the people asked Moses: "Go thou near, and hear all that YHVH our Elohim shall say: and speak

thou unto us all that YHVH our Elohim shall speak unto thee; and we will hear it, and do it."

According to verse 21 of Exodus 20, "Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where Elohim was." Then YHVH spoke to Moses and gave him all the statutes so he can pass them on to the people and wrote them in a book. These everlasting covenant judgments and statutes are listed in Exodus 21, 22 and 23 and the complete covenant (also including the 10 commandments) was ratified in chapter 24. Just something to think about, the yearly appointed feasts are listed in verses 18, 21-23 of chapter 23 and belong to the everlasting Sinai Covenant prior to the worship of the golden calf! (Deuteronomy 5:23-27)



So, <u>both</u> the 10 words (and the judgments/statutes in Exo 21-22-23) were written on tables of stone and the book originally written down by Moses originated with the voice of the Creator – then finalized when His finger inscribed these words in stone. Can it be any clearer?

It doesn't make sense to say that the 10 Commandments, were the only words written with the finger of Elohim and placed inside the Ark of the Covenant. The 10 commandments do not greater significance than the everlasting statutes and judgments. Why? It is the everlasting statutes and judgments that further explain the 10 brief commands. In other words: the statutes and judgments were just as important as the 10 commandments as these were given explicitly to explain the Ten Commandments in detail and they are binding upon men in every age as long as time should last. Every command was dictated by YHVH – then written by Moses in the Book of the Covenant (Exo 24:4-8), and finally inscribed in stone tablets by YHVH's finger (front & back). Yes, Moses also wrote all the dictated laws of the temporary covenant found in brief form in Exo 25-31. These words were written in what is called The Book of the Law and placed at the side of ark.

Exodus 34:27-28 states "And YHVH said unto Moses, write thou these words: for after the tenor of these words I have made a covenant with thee and with Israel. And he was there with YHVH forty days and forty nights: And he wrote upon the Tables the Words of the Covenant, the Ten Commandments." Exodus 21-22-23 are judgments and statutes that belong to the everlasting commands, not to the temporary commands. Naturally these words are on the tables of stone too.

We call that The Tables of the Covenant

The Bible also mentions the book of the Covenant in Exodus 24:7 "And he took the Book of the Covenant and read in the audience of the people: and they said, all that YHWH hath said will we do, and be obedient."

The Book of the Covenant!

Then in 2Kings 23:2 it states, "And the king went up into the house of YHVH, and all the men of Judah and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with him, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the people, both small and great: and he read in their ears all the words of the Book of the Covenant which was found in the house of YHVH."

Isaiah 30:8 clearly reveals the Ancient Covenant Custom that what was written upon the Tables of the Covenant, was also written in the Book of the Covenant. Here it is: "Now go, write it before them in a Table, and wrote it in a book, that it may be for the time to come for ever and ever."

We see here that the "words of the covenant," (whether written in summary on stone, or written in detail in the book), are written down in two places, upon Tables and in the Book!

Coming back to the Ancient Covenant customs, let's look now at Nehemiah 9:13-14, "Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments.

14. And madest known unto them thy holy Sabbath, and commandest them precepts, statutes and laws by the hand of Moses thy servant."

Can we notice that what was spoken by the Messiah from Mt. Sinai and what was written by the Hand of Moses corresponds, it is the same thing, we cannot separate the Table of the covenant from the Book of the Covenant, because the author of both is YHVH. One was spoken by YHVH directly to the people and the other one was dictated to Moses by YHVH to give to the people — but do remember that the people at the bottom of the mount could hear what YHVH was dictating to Moses at the top of the mount. We find this detail laid down by YHVH in Exo 19:9.

• And Yahuah said unto Moses, Io, I come unto thee in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with thee and believe the forever. *KJV*

The Jews divided the Law (Torah) into three main divisions:

- 1. Commandments (mitzvoth)
- 2. Statutes (chokim or chuqqim)
- 3. Judgments (mishpatim)

Deuteronomy 5:31, "But as for thee, stand thou here by me, and I will speak unto thee all **the commandments** (#H4687 – mitsvot), and the statutes (#H2706 – chuqqim), and the judgments (#4941 – mishpatim), which thou shalt teach them, that they may do them in the land which I give them to possess it."

Deuteronomy 6:1: "Now these are the commandments (#H4687 – mitsvot), the statutes (#H2706 – chuqqim), and the judgments (#4941 – mishpatim), which YHVH your Elohim commanded to teach you, that ye might do (them) in the land whither ye go to possess it."

Deuteronomy 7:11, "Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments (#H4687 – mitsvot), and the statutes (#H2706 – chuqqim), and the judgments (#4941 – mishpatim), which I command thee this day, to do them."

Deuteronomy 11:1: "Therefore thou shalt love YHVH thy Elohim, and keep His charge, and His **statutes** (#H2706 – chuqqim), **and His judgments** (#4941 – mishpatim), **and His commandments** (#H4687 – mitsvot), always."

The Jews also divided the Ten Commandments into these three categories (commandments, statutes, and judgments)

First, the 10 Commandments are divided by the first five commandments that have the Sacred Name YHVH, and the second five that do not have the Sacred Name.



The last five commandments pertain to man's duty to man. This division is supported in the New Testament by Paul's statement in Romans 13:9 "For this, thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if (there be) any other commandment, it is ...

...briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself."

Note, that Paul does not include the Fifth Commandment. He teaches that it is the last five commandments that are comprehended by the words, "Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself." That was new to me as I was taught the other way.

The 1st and 2nd Commandments are understood by the Jews to be <u>Commandments</u>, a statement of fact.

The 3rd, 4th and 5th Commandments are understood by the Jews to be Statutes.

The last five commandments are understood to be <u>Judgments</u>. They describe how to treat one another. Then Exodus 23:10-17 how to worship Yahuah, that falls under statutes and the 4th commandment.

Even though the 10 commandments, the statutes and the judgments are Yahuah's laws, HE still calls them in Malachi 4:4 the "law of Moses," that I commanded him.

The Bible also states in Exodus 33:11a, "And YHVH spake unto Moses' face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend!"

In Numbers chapter 12 Miriam and Aaron murmured against Moses saying "Hath YHVH indeed spoken only by Moses? Hath he not spoken also by us? And YHVH heard it." Miriam and Aaron, by their murmurings, were guilty of disloyalty, not only to their appointed leader, but to Elohim Himself."

How did YHVH rebuke them in verse 7-8:

"My servant Moses...who is faithful in all mine house ... with him will I speak mouth to mouthwherefore then were ye not afraid to speak against my servant Moses." Numbers 12:7-8

By speaking against Moses, Miriam and Aaron were speaking or murmuring against YHVH himself. Remember, Moses was only the instrument!

Question: If YHVH really meant it, when He told Moses that He wanted people to "believe thee forever," and if YHVH was angry with Miriam for speaking against Moses, how is it that Christians today think nothing of speaking against Moses and against Moses law?



Is there a lesson for today's generation? Should we be careful how we treat the Law of Moses, which is in reality the Law of YHVH?

No other prophet can make such a boast as Moses. He had the highest level of inspiration, and his experience was unparalleled by any other writer in the history of mankind.

That's why Messiah made it clear that He did not come to do away with the teachings of Moses according to Matthew 5:17-19! The law of Moses is the Law of Yahuah! This is why every prophet or prophetess in every denomination is to be interpreted and understood and in subjection to the authority of Moses and not the other way around.

Whenever there is a disagreement or a discrepancy between any other prophet and the law of Moses, <u>Moses has the upper</u>

<u>hand</u>. Some people may have a problem with it, but that's the way it has to be handled. <u>Every prophet must be interpreted</u> and understood in subjection to the authority of the Torah.



If the Torah, the Law of Moses as written in the everlasting Book of the Covenant – every word engraved on tables of stone – those words are the final authority.

The Bible states in Deuteronomy 34:10, "And there arose not a prophet since in Israel like unto Moses, whom YHVH knew face to face."

Let's ask the question: "Does Moses Matter Anymore Today?"

In the parable of the rich man and Lazarus, Abraham told the rich man in Luke 16:31, "If they hear <u>not</u> Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead." KJV

Before His ascension Messiah told his disciples in Luke 24:44, "....all things <u>must</u> be fulfilled, which were written <u>in the Law of Moses</u>, <u>and</u> in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me."

"Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, we have found him, of whom Moses in the law (#3551 Nomos – Torah), and the prophets, did write, Yahuah of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." John 1:45

What did Stephen say about Moses in Acts 7:38-39? "This is he (Moses) that was in the church in the wilderness with the angel which spake to him in the Mount Sinai, and with our fathers: who received the lively oracles to give unto us: to whom our fathers would not obey, but thrust him from them, and in their hearts turned back again to Egypt."

What did Paul say about Moses in Acts 28:23? "And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into (his) lodging: to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of Yahuah, persuading them concerning Yahuwa, both out of the law (#3551 Nomos – Torah) of Moses, and (out of) the prophets, from morning till evening." Restoration Study Bible

What did James say about Moses in Acts 15:21? "For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every Sabbath day."

Then we have the words of YHVH himself: "And YHVH said unto Moses, Lo, I come unto thee in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with thee and believe thee forever" (Exodus 19:9).




Does Moses have any end-time significance? All we have to do is look at Malachi 4:4-6

"Remember ye the Torah (the law) of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, (with) the statutes and judgments." Malachi 4:4-6

The last generation is to remember the Torah, given by YHVH, with the statutes and judgments written down by Moses! For what purpose? So that they will keep it!

We must ask the question: Why is Christianity as a whole trying so hard to nail the "Law of Moses," the book of the Torah to the cross?



The main reason seems to be, to get rid of the 7th day Sabbath and the yearly appointed Feast Days!

Remember, Satan hates all of the Sabbath days, weekly and yearly, because these belong to the Creator and are designed to sanctify His people. Remember the weekly Sabbath (of the 4th commandment in Exo 20:8-11), and the annual feasts and festivals (Exo 23:10-17) are found in the everlasting Book of the Covenant, these very words dictated from the top of Mt Sinai.

When we truly love our Savior, we will joyfully obey <u>all</u> of His commandments, statutes and judgments! We will not pick and choose!

Peuteronomy 30:16 states, "I command thee this day to love Yahuah thy Elohim, to walk in his [everlasting] ways, and to keep his [everlasting] commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and Yahuah thy Elohim shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it." (Restoration Study Bible)

YHVH loves to bless us, but He cannot do it, if we rebel and refuse to walk in the path of obedience!

For He states in 1 Kings 2:3, "And keep the charge of Yahuah thy Elohim, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the Torah (law) of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself." Also consider Deuteronomy 28 and 29.

On the other hand we have the curses listed in Leviticus 25:15-16, "And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, (but) that ye break my covenant: I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and ye shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it."



"YHVH said unto Moses, how long refuse ye to keep my commandments (#H4687 – Mitzvah) and my laws (#H8451- Torah)?" Exodus 16:28

Then said YHVH to the children of Israel through Moses, "I will rain bread from heaven for you; and the people shall go out and gather a certain rate every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in my law, or no." Exodus 16:4

Notwithstanding this special direction of Elohim, some did go out to gather manna on the seventh day, but they found none. Mankind

has a sinful tendency to rationalize evil into good. The children of Israel, especially the mixed multitude, were continually disposed to rebel, and by their works, provoked YHVH to destroy them. It happened over and over again. In Exodus 32:9 we read: "And YHVH said unto Moses, I have seen this people, and behold, it [is] a stiff-necked people" (Exodus 32:9).

The same message about a rebellious people that refused to hear, refused to listen, and refused to obey the Law of Moses was given to Hosea in Chapter 8:12: (NLT) "Even though I gave them all my laws (Torah), they act as if those [everlasting] laws don't apply to them."

"I have written to him the great things of my law, but they were counted as a strange thing." KJV

"I have written many things for them in my teachings, but they consider these things strange and foreign." *Elohim's Word Translation*

The same was true In the New Testament. Stephen said to the priests and leaders of that day after they had accused him of blasphemy in Acts 7:51.



"Ye stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers [did], so [do] ye."

The Bible says in verse 54, "When they heard these things, they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed on him with their teeth

....58. And cast him out of the city and stoned him." They were furious! So they silenced him for good or permanently!



The temporary laws of the Torah describing the Aaronic Priesthood and the sanctuary – expired at the cross, along with the sacrifices and oblations. It is good to throw out those laws. What is left in the Torah are the laws of the bloodratified everlasting covenant – that should never be disposed

of – they are forever. There are worship statutes in these everlasting covenant laws that restore us in a right relationship to our Messiah, so we can be called His People.

We cannot separate the Book of the Covenant from the Tables of Stone that include the words in the everlasting Book of the Covenant. And do remember, that book was blood-ratified. Nothing could be added, nor removed from those laws. The Book of the Covenant and the Tables of Stone are one and the same! However, "books" don't last forever on this earth. Stone does. It is impossible to change the words written on the stone tablets. So, beware of those that try to remove any of the worship statutes, or any of the other everlasting covenant laws – specifically the laws of "eating clean" (Lev 11) and the feasts of YHVH in Lev 23. And also remember, the Book of the Law is temporary, and done away with long ago.

When people nail the law of Moses to the cross, they are throwing out all of the everlasting statutes, which means breaking them still constitute sin whether these people think so or not! Here are just a few of the everlasting laws that are being thrown out: Instructions of tithe and offerings (Lev 27:30-31; Lev 27:17-18: Deut 4:5-6; Deut 4:12-14; Deut 4:40) We don't see tithe in Exo 20-23. The NT tells us to take care of the poor, the widows, and the orphans ... and if that needs more than 10%, give it!

Eating the Fat of an animal (Lev 3:17; Lev 7:23-24) Eating the blood of an animal (Lev 3:17; Lev 7:26-27; Lev 17:13-14; Lev 19:26)

The following laws are connected to the 7th commandment: Looking at nudity and pornography (Lev 18:6-19; Lev 20:19-21)

Committing acts of rape (Lev 19:20)

Committing acts of incest (Lev 20:10-12; Lev 20:13-17)

Committing acts of fornication (Lev 18:20; Lev 19:20)

Committing acts of homosexuality (Lev 18:22; Lev 20:13-17)

Committing acts of bestiality (Lev 18:23-24; Lev 20:13-17)

Not paying a timely and fair wage (Lev 19:13; Lev 19:15) Being selfish to the poor (Lev 19:9-10; Lev 19:15; Lev 25:35-37)

Snubbing or making fun of the handicapped (Lev 19:14)

Snubbing or making fun of the elderly (Lev 19:32)

Rejecting strangers (Lev 19:33-34)

Gossiping (Lev 19:16)

Bearing grudges and getting even (Lev 19:17-18)

These are laws NOT to follow the ways of the pagans:

Cutting designs into your beard or hair (Lev 19:27)

Cutting scars or tattoos into your skin (Lev 19:28)

Selling your daughter into prostitution (Lev 19:29)

Attempting to contact the dead (Lev 19:30; Lev 20:6)

Unscrupulous business dealings (Lev 19:35-37)

These laws are all connected to the 4th commandment for the weekly Sabbath, and the annual worship statutes are

"statutes" or "by-laws" of the 4th commandment. The annual statutes are first found in Exo 23:10-17:

Ignoring the Sabbath (Lev 23:1-3)

Ignoring the Passover (Lev 23:4-8)

Ignoring the Feast of Unleavened Bread (Lev 23:10-11)

Ignoring the Feast of Weeks (now Pentecost) (Lev 23:21)

Ignoring the Feast of Trumpets (Lev 23:24-25)

Ignoring the Day of Atonement (Lev 23:29-32)

Ignoring the Feast of Tabernacles (Lev 23:34-44)

Killing animals for sport (Lev 24:18)

And many more!

Remember that His followers are being sealed with the Torah: "Bind up the testimony, seal the Torah among my disciples" (Isaiah 8:16).

Therefore, following Torah is a salvational issue!



Is the Law of Moses, the book of the covenant, a "Thus saith Moses or a "thus saith YHVH?" Therefore, to do away with the Law of Moses, the book of the blood ratified covenant, is an attempt to do away with the Torah (law) of YHVH!

The Spirit of Yahuah is causing more and more of His people to "rediscover" His ancient words. No longer is the Torah just a children's story book featuring our favorite Bible characters. Believers are rediscovering it as a book of the [everlasting & permanent] covenant given to Elohim's redeemed people, as a document describing the lifestyle for them, and as a sacred

marriage agreement between Him and HIS people. Today, more than 2,500 years since Hilkiah's monumental find, believers in all parts of the world are making the same rediscovery for their own personal and corporate lives. "Torah Rediscovered" by Ariel and D-vorah Berkowitz

WE are living in a time of revival and reformation as far as the lost book is concerned!



By the way, Torah does not mean "law", that is not a good translation. The word Torah primarily means "instructions". Moreover, the root for "Torah" can be traced to the Hebrew word meaning, "to shoot an arrow", or "to hit the mark."

Thus, the word "Torah" means literally, 'teaching,' whether it is the wise man instructing his son, or Elohim instructing Israel. Hence, we can say "Torah" is Elohim's teaching, hitting the mark of man's needs, including his need, to know who Elohim is and what His righteousness looks like.

Second, some of Torah today is still everlasting covenant. By this we mean that the part of everlasting Torah is a legally binding agreement between YHVH and His own people. The evidence for this is overwhelming. The Torah refers to itself several times as a covenant – which is always an everlasting covenant. Any number of references could be cited, like Exodus 34:27, "And YHVH said to Moses, 'Write down these commandments, for in accordance with these Command-ments I make a covenant with you and with Israel.' "The second reference is Deuteronomy 29:1.

Torah rediscovered by Ariel and D'vorah Berkowitz


That covenant included the Ten Commandments as well as other instructions.

Let's note that the Torah (YHVH's teachings) was not lost and is not lost, but merely hidden among the traditions and doctrines of man.

It is my prayer that we are willing to rediscover the true Torah, both the written Word and the Word made flesh who dwells among us, Yahuah the Messiah. He is the everlasting Torah revealed and the complete fulfillment of the temporary Book of the Law, also found in Torah!

Paul asked the question, "Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound? By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it?" Romans 6:1-2


Yahusha made this statement, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." John 14:15 This is the only proof of love towards our Master an Savior.


Yahusha is our example, "Though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered." Hebrews 5:8.


Here is something every person needs to understand, "Not everyone that says Master, Master will enter the kingdom of heaven but he that does the will of my Father in heaven." Matthew 7:21.

Q 1 What is the will of our Heavenly Father?

"For this is the love of YHVH, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome." 1 John 5:3 Here again is the proof of love towards our Redeemer, which is obedience.







Q2 How can you be an incredibly special treasure to Yahuah?

YHVH says "IF you OBEY my voice, you will be a special treasure unto me." Exodus 19:5 Over again, we are being giben the same message.

Q3 Many think they are good people. They have not harmed anyone and live a life of love and caring so they are okay. What does the Bible say?

Scripture says "The wage of sin is (eternal) death. Romans 6:23. Because we are all Sinners the Bible says we are Condemned to death.

Q4 What does it mean to repent?
"To turn from evil, and to turn to the good."

We need to let the Bible define what is the meaning of evil.

Q 5 What is the definition of the Scriptures?

Because of the sins he (Jeroboam) had committed, doing evil in the sight of Yahuah. So, we can see when we choose to disobey Yahuah's laws, we are doing evil. No matter how good a person we think we are, our self-righteousness is like filthy rags to Yahuah. 1 Kings 16:19

Q5, Can you imagine the horror of standing before a judge and hearing the sentence of death pronounced against you?

Have you ever felt the driving guilt and fear when YHVH's Word stabs you with this sentence, "**The wage of sin is death**" (Romans 6:23).

Why fear and guilt?

Because "all have sinned and come short of the glory of YHVH" (Romans 3:23).

For the wages of sin is death. (Eternal Death) but the gift of YHVH is Yahusha your Savior who died and took your punishment of sin upon Himself so that you can repent and confess your sins and no longer be under the condemnation of eternal death.

Q6 What if you have a special relationship with your Savior but do not keep His Commandments?

"If we say that we have no sin, we are misleading ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is trustworthy and righteous to forgive us the sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His Word is not in us." 1 John 1L8 to 10.

"They profess to know Yahuah, but by their deeds they deny Him, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed." Titus 1:16.

So, according to Scripture if you are not obeying His commandments you are called evil and you are deceiving yourself because faith without works (obedience) is dead.



Q7 What will we be judged by when we appear before Yahuah on Judgment Day?

"He that rejects me, and receives not my words, has one that judges him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day." John 12:48

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Yahusha, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the

body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad." 2 Corinthians 5:10.

Q8 Did you know that every deed, word, thought, and action are being recorded in the books by the angels?

"And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds." Revelation 20:12

Q9 Will anyone escape the judgment of YHVH?

We are all going to appear before YHVH on judgment day.

The fact is that you are guilty, just as guilty as sin. According to 1 John 3:4, "sin is the transgression of the Torah (law)," and you must plead guilty to breaking the law. Whose law did you break?

Paul answers quickly, "I had not known sin, but by the Torah (law). Romans 7:7.

Yahuah's Law is found in the commandments, statutes, and judgments and we will be judged according to these laws and we will be found guilty unless we repent and confess our sins to Yahusha and choose to turn away from sin and accept Him as your Savior.

Q10 What will happen to you if you refuse to obey the commandments, statutes, and judgements of YHVH?

Yahuah says if you think you have a special relationship with Him and refuse to obey His commands you are deceiving yourself and He will allow you to have a strong delusion, **because you did not love the truth.** "... **Your Torah is truth.**" Psalms 119:142

"And with every wicked deception directed against those who are perishing, because they refused the love of the truth that would have saved them. For this reason, YHVH will send them a powerful delusion so that they will believe the lie, in order that judgment will come upon all who have disbelieved the truth and delighted in wickedness." 2Thessalonians 10:10 to 12

Q11 Does grace give us the excuse to ignore Yahuah's commands?

Yahuah's Torah (instructions) is binding forever. Now we are brought to the question that has created confusion for multitudes of Christians: If the works of the law cannot save a person, is it therefore necessary to keep the law?

Apparently, this was a burning issue with the early believers, because Paul asked the same question in Romans 6:1,2. "Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?"

In other words, does grace give us a license to disobey the law of Yahuah? His answer is: "Yah forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?"

GRACE is not an excuse of continuing living in sin!



• "... Noach found grace in the eyes of Yahuah."

• "AND Yahuwah said unto Noach, ... you have I seen righteous before me in this generation." Genesis 6:8 and 7:1 (Cepher)

How interesting it is that Christians in this age of rebellion can invent their own definitions that condone lawbreaking.

Scripture says sin is violating Yahuah's commandments, statutes, and judgments. This law which has been described as irrelevant and old-fashioned by many modern theologians. **Don't be deceived.**

Every one of those great moral precepts is just as timely and needful today as they were when Yahuah wrote them on the imperishable tables of stone. And nothing has ever happened to make them less binding than they were when Yahuah gave them as He does not change His mind He says, "I am the same, yesterday, today and forever, I change not." Malachi3:6

"Your word, Yahuah, is eternal; it stands firm in the heavens." Psalms 119:89

"The word of Yahuah, stands forever." 1Peter 1:25

Q12 How do we follow and obey Yahusha Messiah?

Yahusha came to magnify the Torah and to open up its spiritual application, making it more comprehensive than the legalistic Pharisees ever imagined.

Yahusha's perfect life of obedience was an example for us to be followers of Yahusha who obeyed all the commandments, statutes and judgments of His Father and taught other people to do the same.



When Yahusha healed people, He said "Go and sin no more." It is the devil that wants you to continue living in sin and rebellion against Yahuah so you can lose your eternal life and he can destroy your life.

Yahuah cannot protect you from evil if you are not obeying Him.

Q13 What does it mean to be under the law?

Suppose a murderer has been sentenced to death in the electric chair. Waiting for the execution the man would truly be under the law in every sense of the word, under the guilt, under the condemnation, under the sentence of death, etc. Just before the execution date the governor reviews the condemned man's case

and decides to pardon him. In the light of extenuating circumstances, the governor exercises his prerogative and sends a full pardon to the prisoner. Now he is no longer under the law but under grace. The law no longer condemns him. He is considered totally justified as far as the charges of the law are concerned. He is free to walk out of the prison and no policeman can lay hands upon him. But now that he is under grace and no longer under the law, can we say that he is free to break the law? Indeed not!

In fact, that pardoned man will be doubly obligated to obey the law because he has found grace from the governor. In gratitude and love he will be very careful to honor the law of that state which granted him grace. Is that what the Bible says about pardoned sinners? "Do we then make void the Torah through faith? Yah forbid, yea, we establish the Torah" (Romans 3:31). Can you see that since Yahusha has paid for your sins in full by dying in your place, you are no longer under the law of condemnation once you have confessed and turned away from sin.

If you continue in disobedience of Yahuah's laws, then you are under the condemnation of the Torah because on judgment day you will be under condemnation of eternal death in the Lake of fire.

Obedience to Yahuah's commandments, statutes and judgments is true Love for Yahusha your Savior. He suffered and died in your place so how can you now go on living in sin and disobedience to Him?



Law (Torah) and grace do not work in competition with each other but in perfect co-operation.

The Torah points out sin, and grace saves from sin. The Torah is the will of Yahuah and grace is the power to do the will of Yahuah. We do not obey the Torah in order to be saved <u>but because we are saved</u>, we gladly obey Yahuah's Torah, His instructions.

A beautiful text which combines the two in their true relationship is Revelation 14:12, "Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of Yahuah and the faith of Yahusha."

What a perfect description of faith and works! And the combination is found in those who are truly converted and have crossed over

from sin to obedience to YHVH's commandments, statutes, and judgments. You are now grafted back into "Israel" with Yahusha as the root of the tree.

"And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: 7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up." Deuteronomy 6:6-7

Q14 How does Yahuah know whether you really love HIM?




The works of obedience is the real test of Love!

Therefore, they are so necessary in the experience of a true believer. "Faith without works is dead" (James 2:20). No man ever won a young woman's heart by words alone.

Had there been no flowers, no acts of devotion, no gifts of love, most men would still be searching for a companion. Love is defined by your actions when you truly love someone you will gladly do what makes them happy.

Yahusha said, "Not every-one that says unto me, Master, Master shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the will of my Father which is in heaven" (Matthew 7:21). "Only those who do His commandments shall have the right to the tree of life and enter the New Jerusalem." Revelation 22:14



A beautiful text which combines the two in their true relationship is Revelation 14:12, "Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of Yahuah and the faith of Yahusha." What a perfect description of faith and works! And the combination is found in those who are truly converted and have crossed over from sin to obedience to Yahuah's commandments, statutes, and judgments. Words and profession are not enough. The true evidence is obedience.

Yahusha said "If ye love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15). One of the strongest texts in the Bible on this subject is found in 1 John 2:4. "He that says I know him, and keeps not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him." John could write that with such assurance because it is one of the most deeply established truths in the Bible. Yahusha spoke of those who said, "Master, Master," but did not do the will of the Father. Then He described many who would seek entrance to the kingdom

claiming to be workers of miracles in the name of Yahusha. But He would sorrowfully have to say, "I never knew you: depart from me" (Matthew 7:21–23).

To know your Savior Yahusha is to love Him, and to love Him is to obey Him. To obey His commandments, statutes and judgments.

Words and profession are not enough. The true evidence is obedience.

The valid assumption of the Bible writers is very clear and simple: If one is not obeying Yahusha you do not love Yahusha. And if you don't love the Master, then you do not know Him. John assured us, "And this is life eternal, that they might know YHVH the only true Elohim, and Yahusha Messiah whom thou hast sent" (John 17:3). Thus, we can see how knowing and loving and obeying are all tied closely together and are inseparable in the life of Yahuah's faithful people.

When we have Yahusha living in us then we can overcome sin by His Spirit that gives us the power to obey Yahusha by reading, meditating and obey His Word daily.




You cannot pick and choose which Laws you want to Keep. This is very dangerous.

"For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all. For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if you commit no adultery, yet if you kill, you are

a transgressor of the law. So, speak and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty" (James 2:10-12).

When you obey YHVH's law you are free from the law of sin and death because the law no longer condemns you as you are not breaking the law.

Every individual will be judged at last by the mighty moral code of Yahuah's law, His Torah.



Look into Yahuah's Torah right now for a divine revelation of what YHVH wants your life to be. When you are free from sin you are free from the bondage and lies of Satan that is keeping you in slavery to sin. Confess that you have no strength but trust in Yahusha who gives you the power to overcome sin. Turn your eyes to Yahusha who has kept that law perfectly and who desires this very moment to enter your life with enabling power.

He will fulfill the righteousness of the law (Torah), the just requirements of the Torah in you by His Spirit, so that you can say with Paul, "Yahusha lives in me and the life which I now live in

the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of YHVH, who loved me, and gave himself for me." (Galatians 2:20)

When you disobey YHVH, you are obeying Satan and his lies!



"Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that one's slaves whom you obey, whether of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness?" Romans 6:16

This is the essence of our trials and tribulations in this life as children of YHVH; we learn obedience, but rarely never to the extent that Yahusha suffered!

Obedience was the purpose in the life of Yahusha, to do the will of His Father, this was His desire! The love of His Father made Him obedient to death. As our love for Yahusha grows, through much quiet time spent alone with Him, so does our willingness to obey.

The stronger our relationship to Yahusha, greater will be our love for Him!

When you yield your heart and love obediently to Yahuah's will, His blessings flow so generously. All He desires of us is our love and devotion and a willingness to obey His commands. So little is asked of us and Yahusha gave so much, what shall we be willing to give in return?



The Bible has one simple way of saying that perfect obedience is necessary for eternal life. "Do this and live." The "do this" is perfect obedience, and the "live" is eternal life."

Yahusha said to the rich, young ruler, "If you want to enter into life, keep the commandments" (Matthew 19:17).

Yahusha died for the forgiveness of our sins. That is very good news, for we deserved eternal punishment because of our sin. Yahusha has paid that penalty for us. But paying the penalty for our sins is not enough to get us into heaven. If we only had forgiveness of sins, then we would merely have a clean, blank slate.

A blank slate will not get us into heaven.

The Bible says that eternal life is for those who have obeyed Yahuah's Commandments, statutes, and judgments.

The slate must have "good works," "performance of the law," "righteousness," or "done this" written on it. Faith without

obedience to Yahuah is not true faith but rebellion to Yahuah. Do not be deceived we need to obey all that Yahusha obeyed all the commandments, statutes, and judgments. By His Spirit living in us we can overcome sin and temptation and have a new life in YHVH. Please read and study the Scriptures daily so that your faith can grow from strength to strength. Yahuah's Word is a lamp unto your feet and a light unto your path. Choose eternal life by obeying all that Yahusha has asked you to do and you will be blessed in this life and enjoy eternal life.



The Ten Commandments!

1 I am YHVH YOUR ABBA, which have brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. You shall have no other gods (Elohims) before ME.

- 6 You shall not murder.
- 7 You shall not commit adultery.
- 8 You shall not steal.
- 9 You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 10 You shall not covet your neighbor's house, you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is your neighbor's.



Chapter 5

COME OUT OF HER MY PEOPLE

The Bible states in 2. Timothy 4, 3-4 (KJV) "For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but after their lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears. And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables (to Greek mythologies)."

This has taken place and is taken place!

Don't forget! The fact that we believe something to be true does not make it true. Truth is truth whether we believe it or not, truth stands on its own!

Remember also: The Truth is the original, and what is not the original is a counterfeit!

I would like to say that it is not my intention nor desire to offend, to judge or to condemn anyone with any of my presentations, but to humbly present what I have found in Scripture! By the way, no one should have to sacrifice who they are and what they believe just because someone else has a problem with it!


This command "come out of her my people" is taken from the book of Revelation chapter 18:1-4 called the message of the fourth angel!

The Bible also speaks about a "Three angel's message" in Revelation chapter 14:6-12.

The message of the 1st Angel states in Revelation 14:7 KJV, "Saying with a loud voice, Fear Elohim, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters."

The message of the 2nd Angel we find in Revelation 14:8 KJ, "....saying: <u>Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication."</u>

Then we have the message of the 3rd Angel in Revelation 14:9-11, saying with a loud voice: If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive [his] mark in his forehead, or in his hand, 10. The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of Elohim, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: 11. And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name."



In short:

Angel: Fear Elohim and give Him glory, the Hour of His judgment is come and worship Him.

Angel: Babylon is fallen

Angel: Warning against anyone that worships the beast and his image and receives his mark in his forehead, or in his hand.

In a sense, the Bible is the story of the struggle between <u>True</u> worship and false, apostate or mixed worship. Therefore, the message of the Three Angels is a call for turning back to

YHVH, a restoration, a call for revival, a call for a reformation, a call to return to the old paths.

These are the most solemn and the most serious messages ever given to man and deserve our attention to say the least! However, there is another angel following, called the 4th angel or some call him the 7th angel recorded in Revelation 18: 1-4 with another message.

Here is what the Bible says: "And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory. 2. And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, <u>Babylon the great is fallen</u>, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

. For <u>all nations</u> have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies. 4. And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, <u>Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues."</u> KJV



And in order <u>not</u> to receive the plagues <u>one must get out</u>, <u>be separate</u> of that system and <u>not participate</u> in any of the abominations which are being practiced in the name of YHVH.




If realized or not, most people are in captivity today, stuck in a box of man-made organized religion, man-made traditions and teachings!

No matter, which organized church or denomination you belong to, you are being stuck in that particular system! And you can't serve YHVH completely and freely, unless you get out of these manmade systems and their practices. Isn't that the message of this fourth angel?

The elect of Elohim cannot belong to the groups fenced in by creeds, dogmas, church-house walls, or personalities, because one cannot serve two masters!

We read in Revelation chapters 13 to 19, clearly that all the nations of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication. That's why we read the call by the Most High "Come out of her, My people."

The first one to be called out was Abram in Genesis 12:1, "Now YHVH said unto Abram, get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will show thee." KJV



Ever since the Reformation began at the beginning of the 16th century, there have been steps taken to "come out of Babylon's teachings and paganism". Hopefully this presentation can unveil some of the Great Apostasy of which Revelation talks about.

It is well known that the Christian Church, from the 2nd century onwards, had accepted many pagan festivals, teachings, customs, images, idol's names etc. with the apology that these things of idolatry have been Christianized or sanctified.

However, the Scripture is clear that heathen customs, deities, festivals, or days of worships cannot be sanctified, only repentant sinners, humans can be sanctified and be made holy!


If we earnestly seek a restoration or a revival, we must repent and turn back to YHVH, turn back to Torah, from Babylonian captivity, and reject all Babylonian practices and customs!

Hislop tells us in The Two Babylon's page 122, that "The Pagans were in the habit of worshipping the same god (Elohim) under different names."

Pagan worship is strictly forbidden to the people of the Almighty, even if mixed with True Worship.

Many Scriptures testify to this! Our Elohim does not accept mixed worship or partial obedience. Why should we?





Aaron tried out of fear of the people to worship YHVH **by mixing** paganism with the true worship when he made a golden calf. Here is what happened in Exodus 32:4-5

"... he (Aaron) made it a molten calf ... he built an altar ... and Aaron made proclamation, and said 'tomorrow is a feast unto YHVH."

Did YHVH approve f this mixed worship? NO, He DID NOT!

It states in Exodus 32:7 and 9 "And YHVH said unto Moses, go, get thee down; for thy people which thou broughtest out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves ... 9. Behold it is a stiff-necked people." KJV

How did they corrupt themselves?

By mixing true worship with paganism!

What about today's Christmas Celebrations as an example in honor of Messiah's birth on December 25?



CAN YOU SPOT THE DIFFERENCE?



NEITHER CAN YHWH

YHWH your Elohim will cut off before you the nations you are about to invade and dispossess. But when you have driven them out and settled in their land, and after they have been destroyed before you, be careful not to be ensnared by inquiring about their gods, saying, "How do these nations serve their gods? We will do the same." You must not worship YHWH your Elohim in their way, because in worshiping their gods, they do all kinds of detesable things YHWH hates...

Deuteronomy 12:29-31

The fact of the pagan origin of the festival of Christmas on the 25th of December, namely, as birthday of the Sun-deity, is admitted by all scholars. The date of our Messiah's birth has been calculated to be in fall during the feast of tabernacles.

However, we are not commanded anywhere in the Bible to remember the day of His birth, rather, to remember the day of his death.

One thing is certain!

- Yahusha was not born on December 25!
- The festival of Christmas was celebrated by pagan societies many centuries before the birth of Messiah.
- There is absolutely no record in the Bible of anyone observing Christmas.
- There is not even a hint of a Christmas celebration of the first century church or anything remotely like it.

The fact is that

- The birthday of the <u>Babylonian</u> sun god "Tammuz" was celebrated on December 25.
- The birthday of the **Egyptian** sun-god "Ra" was celebrated on December 25.
- The birthday of the <u>Greek</u> sun-god "Zeus" was celebrated on December 25
- The birthday of <u>Roman</u> sun-god "Mithras" was celebrated on December 25

Would you feel honored?

Say that I want to honor you, so I throw a big party every year on your worst enemy's birthday, decorate with your enemy's favorite styles, and serve foods that your enemy loves but that are an abomination to you.

Would you overlook all this, and take it <u>as an honor</u>, if I said that even though these things had origins from your enemy, I was now dedicating them to you with a sincere heart and out of love to you?



Then what makes you think YHVH will?
Remember, Elohim (Elohim) will not be mocked.

(See Galatians 5:7)

The Scripture says, "Come out of her my people!" Don't do as the world does!

Let me read Deuteronomy 12:29-32 KJV again in this respect, "When YHVH thy Elohim shall cut off the nations from before thee,30. take heed to thyself that thou be not snared by following them, ...and that thou enquire not after their gods (Elohims), saying, how did these nations serve their Elohims? Even so will I do likewise. 31. Thou shalt not do so unto YHVH thy Elohim for every abomination to YHVH, which he hateth, have they done unto their Elohims; for even their sons and their daughters they have burned in the fire to their Elohims. 32. What thing so ever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it."

Also read Deuteronomy 4:14-19; 12:1-4; 18:9; Leviticus 20:23-26; Jeremiah 20:2-3; 2. Kings 17:22 and 41;

In Ezekiel 8:3-16 we see the most alarming description of how idolatrous worship **is merged** with True Worship, especially in verses 14-16, where Sun-worship has been brought into the House of YHVH. The Tammuz-worship of verse 14 is just one form of Sun-

worship, Tammuz being the incarnate Sun, the young rising Sun as a deity. (Alexander Hislop, The Two Babylon's, p. 96, p 118, p 228)

Here is verse 14 of Ezekiel 8, "Then he brought me to the door of the gate of YHVH's house which was toward the north; and behold there sat women weeping for Tammuz."

In Verse 16 of Chapter 8 Ezekiel was also shown twenty-five men worshipping the Sun **towards the East**, and that is exactly what started taking place in post-apostolic Christianity. Worship towards which direction? Toward the East!

This praying towards the Sun in the East is recorded in the writings of **Clement of Alexandria**, a teacher at the Catechetical School in Alexandria, Egypt, **as well as in the writing of his scholar**, **Origen.** They were both guilty of trying to justify this practice, which YHVH labeled "wicked abominations" (Ezekiel 8:9).

Clement of Alexandria trained the famous theologian and teacher Origen. Writer and confessor of the faith.

These two teachers (Clement and Origen) through their many writings had done much to justify the adoption of Greek philosophy, Gnostic teachings and also Sun-worship, into Christianity. Origen not only called our Saviour "the true Sun", but both attempted to justify Eastward oriented prayer and worship.

F.J. Dölger, Sol Salutis, p 143



The Bishop of Carthage, Cyprian, in the year of 258 C.E. also exhorted Christians to pray to the East at sunrise.

Most Christian Churches of today have Easter Sun Rise Services!

I found even one church on the internet that calls themselves

In Deuteronomy 17:3-5 the civil law demanded that those of Israel who were found guilty of worshipping "the sun, or moon, or any of the host of heaven," were to be stoned to death.

Has our God changed?

Malachi 3:6 states, "For I am YHVH, I do not change" KJV

He is "the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning." James 1:17 KJV

Israel was commanded to keep the worship pure and undefiled by destroying everything pertaining to pagan worship, even to destroy the names of the pagan deities.


In Deuteronomy 12:3 YHVH stated, "Ye shall overthrow their altars, and break their pillars, and burn their groves with fire; and ye shall hew down the graven images of their Elohims and destroy the names of them out of that place." KJV

Israel was commanded not even to do what according to Exodus 23:13 KJV?

And in all things that I have said unto you be circumspect: and make no mention of the name of other Elohims, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth."

"Make no mention of the name of other Elohims, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth?"

The Scripture says, "Come out of her, My people!"



Let us rather commemorate our Savior's Memorial Passover and the subsequent events according to Scripture, starting on the evening of the 14th day of Abib.

Let us repent of and eliminate the pagan Easter festival!

A prophecy for the end time is given to us in Jeremiah 16:19. Jeremiah addresses YHVH and says, "The Gentiles shall come to You from the ends of the earth and say, 'surely our fathers have inherited lies, worthlessness and unprofitable things." *KJV*

Could these lies keep us from entering the New Jerusalem?




Another tradition of the Church, which our fathers have inherited, was:
The adoption of the words "cross" and "crucify."
These words are nowhere to be found in the Greek of the New Testament!

These words (cross and crucify) are mistranslations of the Greek words stauros and stauroo. Vine's Expository Dictionary of New


Testament Word says, "Stauros denotes, primarily, an upright pole or stake...Both the noun and the verb stauroo, to fasten to a stake or pole, are originally to be distinguished from the ecclesiastical form of a two-beamed cross. The shape of the latter had its origin in Ancient Chaldea (Babylon), and was used as the symbol of the god (Elohim) Tammuz (being in the shape of the mystic Tau, the initial of his name) ... By the middle of the 3rd century AD the churches had either departed from, or had travestied, certain doctrines of the Christian faith. In order to increase the prestige of the apostate ecclesiastical system pagans were received into the churches apart from regeneration by faith, and were permitted largely to retain their pagan signs and symbols... Hence the Tau or T, in its most frequent form with the cross piece lowered, was adopted ..." Vine's Expository Dictionary of New Testament Word

Alexander Hislop in His book "The Two Babylon's" pp 197-205 he frankly calls the cross "this Pagan symbol ... the Tau, the sign of the cross, the indisputable sign of Tammuz, the false Messiah ... the mystic Tau of the Chaldeans (Babylonians and Egyptians), the true original form of the letter T – the initial of the name of Tammuz ... the Babylonian cross was the recognized emblem of Tammuz."

In the Encyclopedia Britannica, 11th edition, volume 14, p 273 we read, "In the Egyptian churches the cross was a pagan symbol of life borrowed by the Christians and interpreted in the pagan manner."



Scripture says: Come out of her My People!



Where does the word "church" Come from? Common dictionaries are all tracing the word back to its Old English or Anglo-Saxon word, namely "Circe" or "Kirke". And what is the origin of Circe (Kirke)?

Circe = the daughter of the well-known Sun-deity Helios. This "Circe" or "Kirke" is the identical Old English word for "Church". Any encyclopedia, or dictionary of mythology, will reveal who Circe (Kirke) was. She was the goddess-daughter of Helios, the Sundeity!

Again, another form of Sun-worship, this time the name of the daughter of the Sun-deity, had become mixed with the Messianic belief.

Circe (Kirke) was in fact originally a Greek goddess where her name was written as "Kirke" and pronounced as such.



Let us therefore rather use the Scriptural word:

Assembly or Congregation, Instead of Church, whenever we can in order to have the correct meaning!

What about the word "Amen?"

The Hebrew of the Old Testament reveals to us that the Scriptural Hebrew word (which means so be it, or verily or surely) is "Amein" and not "Amen". Likewise, the Greek equivalent in the Greek New Testament is also pronounced: "Amein."

Anyone can check this out in Strong's Concordance, # 543 in its Hebrew Lexicon and #281 in its Greek Lexicon, or in Aaron Pick's Dictionary of Old Testament Words for English Readers.

At times in Egyptian history, devotees of Amen-Ra claimed that he was the Creator. Thus, some dictionaries of Egyptian mythology claim **Amen** was self-created in the beginning. Yet other dictionaries follow other older records claiming that Amen was one of eight gods made by Thoth. Thus it is clear that earlier Egyptians considered **Amen** as a created being, not the Creator, as one of many lesser gods, not as the One Great High Elohim.

Our Savior calls himself "the Amein" in Revelation 3:14.

Substituting a title or name of our Savior with the name of the great hidden Sky-deity or the great Sun-deity of the Egyptians "Amen" is inconceivable!

The difference is subtle, but it is there.

By ending our prayers with "Amen" instead of "Amein," one could very well ask: Have we been misled to invoke the name of the Egyptian Sun-deity at the end of our prayers?

What about The Fish Symbol?
This fish symbol is used
because Christians are told that
it is because we are called to be
"fishers of men". Again,

Alexander Hislop states that our Messiah "began to be popularly called ICHTHYS (or ICHTHUS), that is "the FISH", manifestly to

identify Him with Dagon." (The Two Babylon's, p. 247) Dagon was the Fish-deity.

In the book "The Two Babylon's, pp. 252 and 270 it states also "that ICHTHUS, or the Fish, was one of the names of Bacchus." Bacchus was just another name for Tammuz, the Sundeity. The adoration or veneration of the fish emblem is clearly and emphatically forbidden in Deuteronomy 4:15-19.

In another presentation I am discussing the lost or forgotten names of our Heaven Father and His Son!

In Jeremiah 23:27 it states, "....their fathers have <u>forgotten</u> my name for Baal." *KJV*


The truth is that the Father's Name and His Son's Name have been <u>hidden</u> and <u>replaced</u> by other names derived from Sunworship!

There is not a single authoritative reference source which gives the name **Jesus or lesous** as the original name of our Savior! All of them admit that the original form of the Name was more like **Yehoshua**, **Yahushua**, **Yeshua or Yahshua**. The question is, why was it changed to Jesus? Because the Gentiles wanted a Savior, **but not a Jewish one.** They loathed, they hated the Jews, and they even loathed the Elohim of the Old Testament. Thus, a Hellenized Savior was preferred.

The Messianic Belief and its Savior had to become Hellenized to be acceptable to the Gentiles.



Remember the words of our Savior in John 5:43, "I have come in my Father's name, and you do not receive me; if another one comes in his own name, you will receive him."



Also we do not know the absolute solar origin, we can clearly see, however, that with the Greeks using both the Greek words Messias (a transliteration) and Christos (a translation) for the Hebrew Mashiach (Anointed), the word (Come out of Her my

..... people by C.J. Koster – page 62) Christos was far more acceptable to the pagans who were worshipping Chreston, Chrestos and perhaps also those worshipping Krista.



Here is the Verse in Psalm 68:4, "Sing unto Elohim, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name JAH (YAH), and rejoice before him." KJV

Further, wherever we read "GOD" in capital letters, that too is a substitute for "YHVH." This title, "lord, is applied to all heathen deities, if the word "god" is not used for them. In most cases "lord" and "god" are used interchangeably for pagan idols.

There is not a single text in all Scripture which prohibits us from calling Him by His Name of YHVH!

He Himself says in Isaiah 42:8,"I am Yahuah, that is my name."

In spite of attempts made to justify the "translating" of the Father's Name and His Son's Name, the fact remains: A personal name cannot be translated! It is simply not done. The name of every single person on this earth remains the same in all languages. Satan's name is the same in all languages. He has seen to it that his name has been left unmolested!



What about Obelisks? The well-known pointed obelisks or sun-pillars of Egypt are found in the Scriptures in the Hebrew words "matzebah" and "hammanim". The former word is best translated as "pillars" or as "sun-pillars," and the latter as "sun-sun-pillars," and the latter as "sun-images."

.....The KJV rendered this word matzebah in most places as "images" instead of "obelisks" or "pillars", as the other English versions correctly do.

In Jeremiah 43:13 this matzebah (sun-pillars) are identified as those obelisks found in Bethshemesh (in Greek: Heliopolis) in the land of Egypt.

"He shall break also the images of Bethshemesh, that [is] in the land of Egypt; and the houses of the gods of the Egyptians shall he burn with fire." *Jeremiah 43:13 KJV*

In Exodus 23:24 Israel was commanded to break down these pillars of the heathen nations. This was repeated in Exodus 34:13, Deuteronomy 7:5 and 12:3. In many other places in Scripture these pillars or obelisks are emphatically described as an "abomination" by our Creator. **Israel was also strictly commanded not to erect these.**

Deuteronomy 16:22, "Neither shalt thou set thee up [any] image (H4676 – matzebah); which YHVH thy Elohim hateth."

We are told by the Catholic Encyclopedia, "It is a striking fact that most Babylonian cities possessed a ... temple-tower." Volume 2, p 185

Whether it be a tower, a steeple or a spire, they are all unScriptural. Several writers link, and not without some justification, the towers, steeples and spires with the ancient obelisk.

"There is evidence," says one, "to show that the spires of our churches owe their existence to the uprights or obelisks outside the temples of former ages."

(Brown, Sex Worship and Symbolism of Primitive Races, page 38)


Another says, "There are still in existence today remarkable specimens of original phallic symbols ... steeples on churches ... and obelisks." (Eichler, the Customs of Mankind, page 55)

Christianity has sadly failed to destroy the obelisks or sun-pillars of Sun-worship. They have kept on erecting new ones, similar to the obelisks, nowadays standing separate from the main building, often similar to the obelisks of old. However, this will continue only till the time of the end, for we read in Isaiah 27:9 in ASV, "the Asherim and the sun-images shall rise no more."

Our Elohim Himself will destroy them as it states in Micah 5:13 (ASV,) "and I will cut off your carved images and your pillars out of the middle of you, and you will no more worship the work of your hand."

Christianized" pagan activities, traditional inventions of men, are <u>not</u> in honor of the Biblical Yahusha.

Today, it is amazing what is being presented as Christianity. The truth has been thrown in the streets as a gesture of religious tolerance and compromise. It has given the adversaries of Scripture exactly what they need to substantiate their claims that what most present as Christianity is nothing more than redefined pagan mythology. Educated theologians know that; yet they continue to present a compromised gospel filled with pagan tradition that never had anything to do with Messiah. There has never been a more important time in the history of mankind for those called out as servants of our Creator to confront the philosophy and vain deceit that would lead people away from our Savior. We must not stand idly by and allow this to happen on our watch. (Too long in the Sun)



"Coming out of her" requires of us to stop taking part in her sins, including all of her Sun-worship, or the worship of the host of heaven, which were inherited by the Church. These components are not acceptable to YHVH, just as little as Israel's golden calf was

acceptable to Him. Although Israel attempted to use the golden calf to honor YHVH with. (See Exodus 32:5).

Coming out of Babylon, Rome, simply means: Coming out of the sins, the teachings derived from pagan Rome, which Rome had composed from her forerunners, namely Paganism, Gnosticism, Hellenized Alexandrian theology, and above all the prevailing Sun-worship.

(Come out of her my people by C.J. Koster, p. 113)

The "wicked abominations," as YHVH had labeled Sunworship customs, which are mixed with the True Worship (See Ezekiel 8:9-16) are <u>not acceptable to Him</u>.

The message of Elijah must again go forth in the end-time, before the great and terrible Day of YHVH comes (Malachi 4:5). Elijah found the people in mixed worship, the worship of YHVH plus the worship of Baal (the Sun-deity).

The message of Elijah, a message of challenge, he again proclaimed, "How long will you falter between two opinions"

If YHVH is Elohim, follow Him, but if Baal, then follow him" (. Kings 18:21 KJV).


Shall we do as Israel did at that time, remain silent?

Chapter 6

What happens when you Die? Your Eternal Destiny ... Heaven or Hell



Choose Heaven

Then Yahusha said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

Matthew 4;4 Yahusha said, "It is written, "'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of Yahuah."

We have to first understand how we came alive so let us look at Scripture.

Q1. How did man get here in the first place?

"Yahuah Elohim formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being" (Genesis 2:7).

From this we understand the breadth of Yahuah gives us life and when Yahuah takes away our breadth we no longer live.

Q2. What happens when a person dies?

"Then the dust will return to the earth as it was, and the spirit will return to Yahuah who gave it." (Ecclesiastes 12:7).

The body turns to dust again, and the spirit goes back to Yahuah, who gave it. The spirit of every person who dies whether saved or unsaved returns to Yahuah at death.

Q3. What is the "spirit" that returns to Yahuah at death?



"The body without the spirit is dead." (James 2:26).

"All the while my breath is in me, and the spirit of Yah is in my nostrils." (ob27:3) KJV

The spirit that returns to Yahuah at death is the breadth of life. Nowhere in all of the Scriptures does the "spirit" have any life, wisdom, or feeling after a person dies. It is the "breadth of life" and nothing more. The spirit is not a floating ghost like image.

Q4. What is a "soul"?

"Yahuah formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul." (Genesis 2:7).

From Scripture it says a soul is a living being. A soul is always a

combination of two things: body plus breath. A soul cannot exist unless body and breath are combined. Yahuah's Word teaches that we are a living soul and not that we have souls.

Body(Dust) - Breath(Spirit) = Death (No Soul)



Q5. Do souls die?

"The soul that sins, it shall die" (Ezekiel 18:20). "Every living soul died in the sea." (Revelation 16:3).

According to Scripture, souls do die! We are souls, and souls die. Man is mortal. (He will die). (Job 4:17)

Only Yahuah is immortal (1 Timothy 6:15, 16). The concept of an undying, immortal soul is not found in the Scripture, which teaches that souls are subject to death because we have all sinned.

Q6. Do good people go to heaven when they die?

"All who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth some to everlasting life and some to everlasting destruction." (John 5:28, 29).

"David ... is both dead and buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. ... For David did not ascend into heaven." (Acts 2:29, 34).

"If I wait, the grave is mine house" (Job 17:13).

Nobody goes straight to heaven when they die. People do not go to heaven or to hell at death. They don't go anywhere, but they wait in their graves for the resurrection and judgment according to what they did in this life. Only those who have humbled themselves and have accepted Yahusha as their Savior and have repented of their sins and obey His Torah, will have their sins forgiven and because Yahusha took our punishment of sin upon Himself, we are forgiven and will enjoy eternal life. Praise Yahusha our wonderful Savior.

Q7. How much does one know or comprehend after death?

"The living know that they will die; but the dead know nothing, and they have no more reward, for the memory of them is forgotten. Also, their love, their hatred, and their envy have now perished; nevermore will they have a share in anything done under the sun. There is no work or device or knowledge or wisdom in the grave where you are going." (Ecclesiastes 9:5, 6, 10).

"The dead do not praise Yahuah." (Psalm 115:17).

Scripture says that the dead know absolutely nothing! Though millions think it is possible, the dead cannot communicate with the living. They cannot hear you if you speak to them at the grave side. If they appear to you like a ghost, it is not your loved one, but a familiar spirit of a demon which is there to deceive you.

Q8. But can't the dead communicate with the living and aren't they aware of what the living are doing?

"Man lies down and does not rise. Till the heavens are no more, they will not awake nor be roused from their sleep. His sons come to honor, and he does not know it; they are brought low, and he does not perceive it." (Job 14:12, 21).

"Nevermore will they (the dead) have a share in anything done under the sun." (Ecclesiastes 9:6).

No. The dead cannot contact the living, nor do they know what the living are doing. They are dead. Their thoughts have perished. (Psalm 146:4).

Q9. Yahusha our Savior called the unconscious state of the dead "sleep" in John 11:11–14. How long will they sleep?



"Man lies down and does not rise. Till the heavens are no more." (Job 14:12)

"The day of Yahuah will come ... in which the heavens will pass away." (2 Peter 3:10).

The dead will sleep until the great day of Yahuah at the end of the world. In death, humans are totally unconscious with no activity or knowledge of any kind.

Q10. What happens to the righteous dead at the second coming of Yahusha?

There are no exceptions, no one has ascended into heaven yet as Yahuah loves us all equally.

"Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to everyone according to his work. (Obedience)." (Revelation 22:12).

"The Master Himself will descend from heaven with a shout. ... And the dead in Yahusha will rise first. ... And thus, we shall always be with the Master." (1 Thessalonians 4:16, 17).

"We shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye ... and the dead will be raised incorruptible. ... For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality." (1 Corinthians 15:51–53).

The righteous (Torah obedient) will be rewarded. They will be raised, given immortal bodies, and caught up to meet the Master in the air. There would be no purpose in a resurrection if people were taken to heaven at death. I am so tired of listening to pastors at funerals who lie about the state of the dead and even tell the grieving family that their loved ones are in heaven looking down at them. Scripture does not say this. Also, pastors never say that anyone is going to eternal damnation all are going to heaven no matter how evil that person was. Why do pastors lie to their congregation when Scripture is very clear about what happens when you die? That is why Yahusha said, cursed is anyone who trusts in man. Many "good people" who chose not to obey Yahuah, will be shocked to find that they will not be going to heaven, that is why Scripture says, "Many will come in my name, but I will say to them Get away from me I never knew you."

Q11. What was the devil's first lie on Earth?

"The serpent said to the woman, 'You will not surely die.' (Genesis 3:4).

"That serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan who deceives the whole world." (Revelation 12:9). You will not die is Satan's lie.

Q12. Why did the devil lie to Eve about death? Could this subject be more important than we think?

The devil's lie that we will not die, is one of the pillars of his teachings as well as the lie that we no longer need to obey Yahuah's Commandments statutes and judgments. For thousands of years, he has worked powerful, deceptive miracles to trick people into thinking they are receiving messages from the spirits of the dead. (Examples: Magicians of Egypt — Exodus 7:11; Woman of Endor — 1 Samuel 28:3–25; Sorcerers — Daniel 2:2; A slave girl — Acts 16:16–18.)

A Solemn Warning

In the near future, Satan will again use sorcery as he did in the prophet Daniel's day to deceive the world. (Revelation 18:23). Sorcery is a supernatural agency that claims to receive its power and wisdom from the spirits of the dead. Hence all evil people worship and pray to their ancestors.

Great deception is all over.

Satan and his demons are posing as loved ones who have died, The prophets, or even the apostles of Yahusha. (2 Corinthians 11:13), Satan and his angels will deceive billions when

he comes disguised as "Jesus Christ the Anti messiah." Those who believe the dead are alive, in any form, will more than likely be deceived, especially those who do not study the Scriptures.

Q13. Do devils really work miracles?

"For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles" (Revelation 16:14).

"False Messiahs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect." (Matthew 24:24).

Yes indeed! Devils work incredibly convincing miracles even today. (Revelation 13:13, 14). Satan will appear as an angel of light. (2 Corinthians 11:14) and, even more shocking, as "Jesus Christ" Himself (Matthew 24:23, 24). The universal feeling will be that Messiah and His angels are leading out in a fantastic worldwide revival. Jesus Christ is the Anti-Messiah and Satan will deceive millions when he comes and walks on this earth as Jesus Christ. The entire emphasis will seem so spiritual and be so supernatural that only Yahuah's elect will not be deceived. All miracle working is not from Yahuah, because devils also work miracles to deceive many.

Q14. Why will Yahuah's people not be deceived?

"They received the word with all readiness and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so" (Acts 17:11).

"If they do not speak according to this word, it is because there is no light in them." (Isaiah 8:20).

Yahuah's people will know from their study of the Scriptures that

the dead are dead, not alive. They will know that a "spirit" claiming to be a deceased loved one is really a devil! Yahuah's people will reject all teachers and miracle workers who claim to receive special "light" or work miracles by contacting the spirits of the dead. Yahuah's people will likewise reject as dangerous and false, all teachings that claim the dead are alive in any form, anywhere.

Q15. Back in Moses' day, what did Yahuah command should be done to people who taught that the dead were alive?

"A man or a woman who is a medium, or who has familiar spirits, shall surely be put to death; they shall stone them with stones." (Leviticus 20:27).

Yahuah insisted that mediums and others with "familiar spirits" (who claimed to be able to contact the dead), should be stoned to death. This shows how Yahuah hates the false teaching that the dead are alive.

Q16. Will the righteous people who are raised in the resurrection ever die again?

"Those who are counted worthy to attain eternal life, and the resurrection from the righteous dead ... nor can they die anymore." (Luke 20:35, 36).

"Yahuah will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away" (Revelation 21:4).

No righteous people will ever die again. Death, sorrow, crying, and

tragedy will never enter into Yahuah's new kingdom. "When this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: 'Death is swallowed up in victory.' (1 Corinthians 15:54).

Q17. Is reincarnation a Biblical teaching?

No. "The living know that they will die; but the dead know nothing. ... Nevermore will they have a share in anything done under the sun." (Ecclesiastes 9:5, 6).

Almost half the people on earth believe in reincarnation, a teaching that the soul never dies but is instead continually reborn in a different kind of body with each succeeding generation. This teaching, however, is contrary to Scripture. Scripture says, after death a person returns to dust, (Psalms 104:29), knows nothing, (Ecclesiastes 9:5), possesses no mental powers, (Psalms 146:4), has nothing to do with anything on earth (Ecclesiastes 9:6), does not live (2 Kings 20:1), waits in the grave, (Job 17:13) and continues not. (Job 14:1, 2).

Satan invented the teaching that the dead are alive. Reincarnation, channeling, communication with spirits, spirit worship, and the "undying soul" are all inventions of Satan, with one aim to convince people that when you die you are not really dead. When people believe that the dead are alive, "spirits of devils are working miracles" (Revelation 16:14) and posing as spirits of the dead, will be able to deceive and lead them astray virtually 100 percent of the time. (Matthew 24:24). Some even pray to the dead instead of praying to Yahusha who is the only one who can help you. Are you thankful for the Scriptures, which tells us the truth on this sensitive subject of death?

Q18 Didn't the thief on the tree go to paradise with Yahusha the day He died?

No. The thief did not die the same day and Yahusha was in the grave three days and three nights. In fact, on Sabbath, just before dawn, Yahusha said to Mary, "Do not touch me, I have not yet ascended to My Father in heaven." (John 20:17). This shows that Yahusha did not go to heaven at death but fulfilled what the Scriptures say For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. Matthew 12;40.

It's important to note that the punctuation we see in the Scripture today is not original, but added, centuries later, by translators. The comma in Luke 23:43 would be better placed after the word "today" rather than before, so that the passage reads, "Assuredly, I say to you today, you will be with Me in Paradise." Another way to put this verse that makes sense in the immediate context is, "I'm telling you today, when it seems that I can save no one, when I Myself am being crucified as a criminal, I give you the assurance today that you will be with me in Paradise."

Yahusha's kingdom of glory will be set up at His second coming, (Matthew 25:31), and the righteous of all ages will enter it at that time. No one is in heaven all are waiting in the grave for the resurrection. (1 Thessalonians 4:15–17). How terrible it would be if your loved one was in heaven looking down on the terrible things that happen on this earth and not being able to change it. For them it would be hell not heaven. No one has gone up to heaven except the one who came down from heaven, the Son of Man who is in heaven. John 3:13.

Q19. Doesn't the Bible speak of the "undying," "immortal" soul?

No. The undying, immortal soul is not mentioned in the Scriptures. The word "immortal" is found only once in the Scriptures, and it is in reference to Yahuah. (1 Timothy 1:17). Only Yahuah has immortality.

Q20. At death the body returns to dust and the spirit (or breath) returns to Yahuah. But where does the soul go?

It goes nowhere. Instead, it simply ceases to exist. Two things must be combined to make a soul: body and breath. When the breath departs, the soul ceases to exist because it is a combination of two things. When you turn off a light, where does the light go? It doesn't go anywhere. It just ceases to exist. Two things must combine to make a light: a bulb and electricity. Without the combination, a light is impossible. So, with the soul, unless body and breath are combined, there can be no soul. There is no such thing as a "floating soul."

Q21. Does the word "soul" ever mean anything other than a living being?

Yes. It may also mean life itself, or the mind, or intellect. No matter which meaning is intended, the soul is still a combination of two things (body and breath), and it ceases to exist at death.

Q22. Can you explain John 11:26, "Whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die"?

This refers not to the first death, which all people die. (Hebrews 9:27), but to the second death, which only the wicked die and from

which there is no resurrection, but the righteous will live forever. (Revelation 2:11; 21:8).

Q23. Matthew 10:28 says, "Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul." Doesn't this prove that the soul is undying?

No. It proves the opposite. The last half of the same verse proves that souls do die. It says, "Rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell." The word "soul" here means life and refers to eternal life, which is a gift (Romans 6:23) that will be given to the righteous at the last day. (John 6:54). No one can take away the eternal life that Yahuah bestows. (See also Luke 12:4, 5.). Only your rebellious and disobedient actions can take away your eternal life. That is why Yahusha said Only those that endure to the end will be saved. It is a daily walk of obeying Torah that leads to eternal life. Yahuah said He will not blot you out of His Book of life IF you continue daily in obedience to Torah.

Q24. Doesn't 1 Peter 4:6 say the gospel was preached to dead people?

No. It says the gospel "was" preached to those who "are" dead. They are dead now, but the gospel "was" preached to them while they were living. It can also mean the gospel was preached to the unrighteous who are dead in Yahusha so that they can live.

Q25. Is it true that Scripture says that no one goes to heaven until Yahusha comes back?

Yes, no-one is in heaven or burning in hell yet. John 3;13. And no one has gone up into heaven except the One having come down out of heaven, the Son of Man. King David did not go to heaven

"Fellow Israelites, I can tell you confidently that the patriarch David died and was buried, and his tomb is here to this day. If no one has ever gone into heaven, then it means Mary (Yahusha's mother) is also still in the grave. (Acts 2:29;34).

And by faith even Sarah, who was past childbearing age, was enabled to bear children. Yahuah considered Abraham faithful who had made the promise. And so, from this one man, and he as good as dead, came descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sand on the seashore. All these people were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised; they only saw them (the promised land to come in the new earth) and welcomed them from a distance, admitting that they were foreigners and strangers on earth. Hebrews 11:11-14.

Q26. What does the parable of the rich man and Lazarus teach? Luke 16v19 to 31

A parable is not literal, but a story to bring across certain truths of Scripture. The parable of Lazarus uses clear symbolic imagery. The rich man wants Abraham to send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool his tongue (verse 24). This must be symbolic because it can't possibly happen physically. How much water could pass through the flames, and what help would a few drops of water provide someone suffering in hell?

Many interpret the parable of Lazarus to mean that people have immortal souls that go to heaven or hell immediately at death. This is not what the parable is telling us. Scripture tells us, only Yahuah has immortality.

The parable uses figurative expressions. Do the people who died with faith in Yahusha find their rest in Abraham's literal bosom?

How can millions of people fit in Abraham's bosom? This must be a figurative expression, for we know that at Yahushas coming, angels will gather the saints of Yahusha as Scripture does not contradict itself. (See Matthew 24:30, 31). **Scripture says, "in death there is no remembrance."** (Psalm 6:5). Instead, those who die are asleep in the grave awaiting resurrection. (1 Thessalonians 4:15, 16).

Scripture describes death as sleep over 50 times. See one example by Yahusha in John 11:11–14.

In the Parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus, the rich man does nothing while alive to help Lazarus, a poor beggar, and when he dies the rich man goes to Hell whilst Lazarus goes to Heaven. This parable sends the message that worldly and earthly possessions are of no benefit in the afterlife, and being rich and blessed on this earth, does not mean Yahuah is blessing you. The Pharisees and Sadducees thought, because they were rich, they must be blessed by Yahuah and the poor beggar must be cursed by Yahuah, and they did nothing to help the poor beggar.

makes a stunning charge: the Yahusha hardness and unwillingness of the Pharisees and teachers of the Torah, their actions reflect a hardness to the Word of Yahuah itself, which these men pretend to honor while following traditions of men. The point of the story is found in verse 31 of Luke 16, "'If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded through one rise from the dead." And to prove this point, a few weeks after this parable. Yahusha raised from the dead a man named Lazarus who was dead four days, as if in response to the challenge of the Jewish leaders for greater evidence that Yahusha was Messiah. If Lazarus was in heaven or hell, would he not have said why did you bring me back here? Or if he was in hell he would have said, thank goodness you took me out of hell. The Parable of the Rich man and Lazarus explained.

Sadly, even Yahushas miracles led the leaders of the Jews to plot

harder to have Yahusha killed. (John 11:47–54). They also felt it necessary to do away with Lazarus in order to protect their evil unbiblical beliefs. (John 12:9, 10). The Pharisees thus gave a literal demonstration of the truth of Yahushas statement that those who reject the Torah would reject "greater" light, even the testimony of one who "rose from the dead."

It would be tragic to miss the actual point of the parable. We are not to think of ourselves better than others. Each person is a precious soul to Yahuah. Are we doing all we can to spread the message of salvation to others? Do we have a genuine love for those around us, and have we invited them to share our spiritual inheritance? If we hoard our riches, like the Pharisees of old, we will become self-righteous and corrupt and selfish, and we will lose our salvation. In contrast, by active, loving service by always reaching out to others like Yahusha did each day, are we doing all that we can to share the truth of the Scriptures with others.

Q27. Did Israel's King Saul Consult with a Witch and speak to the dead prophet Samuel?

1 Samuel 28 throughout the Old Testament, Yahuah's people should not consult with mediums, because it is an abomination to try to communicate with demons as the dead cannot communicate, they are in the grave. In 1 Samuel 15, Saul disobeyed Yahuah and failed to destroy the Amalekites. Samuel the prophet, confronts him and says that Yahuah has now rejected him as being kin because of his disobedience. Yahuah tore the kingdom away from him. He's going to give it to David.

Then Samuel says something very significant in 1 Samuel 15:22–23. It's very relevant to what's going to happen over in chapter 28. Saul had defended his disobedience by saying he intended to sacrifice some of the stolen things to Yahuah. Samuel says, "Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice. For rebellion is as the

sin of divination" necromancy, mediums and presumption is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of Yahuah, he has also rejected you from being king."

Q28. Did you hear the reference to divination?

Divination refers to trying to get revelation about the future and about Yahuah's secret plans by using demonic spirits. Samuel says it is, in essence, rejecting the word of Yahuah. Yahuah's word is not enough. Samuel says that Saul's disobedience, therefore, is like divination. It's like idolatry. He puts divination and idolatry in the same category, and that's the root issue in using mediums and necromancers. It puts the mediums and the necromancers in the place where Yahuah belongs. Yahuah tells us as much as he wants us to know about the secret councils of his plans for the future. We might ask, "If it was really a demon communicating with Saul, why did it tell him the truth?" (1 Samuel 28:16-19; compare 13:9-14; 15:8-9, 26; 31:2-4).

We must remember that the primary goal of Satan and his demons is to destroy us. By selectively telling Saul pieces of the truth, the demon posing as Samuel, was able to depress him to the point where Saul was no longer able to stand up. (1 Samuel 28:20). The demon used parts of the truth, while posing as Saul, to paint a picture of hopelessness. "And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light. Therefore, it is no great thing if his ministers, also transform themselves into ministers of righteousness, whose end will be according to their works." (2 Corinthians 11:14-15). Obviously, this was not Samuel but a demon posing as Samuel to deceive Saul.

Yahusha loves you and does not want you to perish (die eternal death) but wants you to admit that you are a sinner in need of His saving love by confessing and repenting your sins to Him and


choosing to obey His Commandments, statutes and judgments found in the Torah, so you can enjoy eternal life. Whatever you do in this life is recorded by the angels in heaven and you will have to stand before Yahusha at the final judgment to give an account of every evil thing you did. Once you have repented and confessed your sins to Yahusha and choose to obey the Scriptures then you are free from your sin and guilt and have assurance of eternal life.

Q29 Why do only a few find eternal life?

Many people enjoy their lifestyle including doing things that Scripture tells us to walk away from, so they have a form of Godliness, but because they walk in their own ways choosing what to obey, they continue breaking Yahuah's laws

Q30 What does the Bible say about lawlessness?

To be lawless is to be contrary(opposite) to obeying the law (Torah) or to act without regard to the law. Laws are necessary in a sinful world (1 Timothy 1:9), and those who choose to act lawlessly are called evil even if they are religious.



Q31. Why is the law necessary for us to obey Yahuah's Commandments, statutes, and judge-ments?

The human heart is selfish and evil and loves the fleshly things of this world that leads to eternal destruction. Without the law (Torah) as a lamp and a guide we do not know what is right or wrong. Just look at the world today and see how evil it has become because each person is living according to their lusts and desires. 1 Timothy 3;8 to 11 says; We know that the law is good if one uses it properly. We also know that the law is made not for the righteous but for lawbreakers and rebels, the ungodly and sinful, the unholy and irreligious, for those who kill their fathers or mothers, for murderers, for the sexually immoral, for those practicing homosexuality, for slave traders and liars and perjurers(swearing falsely under oath) and for whatever else is contrary to the sound doctrine that conforms to the gospel concerning the glory of the blessed Elohim which he entrusted to me."

Q32. What is sin according to the Bible?

<u>1 John 3:4</u> defines sin as lawlessness, "Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact, sin is lawlessness." To commit sin is to be lawless; that is, the sinner breaks Yahuah s law. In this way, lawlessness is a rejection of Yahuah. Satan the Antichrist will come as Jesus Christ. He is called "the lawless one," whose rises to power "will be in accordance with how Satan works with lying signs and wonders." (2 Thessalonians 2:9).

Q33. What is the opposite of righteousness (obeying Yahuah's laws)?

Lawlessness is the opposite of righteousness in verses such as Romans 6:19, 2 Corinthians 6:14, and Hebrews 1:9. The righteous,

who have the character of Yahusha hate the deeds of lawlessness. Lot, a righteous man living in Sodom, "was tormented in his righteous soul by the lawless deeds he saw and heard" (2 Peter 2:8). The psalmist said, "I abhor the assembly of evildoers and refuse to sit with the wicked" (Psalm 26:5). We Israelites are to be law-abiding. (1 Peter 4:15).

Q34. Is Baptism important once you believe and want to follow Yahusha your Savior?


Baptism first and foremost is for the forgiveness of your sins. Baptism is the only way to find forgiveness, i.e. a washing away of our past sins by dying to our old life of sin and our past life. To be cleansed from our previous sins and be justified, we must seek water baptism into Yahusha's Name. You are baptized in water and in the Spirit of Yahusha which abides in you. He gives you His power to not sin anymore and to hate sin.

"For the living know that they shall die, but the dead know not anything, neither have they any more reward."

Ecclesiastes 9:5

Your Actions show whether you Truly Love Yahuah and Yahusha John 14:21 Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. 1 John 5:3 This is love for Yahuah: to obey his commands. And his commands are not burdensome.

Will you choose to obey Yahuah and keep all His Commandments, statutes and judgments and then be baptized in the Name of Yahusha Messiah?



Chapter 7



What does it mean to worship in vain? Vain means, it has no real significance, no value, no importance; it is worthless: and in this case a waste of your time!

In Matthew 15:3 Yahusha said

transgress the commandment of Elohim by your tradition?" He continued in the verses 7-9 "Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying, 8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me. 9 But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the command-ments of men." KJV

Here are the words in Isaiah 29:13, "Wherefore YHVH, Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their mouth, and with their lips do honor me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men."



What made their worship worthless? **Teaching for** doctrines the commandments of man, instead of a "Thus saith YHVH!"

Does that sound like a salvation issue?

The scribes and Pharisees put great importance on their traditions, which they claim was an unwritten law, given by YHVH to Moses on Mt. Sinai, and

handed down to descendants by oral communication. And with each succeeding generation there had been rites and customs

added, removed, and changed. The Savior calls this kind of worship worthless.

These scribes and Pharisees were willing to do most anything to protect their man-made systems and agendas. They would resort to treachery, hypocrisy, slander, and the spreading of malicious lies in the name of Elohim, and finally, would put to death His Son before they would give up their "sacred idols."

As then, so now. The same deception is true of all the Christian Churches, denominations, and groups today. They put customs and man-made ideas above the Word of the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel. Some may deny this, but man hasn't changed, and Satan has been influencing every generation to turn from true worship to false worship. Much of what Christianity has defined as "being biblical and following YHVH's law" rests upon the fallen, fallible and frivolous wisdom of man.

I personally have concluded that <u>all</u> man-made organizations are your condemnation if you join and are part of them. Why? Because one cannot be a member of any such group, and follow their formulated creeds, doctrines, and religious beliefs and at the same time follow "a Thus saith the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Israel!" No man can serve two masters (Matthew 6:24).

The Bible and the Bible alone must be our rule of faith and doctrines. When you ask the over 41,000 different groups, churches, and denomination, they all will claim that the Bible alone is their foundation. However, when you look closer and investigate their teachings this claim is not correct.

We can take nothing for granted! We can't believe everything we hear, see, or read! Because, when you come to the end of the road,

the end of your life, standing before the judge of all the earth, expecting to enter into HIS kingdom but instead hearing the words: "I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity (a nomos – ye that are without Torah, without my instructions)," Matthew 7:23 *Then it* is too late to turn around!

Here Yahusha was talking to the leadership of Judaism. Would the Messiah be possibly repeating the same words today when talking to Christianity?


When we research some of the teachings of the other Lutheran denominations, we find some additional non-biblical teachings like:

- 1. We are living under grace and not under law
- 2. The Trinity Doctrine
- 3. The 3 ½ year Ministry of Yahusha
- 4. The Friday Crucifixion and Sunday resurrection
- 5. Christmas and Easter Celebration
- 6. The biblical Day begins at Sunset say some
- 7. Most claim that the biblical month starts with the New Moon
- 8. When man dies, the soul goes to hell or heaven
- 9. The monthly communion service instead of the yearly Passover
- 10. Calling on the Greek Jesus instead of the Hebrew Yahusha
- 11. Calling the Creator LORD (Baal) instead of YHVH (Yahuah)
- 12. Waiting for a pre-tribulation rapture and the millennium
- 13. Baby Baptism instead of full immersion
- 14. Sunday Sacredness
- 15. The Replacement Theology

Then we could mention the various false teachings in each of the Churches or denominations. Some teach about a coming Sunday Law, an investigative judgment that started in 1844, the lunar Sabbath, some teach once saved, always saved, a second probation, a temple being built during a 1000-year reign of the Messiah with animal sacrifices, the tithing system of the Levitical system in the Christian Churches.

All these things cannot be proven from the Bible, but are based solely on man's ideas and their interpretation of Scripture. We could go on and on. That is confusion or as the Bible calls it "Babylon".

We can safely say that Christianity is not the Religion that the



Hebrew Messiah Yahusha started nor supports. It is a hybrid religion, a mixture of some of the teachings of Yahusha, but not the same religion that He nor the apostles taught!

The great departures from the original 1st Century Church blossomed in the second Century with the Emperor Constantine and grew in number and seriousness with each passing generation.

These are the facts, which are **not intended to offend, condemn or to judge individuals**, **but to be a wake-up call**. Most of us have been in the same boat. It is for our own good to find out what happened during the past 2,000 years and make a U-turn to the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Israel) and to the written instructions He gave through Moses. According to 1 Timothy 2:4

"Elohim wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth."

According to the words that Paul spoke to the people in Athens (Greece), he said, "the times of this ignorance Elohim winked at; but now commandeth all men everywhere to repent."



YHVH doesn't force anyone to accept Yahusha as their Savior and receive His free gift of eternal life. Man has a free will; He must choose his destiny. YHVH invites people to believe Him and to accept His invitation. Yet there are plenty of folks who are not interested,

and who don't believe any of this stuff, **because of their ignorance** and carelessness.

There are only two camps, two groups of people, the good and the bad, the saved and the lost, the holy and the unholy, the righteous and the unrighteous, the obedient and the disobedient, the assembly of the saints and the synagogue of Satan!

We all have been deceived in general and by false Messiahs and false prophets, especially within Christianity. Reverence to YHVH's Torah, His instructions has been subverted! Religious leaders (mostly unknowingly) are teaching for doctrines the commandments of men! They have been lied to by their forefathers and their Churches and they passed these false teachings on to their congregations.

The responsibility lies mainly with the false leaders or false shepherds! The most scathing remarks that Yeshua made were made against the religious leaders of His day, those with a pretense of religion but with hearts full of every evil thing. They had ears to hear but could not hear, eyes to see but could not see. Blind

leaders of the blind. Yahusha said, "Let them alone: . . . both shall fall into the ditch" (Matthew 15:14). Paul, speaking of those who receive not a love for the truth that they might be saved, says YHVH will send them strong delusion, that they might believe a lie and be damned (2 Thessalonians 2:10-12).

In Revelation 18:4 we read about an angel coming down from Heaven, saying that Babylon is fallen and therefore gives the command, "Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues."

The call to come out of Babylon, out of confusion, applies to Christian Churches and Denominations that may once started out pure, but have become corrupt. And when you look at the manmade doctrines I have listed, all denominations are corrupt. Every honest hearted, serious follower of Yahusha is commanded to leave the man-made organizations and their non-biblical teachings, in order to not be partaker of their sins and not to receive their plagues.


Let's think again of the words in Matthew 15:9 that were quoted in the beginning of this article: "In vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of man."

YHVH will not accept the doctrines, teachings and commandments of man, no matter what. The Creator calls this worthless worship.

As an example, Yahushas followers cannot keep Christmas, because YHVH condemns using pagan religious practices in His worship (Deuteronomy 12:29-31), He condemns adding to or taking away from His commandments (Deuteronomy 12:32), He condemns doing anything under green trees in His worship (Deuteronomy 12:1-4),

He condemns the heathen use of decorated trees at a solstice (Jeremiah 10:1-4), commands us to separate from and not touch pagan religion (II Corinthians 6:14-18), He condemns turning to the left or right from His commandments (Deuteronomy 5:32-33), He told the apostles to teach us to observe only His commandments (Matthew 28:20), He rejected David's worship for a small detail and killed Uzzah (II Samuel 6:1-10), He rejected and killed Nadab and Abihu for offering different fire (Leviticus 10:1-7), He rejected Moses from seeing Canaan for a slight modification (Numbers 20:12), He rejected Cain's worship simply for bringing an alternative sacrifice (Genesis 4:7), He rejected Saul forever for noble intentions in a modification (I Samuel 15:22-23), He rejected Uzziah and gave him facial leprosy for a new idea (II Chronicles 26:16-21), etc

Chapter 8

It is a fearful thing to fall in the hands of the living ELOHIM!



This statement is found in Hebrews 10:31. Remember, Yahuah is talking about has the last word. He is in control. He is the one that calls the shots, and He lays down the rules for the whole universe. He is without equal.

It is important that we know when using certain words what they mean. A prophecy for the end-time is given in Isaiah 65:11 wherein our Mighty One warns of the apostasy of His people, "But you are those who forsake YHVH ... who prepare a table for Gad, and who furnish a drink offering for Meni." All commentators agree that Gad is a pagan deity, and so is Meni. Gad is usually interpreted as the well-known Syrian or Canaanite deity of "Good Luck" or "Fortune," and Meni the deity of "Destiny." (From the book come out of her my people by C.J. Koster)

We ask the question: How and when did this title or name become adopted into our modern languages? Encyclopedia Britannica, 11th edition, says, "ELOHIM – the common Teutonic word for a personal object of religious worship ... applied to all those superhuman beings of the heathen mythologies. The word 'Elohim' on the conversion of the Teutonic races to Christianity was adopted as the name of the one Supreme Being..."

Let's look at some more answers. Webster's Twentieth Century Dictionary, Unabridged, 1st edition, says "The word is common to Teutonic tongues ... It was applied to heathen deities and later, when the Teutonic peoples were converted go Christianity, the word was elevated to the Christian sense."


James Hastings, Encyclopedia of Religion and Ethics, vol. 6, p. 302 reads, "After the conversion of the Teutons to Christianity the word came to be applied also to the Christian Deity ... Its etymology and the original meaning are obscure and have been much debated." (From the book Come out of her my people by C.J. Koster)

For this reason, I try to stay away (as much as possible) from using the word "god" and use instead the Hebrew word "Elohim".

"The basic meaning behind the name Elohim is one of strength or power of effect. Elohim is the infinite, all-powerful ONE who shows by His works that He is the creator, sustainer, and supreme judge of the world. "Bring to an end the violence of the wicked and make the righteous secure — you, the righteous [Elohim] who probes minds and hearts" (Psalms 7:9). (https://www.gotquestions.org/meaning-of-Elohim.html)

ו am referring to the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Israel, whose name according to Exodus 3:15 is known by the four Hebrew letters YHVH (יהוה) (Yod, Hay, Vav, Hay). Some people pronounce the four Hebrew letters as Yahuah, some as YeHoVaH and others as YaHUaH. People argue among themselves what the correct pronunciation of this four-letter Hebrew word is. One thing is certain that His name is NOT lord, that is a title being used for any no-Elohim. Christians claim that for this reason when referring to YHVH, they write "LORD" in capital letters.

Oxford Dictionary of World Mythology states that the literal meaning of Lord is Baʿal meaning "master" or "lord", which is being used for various gods (Elohims).



Scripture is very clear that there is ONLY ONE Elohim, the Creator and life-giver. Moses told the Children of Israel in Deut. 4:35,39,"Unto thee it was shown, that thou mightest know that YHVH he is Elohim; there is none else

beside him. 39 know therefore this day, and consider it in thine heart, that YHVH he is Elohim in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath: there is none else."

In John 17:3 we have the words of Yahusha saying "And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true Elohim, and Yahusha Ha Mashiach, whom thou hast sent." There is no other, we need to establish that fact in our minds. This verse is speaking about the Father and the Son.

According to Matthew 28:18 the Father transferred "all power and authority ... in heaven and earth" to His Son Yahusha Ha Mashiach.

In Mathew 11:27 the Messiah stated, "All things have been handed over to me by my Father ..." (ESV)

John 3:35, "The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hand." (KJV) יהושעו Yashua or Yahusha –spelled with 5 Hebrew letters yod, hay, vav, shin, ayin)

Philippians 2:5-11, "For, let this mind be in you which was also in Messiah 6 יהושע) (Yahusha) who, being in the form of Elohim,

did not regard equality with Elohim a matter to be grasped, 7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a servant, and came to be in the likeness of men. 8 And having been found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death, death even of a stake. 9 Elohim, therefore, has highly exalted Him and given Him the Name, which is above every name, 10 that at the Name of יהושע (Yahusha) every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 11 and every tongue should confess that יהושע (Yahusha) Messiah is Master, to the esteem of Elohim the Father." (The Scriptures)



According to John 1:29 and 1:36 Yahusha is the Lamb of Elohim who takes away the sins of the world, the one who gave His life for everyone that accepts Him as the Savior for the forgiveness of their past sins and repents and from henceforth decides to walk in His commandments, statutes and judgments.



What many people forget is that Yahusha is also the lion of the tribe of Judah (Genesis 48:8-9) That means He is the Judge, He is the Aleph and the Tav, the beginning and the end, the first and the last according to Revelation 1:8. Even though Yahusha is the lamb that was slain for us, the time is coming, when He will be

a roaring lion to those who have rejected Him as their redeemer.

The final judgment will come for those that have rejected the salvation offered to them.

There was a time, about 1600 years after creation, when the Bible tells us in Genesis 6:6, "And יהוה (YHVH) was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart." (The Scriptures)

Why was He sorry? Because man had so corrupted himself that there was only one remedy left, complete annihilation of all living things.

When it states that YHVH was "grieved" in His heart, the Hebrew means difficulty in breathing, He was very disappointed, sad and deeply stirred because of the rebellion and wickedness of man. Though YHVH once "saw" His perfect creation and called it "very good," now He is grieved by what He "saw," for though man was once sinless, he became utterly immoral.

What Elohim therefore saw was that the wickedness of man had permeated every inch of society. There were simply no boundaries for man's evil behavior.



Then it states in the next verse, "And nin (YHVH) said, 'I am going to wipe off man whom I have created from the face of the ground, both man and beast, creeping creature and birds of the heavens, for I am sorry that I have made them."

There came a point of time that the only remedy was complete destruction and a need for a new beginning! This is when we let Satan take control of our thoughts and actions!

YHVH said to Adam and Eve in the garden, "In the day that you eat of the fruit, you'll die." They both ate, and Adam still lived 930 years. What amazing patience with sinners? Elohim said, "I'm going to destroy the world in a flood." But before the destruction came, He warned the world through Noah and called

people to repentance for 120 years. Peter in 1 Peter 3:20 describes this **as the patience of Elohim**.

Even the psalmist at his highest moments of reflective worship questions why YHVH doesn't act against those who violate Him. Again, in 2Peter 3:9 it states, "YHVH is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." KJV



Only Noah found grace because he was found **righteous** in his generation according to Genesis 8:1

Again Genesis 6:9, "Noah was a just man [and] perfect in his generations, [and] Noah walked with Elohim."

What does it mean to walk with Elohim?

Walking with Elohim is a picture the Bible uses to describe the life of His children.

Galatians 5:16 says, "Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh." Colossians 2:6 tells us, "As you therefore have received Messiah Yahusha, so walk in Him." And in Micah 6:8 we read, "He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does YHVH require of you but to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your Elohim?" KJV

That is a decision, a commitment, one must make!

We find an interesting verse in Amos 3 which gives us an important aspect of walking with Elohim: "Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?"

To walk with Elohim means being one unit and having the same desires and goal. We are putting our strength toward the same end; we are moving in harmony with Him; we are staying close to Him. It is the same concept as abiding.

James 4:4, "Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with Elohim? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of Elohim." KJV

Noah did not walk with the world, he walked with YHVH. He was a man who stood alone in a godless culture. He was ridiculed for building the ark, especially since it had not rained before. Yet, he was faithful to do what Elohim asked of him. By faith, he stood alone in obedience to YHVH and refused to listen to the world. So must we!

Of those that did not walk with Elohim, it says in Genesis 7:23, "And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained alive, and they that were with him in the ark." KJV

THIS IS JUSTICE! There will be justice at the end of the world, for "He has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead." Act 17:31 (English Standard Version)

When the door of the arc was shut by YHVH, the time of mercy had passed, and judgment was executed, there was no return, no second chance.

As it was in the days of Noah, so will it be again!



The door will be shut again, This time forever!

Currently the door of mercy is still open for those you decide to enter!

I am thinking of Moses' request in Genesis 33:18 when he said" I beseech thee, show me thy glory!"

Then Exodus 34:6-7 states, "And YHVH passed by before him, and proclaimed, YHVH, YHVH Elohim, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, 7 keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation."

Moses was overwhelmed with the glory and mercy of Elohim, and he bowed down to worship YHVH. Why not worship YHVH today? Because He is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. Psalms 103:8 (KJV)

There is salvation and redemption on one side and destruction on the other side! The choice on which side we will be is yours and mine!

The purpose of this life is to decide where we want to spend eternity! Do not procrastinate to make that decision!

In Genesis 19 we read the story of Sodom and Gomorrah. The inhabitants of those two cities were **so wicked** that Yahusha himself came to check things out and to inform Abraham of His plan. Since there were not even 10 righteous persons found among a population of 120,000 people, we are told in Genesis 19:24 that YHVH rained Sulphur and fire out of the heavens to destroy them all. Only Lot and his two youngest daughters barely escaped as the

angels had to take them by their hand to pull them out, and that was probably only because of Abraham's intercession.



Again, we see two camps, one saved and one lost! Which side to you want to be on? Even though we read in Psalms 100:5 that YHVH is good and that his mercy is everlasting, there are limits to His mercy and patience as we have seen in just these two examples.

We live in a very twisted world today, a world where everything is reversed. Dark has substituted for light. Evil has substituted for good. Bitterness has substituted for sweetness, to borrow the words of the prophet Isaiah. It's a twisted world where sins have become rights, iniquities have become virtues. Evil is considered personal freedom. We could talk a lot about the twisting of our morals in this culture. We could talk about the various aspects of morality that have been perverted and inverted, twisted.

We live at the very end of civilization; time is running out according to Scripture. There will be a final judgment according to 2Corinthians 5:10 where it states, "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Messiah; that everyone may receive the things [done] in [his] body, according to that he hath done, whether [it be] good or bad." KJV

Revelation 20:15 states it this way "And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." KJV It is extremely important that our names be written in this book of life in order not to be cast into the Lake of Fire!

Therefore, it is a good idea to find out what it will take for our names to be written in the book of life! For this reason, I encourage people

to search the Scriptures for themselves, to find the answer! Don't leave that to anyone else. Don't trust a church or denomination!



The Lake of Fire will be real and there will be no escape!

This means permanent, eternal destruction!

In Revelation 21:8 we are told who will end up in that fiery furnace, "... the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death." KJV

Remember, the title of this presentation taken from the Easy-to-Read Version "It is a terrible thing to face punishment from the living Elohim." Hebrews 26:31

This punishment will be only for the ungodly, the unbelievers!

Here is what we read in Matthew 13:41-42 explaining the parable of the weeds! 41 The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will weed out of His kingdom every cause of sin and all who practice lawlessness. 42 And they will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth... (Berean Study Bible)

Do you know what it means to be thrown into a fiery furnace?



At that time, there will be serious "weeping and gnashing of teeth!" by those that were rebellious towards the King of kings according to Yahusha! (Matthew 8:12; 22:13; 24:51; 25:30 and Luke 13:28)

The phrase gnashing of teeth is found in several places in the Bible and is used exclusively in reference to the final judgment of sinners, where it is combined with either weeping or wailing.

The gnashing of teeth combined with weeping or wailing communicates much pain!

We have choices, no one is being forced to be rebellious against the King of kings! There is a way to escape these punishments if you act beforehand!

While you still breathe, seriously consider choosing Life in order to escape the lake of fire and to rather live on the New Earth for eternity, because:

Eternal Life as well as the new Earth and Heaven are for REAL! Yahusha is pleading with you, to choose LIFE!

Back in Deuteronomy 30:19 Yahusha was pleading with His people, saying, "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, [that] I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore, choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live." KJV

Yes, it was Yahusha speaking to the people of Israel. He was the Elohim, the great I AM of the Old Testament! DO YOU WANT THE PROOF?

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with Elohim, and the Word WAS Elohim." John 1:1 (The Scriptures) "All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made. 4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men." John 1:3 and 4 (KJV)

YAHUSHA IS THE CREATOR!

He had existed **long before** His birthplace in Bethlehem, because He openly told the Pharisees in John 8:59, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham came to be, I AM." (The Scriptures)

In Revelation 1:8 Yahusha said of Himself, "I am the 'Aleph' and the 'Taw', Beginning and End," says " יהוה '(YHVH) who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty." (The Scriptures)

The Apostle Paul refers to that Rock in the Old Testament as Messiah because he wrote that all Israel "were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea, and all ate the same spiritual food (manna), and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and the Rock was Messiah" (1Cor 10:2-4), and Yahusha had already said He was the bread that came down from heaven, so there is no reason to disbelieve that Yahusha is the Elohim of the Old Testament.



The Elohim is the same in both the Old Testament and the New Testament; it's just that He was dealing with Israel, and later, Judah (the Jews), in a way **that seems harsh to us**, but to Elohim it was a way of bringing them to repentance and coming back to Him. YHVH is just in all He does,

and we cannot question what our Creator is doing and try to give Him counsel or advice. No matter what YHVH did in the Old or New

Testament, the Potter has every right over the clay vessels, and He has never once asked our advice on how to run the universe. That's a good thing because we'd mess it up.

The angel that Moses met at the burning bush was Yahusha (Ex 3:5) The "I Am" in whom Abraham rejoiced was Yahusha (John 8:56–58). The YHVH who motivated Moses was Yahusha (Hebrews 11:26). The Redeemer who brought them out of Egypt was Yahusha (Jude 5). The Rock in the wilderness was Yahusha (1 Corinthians 10:4). The King of Isaiah's temple vision was Yahusha (John 12:40–41).

Accept the true Hebrew Messiah Yahusha Ha Mashiach as your Savior, I don't mean the Greek man-made Jesus. Repent of your sins and out of a thankful heart and love to Him keep His commandments, statutes, and judgments! It is not difficult. There is NO other way! He is "the Way, the Truth and the Life!"

"Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved." Acts 4:12 (KJV)

That name is Yahusha! Yahusha is still calling today!



Yahusha is not calling you to join a manmade religion, an institution, a church, or a denomination. He is inviting you to give your life, your heart and thoughts to HIM alone. Go into your closet at home and submit to HIM!

And be baptized by immersion in the name of Yahusha!

In order to be a member of any denomination in regular and good standing, you would not be able to follow a "thus saith YHVH" because you must submit to their established creeds or doctrines, even though they are not biblical. Because the second commandment states, "thou shalt have no other gods (Elohims) before me!" (Exodus 20:3) KJV Following the traditions, teachings and doctrines of man would be worshipping other gods (Elohims)!

Here are the words of YHVH to ancient Israel found in Jeremiah 7:22-23, "I (YHVH) said nothing to your fathers, and gave them no orders, on the day when I took them out of Egypt, about burned offerings or offerings of beasts: 23 But this was the order I gave them, saying, Give ear to my voice, and I will be your Elohim, and you will be my people: go in all the way ordered by me, so that all may be well for you." (Bible in Basic English)

Or the encouraging words of Joshua in chapter 22:5 to the Rubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh when they returned home from helping their brothers conquering the land: "... take diligent heed to do the commandment and the Torah (instructions), which Moses the servant of YHVH charged you, to love YHVH your Elohim, and to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and to cleave unto him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul." (KJV)

The same advice is given to this generation!

NOTHING HAS CHANGED! He said in Malachi 3:6 "I

am YHVH, I change NOT!"

Chapter 9

THE SIMPICITY OF THE GOSPEL OF YAHUSHA


I believe that the gospel of salvation is simple, meaning it is easy to understand, even a child can comprehend it. It is the grown-up people, inspired by Satan that make the message of salvation complex and confusing!



Yahusha stated in Matthew 13:25, "... while men slept, the enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way." Adam and Eve were deceived by Ha Satan, and he has continued his deception for the past 6,000 years!

Why are there more than 41,000 churches and denominations with different doc-

trines? The gospel of the Hebrew Messiah is NOT complex and confusing, it is easy to understand, but the enemy is bringing in confusion!



The message of salvation is amazingly simple, believe in YHVH and in what He says: "OBEY AND LIVE, DISOBEY AND DIE!"

Do you have a problem understanding this?

This is true for the Old as well as for the so-called New Testament! Obey and live, disobey and die!

We read in Genesis chapter 2:16-17, "And יהוה (YHVH) commanded the man, saying, 'Eat of every tree of the garden, 17 but do not eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for in the day that you eat of it you shall certainly die." (The Scripture 2009)

YHVH says, Obey and live or disobey and die! The choice Is yours!

Satan, in the form of a serpent, came along and said unto the woman in Genesis 3:4-5, "... Ye shall not surely die: 5 For Elohim doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil." (KJV)



The Enemy says, you are **not going to die** when you disobey, you will even be like the Creator! Your eyes are going to be opened!

Here is where the problem started! The Creator, the one they knew and talked to daily, told Adam "In the day that you eat of it you shall certainly die." On the other hand, the deceiver told Eve "Ye shall not surely (not

really) die!"

Who should Eve believe, who was correct? The one giving the command not to eat, was the Creator, the Life-giver, the Great I

AM, the Aleph-Tav, YHVH, the one they communed with every day and the other one was the one they had never seen or talked to before, a stranger!

Once Satan had his initial success in tempting Adam and Eve and introducing distrust of YHVH into their minds, they were under his control and his servants!

In Romans 6:16 Paul ask the question, "Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey, whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?" KJV

Do not listen to the enemy, do not make flesh your arm! "Thus saith YHVH; Cursed [be] the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departs from YHVH." (Jeremiah 17:5) KJV

Stay way from corrupt
Bibles. Use Bibles that

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Third Tip!

Stay away from Manmade doctrines and
teachings!
"But in vain they do
worship me, teaching for
doctrines the
commandments of men."
(Matthew 15:7-8; Isaiah 29:13)
KJV

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Vain means worthless, no use, a waste of time!



Fourth Tip!

Accept Scripture as your compass, starting in Genesis 1:1! Here is the Saviors advice "Search the Scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me."

(John 5:43) KJV

There was NO New
Testament yet. The O.T.
contains all information to
find salvation!

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Fifth Tip!

Accept the God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel, whose name is YHVH, pronounced as Yahuwah or Yahweh!
"...make no mention of the name of other gods, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth."

(Exodus 23:13) KJV

Jesus is a false messiah, another god, created by Constantine, who was a sunworshipper until his death!

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Sixth Tip!

Accept the Sacrifice of His Son Yahusha (NOT THE CHRISTIAN JESUS, wo never existed). Jesus is a mask for Tammuz, he was an image of Yahushua but not the Hebrew Messiah.



The Christian Jesus and the Hebrew Messiah are two different entities. Yahusha means the ONE that exists saves!

Seventh Tip!

Acknowledge, confess your past sins, forsake them and be baptized in the name of Yahusha, not in the unholy, pagan Trinity.



He that covereth his sins shall not prosper but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy. (Proverbs 28:13)

Eighth Tip!

Obey YHVH's instructions He himself gave to Moses at Mt Sinai, called the Torah, which is your seal according to Isaiah 8:16



Yahusha said "...if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. (Matthew 19:27) KJV
He was referring to the Torah, He himself gave through Moses at Mt Sinai

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Ninth Tip!

Live a set-apart, holy life, be a blessing, love your neighbor as yourself, be a good citizen, endure until the end, which is soon!



"Be set-apart, for I am set-apart." (1Peter 1:16 and Leviticus 11:44-45)



Tenth Tip!

Put Yahuwah first in your life in all things and trust Him to supply all your needs because you remain obedient and faithfu to HIM. Do not compromise truth, compromise is sin!



"And ye shall be hated of all [men] for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved." (Matthew 10:22) KJV

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There is only one way to salvation! It was grace and a living, active faith in the Old Testament, and it is grace and a living active faith in the New Testament! There is not one way to be saved in the Old Testament and a different way in the New Testament. That would be two different gospels. There is only one road to heaven through Yahusha the Messiah, the living Torah!

Look at Hebrews 4:2, "For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard [it]." KJV There are not two different gospels!

Remember, mercy and grace is only for those who obey! Here is the proof:

"The mercy of YHVH is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children; To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them." (Psalms 103:17-18) KJV

When Yahusha healed people, He said "Go and sin no more." It is the devil that wants you to continue living in sin and rebellion against Yahuah so you can lose your eternal life and he can destroy your life.


Yahuah cannot protect you from evil if you are not obeying Him. To know your Savior Yahusha is to love Him, and the only proof of Love is obedience to His instructions.

THE BOTTOM LINE! Obey and life, disobey and die!

How interesting it is that Christians in this age of rebellion can invent their own definitions that condone lawbreaking.

Scripture says sin is violating Yahuah's commandments, statutes, and judgments (1John 3:4). This law which has been described as irrelevant and old-fashioned by many modern theologians. Don't be deceived.

Every one of those great moral precepts is just as timely and needful today as they were when Yahuah wrote them on the imperishable tables of stone with His own finger.



In Luke 18:18-21 we have the recorded words of Yahusha saying If you want to inherit life, amazingly simple, "keep the commandments". Since there was no New Testament at this time, Yahusha is obviously referring to the Old Testament, to Exodus chapter 20, where we find the Ten Commandments recorded, that He Himself gave to Moses at Mount Sinai!

In Hosea 13:9 YHVH says to His people, "O Israel, thou hast destroyed thyself..." How did they destroy themselves? The answer is in Jeremiah 6:19

"Hear, O earth! See, I am bringing evil upon this people, even the fruit of their thoughts, because they have not listened to My words, nor My Torah – and they rejected it." (The Scripture Translation)

It is obvious from the previous slide that the Torah (the instructions given to Moses) is YHVH's expression of His will and that through obedience to these instructions He will accept the children of men as His sons and daughters. It was true then and it is still true today! For He states in Malachi 3:6 "I am Yahuah I change not!"

We are talking about Yahuah, the Great I AM, the Aleph Tav, the Creator, the King of kings, the Master of masters, who holds the Universe in His hand that invites us to be His children!

That can only happen if we respond by loving Him in return, which is expressed in obedience to His Torah.

The choice is yours! Obey and live, disobey and die!

Chapter 10

Are you living for eternity?

Why is this question important to think about?



120 JUBILEES

The Messiah, while here on earth 2,000 years ago, referred at various times to the time of the end of civilization. When we study Scripture, we will learn that mankind after the entrance of sin was given a time of probation of 6,000 years, not 7,000 years or 120 Jubilees, not 140 jubilees of 50 years each. That time of 6,000 years is up or almost up, some believe that will be the year of 2028 or 2030, if their calculation is correct. In addition, the Messiah

stated in Matthew 24:22, "except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened"

He stated in the previous verse "For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be."

Tribulation means distress, oppression, affliction. That sounds like a really bad time for people living during these days.

The same is prophesied in Daniel 12:1-2. "AND at that time shall Miyka'el stand up, the great prince which stands for the children of your people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time your people shall be delivered, everyone that shall be found written in the Cepher (book)."

The Messiah mentioned that before His return, there would be many signs signaling His Second Coming. He lists wars and rumors of wars. (Matthew 24:7; Revelation 6:4); Famine. (Matthew 24:7; Revelation 6:5, 6); Great earthquakes. (Luke 21:1). Pestilences, or epidemics of "terrible diseases." (Luke 21:11); Increase of crime (Matthew 24:12); Ruining of the earth by mankind. (Revelation 11:18); Deterioration of people's attitudes, as shown by many who are "unthankful, disloyal, . . . not open to any agreement, slanderers, without self-control, fierce, without love of goodness, betrayers, headstrong, puffed up with pride." (2 Timothy 3:1-4)

Breakdown of the family, with people who have "no natural affection" and children who are "disobedient to parents." (2 Timothy 3:2,3). Love of the Creator Elohim growing cold in most people. (Matthew 24:12) Noteworthy displays of religious hypocrisy. (2 Timothy 3:5); Increased understanding of Bible prophecies, including those related to the last days (Daniel 12:4) Global preaching of the good news of the Kingdom. (Matthew 24:14).

In Luke 21:25-26 Yahusha said, "And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; 26 Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken." (KJV)

Scripture speaks also about a time when there will be a time of persecution of those that believe and stand for the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Israel and His Son Yahusha. Such persecution of believers has taken place in the past but will be taking place again according to Scripture. Satan is behind all this hatred. He hates Yahusha and those that follow Him. But be reminded that he was conquered at the stake 2,000 years ago and is waiting for his complete destruction.

The book of Revelation speaks about a time when Yahuah's judgment will be poured upon the wicked. It talks about seven seals, seven trumpets, seven thunders and seven bowls of the wrath of Elohim. Revelation chapter nine, verse 15, speaks about four angels that were loosed and prepared for an hour, a day and a month, and a year, to slay the third part of men, which amounts to between 2 and 3 billion people. It mentions a great earthquake, the darkening of the sun, the moon and the falling of stars from heaven.



The Old Testament records Moses' warnings to the Israelites about the punishments they would receive, if they persist to disobey their maker, if they adopt pagan worship and practice their abominations. There would be consequences, like war, famine and diseases.

The Word of Elohim is very clear that He deals with people, individually or as groups (cities, nations, etc.) according to how they honor, or refuse to honor, Him. YHVH pronounced judgment on quite a few cities and nations before. Consider the flood, Sodom and Gomorrah, Egypt, Babylon, Israel, his chosen people as well as its enemies.

He is about to deal with the entire world for the last time.

The condition today is likened to the days of Noah and Sodom and Gomorrah. It states in Matthew 24:37, ...'But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.' This is referring to the time we live in, just before the Second Coming.



Genesis 6:13 tells us that in Noah's day the "earth was filled with violence." And in Jude 1:7 it says that in Lot's day, Sodom and Gomorrah had given itself over to "fornication and strange flesh". So, violence prevailed in Noah's day and sexual immo-

rality prevailed in Lot's Day. And this would be a sign of the end times before Yahusha's return.

Today, the world is FULL of violence and sexual immorality. You only need turn the tv on. You can watch these things on YouTube and on your I-phone. The cities of the world today are especially bad and are no longer safe places to be.

In Jude 1:7 we are told that what YHVH did to Sodom was set forth as an example to us today. And what did He do to the people of Sodom? He DESTROYED them with fire! That will happen again, only this time for good. YOU CAN COUNT ON IT!

Here is what 2Peter 3:10 (American King James Version) states in reference to the Second Coming, "But the day of YHVH will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up."

Human probation is **soon to close**, you can count on that, and the final plagues are coming. We can hear the steps of the coming of the King of kings for a while already. The signs are being fulfilled daily. These signs are **intended as warnings and to wake people up**, **to seek YHVH**, **the Creator and Savior and to choose life while we have breath**



HERE IS THE QUESTION: Are you prepared to meet the Creator?

Are you living for eternity?

DO YOU CARE?



We have a Heaven to gain and a Hell to shun!

The new Earth and the New heaven is a real place for real people that have been redeemed from this earth through the ages.

"Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which Yahuah has prepared for them that love him." 1 Corinthians 2:9

Hell on the other hand is a place of pain and destruction! The wicked, meaning those that rejected the Messiah and His Torah

shall be cast into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. (Matthew 13:50) These are the very words of the Creator and Savior.



Every person must ask themself what must I do to inherit eternal life of JOY and BLESSING and not end up in the lake of fire?

Will religion have the answer?

Religion is man-made and does not have the answer. Judaism, Islam and especially Christianity with the different denominations or groups do not have the answer. They all claim to have the truth that leads to eternal life, but **that is a false claim**. How can we know for certain that what you believe is preparing you for eternal life? Most people are very sincere and are doing what they **think** is the right thing to do by attending church every Sunday and being a good person, **but will that give them eternal life and salvation?**

Can you trust your church, pastor or priest and believe what they teach? Is this the way to find truth? After all every church claims to be the true church but how will you know for certain? Just because it feels good to be attending your church and the people are very nice including the priest or pastor does not mean that this is the true church of Elohim.

It is fatal to trust in people, no matter what positions they hold because all people and man-made organizations are based on traditions of men and some Bible truth.

We must diligently <u>STUDY</u> Scripture to guide us to the Pure Undefiled TRUTH, for pastors, rabbi's, prophets, ministers, churches, and religion have deceived us for long enough!

Jeremiah 17:5 warns us, saying, "...Cursed (doomed, damned) is the man who trusts in man."




Trusting in man for salvation has resulted in thousands of churches, denominations, and beliefs amongst those who claim to follow the Scriptures.

The Holy Scriptures, starting in Genesis 1:1, is the only Way to determine what Truth is as it is the very words of our Savior Yahusha Messiah.

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Let's look at this verse again!

And now, Yisra'ěl, what is יהוה (Yahuah) your Elohim asking of you, but to fear יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, and to

serve יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim with all your heart and with all your being, 13 to guard the commands of יהוה (YHVH) and His laws which I command you today for your good?

That should be clear to anyone!



Let's go to another verse, the words of Joshua to Israel and to us today! "Only, diligently guard to do the command and the Torah which Mosheh the servant of יהוה (YHVH) commanded

you, to love יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim, and to walk in all His ways, and to guard His commands, and to cling to Him, and to serve Him with all your heart and with all your being." Joshua 22:5 (TS2009)

THAT IS THE ONLY PROOF THAT WE LOVE YHVH!



LOVE IS AN ACTION WORD!

Let's go to another verse, here are the words of YHVH in Jeremiah 7:22-23, "For I (YHVH) spake not unto your fathers, nor commanded them in the

day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings or sacrifices: 23 <u>But</u> this thing commanded I them, saying, <u>Obey</u> my voice, and I will be your Elohim, and ye shall be my people: and <u>walk</u> ye in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well unto you. " (KJV)

Deut. 6:4-9 "... these words, (commandments, statutes, and judgements) which I command you this day, shall be in your heart: 7 And you shall teach them diligently unto your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise up. 8 And you shall bind them for a sign upon your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 And you shall write them upon the posts of your house, and on your gates." (Cepher)

What does it mean, and you shall talk of the commandments, statutes, and judgments, when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise up?

Let's look at

Psalms 1:1-2 For an example, "BLESSED is the man that walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful. 2 But his delight is in the Torah of Yahuah; and in his Torah he meditates day and night."

Some people would call that person fanatical! But Yahuah calls that person blessed!

The idea here is that the Israelites were to **constantly** have Yahuah's commandments, statutes, and judgements in view and in mind, to **observe them carefully and continuously**. Such a careful observance would translate Israel's genuine love and faithfulness toward YHVH into action. It would be a public demonstration of their commitment to His precepts, and a witness to surrounding nations.

Let's go to the N.T. in Matthew 7:21-23, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Master, Master,' shall enter into the reign of the heavens, but he who is <u>doing</u> the desire of My Father in the heavens. 22 "Many shall say to Me in that day, 'Master, Master, have we not prophesied in Your Name, and <u>cast out demons in Your Name</u>, and <u>done many mighty works in Your Name</u>?' 23 "And then I shall declare to them, 'I never knew you, depart from Me, you who work lawlessness (anomia)!" (TS2009)

Anomia = transgressors of the law (Torah)


In this respect I am thinking of Luke 8:21, "And he (Yahusha) answered and said unto them, My mother and my brethren are


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What does a narrow gate and road mean and look like? Yahusha makes it clear that we all stand at a spiritual crossroads, and there are two paths in front of us. The wide path leads to hell. The second, narrow path leads to eternal life, unfortunately only very few of the lost want to enter the narrow gate and travel that narrow road.

The road is narrow because it doesn't allow anything of this world upon it. The only thing allowed is Yahuah and His word. There's no room for chasing worldly pleasures, unforgiving spirits, self-righteousness, or selfishness of any sort. The narrow way requires you to seek the kingdom of Heaven FIRST, EVERYTHING ELSE IS SECOND PLACE.

Question: "Are you, am I on the narrow road which leads to eternal happiness and blessings or are you on the wide road that leads to Eternal destruction?"

Here is another incident in the Life of Yahusha, which we read in Luke 13:23-24 "...someone said to Him, "Master, are there few who are being saved?" And He said to them, 24 "Strive (Do all you can – CEV – Make every effort – Tree of Life Version) to enter through the narrow gate, because many, I say to you, shall seek to enter in and shall not be able." (TS2009) I wonder why?



Striving means to make serious efforts to reach your goal, in this case the kingdom of Heaven!

Matthew 11:12 talks about this, "And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force." (KJV)

This violence it is speaking about, takes in the whole heart. To be double minded is to be unstable. Resolution, self-denial and consecrated effort are required for the work of the master. Understanding and conscience may be united; but if the will is not set to work, we shall make a failure. Every faculty and feeling must be engaged. Ardor and earnest prayer must take the place of listlessness and indifference. Only by earnest, determined effort and faith in the merits of Yahusha can we overcome, and gain the kingdom of heaven.



That means that many hear the invitation of mercy, are tested and proved; but few are sealed with the Torah according to Isiah 8:16. Few will humble themselves as a little child, that they may enter the



James 4:4, "Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with Elohim? Whoever therefore intends to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of Elohim." (TS2009)

The words of Yahusha in Matthew 7:37, "He that loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me, and he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me." (TS2009)

Luke 14:26 (CEV) "You cannot be my disciple, unless you love me more than you love your father and mother, your wife and children, and your brothers and sisters. You cannot come with me unless you love me more than you love your own life."



Why is there a woe announced when all men speak well of you?


When <u>all</u> men, or <u>everyone</u> speaks well of you that could be a sign that <u>as His follower</u>, you have <u>compromised</u> the truth of Scripture,

soften the message to please some people! That would make you an unfaithful messenger.

Because <u>if</u> you are truly faithful, you will almost automatically raise up against you the hatred and opposition of the world around you.

What does it take for all people to speak well of you, especially as a leader? All you have to do is act like a politician, tell everyone what they like to hear and flatter them to get their votes of approval!

It is a serious matter trying to please people, churches and denominations, trying to be well received by them and well spoken of, instead of pleasing the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Israel. the "Great I AM". There is a "woe" pronounced on every one that is seeking to please people above seeking the approval of Yahuah Elohim, seeking to please Him.



When we love Yahuah, we will live our lives in such a way that He is glorified in our actions and attitude. When we love YHVH we will do what pleases HIM and if He commands us to meet on His

weekly Sabbath and three times a year at His appointed times (feasts) we will not argue with Him but will be delighted to accept the invitation and be there.

We will want to be baptized in the name of Yahusha. "Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Yahusha Ha Mashiach for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." Acts 2:38 (KJV)

WE will guard (keep) Yahuah's Commandments! (Exodus 15:26; Deuteronomy 6:2; Psalms 119:60; John 14:15; John 15:10; 1John 2:3; 1John 5:2).



We will follow Yahuah's Instructions / His Blueprint! (His Torah – Deuteronomy 28)

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Ask yourself the question, am I living for eternity?

This is a serious question, Therefore, take inventory Of your Life while You have breath!

"(For) ...anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire." (KJV) Revelation 20:15 THAT WILL BE FINAL

Can you say with Paul? "I have been impaled with Messiah, and I no longer live, but Messiah lives in me. And that which I now live in the flesh I live by belief in the Son of Elohim, who loved me and gave Himself for me." Galatians 2:20 (the Scriptures)

• Will you and I be able to say with Paul, "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have guarded the faith: 8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which Yahuah, the righteous Judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing." 2Timothy 4, 7-8 (Cepher)



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The good news is that we live in the time of Restoration! Those who earnestly and diligently seek for TRUTH will FIND it! Statements of some biblical beliefs:

The Division between Old and New Testament is man-made.

The covenant Yahuah made with His people is everlasting and His instructions and promises are still true.

The Christian Church has **not** replaced the nation of Israel and cannot replace it because it is paganism.

There has never been and there never will be a covenant made between Yahuah and Christianity nor any other religion according to Scripture, only with the House of Israel and the House of Judah (Jeremiah 31 and Hebrews 8).

Grace and mercy cannot exist without Torah (Law).

Scripture is a book about Hebrew (means to cross over) People.

Deuteronomy 28, especially verses 64-68, gives us a clear understanding of who the Hebrews are today.

Israel (meaning overcomers) is comprised of the natural born seed and those who choose to be grafted in according to Romans 11.

The Creator wants to be called by His name, for that reason He listed His name in the Hebrew Scriptures over 7,000 times. Lord and God are not names but generic titles which are being applied to every false god or idol.

The name Jesus (lesus – see 16ll KJV) has no meaning in Hebrew. In Greek it means "Hail Zeus, saying Zeus is god." His Hebrew name is Yahusha, which means "the One who exists saves." The Father cannot have a Hebrew name and the Son a Greek name, for the Son came in the Father's name (see Exodus 23;21).

When one calls on the name "Jesus", even unknowingly, that person is calling on a man-made (Greek) Messiah that never existed, it is mask for Tammuz (Satan). The Christian Jesus is a copy, an image of the true Messiah Yahusha, but NOT Yahusha.

The trinity is a pagan doctrine.

Christmas, Easter, and Halloween etc. are of pagan origin and must not be kept by Yahuah's people.

Yahuah's seven yearly feast days are still binding today as well as the weekly Sabbath. They are not Jewish; they are Yahuah's feasts (see Leviticus 26:2-8). These feasts are signs between YHVH and His people. These are statutes and still binding. They are a compacted prophecy about the plan of redemption.

The Biblical day is from dawn to dawn meaning that the weekly Sabbath starts at dawn also. Evening to Evening Day start was reinforced when the exiles returned from Babylon while Israel was in captivity for 70 years.

However, the holy (set-apart) hours are the light hours only or at least 12 hours according to Yahusha in John 11:9

There is no name in Scripture for the 24-hour cycle. A day is daytime only. YHVH called the light DAY!

The moon does <u>not</u> determine the beginning of the month, nor year, this also comes from Babylon. The Biblical year starts the day after the spring equinox, then you count to 30 for every month in order to determine the appointed times for Yahuah's yearly festivals.

Baptism according to Scripture is by immersion in the name of Yahusha only, baby baptism originated in paganism.

Maty Baker Eddy, Muhammed, Joseph Smith, Ellen G White are false prophets.

There will be no reign of the true Messiah for one thousand years on this polluted, corrupt, sinful earth as some people teach. When Messiah returns, the righteous dead and the righteous living will be translated and taking to Heaven with Him; all the ungodly will be destroyed according to John 14:1-3. Yahusha, however, will reign on the earth made new for eternity .This old planet must first be purified, cleansed by fire, and re-created before Messiah can reign here and He will after it is newly created. ETC.





