




Just for clarification: In my presentations I am using YHVH (Yahuah) instead of LORD, which is a title and not a name and I am using Yahusha instead of Jesus, which is not a translation but a transliteration and really has no meaning, neither in Hebrew nor in English! YHVH (Yahuah) and Yahusha are the actual original names and the true nature and character of them.

### Yahusha said in John 8:32

### Free from what?

#### "ye shall know the truth and the truth shall Make you FREE!"

#### Free from organized Religion, the doctrines And commandments of man!

The Savior <u>did not come</u> to this earth to start a new religion, another religion, another church, or another denomination! He came to reveal the character of His Heavenly Father to us and to point His people <u>back</u> to the Torah, the instructions given to Moses!



# It was the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Israel and He does not change! (Malachi 3:6)

All we have to do is to read Matthew 5:17-18: "Think not that I am come to destroy the law (Torah), or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, <u>but to fulfill</u>. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the Torah (*law*), till all be fulfilled."

> To fulfil means to do, to keep, to obey, to follow Torah and to to abolish it!

Many have the mistaken belief that what is found in the Old Testament is obsolete, old and no longer binding for today's generation.

This misunderstanding completely loses sight of the covenant YHVH made with Israel – and still makes with the spiritual Israel of today.


The Old **Testament's** promises are also part of the New Testament promises. There are **not** two different and separate religious requirements one for the Jews and one for the socalled Christians.

Have you ever asked yourself the question what has happened to YHVH's feast days listed in Leviticus chapter 23?

Why isn't professed Christianity keeping them? Why do you hardly hear anything about them?



# Because Christianity is a strong delusion. It has little in common with the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Israel!



The Gospel taught in Christian churches today is a different counterfeit gospel to the true faith of Yahuah Messiah and the Apostles and is not Biblical. It is a different, false gospel!

The Christian Gospel consists of teachings, prophecies and stories which are from Yahusha and apply them to Jesus (the false man-made Messiah), who never existed.

Therefore, many people believe that the Feasts of Yahuah are not relevant for our day, and that Yahushua's death and resurrection, which they call Jesus, was the beginning of a new era, called Christianity, embracing new festivals and celebrations, such as Christmas, to celebrate His birth, and Easter, to commemorate His death.

Nowhere in the Scriptures does it speak of any pagan feast being instituted by Yahusha (nor by His Apostles, for that matter). Some go as far as to argue that Yahusha did away with the Torah, the instructions given to Israel, thus calling the feasts jewish, making them no longer revelanty. There is not one Hint in Scripture that say that Yahuah's Feast days and laws were abolished (done away with). Yahuah appointed His Feasts to show the Eternal Plan of Salvation for His people. According to Exodus 12:14 the Feasts are **permanent statutes** for the generations to come.

# ...is being Rediscovered!

### With the Torah the statutes are being rediscovered, including YHVH's yearly appointments!

The prophets of old kept the Feasts! The Messiah kept the Feasts! We are to follow in the Savior's footsteps! The first century apostles kept the Feasts! Paul, the emissary to the Gentiles, taught those engrafted Gentiles to keep the Feasts! The feasts were kept by all faithful believers during the past 2,000 years according to Historians.

YHVH made the feast days, they are HIS. The question is "what is the purpose and for what reason were they made?"





The term "feasts" in Hebrew literally means "appointed times".

These feasts reveal to us a special story. They are often called "holy convocations" (translated "rehearsal") and are intended to be a time of meeting between Yahuah and man for "holy purposes." Since these seven feasts of YHVH are "appointed times" for "set-apart purposes," they carry with them great sacredness and solemnity.







YHVH's appointed festival Celebrations were designed for various purposes:

- 1. To bring us closer to our Creator by meeting with Him at his appointed times!
- 2. To be Memorials!
- 3. They are a sign between YHVH and His people
- 4. They are a compacted prophecy of the plan of salvation and
- 5. They prophecy future events!



Feasts are first and foremost the Creator's Appointments to meet with HIS people!

### This is what YHVH states in Leviticus 23:4

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"Proclaim the following festivals at the appointed times...." Leviticus 23:4 GNB

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INTMEN

### We are <u>not</u> inviting HIM!

Think of it, the Creator of the universe wants to meet with you and with me on <u>specific</u>, fixed <u>dates</u>. <u>He is the one inviting us</u>. He made the appointment!



YHVH established Holy Days for these gatherings. Why would anyone be so disinterested not to accept this invitation to meet with the life giver? <u>We need the</u> <u>benefits of these convocations!</u>



**In Revelation** 19:9 it states: "Blessed [are] they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb."



In Matthew 22 Yahusha told a parable starting with verse 2:

2. The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son, 3. And sent forth his servants to call them that were bidden to the wedding: and they would not come. 4. Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and [my] fatlings [are] killed, and all things [are] ready: come unto the marriage.



### DOES THAT SOUND FAMILIAR?

Then in verse 5 of Matthew 22 it says: **"But they made light of [it], and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise."** 



### Because, They were not interested!

We are to spend quality time With HIM According to His schedule!

Yahuah's appointed feasts, weekly, monthly or yearly are designed to bring us closer to our Creator and Savior!


Furthermore, these yearly appointments including the 7th Day Sabbath are also called MEMORIALS

In addition, the weekly Sabbath, the Torah as well as the feast days are a sign between YHVH and HIS people!

#### There are seven yearly feasts, which are seven events in the plan of salvation that are important for us to understand.



The annual feast days are all about Yahusha, the Messiah; they portray in detail the seven (7) great events in the plan of Redemption and <u>all</u> <u>have a final fulfillment</u>!

The weekly Sabbath as well as the yearly appointed feast days are shadow pictures of good things t come!





### That is future!

These feasts were appointed times of rehearsals for events that were to occur in the future. Paul provides the same conclusion

when he refers to the feasts **as shadows of things <u>to come</u> in** Colossians 2:16-17

## What is the <u>First</u> Feast we are to keep?

You may be surprised, but according to Leviticus 23 <u>the weekly Sabbath is</u> <u>The first feast we are</u> Commanded to observe!





#### For it states in Leviticus 23:2-3

"Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, concerning the feasts of YHVH, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts. Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day is the Sabbath of rest, an holy convocation: ye shall do no work therein, it is the Sabbath of YHVH in all your dwellings."





### **A memorial of Creation!**

#### According to Exodus 20:11 the 7th Day Sabbath is ...

"For in six days YHVH made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day, <u>wherefore</u> YHVH blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it." Exodus 20:11 KJV

## The Sabbath(s) is (are) a sign!

In Exodus 31:13 he stated: "...Verily my Sabbaths (plural) ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that I am YHVH that doth sanctify you."





The next verse states: "...every one" surely be put to death: for who therein, that soul shall be people." Exodus 21 shall work

We are to observe the weekly Sabbath from Sabbath dawn to Sunday dawn. This is called the seventh-day Sabbath spoken of in the 4<sup>th</sup> commandment and instituted in Eden (Exodus 20:8-11; Deuteronomy 5:12-15; Leviticus 23:3; Genesis 2:1-3; Hebrews 4:4)


Let's go back to our presentation "The Feasts of the Bible are Shadow pictures of good things to come!"





Yahusha declared Himself MASTER of the Sabbath and thus set an example for His followers to observe the Sabbath as he did. **"For the son of man is Master even of the Sabbath day."** *Matthew 12:8 – (1. John 2:6 and Luke 4:16)* 

Yahusha kept the weekly Sabbath and He resurrected on the Sabbath, the 7<sup>th</sup> Day of the week!



# Is there A Second (future) **Fulfillment?**



"And it shall come to pass, that <u>from one new month to</u> <u>another</u>, and <u>from one Sabbath to another</u>, shall all flesh come to worship before me, said YHVH." Isaiah 66:23



This is a future fulfillment and will take place on the new earth!

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First, we need to talk about the timing of the yearly feast days of Yahuah, because there is much confusion in this respect. As an example, Judaism is looking for the sunset to usher in the weekly Sabbath, They are looking to the moon (whether conjunction or crescent) to calculate when the month begins, so they can calculate the appointed worship statutes. This is paganism and comes from Babylon while Israel was in captivity for 70 years.

The pre-Islamic moon deity called Allah is symbolized by a crescent moon and star. The origin comes from the Hindu culture and the worship on Shiva. The crescent moon was also venerated in the Egyptian culture with the moon below a solar disc. **Because Christianity sprang from Alexandria** Egypt, these objects in the sky were also adopted for veneration. (Emphasis supplied.)

Islam's most prominent symbol is the crescent moon, Shiva's symbol.

**The pre-Islamic Arabs** worshipped 360 sky-deities, one of which was the "greatest" called "Allah." Allah is represented by the crescent moon and was the most favored of all deities by Muhammad's clan. The 360 deities means the Kaaba was originally a Hindu shrine dedicated to the worship of the host of heaven.



Yahweh is <u>not</u> represented by any kind of symbol. AND ... certainly He is not using the objects seen in the sky to determine His appointed times!

## We have 'Zero' Scriptural Permission

- Consider this website quote:, which we copied in the year of 2016, two years later this was removed from the website; I wonder who was behind the removal? https://en.wikibooks.org/wiki/Hebrew\_Roots/New\_Moon
- "There is <u>zero scriptural evidence</u> for sighting new moons to determine the beginning of new months. It is based 100% on teachings within the Talmud."
- The ancient [pagan] Greeks recognized the visible new moon as the beginning of the month when they celebrated the "sickle of the new moon" with offerings and meals. This was also the case with the ancient Babylonians who worshipped the new moon as the goddess Isis, and had her wearing horns, which resembled the new moon." (Theological Dictionary of the New Testament, vol. 4, p. 639.)

- Yahuah's 1<sup>st</sup> day of the new year is the day after the springequinox, because it is the equinox that ends the old year. Logically the next day begins the new year.
- This happens to be the <u>First Day of Spring</u> and the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month Abib and the first day of the year. It is that simple.
- To find the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the 2<sup>nd</sup> month, just count to 30. The 30<sup>th</sup> day ends the old month; the next day begins the new month.





**Passover** (Death of Messiah) **Unleavened Bread** (His Burial) Wave Sheaf – First fruits (His Resurrection) **Pentecost** (*His anointing as priest, king and prophet*)

**The Spring Feasts inaugurate Messiah's** redemptive ministry with Passover, which is the Feast of our Redemption. The sacrifice of Yahusha at the Torture Stake as our Paschal Lamb (1 Cor 5:7) at Passover is the foundation and beginning of Messiah's redemptive ministry.








# **The Passover!**

The Passover, (the time of the **barley harvest**) the first festival of the year, was <u>a</u> memorial of their deliverance from Egyptian bondage!

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## The Passover is to be kept on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the first month (Nisan) of YHVH's calendar. (Leviticus 23:5; Exodus 12:26-27)



The Passover was also typical <u>looking forward to</u> the death of Messiah, the delivery from the slavery of sin (*justification*). That is <u>the first</u> fulfillment!

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Here are Paul's words confirming that: **"For indeed Messiah, our Passover was sacrificed for us."** 1Corinthians 5:7 KJV

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#### THEN PASSOVER POINTS TO THE FINAL DELIVERY OF HIS PEOPLE AT THE 2<sup>ND</sup> COMING, WHEN HE WILL EAT THE PASSOVER MEAL WITH THEM IN HEAVEN!

"And He said unto them, with desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer: For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of Elohim." Luke 22:15-16 KJV

# The next Feast is the Feast of Unleavened Bread!



"And ye shall observe <u>the feast of unleavened</u> <u>bread</u>; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generation by an ordinance (#2708 statute) forever." Exodus 12:17 The Feast of Unleavened Bread is also a Memorial of their leaving Egypt!

Memorial of their leaving Egypt! Leaven represents sin which must be removed from our homes and hearts, that is called sanctification.

Leaven also represents false teachings!

The 1st fulfillment represents Yahusha, who was born in Bethlehem (the house of bread) without sin and lived without sin.





The second fulfillment is when the saints will be raised incorruptible without sin at the 2nd **Coming of the** Messiah!

# THE THIRD FEAST HE IS THE OWNER!

The Feast of First fruits was an acknowledgment that everything belongs to YHVH and comes from HIM?





# Proverbs 3:10 states:

Honor YHVH with thy substance, and with the first fruits of all thine increase!



The first fruits were always dedicated to HIM, the giver of all gifts and they should always be dedicated to HIM!

#### This is being verified by Paul in 1Corinthians 15:20


The 1st fulfillment was the resurrection of Yahusha, who is the real first fruit.


1 Corinthians 15:20 **"But now** is Messiah risen from the dead, [and] become the first fruits of them that slept."

The second fulfillment points to His 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming, when the 144,000 are chosen, the first fruits of all the living!

#### This must be talking About The 144,000!

Revelation 14:4 KJV "These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, [being] <u>the first fruits</u> unto Elohim and to the Lamb."






The crowning of Messiah's Paschal sacrifice occurred at Pentecost, when He was officially enthroned at the right hand of YAH (Elohim) (Acts 2:32; Rev 5:9-12) and began His intercessory ministry in the heavenly sanctuary on behalf of believers on earth: "YAH (Elohim) exalted him at his right hand as Leader and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins" (Acts 5:31 - KJV).



Pentecost, also called the **feast** of weeks during the time of wheat harvest, is the **memorial** of the giving of the Torah on Mt. Sinai!



The first advent fulfillment took place when Yahusha was anointed as prophet, priest and king and when the early rain was falling on His first disciples at Pentecost.

This outpouring of the Spirit is likened to the falling of the latter rain; and it is for this added power that believers are to send their petitions to the master of the harvest "in the time of the latter rain."

The final fulfillment will be near the close of earth's harvest!




"YHVH shall make bright clouds and give them showers of rain." "He will cause to come down . . . the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain," Zechariah 10:1; Joel 2:23. (KJV)



We are told in Joel 2:28 (KJV) : "And it shall come to pass afterward, [that] I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions."

Last Message

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The three Fall Feasts of Trumpets, Atonement, and Tabernacles typify the three steps leading to the consummation of Messiah's redemptive ministry: repentance, cleansing, and rejoicing for the final restoration.









The feast of trumpets was a warning that announced the Day of Atonement or the Day of **Judgment and to** remind the people to search their hearts and to afflict their souls during the next 10 days.

### The first fulfillment was the announcement of the birth of the Messiah by angels to the shepherds!

It states in Matthew 12:10 (KJV) of the wise men coming from the east: **"And when they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy."** 

See also Mark 1:3; Luke 1:42; Luke 2:13, 14, 20 and John 1:15 and 23

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• Jupiter

John 1:29 (KJV) pointed out the Messiah: "The next day John seeth Yahusha coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of Elohim, which taketh away the sin of the world."

# The Feast of Trumpets, represents YHVH's last call to repentance!

There were only 10 days until the Day of Atonement, the day of judgment called the days of awe to prepare for that day.



The days between the Feast of Trumpets and the Day of Atonement are called <u>"the</u> <u>Days of Awe"</u>. The Days of Awe are devoted to self <u>examination and</u> <u>repentance</u> from one's sin and preparation for judgment on the Day of Atonement.



In Jewish eschatology, "the Days of Awe" are representative of a <u>"day of trouble" (Jer. 30:6)</u> <u>that is to</u> <u>come upon the earth before the Second Coming of the</u> <u>Messiah.</u>

## This "day of trouble" is also referred to as the "birth pangs of the Messiah".

That time of trouble is commonly called "the tribulation." During that time of trouble on earth, Yahuah will protect His bride:

"For in the day of trouble He will conceal me in His tabernacle; In the secret place of His tent He will hide me; He will lift me up on a rock" — Psalm 27:5

#### THE DAY OF ATONEMENT!

This day is known as Yom Kippur, it is the holiest day of the year. It was a day of cleansing and purification. On this day the accumulated sins of YAH's people were cleansed from the earthly sanctuary.

Atonement involves individual as well as collective purification. It is a day of cleansing from sin, the climax of ten days of repentance, and returning to YHVH and it culminated in the dispatch into the desert of the scape goat to which the collective sins of Israel had been previously transferred.

The scape goat symbolically bore the sins of the nation of Israel away from the people. It was led into the wilderness and was pushed from a cliff to ensure that it did not inadvertently carry the sins back into the city!







The Day of Atonement will find it's final fulfillment, when Yahusha physically returns to the earth to judge and cleanse His people.

Scripture clearly states Yahusha will return immediately <u>after</u> the great tribulation according to Mark 13:24-26!





"But in those days, <u>after</u> that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will be falling from heaven, and the powers that are in the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory." — Mark 13:24-26 (KJV)

#### **The Feast of Tabernacles!**



The Feast of **Tabernacles** (the time of the fruit harvest) reminds us of the wanderings through the wilderness and living in tabernacles.



This feast is celebrated by a full week of rejoicing, dancing, singing and feasting and is called "Season of our Joy"!

First fulfillment was at Messiah's first advent. He tabernacled among us, healing the sick, binding up the brokenhearted, preaching liberty to the captives, and opening of the prison to them that are bound. (Isaiah 62:1) KJV



This feast points to the 2nd Coming of Messiah, the last ingathering or harvest of His children and the destruction of the wicked as well as trip of the **Redeemed to** Heaven.

**The final Fulfillment** 



Shemini Atzeret, meaning "the eighth day of assembly," is a Biblical holiday that follows Yahuah's festival of Sukkot on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month. It is written: "On the eighth day you should hold a solemn gathering; you shall not work at your occupation" (Numbers 29:35 - KJV).

Shemini Atzeret falls immediately after the holiday of Sukkot. Although its name implies that it is part of Sukkot ("Shemini" means eighth, hence implying that the holiday is the eighth day of Sukkot), Shemini Atzeret is actually considered a separate holiday.

#### Yahushas 1<sup>st</sup> fulfillment1

In the last day, that great day of the feast, Yahusha stood and cried, saying: "If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the Scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water." John 7:37-38 (KJV) The 2<sup>nd</sup> fulfillment is when we enter Heaven. YHVH <u>will also begin this</u> <u>earth anew</u> by recreating it at the beginning of the 8th Millennium after the earth has been purified from all sin and impurity!

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There are 70 appointed times, that the Creator himself has established to meet with His people! 52 weekly Sabbaths
7 Days of Unleavened Bread
1 Day at Pentecost
1 Day of Trumpets
1 Day of Atonement
7 Days of Tabernacles
1 Day for the 8th Day

### These are 70 times To assemble

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Considering YHVH's many commandments to keep HIS Feasts, as well as patriarchs doing just that, what hinders us to fulfill righteousness as well? Clearly the only holidays in the Bible are those kept by Israel and by the Apostles and our Savior as well.

#### All else is man-made!

#### And an abomination

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Still Christianity insists that the Feasts of Yahuah are not relevant for our day, and that Yahushas death and resurrection was the beginning of a new era: a new "Christianity" embracing new festivals and celebrations – such as Christmas, to celebrate His birth, and Easter, to commemorate His death. Nowhere in the Scriptures does it speak of any pagan feast being instituted by Yahusha (nor by His Apostles, for that matter). Some go as far as to argue that Yahusha 'did away' with the law (Torah), claiming that He abolished the Old Covenant (Testament) Scriptures with its Torah (laws) and regulations, thus making the Feasts no longer relevant. There is not one Scripture to say that Yahuah's Feast days and laws were abolished (done away with). 103

Through the brutal force of Emperor Constantine and other Emperors, then Roman Catholic Church which persecuted and murdered the Gentile converts who kept Sabbath and Yahuah's Feast days, the sacred Feasts of the Most-High were replaced by Pagan holidays which were incorporated into Gentile worship and given Christian names: Sunday, Christmas, Easter, Ash Wednesday, the Feast of the Nativity of St John, Whitsun, Halloween, Lady Day, the Feast of the Assumption Etc. All These So-Called Christian Festivals Are Nothing more than Pagan festivals in disguise! Nowhere in Holy Scripture is their observance commanded.

They are heathen festivals through and through and the unholy spirit that motivates their celebration is still apparent in our time. Hundreds of years ago these festivals of paganism caused a mighty split within the early believers. That split continues to this day. Most believers have little idea of how grievous is their sin to Yahuah when they celebrate Sunday, Christmas and Easter etc. Woe to them if they continue to do this after learning the facts. But woe especially to those religious leaders who continue to keep their flocks in blissful and dangerous ignorance. I say - Woe to them! Yahuah will not pardon your sin of idolatry or understand. 105



What happens when we worship Yahuah on these counterfeit pagan holidays and ignore His wonderful Feast days?

Worship on counterfeit worship days dishonors the Creator. It is an abomination. Clinging to pagan holidays and refusing to observe Yahuah's feasts, breaks the divine Torah (law) and your disobedience will be your eternal damnation. Yahuah gave His law for the good of His people. All who break His Torah (law) today, merely follow in the footsteps of ancient Israel as they repeatedly apostatized. If you choose to disobey you will suffer eternal death. "I gave them My statutes and showed them My judgments, which, if a man does, he shall live by them. Moreover, I also gave them My Sabbaths, to be a SIGN between them and Me, that they might know that I am Yahuah who sanctifies them.

"Yet the house of Israel rebelled against Me . . . they did not walk in My statutes; they despised My judgments, which if a man does, he shall live by them; and they greatly defiled My Sabbaths. "But I said to their children, 'Do not walk in the statutes of your fathers, nor observe their judgments, nor defile yourselves with their idols. (Christmas, Easter, Valentines Day, Mothers Day etc). I am Yahuah your Elohim, Walk in My statutes, keep My judgments, and do them; hallow My Sabbaths, and they will be a sign between Me and you, that you may know that **I am [Yahuah your Elohim."** (Ezekiel 20:11-13, 18-20.) It is the worship of the Creator on ALL of His set-apart convocations that is the sign between HIM and His people.
