



The Sins of Jeroboam!

Just for clarification: In my presentations I am using YHVH (Yahuah) instead of LORD, which is a title and not a name and I am using Yahusha instead of Jesus, which is not a translation but a transliteration and really has no meaning, either in Hebrew nor in English! YHVH (Yahuah) and Yahusha are the actual original names and the true nature and character of them.

Yahusha promised in John 8:32: “Ye shall know the truth and the truth shall make you FREE!”

Free from what?

Free from organized, man-made religion and the doctrines and commandments of man!



Yahusha did not come to this earth to start a new religion or another religion, another church, another denomination! He came to reveal the character of His Heavenly Father to us and to point us back to the Torah of Moses!
(SEE Matt 5:17-18)



The fact that we believe something to be true does not make it true. Truth is truth whether we believe it or not, truth stands on its own!

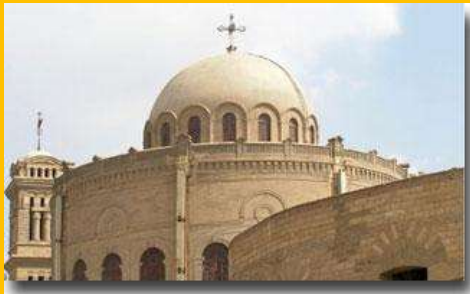




The Sins of Jeroboam!

Some things are hard to understand, because of the way one has been raised, because of what one has been taught and things one has been accustomed to. However, truth is truth and we must be willing to learn and always have an open mind.

What about King Jeroboam? At first glance, the story of Jeroboam seems to bear little, if any, significance to Christianity today:



King Jeroboam became an idolatrous king of ancient Israel, who developed a system of worship that involved two golden calves.

Because Christians today don't worship physical golden calves, it is easy to brush off Jeroboam's story while clucking our tongues and sanctimoniously shaking our heads at his "primitive" folly. We then relegate the story to our mental "back file," classifying it as nothing more than of biblical trivia.



Certainly, this kind of idolatrous foolishness doesn't go on among Christians today, or does it?


Quite to the contrary, a deeper look into the details of this Bible story will reveal that it is extremely relevant to the followers of Yahusha today.

Jeroboam's sin has become so widespread among Christianity that it has now become standard practice in nearly every church around the world.

It is important then, that we take a moment to search out the deeper insights of this biblical story, lest our worship be abominable in YHWH's eyes, as was Jeroboam's.

Many nice people think that they worship the Creator and do His will, when in reality they follow pagan practices and by doing so they honor the arch enemy, Satan!





So let's ask the question: “Does
CHRISTIANITY AS A WHOLE
Repeat JEROBOAM'S SINS?”

Jeroboam's idolatry actually began hundreds of years before, with the construction of the golden calf at the base of Mount Sinai. Here we find its precedent.

As the picture shows, the Egyptian calf "Elohim" was usually made of gold and was not a depiction of a single "Elohim."

The solar disk, representing the serpent/sun "Elohim," as the "father" of the calf "Elohim," is shown on the head of the golden calf.

Most Bible historians believe that the golden calf constructed by Aaron was like the one shown in this picture.



... Thus, in the idolatrous golden image, two “Elohim” were represented (*father = sun disk, son = calf*).



**But there weren't only
two false Elohim
represented before Israel
that day as we can see in
the next slide.**



There was a pagan trinity represented in that altar. The third “deity” Aaron helped the Israelites to represent was female.

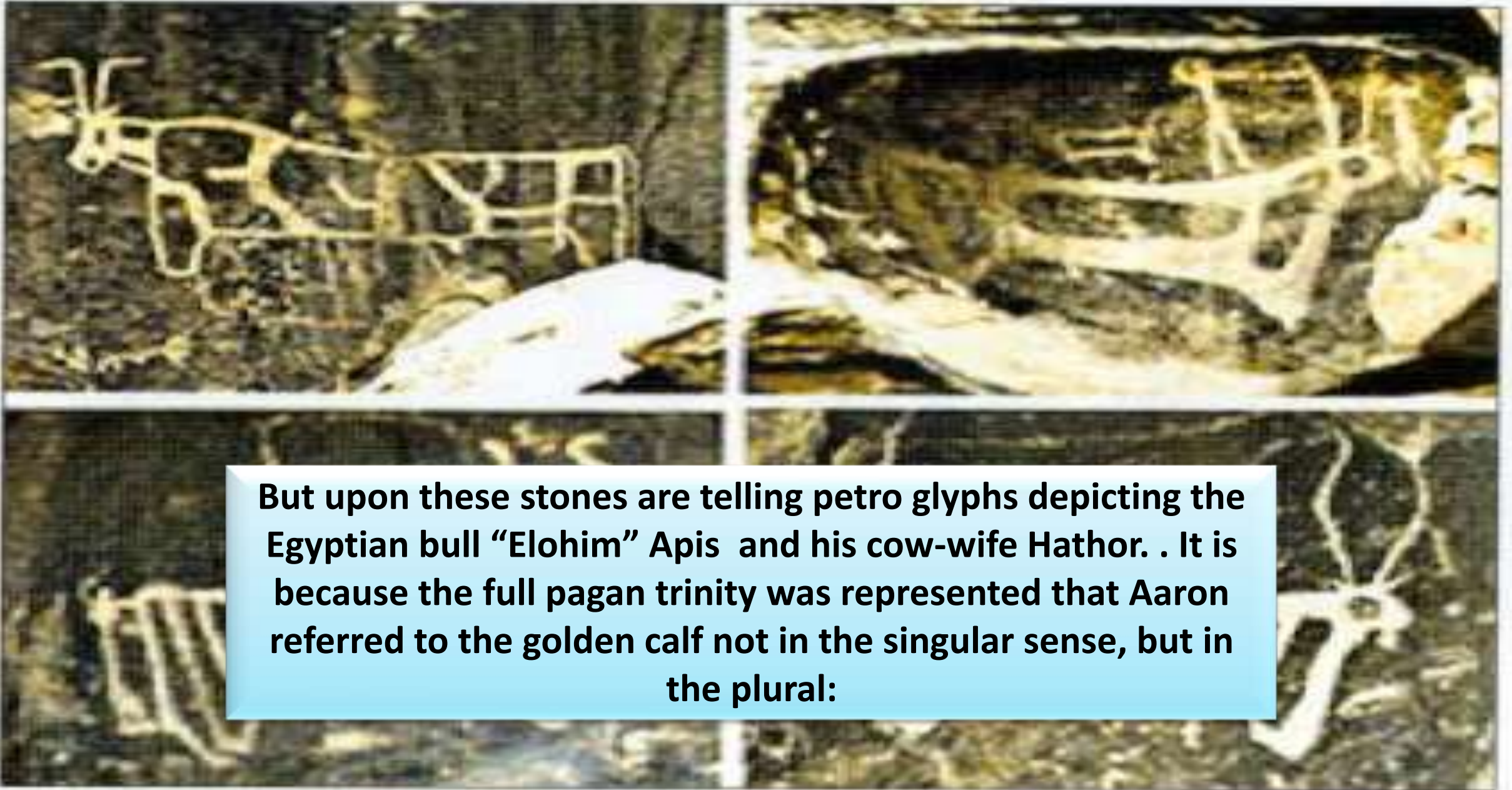


It was not part of the golden calf itself, but rather was part of the altar base.

While Moses rightly destroyed the golden calf (*he ground it up and gave it to the people to drink as a punishment for their idolatry*), its large stone altar base is still standing at the base of Mount Sinai, allowing us to verify the presence of **this third “Elohim.”**



As the picture shows, a fence is now constructed removing access to the stone altar site which once held the golden calf.



But upon these stones are telling petro glyphs depicting the Egyptian bull “Elohim” Apis and his cow-wife Hathor. . It is because the full pagan trinity was represented that Aaron referred to the golden calf not in the singular sense, but in the plural:



How can I say that?

We need to read Exodus 32:4 for that:

“And he (*Aaron*) received them (*the jewelry*) at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These be thy Elohims, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt,” Ex. 32:4 KJV

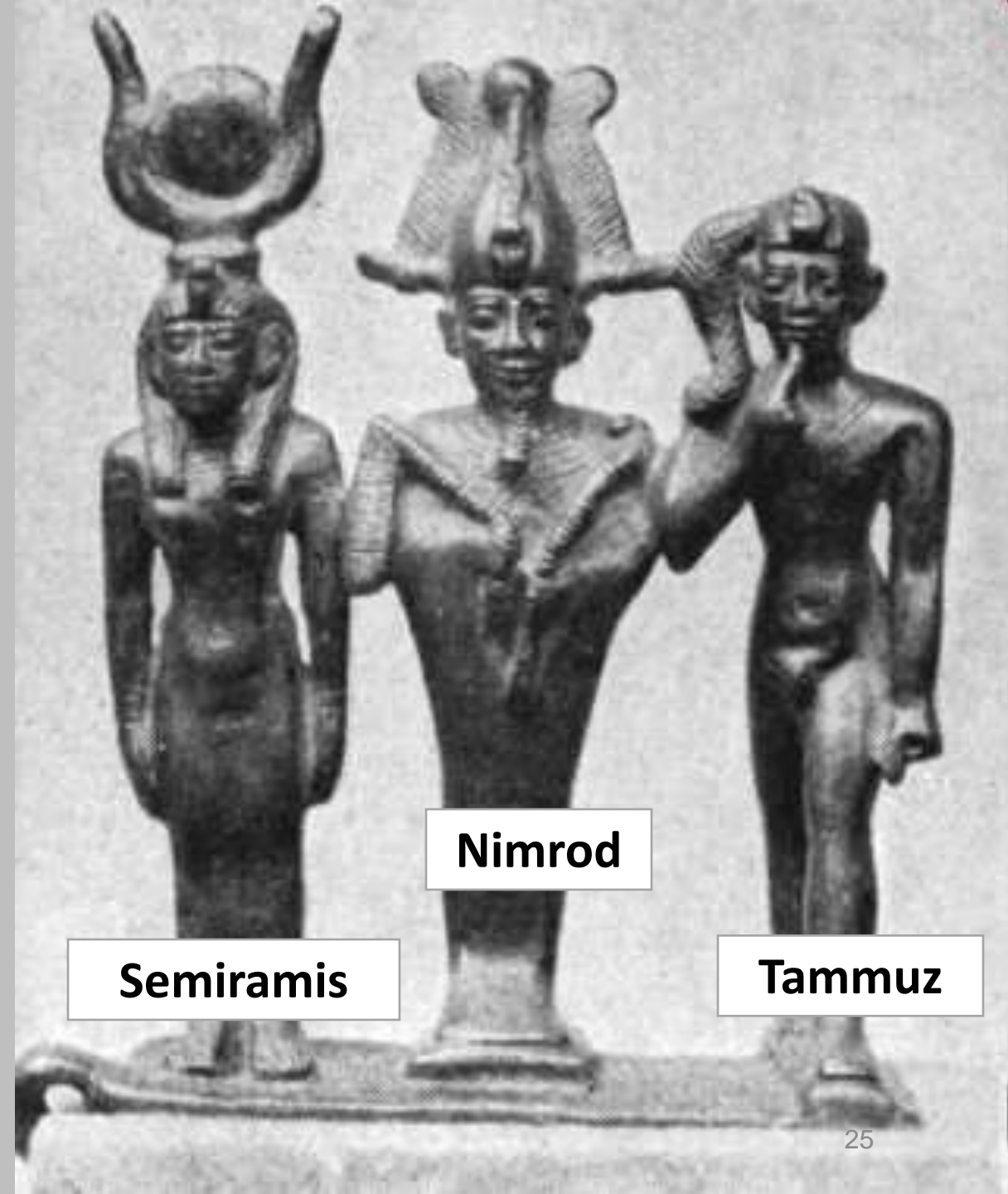
It does not say „This be your Elohim!“ (singular), but it states: „These by thy Elohims!“ (plural). He is talking about more than just one Elohim.

In the Egyptian false religion, this “bovine” family represented the unholy Trinity. They did not always appear in four-legged form. This was merely believed to be the form they took when they walked the Earth.

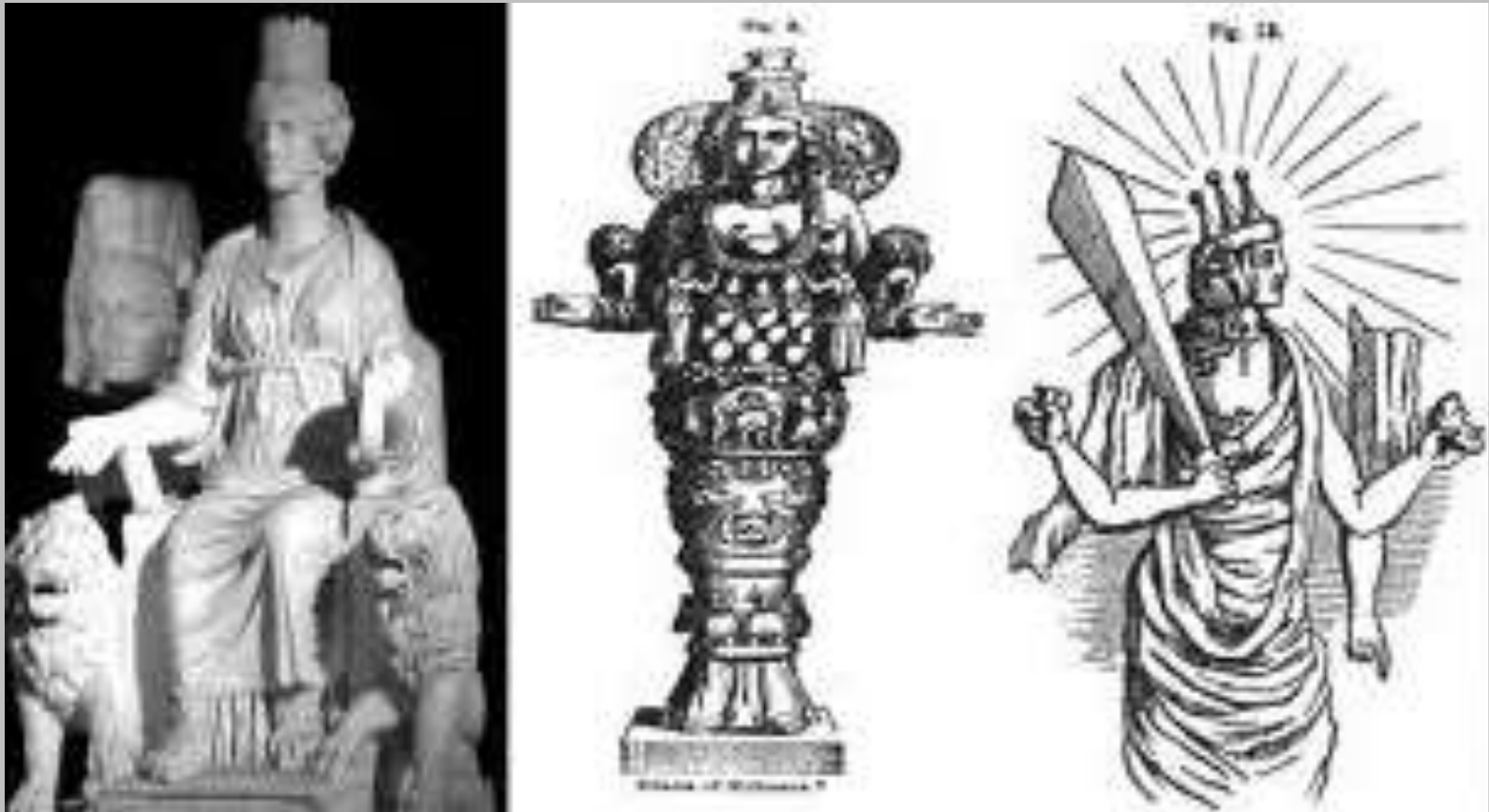


These “deities” were also known as the sun “Elohim” (*Nimrod*), with the moon “godliness” (*Semiramis*) being his wife. Their son was the false “savior” or anti-Christ (*Tammuz*).

In more modern times, the “sun Elohim” has supposedly manifested as a bull in his earthly travels. This teaching is the basis for the myth of Europa and the Bull.



Europa, another name for Semiramis (now called Mary) was a virgin. The sun “Elohim” noted her “purity” and beauty from above.



The story says that he changed into a white bull, came to Earth, enchanted Europa, carried her away, and raped her. He then returned to the sky.

calf*).**

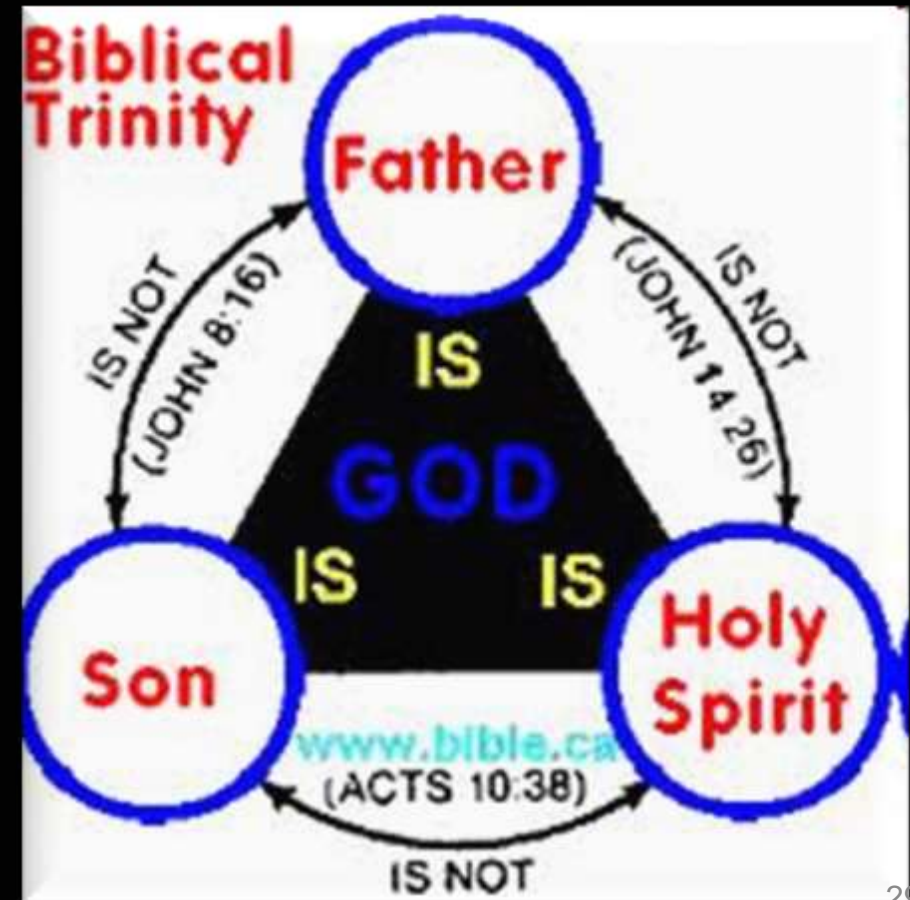


**Horrifying and depraved
as is this story, it is the

It is also the pagan basis for the current “Christian” teachings on the “trinity.”

Totally steeped in pure paganism, this ancient teaching wasn’t just isolated to places like Egypt and Europe.



Throughout the false religions and pagan mythology of the world, this same trinity can be found. They have different names, but the way they are worshipped and the “holy days” which honor them are always the same.



These days include Christmas (December 25, the birthday of Tammuz), Easter (his resurrection), Lent, and the rest of the “Christian” calendar.

Not only was Israel honoring the pagan trinity in their festival to the golden calf, they believed they were worshipping YHVH in so doing!



The Bible states in Exodus 32:4-5: “And he (Aaron) received them (the golden jewelry) at their hand, and fashioned it (the golden calf) with a graving tool,



after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These be thy Elohims, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt. And when Aaron saw it, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made proclamation, and said, Tomorrow is a feast to YHVH.

They got the idea to make a golden calf from Egypt and the surrounding Nations!

However, in Jeremiah 10:2-3 (KJV) they were warned not to do that:

“Thus saith YHVH, Learn not the way of the heathen ...for the custom of the people are vain..”

Even though they had detailed instructions from the Creator himself, not to do this, they still followed the custom of the pagans, serving the No-Elohims.

One must ask the question, why did they do it anyhow?

Why did they continue to follow the customs of the pagans, which are cursed?

*Ezekiel 33:11 YHVH asked the question: „... **why will ye die, O house of Israel?**“*

I can not bless you; I can not save you as long you disobey my voice! It was their choice to disobey, they were blinded by sin by the things of this life!



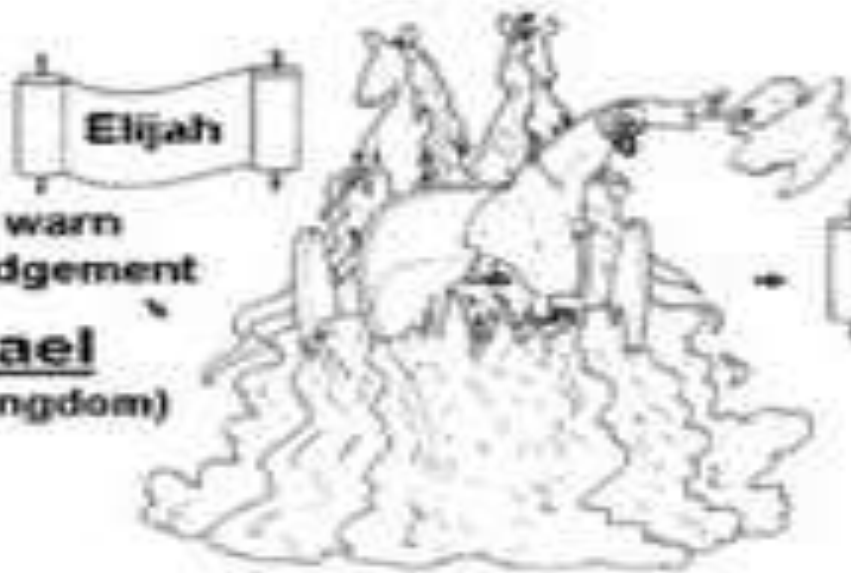
During the past 6,000 years the invitation is being given to His people to separate themselves from the world, the idols, the traditions of man and to follow His instructions, His laws, statutes and judgments.

Let us now examine the story of Jeroboam's idolatrous sin closer.

About 500 years after the Sinai golden calf festival, Israel was divided, and we have the divided kingdom!

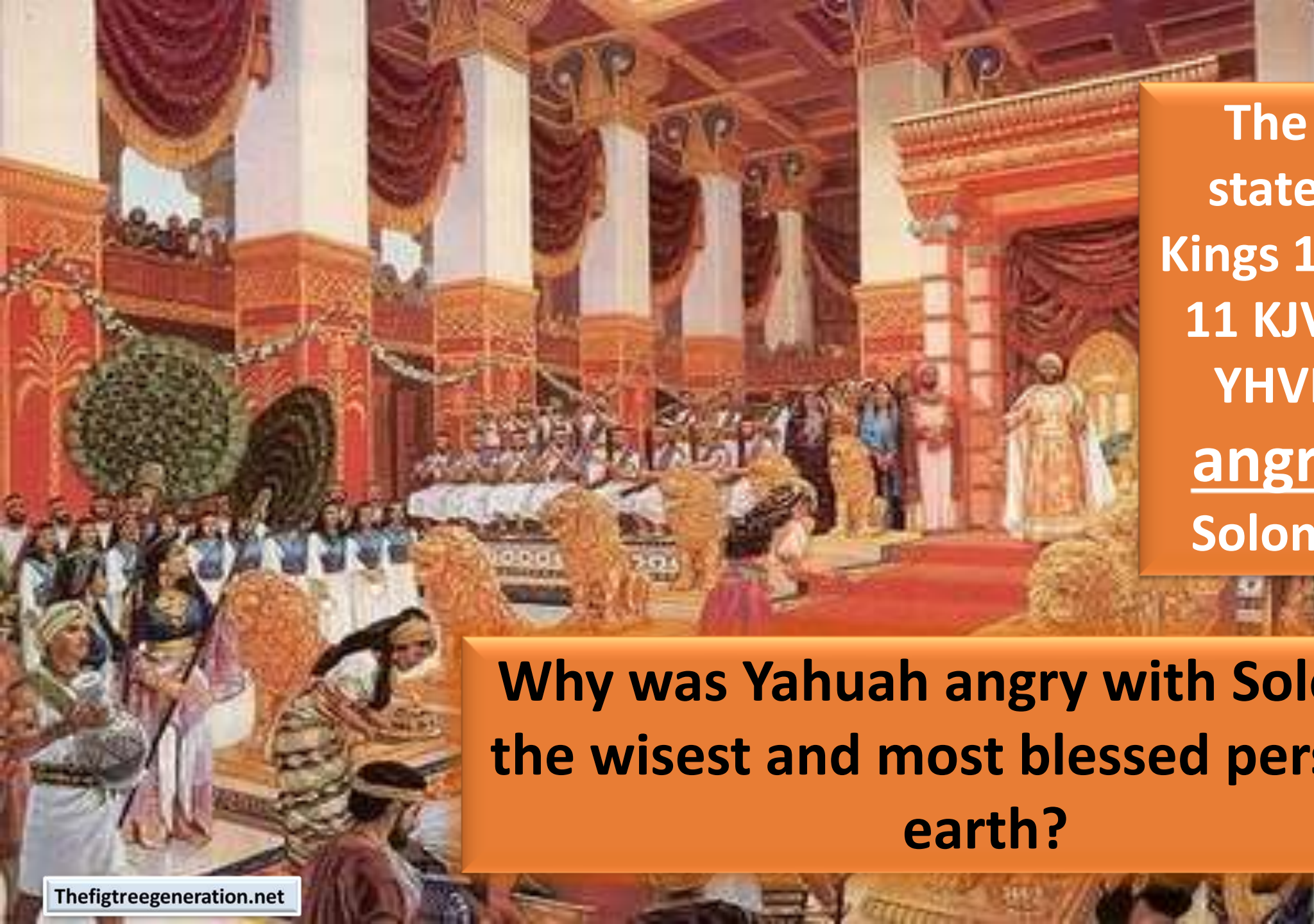

The Bible speaks in 1. Kings chapter 11 about Solomon's idolatry!

„But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, and Hittites; Of the nations concerning ... which YHVH said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall not go in to them, neither shall they come in unto you: for surely they will turn away your heart after their Elohims: Solomon clave unto these in love.“ 1Kings chapter 11 KJV



That was exactly what happened!

We can read that in 1. Kings 11, starting with verse 4



„For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned away his heart after other Elohim: and his heart was not perfect with YHVH his Elohim, as was the heart of David his father ...For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the Elohimdess of Zidonians, and after Milcom, the abomination of the Ammonites. And Solomon did evil in the sight of YHVH, and went not fully after YHVH, as did David his father. Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh ...

**...the abomination of Moab, in the Hill that is before Jerusalem,
and for Moloch, the abomination of the children of Ammon.**

**And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burn
incense and sacrificed unto their Elohims.” 1Kings 11:4-8 KJV**

**Then it states in 1Kings 11: 9-10 – KJV, „And YHVH was angry with
Solomon, because his heart was turned from YHVH the Elohim of Israel,
which had appeared unto him twice, And had commanded him
concerning this thing, that he should not go after other Elohims: but he
kept not that which YHVH commanded.”**

Then it continues in verse 11:

“Wherefore YHVH said unto Solomon, forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the kingdom from thee, and will give it to thy servant.” 1 Kings 11:9-10 KJV

Divided Kingdom

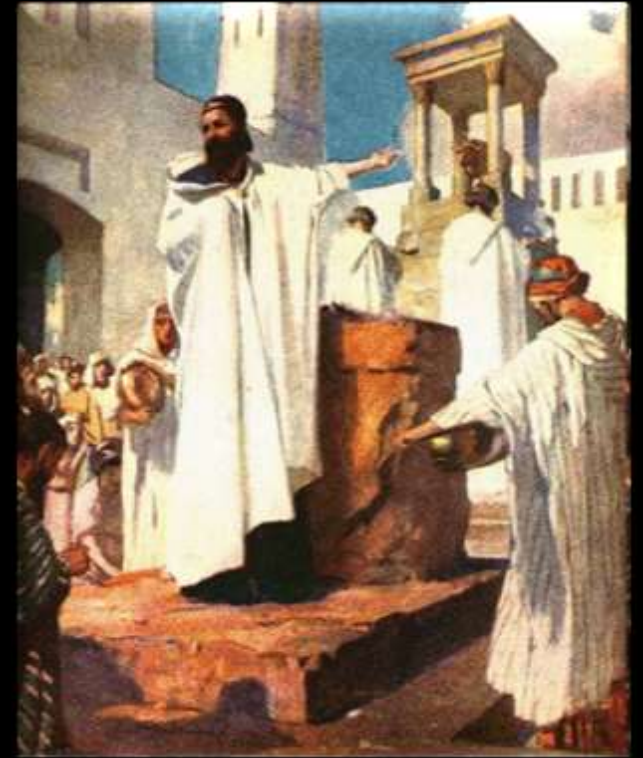
About 500 years after the making of the golden calf at Sinai, the kingdom was split. YHVH had promised Jeroboam 10 tribes (1Kings 11:31). So Jeroboam ascended to the Northern throne, reigning over ten tribes, while Rehoboam ruled the Southern tribes of Judah.

- *What was his decision to prevent that to take place? The Northern king (**Jeroboam**) was afraid he would lose his kingdom if the people visited Jerusalem (*in the south*) to worship and keep the Feast of Tabernacles, according to divine instructions (1 Kings 12:27).*



Jeroboam made **two** fateful decisions: 1. He created two golden calves, like the trinity calf Israel set up after leaving Egypt (*1 Kings 12:28*),

And secondly, he set up new feast days on the “fifteenth day of the eighth month, like the feast that was in Judah” (verse 32).



This festival was a counterfeit of the Feast of Tabernacles, which begins on the 15th day of the seventh month (Leviticus 23:34), exactly one month earlier than Jeroboam's man-made feast.

Jeroboam led the Northern tribes into a Torah Rebellion.

The Bible says, "So he made offerings on the altar which he had made at Bethel on the fifteenth day of the eighth month, in the month which he had devised in his own heart. And he ordained a feast for the children of Israel, and offered sacrifices on the altar and burned incense" (1Kings 12:33 - KJV)

Like Aaron of old, Jeroboam led the people into false trinity worship, and he substituted the pagan system and man-made times of worship in the house of El.

**(*Bethel* means house of *El* or “house of Elohim.”)
Archaeological evidence shows that Jeroboam’s calf was set up for *YHVH* worship, just like that of ancient Israel.**

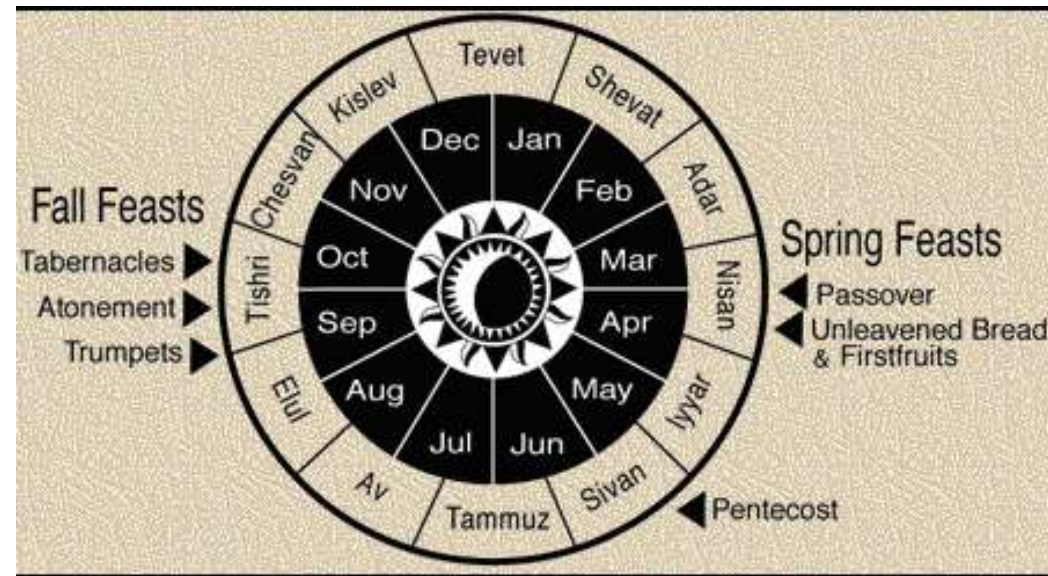
They actually thought they were worshiping YHVH!

The idols were even referred to as the bull-calves of *Yah*, as is explained in Abingdon's Bible Commentary:



"The name *Egeliah* ("bull-calf of Yah") on a potsherd from Samaria shows how far reaching was the sin of Jeroboam, the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin." (p. 119. F.C. Eiselen, Edwin Lewis, & D.G. Downey. *The Abingdon Bible Commentary*. Garden City, New York. Doubleday & Company. 1929, reprint, 1957)

These holy appointment times, had been set in place by *YHVH* Himself. Yet now the king dared to set aside *YHVH*'s appointed times, replacing them **with man-made days.**



This was nothing short of open rebellion against *YHVH*, carried out under the sanctimonious guise of righteous worship but for selfish reasons.

The king's bold defiance of Elohim in thus setting aside divinely appointed institutions was not allowed to pass unrebuked. Even while Jeroboam was officiating and burning incense during the dedication of the strange altar he had set up at Bethel, there appeared before him a man of Elohim from the kingdom of Judah, sent to denounce him for presuming to introduce new forms of worship.

New forms of worship!

**What were the “divinely
appointed “institutions”
Jeroboam had set aside**

**Specifically, the
Feast of
Tabernacles.**

**Has that happened in
Christianity today?**

**Have they removed the divinely appointed feasts
and substituted them with pagan ones? Absolutely!**



We need to remember that at the very seat of the controversy between our Elohim and Satan, who was once Lucifer, is the particular issue of worship! YHVH rightfully claims the worship of His created and redeemed beings!

Satan has made the blasphemous claim that he will be just like the most-High (Isaiah 14:13-14)! Satan, a created being, covets the worship which rightfully belongs solely to the Creator.



So how does he try to accomplish this? One way he did it is by replacing YHVH's feasts, festival-by-festival with His own or man-made "holy" days.



And the whole world follows
thinking they honor the Creator
by doing that. "Christmas" is a strictly Roman Catholic word. All of the customs of Xmas pre-date the birth of Yahusha and are a collection of traditions and practices taken from many cultures and nations.

Yahusha was not born on December 25. This date was celebrated because of the birth of Tammuz!

Think about it! Can we worship and honor the Creator by involving ourselves with customs and traditions, which He Himself forbade as idolatry?

Can we convince Him to somehow “Christianize” these customs so we can enjoy ourselves? Can we obey through disobediences?

**Yahusha does not belong into Christmas, it is
Baal worship!**

There is Easter!

Easter comes from a form of the name “Astarte”, a Chaldean (Babylonian) Elohimdess known as “the queen of heaven.” *(mentioned in Jeremiah 7:18, 44:17, 19, 25 and 1. Kings 11:5, 33 and 2. Kings 23:13)* **Many credible sources substantiate the fact that Easter became a substitute festival for the Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread.**

There is Halloween



As with Christmas and Easter, church leaders adopted this ancient celebration to serve their own purposes. The Christian festival, the Feast of All Saints, commemorates the known and unknown saints of the Christian religion just as Samhain had acknowledged and paid tribute to the Celtic deities.” *(The Encyclopedia of Religion page 177)*

There is Lent!

There are no instructions in the Bible to observe Lent. A forty-day abstinence period was anciently observed in honor of the pagan Elohims Osiris, Adonis and Tammuz

(John Landseer, Sabaen Researches pages 111, 112 – Alexander Hislops)





Centuries before Yahusha (Christ), the pagan Romans celebrated February 15 and the evening of February 14 as an idolatrous and sensuous festival in honor of Lupercus, the “hunter of wolves”! (*Encyclopedia Americana*).

There is more than the days of worship to be restored, if we would completely sever from modern “calf” worship. Like Jeroboam’s golden calf worship, our sin against *YHVH* is twofold.

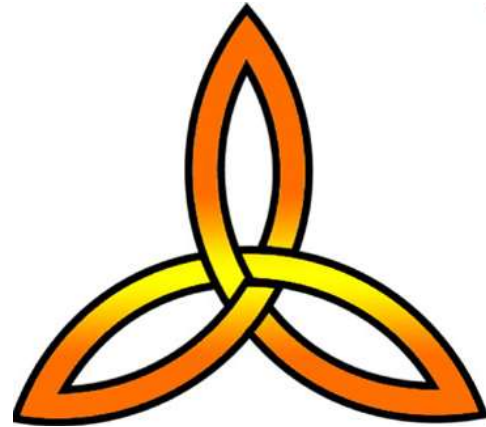


Not only had king Jeroboam dared to set aside YHVH’s days of worship, substituting in their place his own manmade days, he had also mixed pagan trinity worship into the service of YHVH. On the next slide we have a quote from a Peter Eckler in “The History of Christianity”:

“If Paganism was conquered by Christianity, it is equally true that Christianity was corrupted by Paganism. The pure Deism of the first Christians, *(who differed from their fellow Jews only in the belief that Yahusha was the promised Messiah)*, was changed, by the church of Rome, into the incomprehensible dogma of the Trinity. Many of the pagan tenets...were retained as being worthy of belief!

The **first** vital step
in paganizing
Christianity was the
induction into the
Trinity doctrine.

Most Christian denominations in the world today teach the Trinity Doctrine, which is the union of the three divine persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – into one godhead, even though Trinity is not mentioned in the Bible neither in the New Testament, nor in the Old Testament. The Trinity is not a Christian idea and does not reflect accurately the teaching of the first followers of the Messiah regarding the nature of Elohim. The formulation “one Elohim in three Persons” was not solidly established prior to the 4th century.


During the days of the apostles, the Gospel was taught with accuracy, but after their death, it did not take long for the truth to become eroded with falsehoods.

This erosion of Biblical truth grew like a cancer, slow, but sure. Little by little, falsehoods crept in as the Gospel message of Yahusha became more popular.

To increase the church membership, the church became more and more a business. Many Pagans were brought in and with the Pagans came Pagan ideas.

Rituals began to replace serious Bible study and differences in opinion soon became the basis for growth of various creeds and sects. Over the span of years, man-made rites became time honored tradition.





Christian leaders then became powerful forces in the church as well as in politics; religious beliefs, many times, were dictated by the state. All this had been prophesied that it would take place!

“But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them ...And many will follow their licentiousness,, and because of them the way of truth will be reviled. And in their greed, they will exploit you with false words...”

(2Peter 1:20-21; 2:1-3) KJV

In Egyptian religion there is the group of Kneph, Phthas and Osiris



In Phoenicia, the Trinity of Elohims were Ulomus, Ulosuros and Eliun.

In Greece they were Zeus, Poseidon, and Aidoneus.

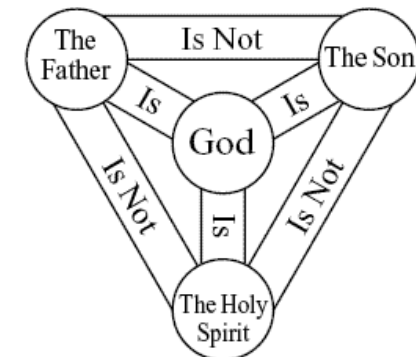
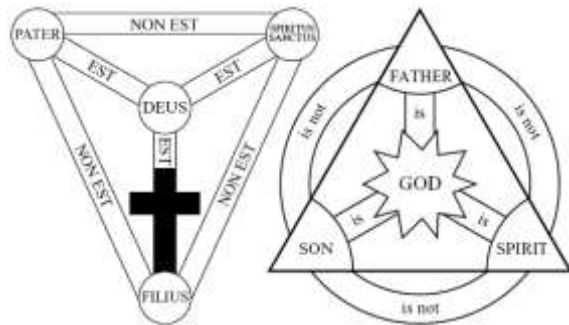
In Rome they were Jupiter, Neptune and Pluto.

As mentioned before, the doctrine of the Trinity does not appear in the Bible, “nor did Yahusha and his followers intend to contradict the Shema in the Old Testament: “Hear, O Israel: Yahuah our Elohim is one YHVH” (*Deut. 6:4 – KJV*) ... The doctrine developed gradually over several centuries and through many controversies ... By the end of the 4th century the doctrine of the Trinity took substantially the form it has maintained ever since.”

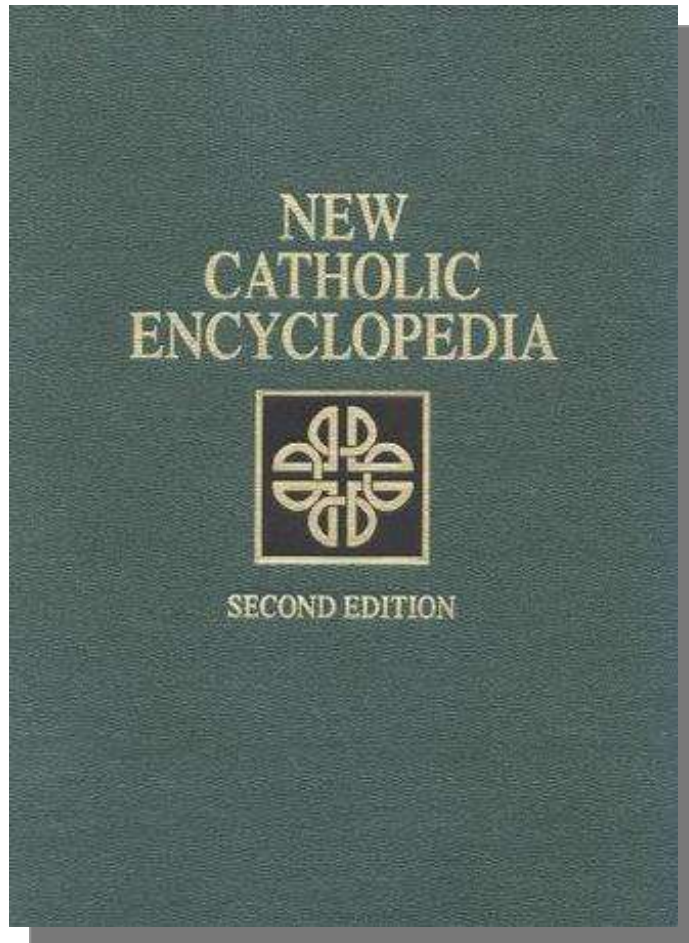

Matthew 28:19 was changed by the Catholic Church as recorded in the Catholic Encyclopedia, II, page 263



"The baptismal formula (in Matthew 28:19) was changed from the name of Jesus Christ to the words Father, Son, and Holy Spirit by the Catholic Church in the second century."

According to Eyewitness Eusebius,

who was the Church historian and Bishop of Caesarea (275-339 AD). He quoted (18x) the early book of Matthew that he had in his library in Caesarea. According to this eyewitness of an unaltered Book of Matthew that could have been the original book or the first copy of the original of Matthew, Eusebius informs us of Yahushas actual words to His disciples in the original text of Matthew 28:19.

Here is the original version according to the Demonstratio Evangelica by Eusebius page 152 **“With one word and voice He said to His disciples: Go and make disciples of all Nations, in My Name teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you.”**

That Name is Yahusha!

That agrees with Acts 2:38, “Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name ofYahusha Ha Mashiach for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.” KJV

That agrees with Acts 19:5, “When they heard [this], they were baptized in the name ofYahusha.” KJV

In the Words of the Pope Benedict

Catholic Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger made this confession about the origin of the chief Trinity text of Matthew 28:19: ...“The basic form of our (Matthew 28:19 Trinitarian) profession of faith took shape during the course of the second and third centuries in connection with the ceremony of baptism. So far as its place of origin is concern, the text (Matthew 28:19) came from the city of Rome.”



What about the verses in 1. John 5:7-8 in the next slide?

For the first 1,000 years these crossed out portions in the next slide didn't appear in the Greek Text. Then around 500 AD this portion appeared in the Latin version known as the Vulgate. Historically it is known and identified as the Johannine Comma.

History of changes to the Bible!

“For there are three that bear record in ~~heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost:~~ and these three are one.

8. And ~~there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.~~”

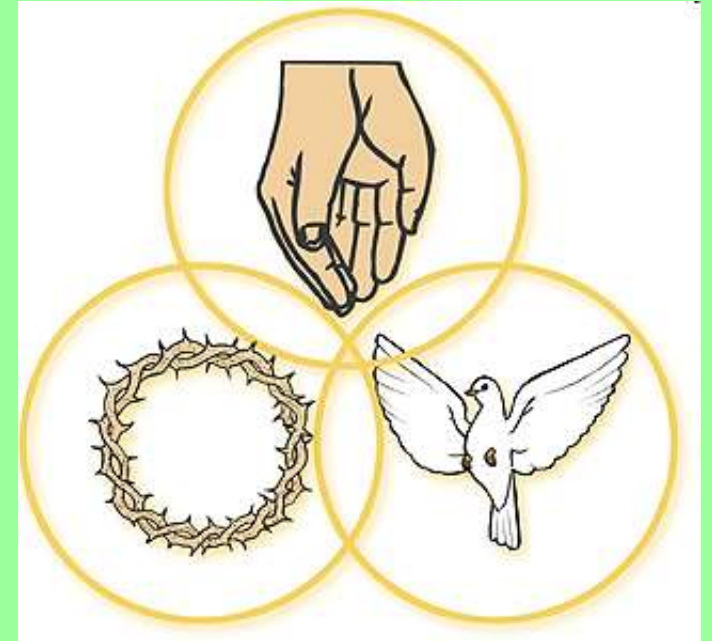
“When Erasmus published his version of the Greek New Testament, he left out the additions to 1 John 5:7 from his first two editions (1516, 1519), arguing that he could not find those words in any Greek manuscript. Pressure by some (Catholics) to include this addition to the Greek text, Erasmus proposed that if they could show him a single Greek manuscript in which the addition was found, he would include it in his next edition. Sure enough, they came up with a Greek manuscript in which the addition was found, one scholar believed it was dated from the sixteenth century AD, translated from Latin to the Greek and added to the Greek text. Erasmus subsequently included it in his 1522 edition of the Greek New Testament.” SDA Biblical Research Institute

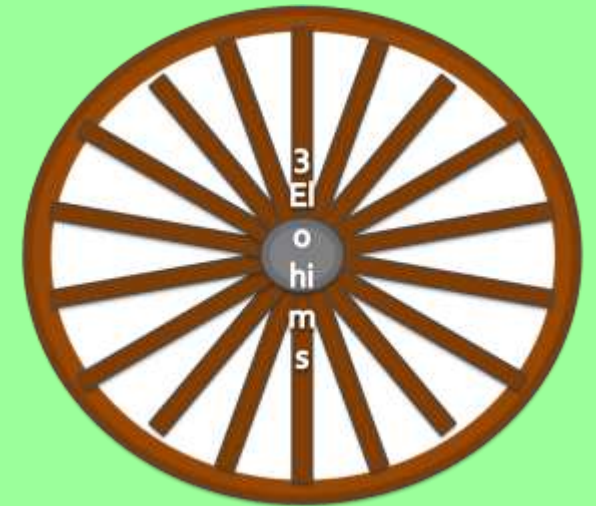
- “Out of one hundred and thirteen manuscripts, the text is wanting in one hundred and twelve. It occurs in no manuscript before the 10th century. And the first place the text occurs in Greek, is in the Greek translation of the acts of the Council of Lateran, held in AD 1215.” *Bible Commentary on 1 John 5.*

Here is what the Catholic Church states by Cardinal Hosius “We believe in the doctrine of the triune Elohim, because we have received it by tradition, though not mentioned at all in Scripture.”


**The Trinity Doctrine – is the
“Hub” of Pagan Doctrine**



The heart of paganism is the teaching that there is a Trinity. From this foundational center flow all other devilish doctrines (1 Tim. 4:1) like spokes radiating out from a wheel hub.

Today this teaching is readily accepted, believed and practiced and no one thinks that it could be false, or being pagan worship!





Having “Christianized” pagan principles, it isn’t surprising to find that the teaching of the Trinity is so pivotal to Catholicism, that it is the single most essential teaching of their faith. Upon it stand or fall, all other doctrines, including the substitution of Sabbath for Sunday.

“The mystery of the Trinity is the central doctrine of the Catholic Faith. Upon it are based all other teachings of the Church,”

Handbook for Today's Catholic, p 12 (March 1994).



In fact, according to Theodosius, in a Catholic edict given in 380 AD (under Constantine), so Catholic has the Paganized Trinity teaching become that **ANY Christian espousing this doctrinal belief is considered (by the papacy) to be a Catholic Christian.**

Whoever believes in the Trinity doctrine is considered a Catholic Christian by the papacy. What do you think about that?




A good concrete illustration of the Blessed Trinity is an equilateral triangle. Such a triangle has three sides equal in every way, and yet distinct from each other. There are three sides, but only one triangle. As we see in this illustration, each Divine

Person is different from the other two, but all three are God. Each one is God, distinct from the two others, and yet one with them. The three Persons are equal in every way, with one nature and one substance: three Divine Persons, but only one God.

Here is the quote: “Let us believe the sole deity of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, under an equal majesty, and a pious Trinity. We authorize the followers of this doctrine to assume the title of Catholic Christians; and as, we judge that all others are extravagant madmen, we brand them with the infamous name of heretics... they must expect to suffer the severe penalties, which our authority guided by heavenly wisdom, shall think proper to inflict upon them.”

According to Theodosius, in a Catholic edict given in 380 AD (under Constantine),

The church has a high ceiling with visible stone pillars and arches. The lighting is warm and indoor. The question is: “Why did they change?”


Because they wanted to be accepted and be part of the ecumenical movement!




2. Also the Yearly Sabbaths (the Feast days) – See Exodus 13:8-10) And
