Peter, writing as he was inspired by the Holy Spirit, described the way the message of Messiah's Second Coming would be received:



2Peter 3:3-6 "Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days <u>scoffers</u>, walking after their own lusts, 4. And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation...

5. For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of Elohim the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: 6. Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished." 2. Peter 3:3-6 KJV

### Pharaoh willingly remained ignorant and refused to be enlightened.





To be <u>willingly ignorant</u> is a very dangerous path, a very dangerous position and yet millions of people find themselves in the same situation as Pharaoh was.

1. Corinthians 10:11 states: "Now all these things happened unto them for examples; and they are written for our admonition...." That means today's generation needs to learn from the past and should not repeat the same mistakes and there is no excuse for it.



In other words, Elohim (Yahuah) has given us many examples in Hebrews Chapter 11, like Abel, Enoch, Abraham, Isaac, Joseph, Moses and many others. People that have gone through the same experiences as we have and they succeeded because they learned from the past and remained firm and faithful to YHVH.





Yahusha said in Luke 17:32

#### Why should we remember Lot's wife?

We are to remember what happened to her. Don't make the same mistake as she did. She disobeyed and as a result became a pillar of salt.



The history of David's fall should serve as a warning that even those whom He has greatly blessed and favored are not to feel secure and neglect watchfulness and prayer!



same blunder, don't commit the same sin as David did!

We should learn humility and obedience when we read the history of ancient Israel, who were His chosen and peculiar people, but who brought their own destruction by following their own ways.



By doing what?

By following their own ways!

Let's turn the page and go to another incident recorded in Scripture, which strikes closer to home and is more applicable to believers today, which we find recorded in Judges 2, 6-13 KJV:

Judges 2:6-13 "And when Joshua had let the people go, the children of Israel went every man unto his inheritance to possess the land. 7. And the people served YHVH all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders that outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of YHVH, that he did for Israel. 8. And Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of YHVH, died, being an hundred and ten years old. 9. And they buried him in the border of his inheritance in Tim-nath-heres, in the mount of Ephra-im, on the north side of the hill Ga-ash10. And also all that generation were gathered unto their fathers: and there arose another generation after them, which knew not YHVH, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel. 11. And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of YHVY and served Baalim;

12. And they forsook Yahuah Elohim of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other Elohims, of the Elohims of the people that were round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked YHVH to anger.

13. And they forsook YHVH and served Ba-al and Ash-ta-roth."

#### WHY? It doesn't make sense!

Why did they forsake the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and serve the no-Elohims? These were the descendants of Yahuah's chosen people. What has happened?

We read in judges 2:10 KJV "and there arose another generation after them, which knew not YHVH, nor yet the works which He had done for Israel." "After that generation died, another generation grew up who did not acknowledge YHVH or remember the mighty things he had done for Israel.." Judges 2:10 NLT "Also, all that generation were gathered to their fathers: and there arose another generation after them, who didn't know Yahuah, nor yet the work which he had worked for Israel." Judges 2:10 World English Bible

### With the following results:

"And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of YHVH and served Baalim; and they forsook YHVH Elohim of their fathers." Judges 2:11 KJV



The history of the children of Israel and the history of Yahuah's professed people is full of such statements!



Judges 3:7 "And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of Yahuah, and forgot Yahuah their Elohim, and served Baalim and the groves." RSB Judges 3:12 "And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of Yahuah; and Yahuah strengthened Eglon the King of Moab against Israel, because they had done evil in the sight of Yahuah." RSB Judges 4:1 "And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of Yahuah, when Ehud was dead." (Restoration Study Bible)

Judges 6:1 "And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of Yahuah: and Yahuah delivered them into the hand of Midian seven years." RSB




We need to ask ourselves the question: Doesn't anybody ever learn anything from history?

What was the problem with those people? What was the reason that a whole nation kept on doing evil against their Creator and to follow the no-Elohims!



#### Why did the new generation Not know the Elohim of Israel?

After all, these people called themselves still Israelites. They had the temple as a reminder. They had the temple services. They had recorded history!



#### WHAT HAD HAPPENED?

Could it be that the parents, the church leaders, the elders, the teachers failed to pass on all those important instructions regarding their sacred history? Could it be that the guardians failed to do their duty to pass on this information to the following generations? Didn't the adults care? Was this the fault of the children, the new generation only? Should the children alone be blamed for their ignorance and apostasy? They were either never told the story or the importance was never impressed on them. So they did not know the work YHVH had done for Israel. They were not there when it happened, or they were too young when it happened. So how could they have known? Only as their parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, neighbors told the story. But could it be that they didn't. As a result an entire generation did not know YHVH or the work he had done for Israel.

Let's read Deuteronomy 6:3 & 16:6-9 KJV.

Here we find YHVH's instructions to the parents and elders and leaders of the nation:

6. And these words, which I command thee




this day, shall be in thine heart; 7. And thou shalt <u>teach them</u> <u>diligently unto thy children</u>, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

They (the parents, the teachers, the leaders) were to do that constantly and be persistent in teaching them the history of their people and the way of YHVH!

- 8. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.
- 9. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates."

We have a good example in Abraham doing exactly that as recorded in Genesis 18:19: "For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of YHVH, to do justice and judgment ..." KJV





Psalm 127:3-5 states KJV: "Children are <u>a heritage of YHVH</u>: and the fruit of the womb is his reward..."
Children are His legacy and are <u>a gift from HIM</u>. Parents have been given the responsibility to mentor



Yahuah's heritage and it is a privilege for them to participate in nurturing the future generation. A mentor, is an adviser, a counselor, a guide, a tutor, a teacher, a shepherd and a leader, all combined. Abraham knew His responsibility and He was faithful in this respect according to Genesis 18:19.

Yahuah also gave Israel HIS weekly Sabbath and yearly feasts, the Sanctuary and other memorials not only to look forward to the Messiah as the ultimate sacrifice but also to remind them continuously of His leading in the past and who they are, who they represent and what their mission is and when their children would inquire what all these things mean they were to explain it to them. They were to pass on these instructions as we read in Ex 12:26-27

Exodus 12:26-27 "And it shall come to pass, when your children shall say unto you:



What mean ye by this service? 27. That ye shall say, It is the sacrifice of YHVH's Passover, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt, when he smote the Egyptians, and delivered our houses. ..."

Exodus 13:8 KJV: "And thou shalt shew thy son in that day, saying: This is done because of that which YHVH did unto me when I came forth out of Egypt."

Ex 13:14 KJV: "And it shall be when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What is this? That thou shalt say unto him, By strength of the hand YHVH brought us out from Egypt, from the house of bondage."



Joshua 4:6-7 KJV "That this may be a sign among you, that when your children ask their fathers in time to come, saying, What mean ye by these stones? 7. Then ye shall answer them, That the waters of Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of YHVH; when it passed over Jordan, the waters of Jordan were cut off: and these stones shall be for a memorial unto the children of Israel for ever."

#### Deuteronomy 6:20-25 KJV

"And when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What mean the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgments, which YHVH our Elohim hath commanded you? 21. Then thou shalt say unto thy son, We were Pharaoh's bondmen in Egypt; and YHVH brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand..."



If the parents, the guardians and the church had done their job passing their heritage and Elohim's instructions <u>faithfully</u> and <u>forcefully</u> on to their children then these words would <u>not have been needed</u> to be written down: "And there arose another generation after them, which knew not YHVH."

Since the next generation apparently wasn't taught properly, they did not know Yahuah, they did not follow Him and they did evil in His sight the Bible says. They followed the practices of the nations around them. By intermarriage and by close association they lost their identity of being a peculiar people. And sad to say this cycle repeated itself over and over again in history and it is repeating itself today.

#### We ask ourselves the question:


How is it possible for all Israel, including 450 proph

ets of Baal and 400 prophets of the groves to stand there listening to Elijah on Mt Carmel when he said in 1. Kings 18:21:



"How long halt ye between two opinions? If YHVH be Elohim (the LORD be Elohim), follow him: but if Baal, then follow him." And instead of giving Elijah an answer, the Bible says in the same verse "And the people answered him not a word." KJV

Israel was confused. They didn't know right from left, truth from error. They had gone so long in darkness that they couldn't tell the difference. Not one individual in that vast assembly dared utter one word for Elohim and show his loyalty to HIM. It was not the in-thing at that time. It was not popular to believe in Yahuah, it was not the new wave. It was considered old fashioned to still believe in Jehovah, to believe in creation. Baal was the in-thing and all the abominations that come with it.




The reason the Nation of Israel were in that kind of a predicament at that time, was partly since one of their leaders, like king Ahab, was foremost in promoting idolatry as we read in 1. Kings 16:30 and 33 where it says:

"And Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of Yahuah above all that were before him." ... "And Ahab made a grove; and Ahab did more to provoke Yahuah Elohim of Israel to anger than all the kings of Israel that were before him." Restoration Study Bible



#### Again we ask the question:

How is it possible to be an Israelite by birth, a leader, a king, knowing the history of this people and to fall so low and worship an idol of gold made by men? And of




course the majority followed their king in the worship of idols. People always seem to follow a leader, especially when he appeals to their carnal nature.

That's why YHVH tells us in Jeremiah 17:5 "... Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from YHVH ." KJV Or in Psalm 146:3 He says: "Put not your trust in princes, nor in the son of man, in whom there is no help." KJV

In Psalm 118:8-9 "It is better to trust in YHVH than to put confidence in man. 9. It is better to trust in YHVH than to put confidence in princes." KJV

Even though most of the Israelites followed Ahab and Jezebel. Even though a new generation arose that did not want to know YHVH, yet HE could say to Elijah in 1. Kings 19:18 KJV

"I have left me seven thousand in Israel, all the knees which have not bowed unto Baal, and every mouth which hath not kissed him." Even though the king worshipped idols, even though the State enforced a false religion upon the population, there remained 7,000 faithful people in



Israel that had **not followed** the example of Ahab or Jezebel. They did not cave in under pressure. **They remained true to Jehovah**; they refused to bow down to an idol and they kept up the true worship.




"..... There arose another generation that knew not Yahuah nor the works which He had done for Israel ."

It is easy to point our finger at the apostasy of the generation mentioned in Judges Chapter 2, verse 10!



When we read as an example the story of the fall of man recorded in Genesis 3:9-13 we noticed that Elohim first pointed the finger at Adam rightfully so, but then Adam instead of taking responsibility for eating of the fruit of the tree pointed the finger at Eve and Eve pointed her finger at the serpent. So we don't want to point the finger or look down on the other generations but learn from their failures, so we don't repeat them!





## So what about Today's **Generation? Does it** Look any better?

In today's generation everyone does what is right in their own eyes to their own destruction. This generation does not have absolutes, all seems to be relative!

Scripture says to confront, confess, and turn from our sins; this generation encourages people to ignore, overlook and to continue in sin!

While we should be concerned with terrorist attacks, yet the greatest threat is the corruption <u>from within</u>. We, like the Roman Empire that collapsed centuries ago, are crumbling from within. Instead of being one Nation "under" Elohim this generation attempts to be a Nation "above" Elohim. This is foolishness and leads to the downfall of any nation.

Here is an annual estimate of how the average U.S. kid spends their time: 1,500 hours in public school, 600 hours watching television, listening to music or playing video games and 35 hours spent in quality family time.

(The Waste Land by T.S. Eliot)




It should be obvious to any one that the world is being controlled by Satan in every area of life!


Our Savior and Redeemer Yahusha Ha Mashiach is the Living Torah who never, ever negated His Father's original teaching and instruction.
