Most Christianity is packaged with Hinduism, Egyptian and Babylonian abomination.


We are to be freed from sin, <u>not</u> from Torah. Forgiveness and mercy is given to them that repent of their sins AND OBEY TORAH!

To be born again by water and spirit means to be walking in Torah!






If you want to be successful follow Torah (see Joshua 1:6-8)

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 The function of the Torah was not to make you perfect, but to show you your sins.



All of man's teachings, be it Judaism or Christianity must be closely compared with the written Torah. Yahuah has not changed; man is continually changing the gospel, adding and subtracting.





He that turneth away his ear from hearing the Torah, even his prayer shall be an abomination. Proverbs 28:9

We must accept this simple principle: Yahuah rules. His Torah is supreme. And he always requires all men in all nations to obey His instructions (laws). And when His laws and man's laws conflict, His law is the unquestionable authority. Man's law at that point is unrighteous tyranny.

According to the Holy Scripture we are to meditate on Torah, look at Torah, speak Torah, listen to Torah, walk in Torah, seek Torah, delight in Torah, have the Torah in our heart, there is liberty in Torah, NOT bondage.

Torah is the way, the truth and the life.

Yahusha, the Hebrew Messiah, NOT the Christian Jesus, is the living Torah, and Yahusha is the same yesterday, today and forever.

A Religion without Torah leads to paganism and idolatry. This is how we Ended up with Christianity!

"Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and Your Torah is the Truth." Psalms 119:142 KJV




The Torah is the compass of life.

Is the Law of Moses a "Thus saith Moses" or a "thus saith YHVH?"


Therefore, to do away with the Law of Moses is an attempt to do away with the Torah of YHVH!

The Torah is the expression of Yahuah's will and it is through obedience to that that Yahuah accepts the children of men as his sons and daughters.


Here is the proof!

"Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth." 2Timothy 3:7


- Yahusha is the truth John 14:6

 For not the hearers of the Torah are righteous in the sight of Elohim, but the doers of the Torah shall be declared right. Romans 2:13 (TS2009)

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There has always been, and always will be ONE Torah for all, the Jews, and Non-Jews, because YHVH does not change according to Malachi 3:6!

Don't let anyone Tell you that the Torah is a burden!

Yahusha at no time "loosened" either Torah or the Prophets! The prophetic Word YHVH gave to His prophets cannot be loosed or annulled, and neither can the Torah of YHVH. These are two witnesses that stand as One. The Word of YHVH is both Torah (instruction in righteousness) and Prophecy declaring, foretelling and revealing the Will of YHVH to each generation. See Deuteronomy 4:2; 13:1.

"And because the transgression of the Torah shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold." Matthew 24:12 (Cepher translation)

Our Father did not do away with His Torah, the commandments, statutes and judgments when He gave us the New Covenant!

We cannot be lawless (being without the Torah) and expect to be redeemed!

TORAH IS THE LAW OF LIBERTY. DISOBEDIENCE TO TORAH IS LIVING IN BONDAGE TO SIN!

In Galatians 1:8 Paul says that there is only one gospel und those who teach a different one are under a curse. In 2Peter 3:14-17 Peter warns that many will misinterpret Paul's difficult to understand writings, resulting in lawlessness and destruction. Are you absolutely certain that you/re not misrepresenting Paul?

- 1. Paul always kept the Sabbath (Acts 17:2; 18:4)
- 2. Paul kept the feasts (Acts20:6 and 20:16)
- 3. Paul instructed us to keep the feasts (1 Co5 5:7-8)
- 4. Paul believed all of the Torah (Acts 24:14)
- 5. Paul stated that we establish the Torah (Romans 3:31)
- 6. Paul taught from the Torah (Acts 28:23)
- 7. Paul obeyed the Torah (Acts 21:24 and Romans 7:25)
- 8. Paul told us to imitate him (1 Cor 4:16 and 1 Cor 11:1)

The word of Yahuah is both the Torah (instructions in righteousness) and prophecy, declaring, foretelling and revealing the will of Yahuah to each generation.

It is insane, to what extend Christianity will go to twist the meaning of the word "fulfill" as an example in Matthew 5:17 to make it fit their theology of lawlessness (claiming that the Torah is no longer binding after the Cross.)

Fulfill means to carry out or to bring to realization, to perform or do, as in a person's duty, or follow the commandments, statutes and judgments by obeying them. (Isaiah 42:1 "Yahuah is well pleased for His righteousness sake, He will magnify Torah and make it honorable.)
