Just for clarification: In my studies I use the four Hebrew letters YHWH (and I pronounce it as Yahuah) instead of LORD, which is a title - not a name. I also use Yahusha instead of Jesus, which is not a translation but a transliteration from a Greek mistransliteration. The name Jesus has no meaning, in Hebrew nor in English! YHWH and Yahusha are the actual original Hebrew names that speak of our Savior's true nature and character.



Since the Scriptures have been modified, changed over the past centuries by the various translations, be it on purpose or an oversight, I am inserting the original Hebrew names in my presentations. Wherever the name „God“ appears, I inserted Elohim or YHVH, wherever „LORD“ is shown, I insert YHVH, wherever the word „Jesus“ is used, I use HIS proper Hebrew name „Yahusha“.

All biblical references are taken from the New King James Version, unless otherwise noted.



What you believe about death may cause you to lose your eternal life, so please study the Bible to find YHVH's truth. Yahusha said **“Take heed that no man deceive you.”** Do not trust your priest or pastor but check the Scriptures to find the truth.



When Adam & Eve chose to disobey YHVH, they sinned, and therefore they brought sin, suffering and death into all the generations of humankind. YHVH warned them that the soul that sins, it will die. Not only physical death but eternal death as well.



The same is true today. If you continue to sin, you will also die a physical and spiritual death, therefore, do not be deceived by false teachings. Satan is deceiving many people today to believe that when you die your soul lives forever as a “spirit.”

Nowhere in the Bible can you find this teaching.



The Doctrine of the Immortal Soul is a Roman Catholic Teaching rooted in paganism and has nothing to do with the truth of YHVH as it is written in the Bible.

First of all we need to find out what is the definition of a soul in the Bible?

A soul is not a “spirit being” without a body.



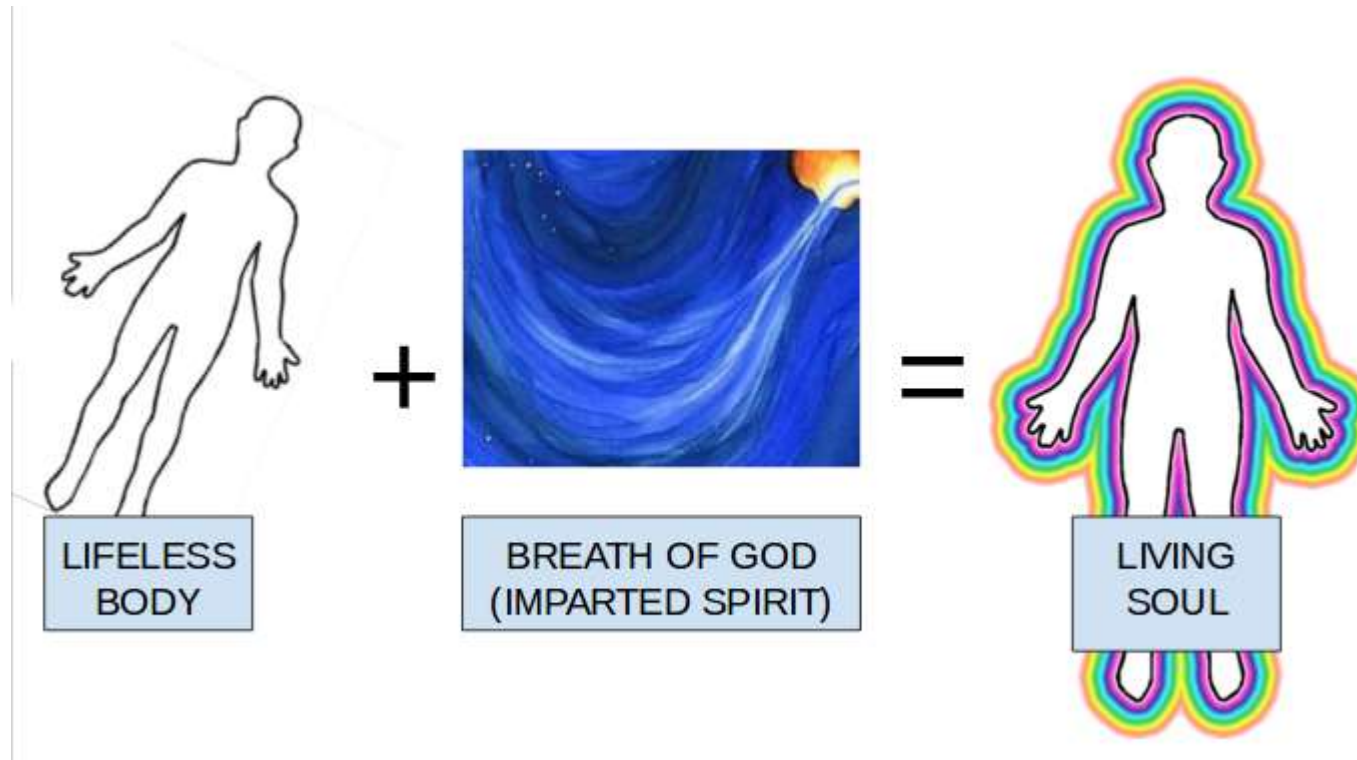
In Genesis 2: 7 we read "And YHVH Elohim formed man of the **DUST** of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the **BREATH** of life; and man became a **LIVING SOUL**."



Here we have two elements: **a clay body and YHVH's breath of life**. Through the union of these, man became a living soul. It's important to note that man was not given a "soul" **as something separate from the body, but became a soul** through the union of body and YHVH's breath. So here's a simple equation.



**Body + Breath = Soul.
Soul - Breath = Death.**



Psalms 104: 29,30 “You hide your face, they are troubled: you take away their breath, they die, and return to their dust. You send forth your spirit, they are created: and you renew the face of the earth.”

So it is very clear that body and breath makes up a living soul and body without breath equals a dead soul.

Do you know that there is no second chance to repent from your sins once you die? Many are wrongly teaching that when you die your relatives can pray and intercede for you and this will give you another chance to be right with YHVH.

This is a great deception



SOULS ARE NOT IMMORTAL!

Ezekiel 18: 4 “Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: **the soul that sins, it shall die.**”

Matthew 10: 28 “And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather **fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.**”

James 5: 20 “Let him know, that he which converts the sinner from the error of his way **shall save a soul from death**, and shall hide a multitude of sins.”



ONLY YHVH IS IMMORTAGL

1 Timothy 1: 17 “**Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible,** the only wise Elohim, be honors and glory for ever and ever. Amein.”

Ezekiel 18: 4 which states: "Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sins, it shall die."



WHEN WE DIE, WE NO LONGER EXIST!

Nowhere in the Bible can you find that we are immortal, in fact the Bible tells us when we die, we **perish**. (To be destroyed; to pass away; to waste away)

John 3: 16 “For YHVH so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

Most Believers can quote this Scripture by heart, but do they really understand what it says? **Again there are only two choices presented. Believers will receive eternal life, but the unbeliever will perish.**



**Job 1: 5 to 7 The wicked shall perish in
his own dung.**

**Job 34: 15 all flesh shall perish
together and turn into dust.**

**Psalms 37: 20 The wicked shall perish
and consume into smoke.**

**Luke 13: 3 Except you repent ye shall
perish.**

**John 10: 28 He gives eternal life and
we shall never perish.**



**Eternal life is given by YHVH by partaking
of the fruit of life in Heaven. Revelation 22:2**

Revelation 22: 2 “In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.”

1 Corinthians 1: 18 preaching of the crucifixion is foolishness to them that perish.

2 Thessalonians 2: 10 perish because they received not the love of the truth.

2 Peter 3: 9 YHVH is not willing that anyone should perish.



Isaiah 5: 22 to 24

22 “Woe unto them that are mighty to drink wine, and men of strength to mingle strong drink: Which justify the wicked for reward and take away the righteousness of the righteous from him! Therefore as the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, so their root shall be as rottenness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: **because they have cast away the law (the Torah) of Elohim of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.**”



There is a false teaching that when we die, we go straight to heaven or hell

There is not one Scripture in the Bible to substantiate this lie.

Ecclesiastes 12: 7 answers simply **"Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit (breath) shall return unto YHVH who gave it."**

Judgement has to take place first before we go to heaven or to hell. We rest in the grave till the Final coming of Yahusha who will wake us up when He comes. **"And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be."** Revelation 22: 12.

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Messiah, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil." 2 Corinthians 5: 10



Death in the Bible is described as a sleep!

Job 14: 12 “So man lies down, and rises not: till the heavens be no more, they shall not awake, **nor be raised out of their sleep.**”

Psalms 13: 3 **Sleep of death.**

Daniel 12: 2 **Sleep** in the dust of the earth shall awake.



**So it is clear from Scriptures
that when you die you sleep
in the grave and have no
conscious memory.**

1 Thessalonians 4: 13,14 “They
which are **asleep** in Yahusha
will rise again.”

John 11: 11 to 13 **Lazarus is
sleeping.** Yahusha said Lazarus
is dead.

1 Corinthians 15: 51 **We shall
not all sleep.**



You cannot move around or float around in a spirit form. The Bible is clear that the dead know not anything and they do not rise again until the final coming of Yahusha Messiah. The Bible says the dead have no memory, no reward, no love or hatred or envy, no praise, the dead know nothing.

Ecclesiastes 9: 5,6 “For the living know that they shall die: **but the dead know not anything**, neither have they any more a reward; for the memory of them is forgotten. Also their love, and their hatred, and their envy, is now perished; neither have they any more a portion forever in anything that is done under the sun.”

Psalms 146: 4 “His breath goes forth, he returns to his earth; **in that very day his thoughts perish.**”

Psalms 115: 17 “The dead praise not YHVH neither any that go down into silence.”



The Great Day of Judgment is coming! Are you ready?



Whether you believe it or not Yahusha said we must all appear before the judgment seat of Yahusha; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

2 Corinthians 5: 10 Yahusha spoke of the judgment day when he walked among men.

Matthew 12: 36 He said "**Every idle word** that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the Day of Judgement. For YHVH shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil. " See also Ecclesiastes 12: 14.



Fact No. 1: Man must give account of himself on the Day of Judgment. Matthew 12: 36, Romans 14: 10,12.

Fact No. 2: All of us shall appear at the Judgment. Acts 17: 31; 2 Corinthians 5: 10

Fact No. 3: We're to be judged by the perfect law of liberty, which is all of YHVH's commandments, statutes and judgements. John 12:48; Revelation 20: 11-13 Malachi 4: 4

Fact No. 4: We need to get ready for the Judgement Day. We must turn away from our sins, repent and change our life. 2 Corinthians 5: 10; Matthew 12: 36-41

Yahusha is going to be the judge and His commandments, statutes and judgements is going to be the standard or rule by which we are judged, therefore, it becomes very important that we understand the Bible and what YHVH requires of us.

Because we have faith, we love to keep His commandments, statutes and judgements. By His grace (power through His Spirit living in us) we are able to obey.

“For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off.”

Deuteronomy 30: 11.



What Are the Three Books In Heaven Which Bear Record Of Our Lives On Earth?

1 The Book of Life

Revelation 20: 12 “And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before YHVH; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.”



What Are the Three Books In Heaven Which Bear Record Of Our Lives On Earth?

2 The Book of Iniquity

Isaiah 65: 6-7 “Behold, it is written before me: I will not keep silence, but will recompense, even recompense into their bosom, your iniquities, and the iniquities of your fathers together, saith YHVH, which have burned incense upon the mountains, and blasphemed me upon the hills: therefore will I measure their former work into their bosom.”

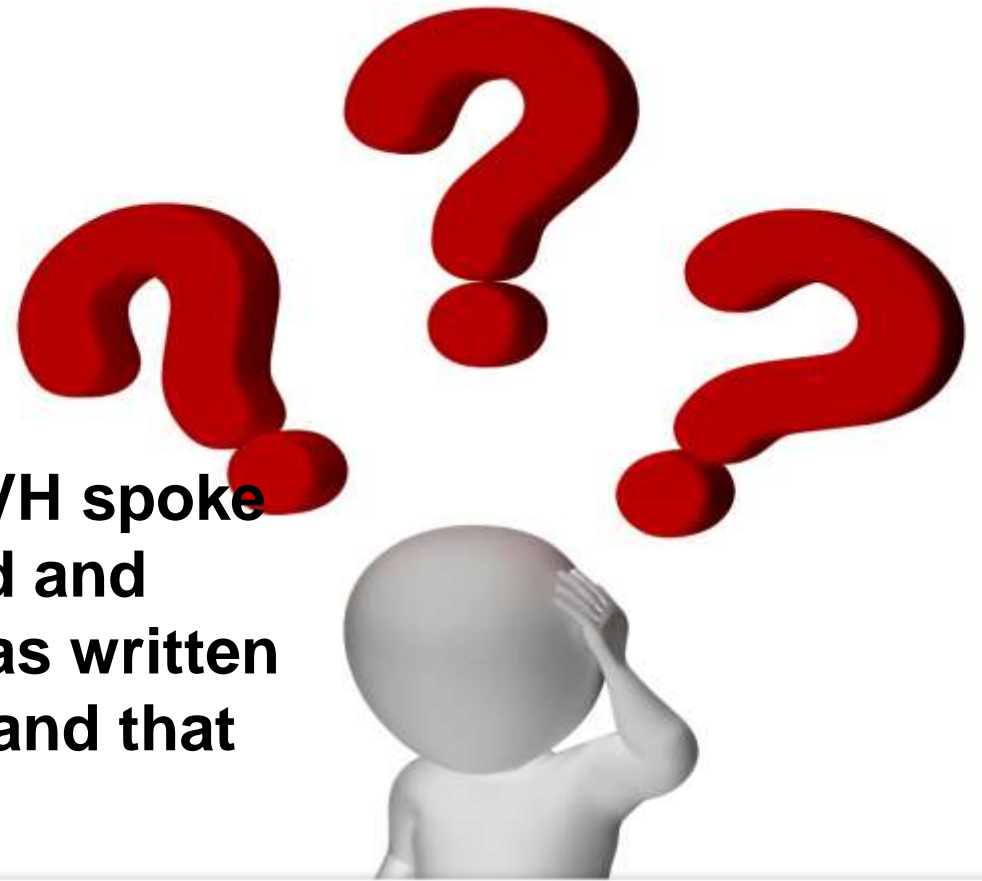


What Are the Three Books In Heaven Which Bear Record Of Our Lives On Earth?

3 The Book of Remembrance

Malachi 3: 16 “Then they that feared YHVH spoke often one to another: and YHVH listened and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared Elohim and that thought upon his Name.”

YHVH's desires that you spend eternity with Him. He gives you a free will to choose. Your actions and how you live your life will determine whether you have eternal life. Today is the day to repent and ask Yahusha into your life to give you a new heart and a new Spirit to accept Yahusha as your Messiah and Savior. The door of mercy is still open, do not wait until it is too late.



Saved by grace through faith produces good works

Once we have confessed our sins to Yahusha and turn away from our sins, we need to change our lifestyle. We no longer do the things we used to do or hang around with friends that will get us into trouble. Our mind and body becomes new when we are baptized into Yahusha and our character becomes changed day by day to be more like Yahusha. The same lie that Satan told Eve that if she disobeyed YHVH she would be “like YHVH” is still being taught today. We cannot continue to live in sin once we are saved.

Romans 6: 14,15 “For sin shall not have dominion over you: for you are not under the law, but under grace. What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? YHVH forbid.”



The Thief on the cross did not go to Paradise that day

Luke 23: 42,43 Be sure to place the comma where it's supposed to be, after the word 'today'. This simple change modifies the meaning totally. **"Then he said to Yahusha Messiah remember me when You come in Your kingdom. And He answered him, Truly, I tell you today, you shall be with Me in Paradise."**

**YAHUSHA DID NOT GO TO PARADISE THAT DAY, BUT
REMAINED IN THE GRAVE 3 DAYS AND 3 NIGHTS.**

Mark 8: 31 “And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and of the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again. So how could the thief possibly go to paradise on the same day, when Yahusha remained in the grave **for three days and three nights?**”



Absent from the body is present with YHVH?

2 Corinthians 5: 6,8

6 “Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from YHVH.

8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with YHVH.”

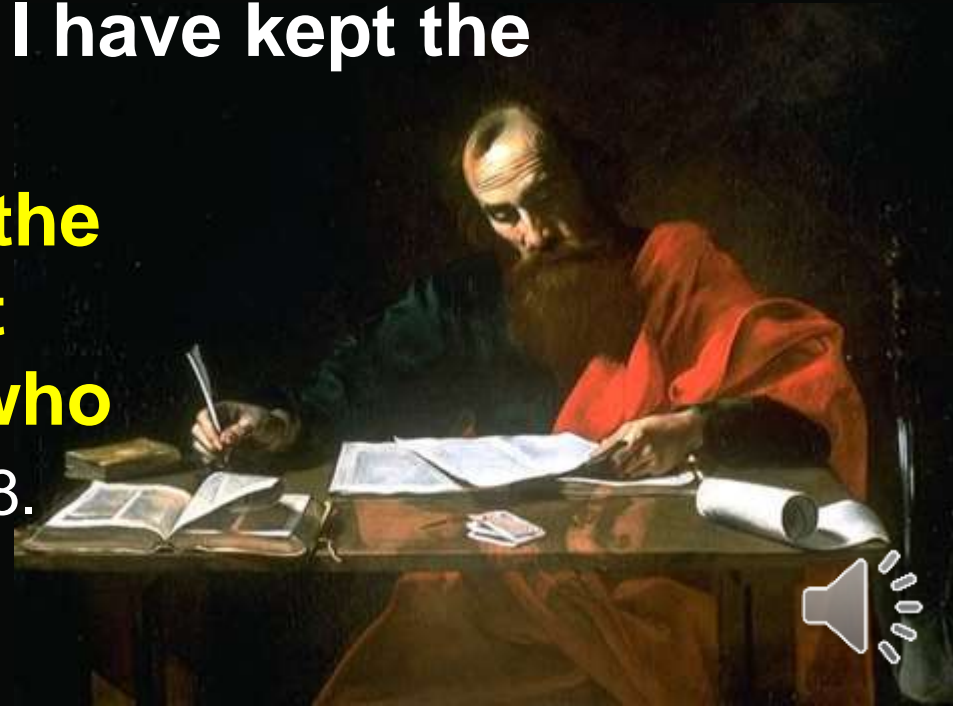
THIS TEXT DOES NOT SAY THAT WHEN YOU DIE YOU GO STRAIGHT TO HEAVEN. PAUL SAID HE WOULD RATHER BE.....

Philippians 1: 23 “For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Yahusha; which is far better.”



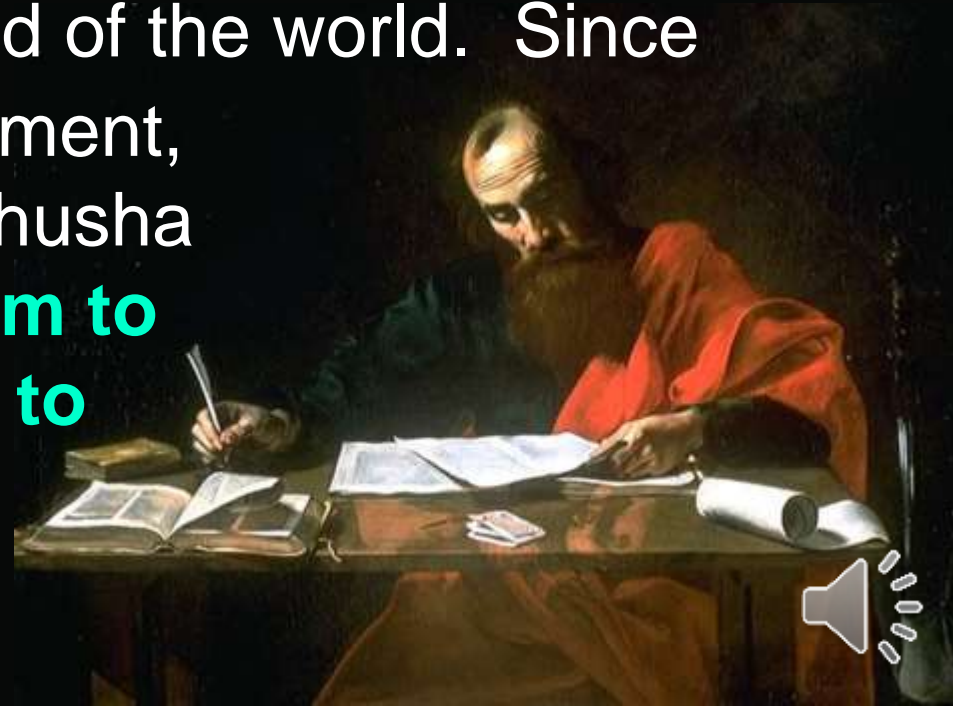
Paul does not say in this text that he will go to be with Yahusha when he dies.

He undoubtedly was using the word "**depart**" in reference to his death. But the Bible clearly reveals that Paul did not believe his "departure" would mean immediate entrance into heaven. Here's the proof: "...the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. **Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which YHVH , the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing**" 2 Timothy 4: 6-8.



Since Paul obviously did not expect to get his eternal crown at his departure in death, when was it that he anticipated actually being with Yahusha?

"For Yahusha Himself shall descend from heaven...and thus we shall always be with Yahusha." 1 Thessalonians 4: 16,17. There it is. Paul's desire to depart and be with Yahusha involved the resurrection that would take place at the end of the world. Since the unconscious sleep of death is like a moment, Paul speaks of death and the coming of Yahusha as almost simultaneous. **And so it will seem to those who depart and awake from death to see Yahusha coming.**



EVERY PROMISE IS BASED ON CONDITON!

1 John 1: 9 **"IF WE CONFESS OUR SINS**, he is faithful and true to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make his word false, and his word is not in us."

Reverend **Isaac** is going to **when the day is just still:**

and he which is in the door of mercy
righteous, let him be righteous
him be holy still. And, behold, I come quickly,
reward is with me, to give every man according as he
shall be.”

There is coming a time, when the door of mercy and forgiveness is going to close and then you will not be able to repent any longer, it will be too late.



The righteous shall rise on the last day at the final
Coming of Yahusha Messiah.

John 11:23-24 “Yahusha said unto her, Your brother
shall rise again. Martha saith unto him, **I know that he
shall rise again at the last day.**”

Job 14:12 “**heavens be no more,**

**Obviously at HIS Second Coming,

Take place?**

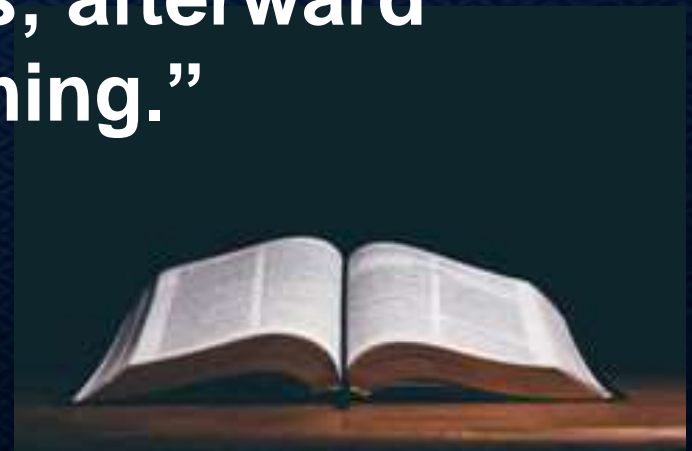

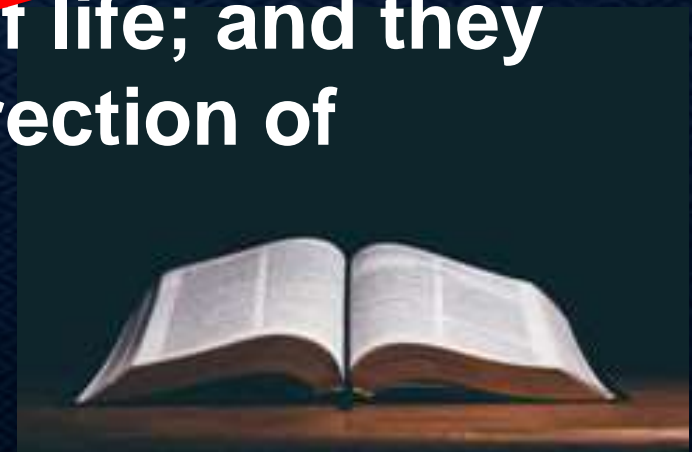

When will that take place?

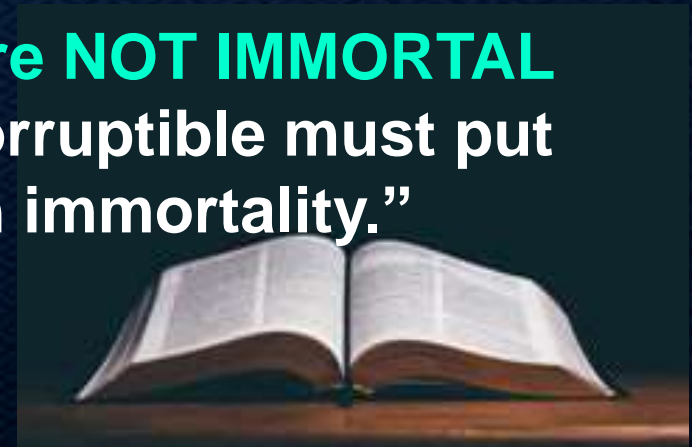


The Scriptures tell us David is **not yet** ascended into the heaven.

Acts 2: 29,34 "Men and brethren, I am David, the patriarch David's son. I am dead and buried, and my sepulchre is here unto this day.

1 Cor 15:51-52 “Behold, I show unto you a mystery, which shall not all comprehend, but we shall all be changed, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.”

Our bodies are corruptible, but notice we are **NOT IMMORTAL**
we must put on **immortality** v 53 “For this corruptible must put
on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.”

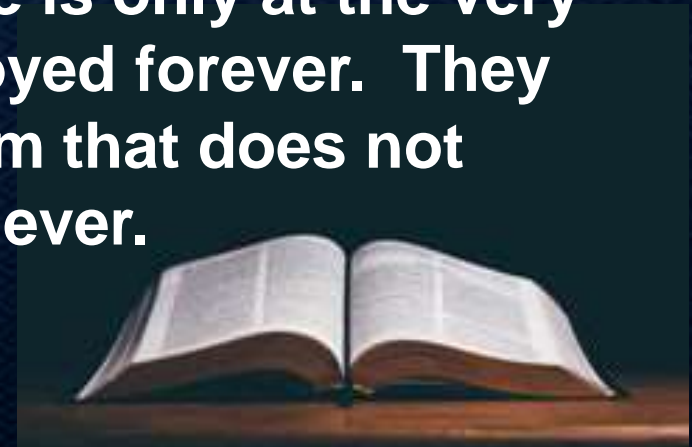


The reason I am emphasizing that the resurrection of the righteous and the wicked will be at the second Coming, and on the second Coming ONLY, is because many denominations believe in a third coming of the Messiah after a thousand year of peace, called a millennium. Christians believe that the Rapture will occur before the tribulation, and that the Millennium will be a thousand years after the Rapture. I made a power point presentation on this topic with the title "the millennium deception". This doctrine of the millenium developed upon six verses in one chapter of Revelation, that is nowhere taught elsewhere in the Torah, the Prophets, the Messiah's words or Paul's preaching.



MEANING OF HELL!

Sheol translated as "grave", "pit", or "abode of the dead" a place of darkness to which all the dead go, (sleep in the dust of the earth) both the righteous and the unrighteous. Twelve times in the New Testament "hell" comes from the Greek word **Gehenna**, which refers to that final lake of fire into which the wicked will be cast alive in bodily form with all their members at HIS second Coming. There is no place in the Scriptures where "hell" means a lake of fire which is burning now, or where the wicked will be burned to all eternity. Hell fire is only at the very end when the unrighteous are finally destroyed forever. They will cease to exist. We serve a loving Elohim that does not want to see you burning in hell forever and ever.



Matthew 13: 40 to 42

“As therefore the tares are gathered and
burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of
this world. The Son of man shall send forth his
angels, and they shall gather out of his
kingdom all things that offend, and them which
do iniquity; And shall cast them into a furnace
of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of
teeth.”

The story of the rich man in hell and Lazarus in Abraham's bosom in Luke 16: 19-31

People use this parable to try and prove the state of the dead and hell. Many people have often mistaken this parable to mean that when you die, you go immediately either to “**heaven or hell**”.

Death in the Bible refers to sleep 66 times. The Bible tells us the dead know nothing, they are asleep.



Do you really think that a literal drop of water on the rich man's tongue would hardly solve his problem of burning in the torment of hell (Luke 16: 24). As a literal story, the picture of Abraham has problems.

Abraham's chest must be symbolic. How many people can really fit on Abraham's chest? Abraham would never accept the prayer of the rich man as all reverence is due only to YHVH. Abraham is still sleeping in the grave so how could he be in heaven?

There is some Problems with this text in Luke 16: 19-31

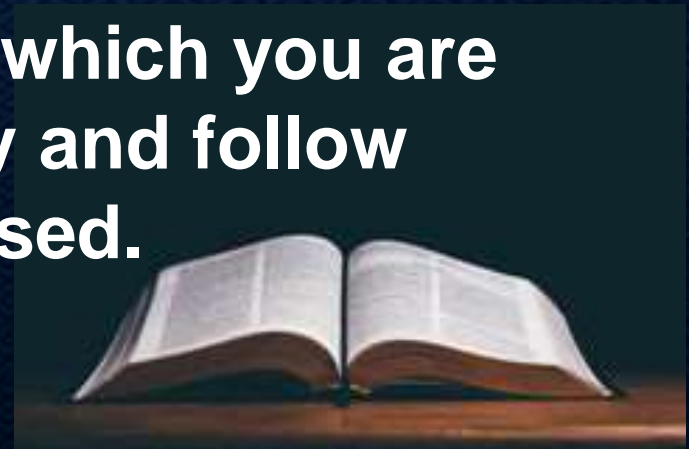


The rich man did not pray to Yahusha, but to Abraham. Thus, he showed that he placed Abraham above Yahusha, and that he relied on his relationship to Abraham for salvation. Acts 4: 12. “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name (except Yahusha) under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.”

Why did Yahusha speak in parables?



Yahusha often spoke in parables which means stories so that people will understand and learn lessons from it. The Pharisees followed traditions and their belief in immediate reward or punishment after death. Through this parable **Yahusha showed them, that according to the Scriptures death is described as sleep and after that the judgement.** In the parable of the rich man and Lazarus, Yahusha shows that in this life men decide their eternal destiny. Probation is a trial period in which you are still given a short time period to obey and follow Yahusha before the judgement is closed.



Now the grace of YHVH is offered to every soul. Repent now and obey His commandments, statutes and judgements as you could die today and then it is too late and your eternal life is lost forever. You will be either judged as being one of YHVH's children where you will have eternal life or one of Satan's children, where you will have eternal damnation.

But if men waste their opportunities in self-pleasing and worldly pleasures, they cut themselves off from everlasting life. No second chance will be granted them. By their own choice they have decided to follow YHVH or Satan the father of lies and deception.





This life is **the only time given to man in which to prepare for eternity**. Are you one of these people that are here in church but your heart is not truly converted to following Yahusha? Are you one of these people that Yahusha is speaking to today?

Are you fooling yourself into believing that you are saved, because you attend church yet you know in your heart that your life does not reflect the good fruits of truly loving Yahusha and have a passion for reaching out to the lost and dying

world?



Psalms 37: 9,10

“For evildoers shall be cut off (killed): but those that wait upon YHVH, they shall inherit the earth. For yet a little while, and the wicked shall not be: yes, you diligently consider his place, and it shall not be.”

**What will happen
To the wicked?**



Scriptures tell us in 15 places that they will die, which means that they will cease to live; in 12 places it says that they will perish, which means they will be brought to nothing, and be blotted out of existence, in 13 places it says they will be destroyed, which means they will be annihilated; in 5 places it says that they will be consumed, which means that they will be exterminated.

THEY WILL CEASE TO EXIST.

Yahusha said in all our trials and sorrow, if we turn to Him, He will comfort us and give us his love and peace and a will to love and obey His commandments, statutes and judgements.



The short answer to why we suffer is that we and other human beings, in the past and in the present, have chosen evil, and **suffering is the result**. It's not fair. It's not even reasonable. **Sin is, by definition, unfair, unjust, hurtful and wrong. It's downright brutal.**

But one thing it is not: it is not YHWH's will. YHWH does not want us to suffer. But neither does He want to make us slaves or robots. To be human is to be free, and to be free means we can either choose good or evil with their respective effects.

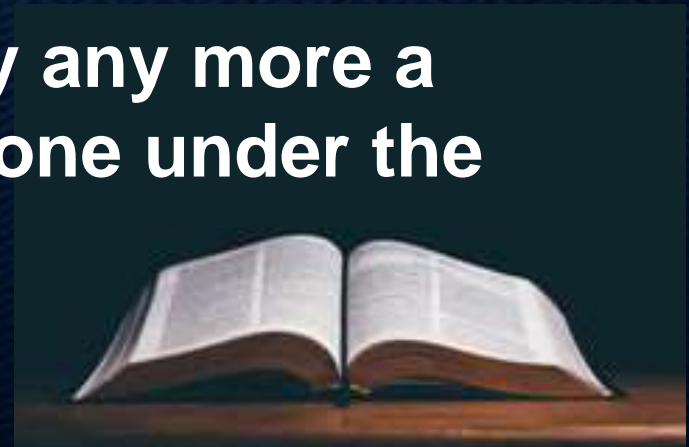
Here are three Bible facts that are so important as to be a matter of life and death!

2. The dead have no part in any earthly affairs whatever.

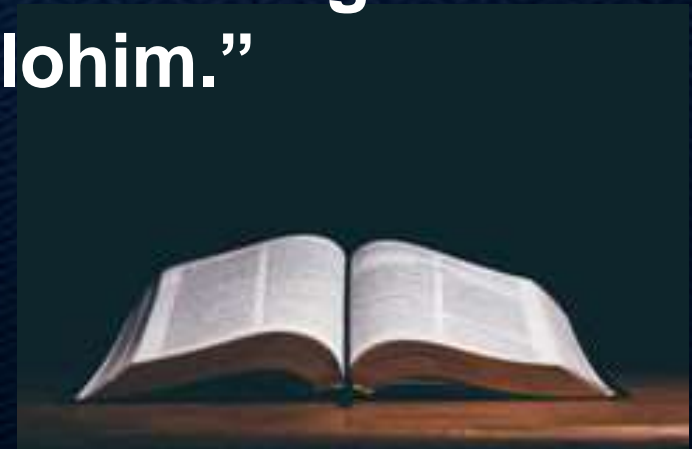
Ecclesiastes 9: 6 "Neither have they any more a portion forever in anything that is done under the sun."



Here are three Bible facts that are so important as to be a matter of life and death!

3. YHVH condemns attempts to communicate with the dead.

Deuteronomy 18: 9-12 “You shall not learn to do after the abominations of those nations - or a consulter with familiar spirits, *(call up the demons disguised as your dead loved ones)* For all that do these things are an abomination unto YHVH Elohim.”



The Scriptures say that attempts to communicate with the dead are considered by YHVH an **"abomination!"** (disgusting, repulsive).



According to Bible prophecy, Spiritism is to have a great revival in these last days, but it is not of YHVH. 1Timothy 4: 1

1 “Now the Spirit speaks expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils.”

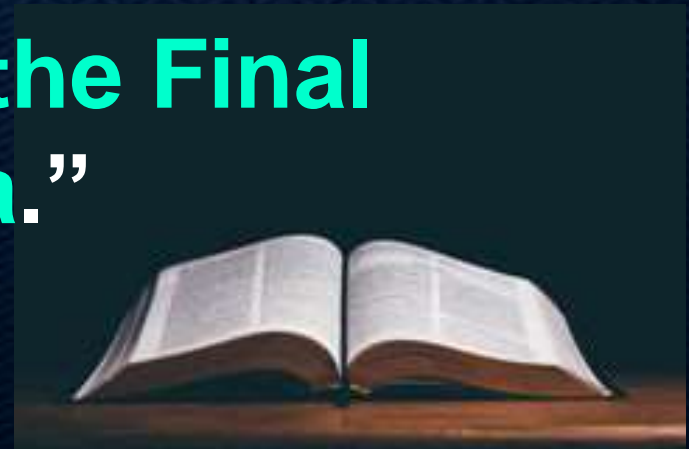


WHAT IS OUR ONLY HOPE?

Our only hope is in the resurrection and the coming of our Savior Yahusha Messiah, for if the dead rise not, all who have died in Yahusha are perished. This is the studied conclusion of Paul:

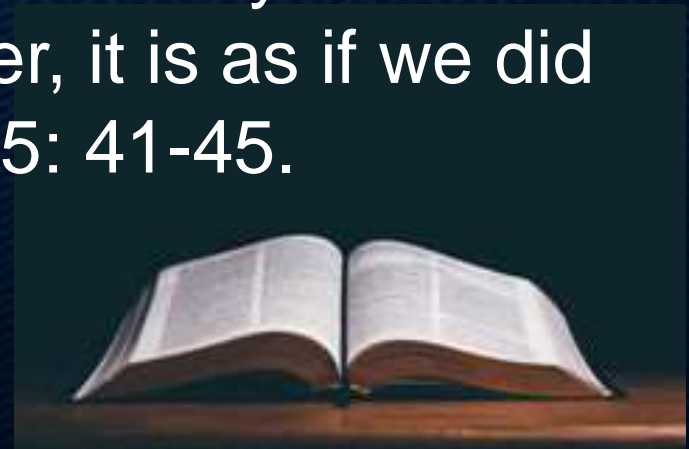


1 Corinthians 15: 16-19 "For if the dead rise not, then is not Yahusha raised: and if Yahusha be not raised, your faith is in vain; you are yet in your sins. Then they also which are fallen asleep in Yahusha are perished. Because Yahusha rose from the dead, **we too will rise from the dead at the last trump at the Final Coming of Yahusha.**"



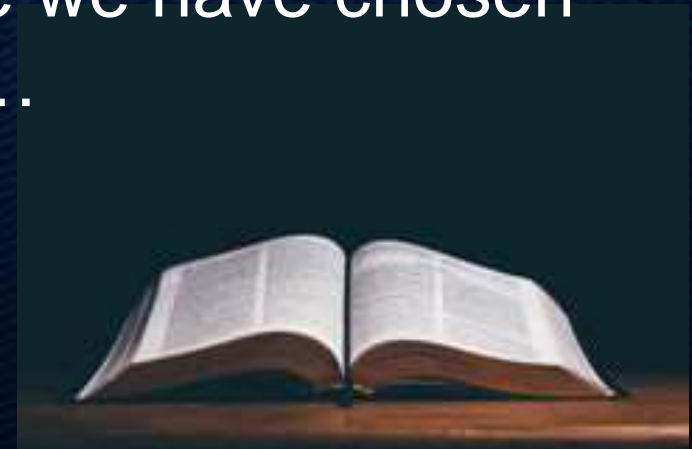
YHVH Elohim is so merciful that He cannot remain isolated from our suffering.

According to the Scriptures, He is “**touched with the feelings of our infirmities**” Hebrews 4: 15 Speaking of YHVH’s relation to human pain, the prophet Isaiah said, “**In all their affliction He was afflicted**” Isaiah 63:9. We are so deeply loved by YHVH that Yahusha basically said that anything we do for or against one another, it is as if we did those deeds to Him. Matthew 25: 41-45.



All suffering touches YHVH. He is aware of all the tears we cry and the sorrow, grief or anguish behind them.

King David sang of YHVH's deep sympathy: **"You keep track of all my sorrows. You have collected all my tears in Your bottle. You have recorded each one in your book"** Psalms 56: 8 Love is like that. It suffers with those who suffer. We suffer in this life because we have chosen sin and disobedience. ...



There will be a resurrection, both for the righteous and for the unrighteous at His second Coming!

John 5: 28,29 “Marvel not at this: **for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice**, 29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.”





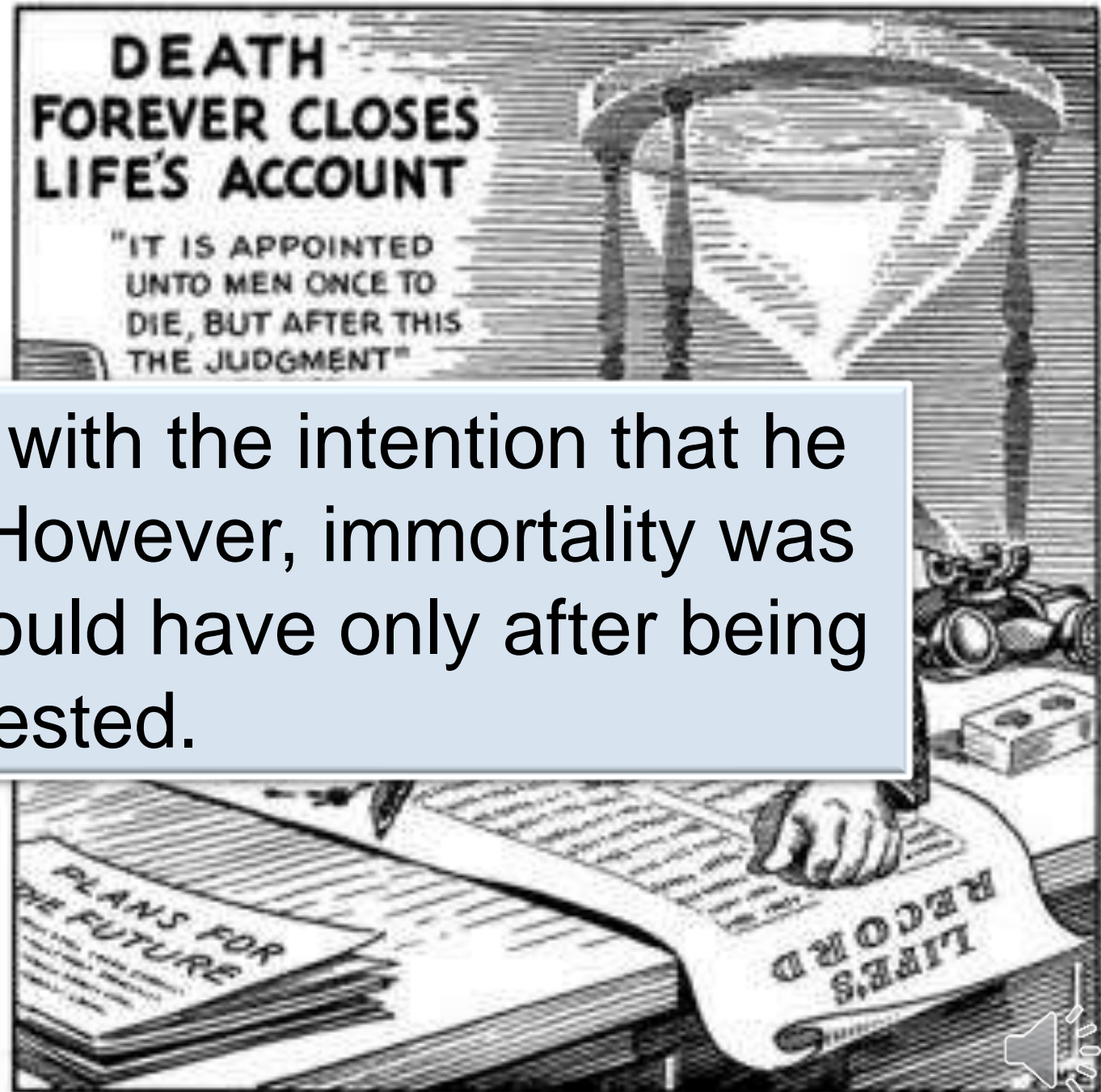

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YHVH created man with the intention that he should live forever. However, immortality was the possession he could have only after being tested.

down into the pit cannot hope for your truth."



Man failed the test. He accepted the words of Satan in preference to the words of YHVH Elohim, and was led into rebellion and disobedience. Eve believed that she would not die, but rather would enter upon a higher plane of experience and become as the gods. How many millions have since been misled as she was, believing that death is not real at all, but just the gateway of release into a higher realm!



There is No Second Chance! Now is the day of Repentance and turning from your evil ways to love and obey the Living Elohim. Many are wrongly teaching that when you die your relatives can pray and intercede for you and this will give you another chance to be right with YHVH. This is a great deception. YHVH's Word says in Hebrews 9: 27 **"And as it is appointed unto men once (not twice) to die, but after this the judgment."**



Praying for the dead is not a biblical concept.

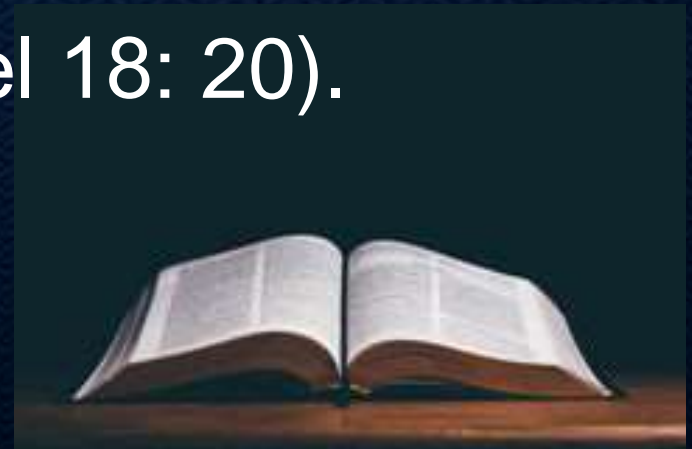
Our prayers have no bearing on someone once he or she has died.

The reality is that, at the point of death, one's eternal destiny is confirmed. If they are saved through faith in Yahusha Messiah then they are asleep in the grave waiting for the resurrection. Often, people who have lost a loved one are encouraged to pray for those who have passed away and for their families. Of course, we should pray for those grieving, but for the dead, no. No one should ever believe that someone may be able to pray for him, thereby effecting some kind of favorable outcome, after he or she has died.



Scripture teaches that the eternal state of mankind is determined by our actions during our lives on earth.

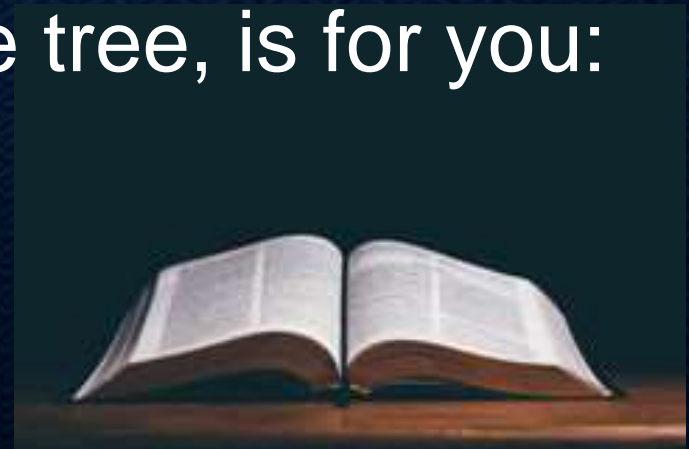


