



What shall I do to inherit eternal life?



Because the Creator promises them that love HIM , “ Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which Yahuah hath prepared for them that love him.” (1 Corinthians 2,9) KJV

Luke 10:25-28 “And behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and tempted him (Yahusha), saying, Rabbi, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? 26 He said unto him, what is written in the Torah? How read you? 7 And he answering said, you shall love ייYahuah Elohayka with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself. And he said unto him, you have answered right: this do, and you shall live.”

This world is not our permanent home; we are strangers. This life has been given to mankind to glorify their Creator and to decide where to spend eternity. There is a heaven to gain and a hell to shun.

For starters, do this: stay away from any man-made religion, including Christianity, Judaism, Islam, and any additional man-made traditions and teachings!

1. Accept only the Scriptures as your compass, starting in Genesis 1:1.



1. Remember, everything (the prophets, Psalms and the so-called New Testament) must be compared with the Torah, the instructions given to Moses at Mt Sinai. The Torah is the foundation of the Scriptures and has the last word.

- 3. Get a Scripture version that has not been changed by removing the name of our Heavenly Elohim/Creator about 7000 times, replacing it with generic titles like LORD or God.**
- 4. Accept the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Yashar'el. Elohim is the most High, whose name is Yahuah!**

- 5. Accept the sacrifice of Yahuah's Son, Yahusha.**
- (This is NOT THE CHRISTIAN JESUS who actually never lived but was created by Constantine as a mask for Tammuz, [representing Satan]).**
 - “Jesus” was an image, a copy of the Hebrew Messiah Yahusha; “Jesus” is NOT Yahusha, (or Yahuah in the flesh); the Greek (Christian) “Jesus” did not give his life for us on Calvary 2,000 years ago. He is an illusion.**

6. Acknowledge, confess and repent of your past sins to be forgiven; be baptized by immersion in Yahusha's name - not into the pagan trinity.

7. Obey all the instructions Yahuah gave to Moses at Mt Sinai. These are found in the "Book of the Covenant" in the Torah books of Genesis to Deuteronomy. This is where you will find the everlasting seal according to Isaiah 8:16!

For starters, that includes the weekly Sabbath, the yearly appointed feast days, the health laws to keep yourself unspotted from the world.

8. Live a set-apart, holy life, enduring until the end, and your name will be written in the Lamb's book of life.

Malachi 3:6, “For I am YHVH, I do not change!”

That means: He didn't change His Sabbath to Sunday, He didn't change His feasts to pagan holidays, He didn't replace His people Israel with the Christian Church, He didn't do away with his Torah, He didn't change his son's Name from Yahusha to Iesous (Jesus), He came to save those that repent of their sins, accept Yahusha as their Savior and keep his covenant he made at Sinai with Yashar'el, with the commandments, statutes and judgments.
