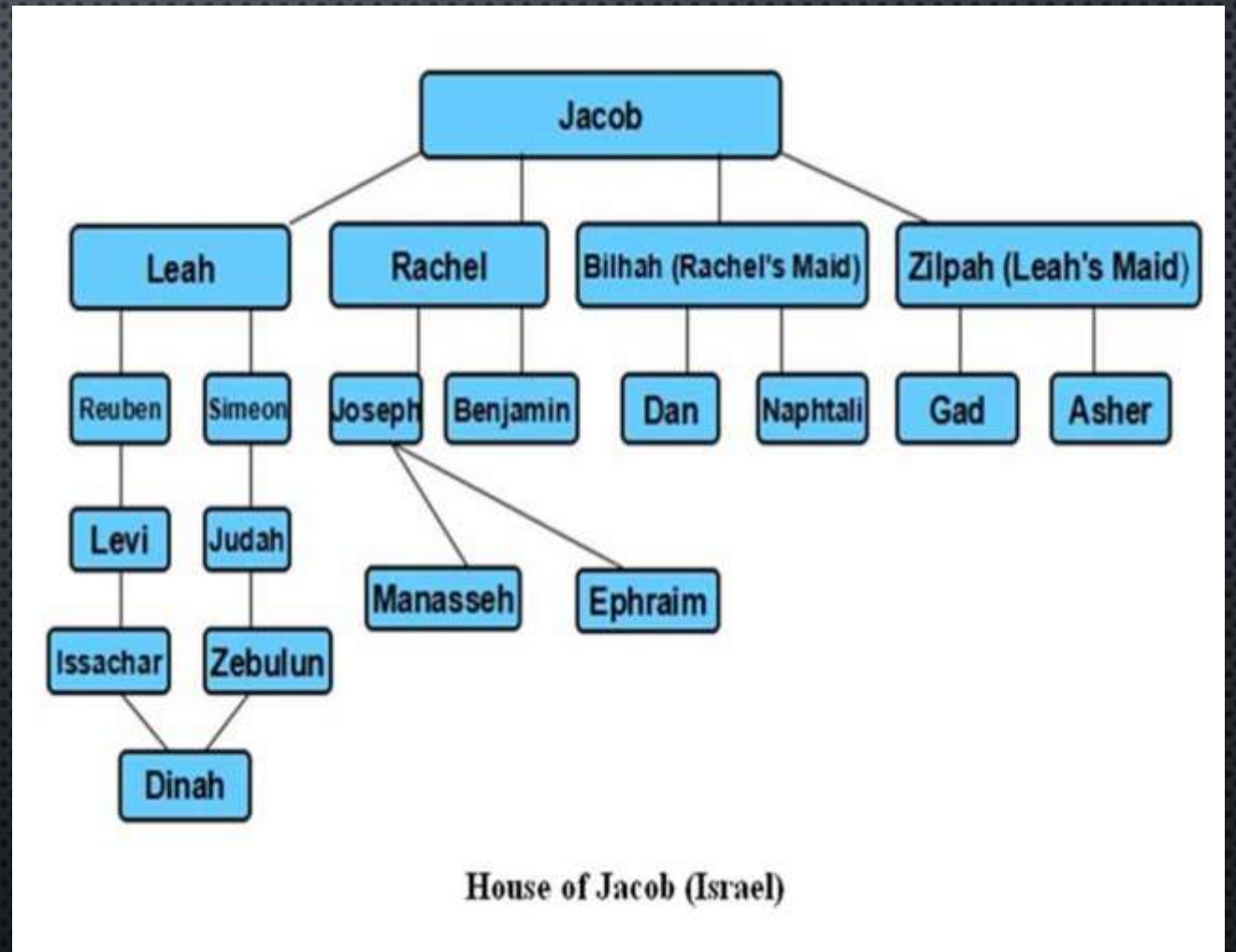

PLEASE NOTE WE USE THE TRUE NAMES OF ELOHIM
Did you know that our Heavenly Father's Name Yahuwah and
His Son Yahusha was removed over 7000 times in our Bibles
and replaced with LORD, God and Jesus which are not names
but titles. **YAH**uwah is our Heavenly Father's Name
YAHusha is the Sons Name, and it means **YAH** is Salvation
(see Psalms 68:4). Leviticus 22:32, **“Neither shall ye profane
my holy name; but I will be hallowed among the children of
Israel: I am Yahuwah which hallow you.”**

The Twelve Tribes of Israel according to Hebrew Scriptures, the descendants of the Biblical patriarch Jacob, also known as Israel, through his twelve sons through his wives, **Leah and Rachel**, and his concubines, **Bilhah and Zilpah**, who collectively form the Israelite nation.

Therefore, Israel is made up of a mixed multitude of people from different nations.



Q 1

Who are the lost sheep of the House of Israel?



The book of James 1:1, “**James, a servant of Yahuwah and of the Master Yahusha Messiah, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greetings.**” We are all part of the lost sheep of the House of Israel that have been scattered into the nations and we have lost our identity. When Israel went out of Egypt a mixed multitude of people went with them (people from many different nations and people). Exodus 12:3,8, “**A mixed multitude (mingled people from different nations) also went up with them, along with flocks and herds, a very large number of livestock.**” Because Israel with the mixed multitude turned to idolatry, Yahuwah scattered them to the ends of the earth, and this includes us. Ten of the twelve tribes were made up of the mixed multitude.

Q 2

What promises did Yahuwah give to the twelve tribes of Israel who disobeyed His Covenant with His Commandments, statutes and judgments?



Deuteronomy 28:15, “And it shall be, if you do not obey the voice of יהוה (YHVH) your Elohim, to guard to do all His commands and His laws which I command you today, that all these curses shall come upon you and overtake you.”

Continued



Deuteronomy 28:63,64, “And it shall be, that as יהוה (YHVH) rejoiced over you to do you good and increase you, so יהוה (YHVH) does rejoice over you to destroy you and lay you waste. And you shall be plucked from off the land which you go to possess. And יהוה (YHVH) shall scatter you among all peoples, from one end of the earth to the other, and there you shall serve other mighty ones, which neither you nor your fathers have known, wood and stone.”

Sadly, we are still lost in the pagan gods of Christianity worshiping idols of wood, stone and images of the false Messiah Jesus Christ.

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Q 3

Where do we come from, what is our purpose, and where do we find this in the Scriptures? What are we supposed to be doing?



We come from one of the twelve tribes scattered abroad (all over the world). Most of us are still deceived by religion and the counterfeit pagan teachings of Christianity. We need to come out of all these churches to follow and obey the true Messiah Yahusha. Galatians 3;26 to 29, **“For you are all sons of Elohim through belief in Yahusha Messiah (not Jesus Christ the false Messiah). For as many of you as were immersed into Messiah have put on Messiah. ...**

Continued ...



...There is not Yehudite (Jew) nor Greek, there is not slave nor free, there is not male and female, for **you are all one in Yahusha Messiah. And if you are of Messiah, then you are seed of Abraham, and heirs according to promise.**” Notice if we are in Yahusha Messiah we are the seed of Abraham and heirs according to the promises of Yahuwah through Abraham. Once you have crossed over from pagan Christianity to follow and obey Yahusha Messiah, you become grafted into Israel with Yahusha as the root.

Q 4

What happened to the twelve tribes of Israel and where are they today?



After the death of David's son, King Solomon, a civil dispute split the twelve tribes of Israel into two kingdoms: The Kingdom of Judah in the south, which included the tribes of Judah and part of Benjamin (and some Levites and priests) and was centered around the capital Jerusalem and the Holy Temple; and the northern Kingdom of Israel, which included the other ten tribes. In the 5th century BCE, because the tribes continually went into idolatry (just like today),....

Q 4

Continued ...



... the Kingdom of Israel was conquered by Assyrian King Sennaherib, and the ten tribes were exiled and scattered abroad. They went into slavery and were scattered all over the world losing their identity and no longer knowing who their true Biblical ancestors were. The only remaining Israelites were the residents of the Kingdom of Judah, and the term "Yehudi" or "Jew" came to refer to all the Israelites, regardless of their tribal ancestry.

Q 5

Q5 What did Yahuwah promise His people Israel if they obeyed Him?



Reward for Obedience: Leviticus 26, “Do not make idols or set up an image or a sacred stone for yourselves, and do not place a carved stone in your land to bow down before it. I am Yahuwah your Elohim. 2 “Observe my Sabbaths and have reverence for my sanctuary. I am Yahuwah. 3 If you follow my decrees and are careful to obey my commands, 4 I will send you rain in its season, and the ground will yield its crops and the trees their fruit. 5 Your threshing will continue until grape harvest and the grape harvest will continue until planting, and you will eat all the food you want and live in safety in your land....

Q 5

Continued ...



... 6 I will grant peace in the land, and you will lie down, and no one will make you afraid. I will remove wild beasts from the land, and the sword will not pass through your country. 7 You will pursue your enemies, and they will fall by the sword before you. 8 Five of you will chase a hundred, and a hundred of you will chase ten thousand, and your enemies will fall by the sword before you. 9 I will look on you with favor and make you fruitful and increase your numbers, and I will keep my covenant with you. ...

Q 5

Continued ...



...10 You will still be eating last year's harvest when you will have to move it out to make room for the new. 11 I will put my dwelling place among you, and I will not abhor you. 12 I will walk among you and be your Elohim, and you will be my people. 13 I am Yahuwah your Elohim, who brought you out of Egypt so that you would no longer be slaves to the Egyptians; I broke the bars of your yoke and enabled you to walk with heads held high.

Q 6

What did Yahuwah promise His people Israel if they disobeyed Him?



Please read Leviticus 26 for the full understanding. 14 “But if you will not listen to me and carry out all these commands, 15 and if you reject my decrees and abhor my laws and fail to carry out all my commands and so violate my covenant, 16 then I will do this to you: I will bring on you sudden terror, wasting diseases and fever that will destroy your sight and sap your strength. You will plant seed in vain, because your enemies will eat it. 17 I will set my face against you so that you will be defeated by your enemies; those who hate you will rule over you, and you will flee even when no one is pursuing you....

Q 6

Continued ...



... 25 And I will bring the sword on you to avenge the breaking of the covenant. When you withdraw into your cities, I will send a plague among you, and you will be given into enemy hands. 27 “If in spite of this you still do not listen to me but continue to be hostile toward me, 28 then in my anger I will be hostile toward you, and I myself will punish you for your sins seven times over. 29 You will eat the flesh of your sons and the flesh of your daughters. 30 I will destroy your high places, cut down your incense altars and pile your dead bodies on the lifeless forms of your idols, and I will abhor you. ...

Q 6

Continued ...



...31 I will turn your cities into ruins and lay waste your sanctuaries, and I will take no delight in the pleasing aroma of your offerings. 32 I myself will lay waste the land, so that your enemies who live there will be appalled. 33 I will scatter you among the nations and will draw out my sword and pursue you. Your land will be laid waste, and your cities will lie in ruins. 34 Then the land will enjoy its sabbath years all the time that it lies desolate and you are in the country of your enemies; then the land will rest and enjoy its sabbaths. ...

Q 6

Continued ...



...35 All the time that it lies desolate, the land will have the rest it did not have during the sabbaths you lived in it. So you will not be able to stand before your enemies. 38 You will perish among the nations; the land of your enemies will devour you. 39 Those of you who are left will waste away in the lands of their enemies because of their sins; also because of their ancestors' sins they will waste away.

Q 7

Did the twelve tribes of Israel obey Yahuwah's Covenant?



The answer is NO! They continued to disobey him over and over again and copied the pagan worship practices of the people around them just like today. Ancient Israel was scattered throughout the earth because the people rejected Yahuwah's covenant. It was prophesied that Israel would be scattered among the nations of the earth because of the people's wickedness (see Leviticus 26:33; Deut 4:23–27; Deut 28.) Therefore, the twelve tribes were scattered abroad because they turned their backs on obeying Yahuwah's Covenant they are lost in pagan Christianity and are still practicing pagan idolatry and traditions of men like Sunday, Christmas and Easter. ...

Q 7

Continued



... The scattering began when the Assyrians carried the ten tribes away into captivity (see 2 Kings 15:29; 17:6). The scattering continued when Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, carried Judah away into captivity (see 2 Kings 25:1, 7, 11.) After the death of Yahusha, the Jews were scattered among the gentile nations. Luke 21:24, **“And they (the twelve tribes) shall fall by the edge of the sword and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. ...**

Q 7

Continued



The scattering of the twelve Tribes is likened in Scripture to a sifting, a divorce, and the sale of a man to pay his debts (see Amos 9:8–9; Isaiah 50:1). Through His prophets Yahuwah promised to re-gather scattered Israel once again, a remnant who hear His voice will come out of pagan Christianity to obey His Covenant Torah. The re-gathering of scattered Israel is a result both of Yahuwah's mercy and also of Israel's repentance (see Isaiah 54:7; Ezekiel 11:17; Jeremiah 50:4–5.)

Q 8

Are you one of the lost sheep
of the house of Israel?



Yahusha said in John 10:14 to 16, “I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine. As the Father knows me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep. And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one-fold, and one shepherd.”

Continued ...



Yahusha also said, John 10:27,28, **“My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.”**

Are you hearing the voice of Yahusha calling you to follow Him and come out of all churches and pagan Christianity to love and obey His Covenant Torah?

Q 9

Christianity teaches there are different laws for the Jews in the Old Testament and now we are free from the law in the New Testament. Is this true?



Christianity through Constantine has separated the true followers of Yahusha by changing Yahuwah's Sabbath day to Sunday, replaced His set-apart Feast days for Christmas and Easter and teaches through Christianity that the Covenant laws were **“nailed to the cross.”** **Yahuwah is the same yesterday, today and forever. Yahusha did not come to bring a new religion called Christianity for the Gentiles, but He came to call all the lost sheep who have been deceived by pagan Christianity back into the fold of the twelve tribes of Israel** (Matthew 15:24). ...

Q 9

Continued ...



... Exodus 12:49, **“One law shall be to him that is home born, and unto the stranger that sojourns among you.”** Galatians 3:26 to 28 **“For ye are all the children of Yahuwah by faith in the Messiah Yahusha. For as many of you as have been baptized into the Messiah have put on the Messiah. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in the Messiah Yahusha.”** Christianity is a counterfeit religion teaching a counterfeit gospel of separation and man-made pagan doctrines and traditions not found in the Scriptures.

Q 10

When will Abraham and his descendants (all that are in Yahusha Messiah) inherit the promised land and live in peace for all eternity?



Not on this earth and not in the Zionist land of Israel, but after Yahusha has created a new heaven and a new earth. Ephesians 1:13–14 says the set-apart Spirit is the “guarantee” of our inheritance. When Yahusha returns to create a new heaven and new earth after the thousand years of the righteous taken to heaven, (Rev. 21), the promises to Abraham will reach their consummation as we are blessed with eternal life in a resurrected body, and we will dwell on the new earth in perfect peace, love and harmony with Yahusha as our King of Kings. Our enemies will be no more, and we will enjoy the presence of Yahuwah forever. Let us put our hope in this inheritance and long for the days when all these things will come to pass.

Q 11

When was the assembly of Yahuwah born?



The assembly was born in Genesis 28:3,4 and connected back to the seed and promise made to Abraham by Yahuwah. Yahusha is the promised seed. Genesis 28:3,4, **“And Yahuwah bless you, and make you bear fruit and increase you, and you shall become an assembly of peoples, and give you the blessing of Abraham to you and your seed with you, so that you inherit the land of your sojourning's, which Elohim gave to Abraham.”** The New Testament says that if we are in Yahusha Messiah then we are Abraham's seed and heirs according to the promises made to Abraham to be a great multitude of people and nations blessed by Yahuwah who will all inherit the promised land in the new earth and dwell in peace there. ...

Continued ...



...You shall become a KAHAL ECCLESIA IN GREEK translated into English word church. The correct translation is assembly of Yahuwah's people Israel (all 12 tribes). To say you are Abraham's seed and do not do what Abraham does, is remaining in deception in a religious denomination and you are not walking in Biblical truth. If you going to follow religion that says church is born in Acts 2, this is not true, so we need to find our foundation on the Scriptures not religious denomination. ...

Q 11

Continued ...



...Because “Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.” Genesis 26;5. Unless you come out of Christianity with its traditions of men, idolatry and pagan holidays like Christmas and Easter, to believe in Yahusha Messiah which is the only name by which you can be saved, you will remain deceived and lost for all eternity. If this truth is opening your eyes, now is the time to repent of your sins and follow the true Messiah Yahusha. **You cannot remain in Christianity nor take part in their false teachings at church.**

Q 12

How is the assembly (Israel) connected to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob that produced a mixed multitude of people?



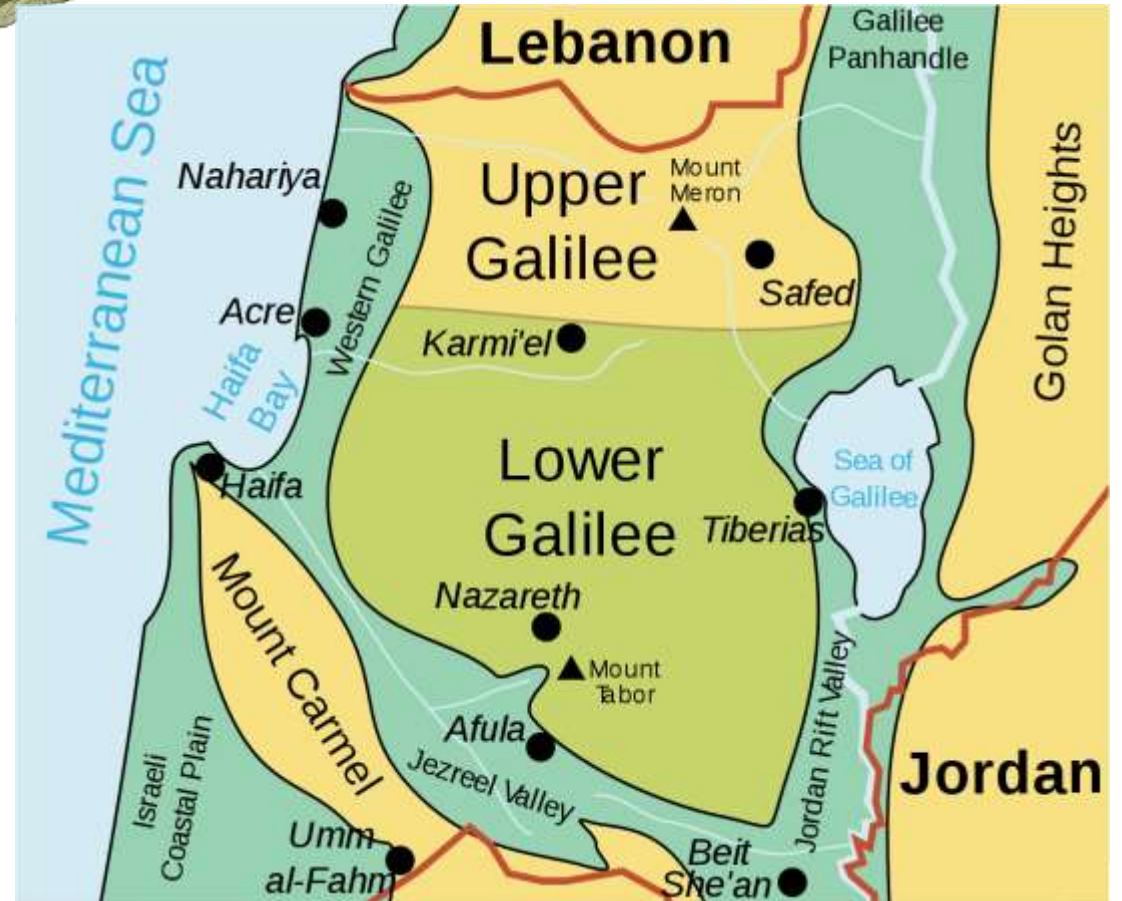
Jacob had four wives all from different pagan nations and this is where the 12 tribes of Israel come from, the twelve sons of Jacob. One of Jacob's sons Joseph married an Egyptian who was the daughter of a High priest in sun-god worship. Their two sons Ephraim and Manasseh were blessed by his Father Jacob and joined to the twelve tribes of Israel. Ephraim was given the land inheritance, not Manasseh the oldest son.

Q 13

Why did Yahusha first go to Galilee to preach there?



Yahusha went to Galilee because Israel was broken and split up in the Galilee, that is why Yahusha started preaching in the Galilee where Israel first split up.



Q 14

What sins did Israel commit that Christianity is doing today?



Christianity has adopted many pagan doctrines and traditions of men for example, Sunday worship instead of honoring the Sabbath day, Christmas and Easter, Valentines Day, Halloween which are all pagan idolatry instead of celebrating the Feasts and Festivals of Yahuwah.



Q 15

What is the message of Repentance and why is it so important?



Repentance is a foundational doctrine of our faith as this Scripture declares. Without true repentance there is no forgiveness of sin. Without believing that Yahusha is the Messiah and obeying His Covenant Torah, you cannot enter into the Kingdom of heaven. Once you have Repented, be immersed so that your sins can be washed away, and you will receive the set-apart Spirit of Yahuwah which will help you obey His commandments, statutes and judgments.

Continued ...



Acts 2:38, “Then Peter said unto them, **Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Yahusha** the Messiah for the forgiveness of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the set-apart Spirit.”

Isaiah 55:7, “Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto Yahuwah and he will have mercy upon him; and to our Elohim, for he will abundantly pardon.”

Continued ...



...Those who remain in Christianity and do not want to come out of Babylon (all religions) will be eternally lost. **Today is the day of Salvation.** Turn to Yahuwah today. Follow His Covenant Torah and keep His weekly Sabbath and the yearly set-apart gatherings not the Satanic pagan holidays of Christianity and their other non-biblical teachings. 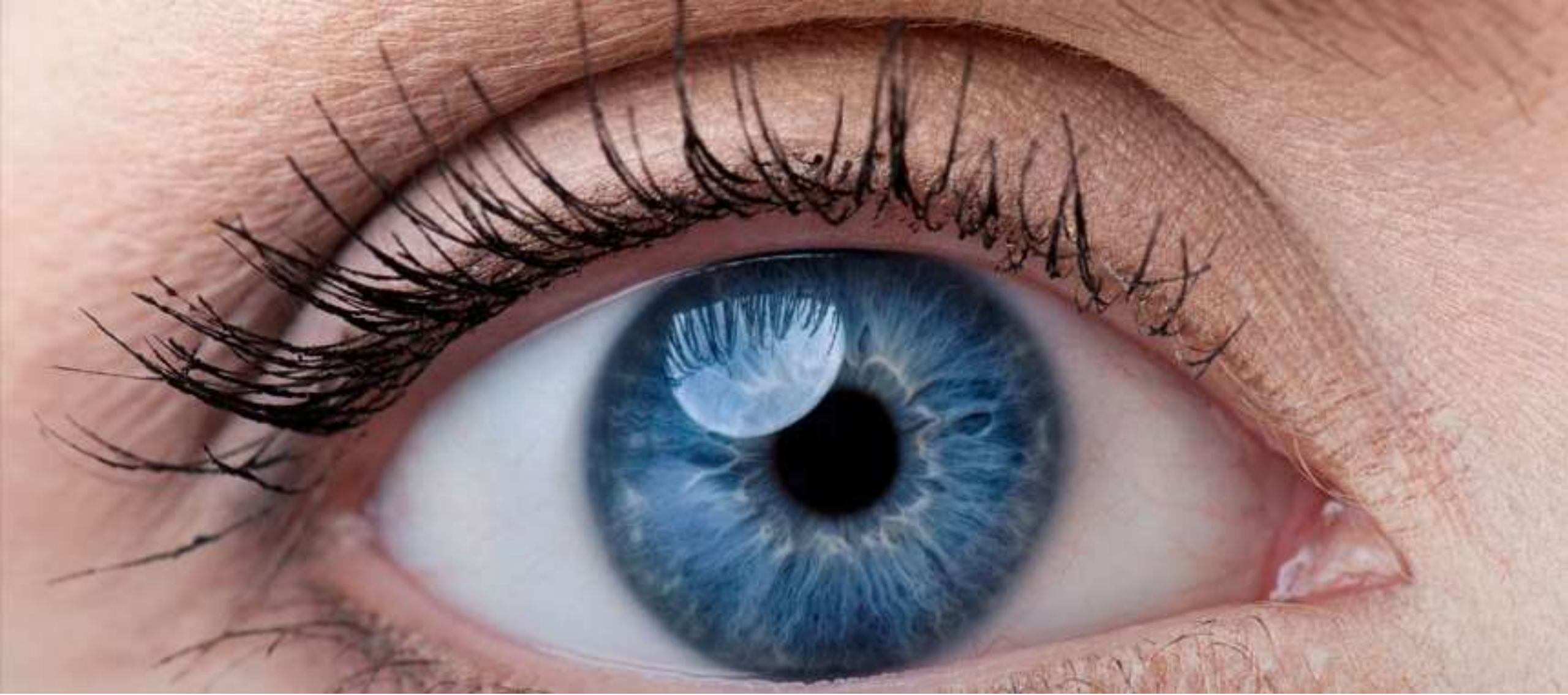
