Who is this God that I should obey and worship?



This was the question Pharaoh put to Mose after he requested to allow Yashar'el to leave Egypt to worship Him! Pharaoh said, "I do not know Yahuah, and I will not let Yashar'el go.

Psalm 96:4-5 states: "For Yahuah is great, and greatly to be praised: he is to be feared above all Elohiym. 5 For all the Elohai (gods) of the nations are idols: but Yahuah made the heavens."

(Cepher)


This Elohim(God), when asked by Moses to identify Himself says, "AhYah-Asher-AhYah" meaning "I AM that I AM"!

Moses does not believe the names "god", "Adonai", "Elohim" and "the gods (Elohim) of your ancestors – the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of Jacob" are convincing enough. He wants something much more explicit. So, Moses desires a name that spells out the exact nature of this Elohim who wants to redeem them. It is wonderful to see – both at the beginning of his career and later when Moses faces the frustration of leading the people of Yashar'el through the desert – that he persists in seeking even greater intimacy with Elohim to give him the confidence to proceed with his mission.

"And Moses said unto Elohim, Behold, when I come unto the children of Yashar'el, and shall say unto them, The Elohim of

your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, what is his name? What shall I say to them? 14. And Elohim said unto Moses, "AhYah-Asher-AhYah" (I AM THAT I AM): and he said, thus shalt thou say unto the children of Yashar'el, I AM hath sent me unto you." (Exodus 3:13-14 - CJB).

Yahuah presents him with the wonderfully enigmatic name **AhYah-Asher-AhYah**. We can personally know Yahuah. He who created the universe in all of his magnitude and creative details, is able to be known by us. We are privileged and encouraged to know him intimately.



Take note that I am not using the word LORD or God as these are generic titles and not names. These titles are being used for all the false or no—gods. Christians worship God, Jews worship God, Muslims worship God, Hindus, Buddhists, and all other pagan religions worship God. Which one is the right one, the Creator? Thee is only one Creator and Savior and He has a name. His name is YHVH (Yahuah) according to Isaiah 42:8. We read in the Scripture translation 2009 as follows: "I am יהוה (Yahuah), that is

My Name, and My esteem I do not give to another, nor My praise to idols." Our Heavenly Father has a name, and He wants His name to be known and glorified in speech, song, and worship. The Creator's name was never intended to be hidden or unspoken. It states in Psalms 69:30 "Theen will I praise Yahuah's name with singing, and honor him with thanksgiving." How can we praise his name, if we do not know His name?

Jeremiah 9, 23-24 states "Let not the wise man boast of his wisdom or the strong man boast of his strength or the rich man boast of his riches but let him who boasts boast about this: that he understands and knows me, that I am Yahuah, who exercises 1) kindness, 2) justice and 3) righteousness on earth, for in these I delight," declares Yahuah."

Jeremiah 33:2 "Thus says Yahuah the Maker thereof, Yahuah that formed it, to establish it; Yahuah is his name; (Cepher) in this verse, the name of the Creator is mentioned three times.

Yahuah is approachable!

He invites us to talk to him and engage him in what concerns us. We do not have to get our act together first. Neither do we need to be theologically correct! It is his nature to be loving and accepting when we go to him seriously!

"Yahuah is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth." (Psalms 145:18)

He Creates.

Everything we make is put together with existing materials or built on previous thoughts. YHVH has the capacity of speaking things into existence, not just galaxies and life forms, but solutions to today's problems. Adonai is creative, for us. His power is something he wants us to be aware of and to rely on. "Great is our Master and mighty in power; his understanding has no limit." (Psalms 147:5)

"...where does my help come from? My help comes from YHVH, the Maker of heaven and earth." (Psalms 121:1,2)

YHVH is forgiving!

We sin. We tend to do things our way instead of HIS way. And he sees it and knows it. YAH does not merely overlook such sin but is prepared to judge and condemn people for their sin. However, HE is forgiving and will forgive us from the moment we begin a relationship with him. Yahusha, the Son of YHVH, paid for our sin with his death on a cross. He rose from the dead and offers us this forgiveness. "We are made right in Elohim's sight when we trust in Yahusha Ha Mashiach to take away our sins. And we all can be saved in this same way, no matter who we are or what we have done... We are made right with Elohim when we believe that Yahusha shed his blood, sacrificing his life for us." (Romans 3:22,25)

He is Honest.

Just like a person who lets you know their thoughts and feelings, Elohim clearly tells us about himself, the possible difference being, he is always honest. Everything he says about himself, or about us, is reliable information. Truer than our feelings, thoughts, and perception, Elohim is totally accurate and honest in what he says. Every promise he makes to us can be fully counted on, he means it. We can take him at his word.

"The unfolding of your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple. Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." (Psalms 119:130,105) KJV



Yahuah is ABLE!

How would you like to be 100% right all the time about everything? YHVH is. His wisdom is unlimited. He understands all the elements of a situation, including the history and future events related to it. We do not have to update him, counsel him or persuade him to

do the right thing. He will, because he is capable and his motives are pure. If we trust him, he will never make a mistake, never undercut us, or deceive us. He can be fully trusted to do what is right, in all circumstances, at all times!

"No one whose hope is in you will ever be put to shame..." (Psalms 25:3) New International Version

Or Psalm 9:10 KJV "And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, YHVH, <u>hast not forsaken</u> them that seek thee."

What hope and encouragement for those, who have faith in this great Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, Yahuah Elohim!

Yahuah's Greatness is unsearchable, and without limit in all He knows, we call that omni-science. There is nothing that He does not already know. He knows the answer to every question we should ask, He even knows the questions we should have asked when we did not ask anything.

Yahuah is measureless in all He does; we call this omnipotence. There is nothing that He cannot do. He's not limited in his ability in any aspect. He has never gotten better because He's always been as good as He can get!

Yahuah's Greatness is untouchable, He is awesome because He is holy and eternal. He is without the element of corruption. He will never tire, never faint, never falter, never fail. He never had a beginning and will never see an end!

Yahuah's Greatness is unmatchable, priceless. Who but YHVH could beautifully design this creation and could spread out the enormity of space, who but Him could set in motion the events of your life, who but Him would love sinners so much to send His only Son to give each one of us a second chance.



Here again the question of Pharaoh "And who is this Elohim that I should listen to and obey?"

Pharaoh's refusal to obey Yahuah comes from His arrogance, and his arrogance came from his ignorance. By the way, one can often find the same thing

today as the source of the problem when men and women live in rebellion against the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Yahuah, the Elohim of Yashar'el reveals himself to be the Creator of heaven and earth. As the one true Elohim, he is an infinite, eternal, and morally perfect personal deity. He was, He is, and He will be! *And according to* Romans 14:11 He states: "As I live, says YHVH, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to Elohim!" There will be NO exception!

Then there is Isaiah 45:23 New American Standard Bible "I have sworn by Myself, the word has gone forth from My mouth in righteousness and will not turn back, That to Me every knee will bow, every tongue will swear allegiance."

Every tongue will confess You are Yahuah Elohim, the true Elohim. One day every knee will bow.

Still the greatest treasure remains for those who gladly choose Yahuah now and obey His voice.

For those who know the Elohim of Israel, and have experienced His glorious holiness in their lives and have developed a healthy awe for Him...Such people understand the praise and obedience due to Him and understand that there is none else to whom we owe are obedience to...It won't matter how powerful something is in our life...It won't matter because the fear of YHVH will outweigh any other outside influence in our life. It will govern every decision we make, and every action we take. If we skipped this first wisdom in our walk with HIM, and we truly want to know Him...we should pray that He instills it in us.

He who truly knows Yahuah, the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob (Yahsharel) understands who He is and knows why they should listen to His voice, as opposed to the other false, man-made in this world. As Pharaoh makes the statement in question we see that he was about to get schooled through the Divine School. In a relatively short period of time, after ten terrible plagues, Pharaoh would learn what it takes others a whole lifetime to learn. He would learn the essence of the words in Deuteronomy 6:4 and that there is nothing else to fear besides Yahuah Elohim, the only true and living Elohim, the Elohim of Israel.
