

Just for clarification: In my presentations I am using YHVH (Yahuwah) instead of LORD, which is a title and not a name and I am using Yahusha instead of Jesus, which is not a translation but a transliteration and really has no meaning, either in Hebrew nor in English! YHVH (Yahuwah) and Yahusha are the actual original names and the true nature and character of them.



We are talking about something today, which is a matter between eternal life and eternal death for every person!



The dictionary definitions of a seal are as follows:

- a) an embossed emblem, figure, symbol, word, letter, etc., used as attestation or evidence of authenticity.
- b) a mark, sign, symbol, or the like, serving as visible evidence of something, anything that serves as assurance, confirmation, or bond: She gave the plan her seal of approval.
- c) to assure, confirm, or bind with or as if with a seal: They sealed the bargain with a handshake.
- d) to decide irrevocably: to seal someone's fate.
- E(to grant under one's seal or authority, as a pardon


A seal indicates **ownership**. You don't place your seal on something that does not belong to you.



A seal indicates that one is set apart from others!

A seal indicates something of worth, something of high value. One does not seal just anything and everything, only those things that are important!





A seal indicates <u>authenticity</u>. It is a guarantee by the person doing the sealing that the thing sealed meets their criteria or is up to their standards. It guarantees that what is sealed is the real thing.

A seal is a sign of higher authority, and as such, can be trusted.



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Think of canning jars of fresh, ripe fruit. The seals preserve the fruit by keeping in what you want to keep in and keeping out the harmful bacteria that will cause the fruit to ruin. The seal protect the fruit: nothing else can get inside, and nothing that is inside is getting out.



The Bible speaks also about Seals! The word seal, seals, sealed appears in Scripture about 55 times!








And our destiny hinges upon which one we receive.

The Bible speaks about <u>two seals</u>, or <u>two marks</u>, one is called the mark of the beast and the other one is called **the seal of Elohim**, meaning the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.


There have always been two marks or signs in the Word of Yahuwah, a mark upon the righteous and a mark upon the unrighteous. This concept goes back to Cain and Abel. When Cain became angry and slew Abel, his brother, Yahuwah put a mark upon him. This mark was not a desirable mark, but it was still a mark that was put upon rebellious Cain.

Here is what it says in Genesis 4:15 (Restoration study Bible) "And Yahuwah said unto him, therefore whosoever slayeth Cain, vengeance shall be taken on him sevenfold. And Yahuwah set a mark upon Cain, lest any finding him should kill him."



This was not Yahuwah's mark, marking one of His faithful and true children, but this was the mark of a murderer. It was a mark of transgression against His law. The idea of a mark is not something new to the book of Revelation; it starts in Genesis as we just saw and continues throughout the entire Bible.

A mark upon both the righteous and the wicked and the fate of each is clearly portrayed in the story of the **Exodus from** Egypt.



There were at that time and there are two groups of people—those who were following and obeying Yahuwah's instructions and those who were following the ways of the world around them. The children of Israel had a sign, mark or seal of deliverance upon their houses, so that the angel of death would pass by.

For it states in Exodus 12:23 "For Yahuwah will pass through to smite the Egyptians, and when he seeth the blood upon the lintel, and on the two side posts, Yahuwah will pass over the door, and will not suffer the destroyer to come in into your houses to smite you." RSB



Thus it was for the people of YHVH. For those who followed and obeyed the directions of Adonai, they were preserved from the destroying angel. But it was only those who had the mark of deliverance that were saved.

If there were any of the children of Israel who did <u>not</u> have Yahuwah's mark, they were <u>not protected</u>, but rather their firstborn perished with the disobedient.



Therefore we want to focus in this presentation on the Seal of Yahuwah Elohim.

The Seal of YHVH is a vital issue in the last days that we live in now, and to know the truth about the seal is of utmost importance!





To know what the seal of YHVH consists of and how to receive it MUST receive all our attention!

There is nothing more important in this life!

First, let's remember "there is only ONE Elohim", the one that created the Heavens and the Earth, the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac andIsrael and there is none other. According to Exodus 3, 15, we are told name is! Thefigtreegeneration.net



Exodus 3:15 states in the Restoration Study Bible: "Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, Yahuwah Elohim of your fathers, the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of Jacob, hath sent me unto you, this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations."





Since our Heavenly Father has given us His name, let's call Him by His name, which I will do in this presentation!




was removed from the Inspired Scriptures, bringing great deception to the world

They Know Not What They Worship!

Let's go to Revelation 7, 2-3 to begin with: "And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living Elohim and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea, saying, Hurt not the earth neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our Elohim in their foreheads." RSB



Then we have another shocking warning in Ezekiel 9:4-6 (RSB) "And Yahuwah said unto him, Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and set a mark upon the foreheads of the men that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof.



5. And to the others he said in mine hearing, Go ye after him through the city and smite, let not your eye spare, neither have ye pity. 6. Slay utterly old and young, both maids, and little children, and women, but come not near any man upon whom is the mark, and begin at my sanctuary. Then they began at the ancient men which were before the house."



So the sealing work foretold in Ezekiel chapter 9 and Revelation chapter 7 is truly a subject that is of utmost importance for every believer in the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, because only those, who have His seal are protected!

NO SEAL, NO PROTECTION, NO SEAL "NO SALVATION!"

We need to let the Bible alone; the very Word of Yahuwah Elohim tell us what His Seal is. Satan is doing his utmost to insert error into these teachings to deceive as many as he can. This is why we need to be rooted in the Holy Scriptures, in a "Thus saith YHVH" alone!

So what does the Seal of YHVH consist of?

Some people teach that <u>only</u> the weekly Sabbath constitutes the Seal of YHVH! Is that true?

When we study Scripture, we will discover that the weekly Sabbath is only part of Yahuwah's seal!



Let's look at Ezekiel 20:11-12 (RSB) "And I gave them my statutes, and shewed them my judgments, which if a man do, he shall even live in them12. Moreover also I gave them my <u>Sabbaths</u>, to be a sign between me and them, that <u>they</u> might know that I am Yahuwah that sanctify them."

Notice that the word "Sabbaths" is plural, which must be a reference to all of the eight Sabbaths (1 weekly and 7 yearly feast Sabbaths)

We see the same in the verses of 19-20 "I am Yahuwah your Elohim, walk in my statutes, and keep my judgments, and do them; 20. And hallow my Sabbaths; and they shall be a sign between me and you, that ye may know that I am Yahuwah your Elohim."

Here again the word "Sabbaths" is plural, which must signal more than just the weekly Sabbath.

If Yahuwah was referring only to the weekly Sabbath, He would have said, "I gave them My Sabbath." (Singular)

Ezekiel 20:20 makes this point even more clear:


"And set apart My Sabbaths, and they shall be a sign between Me and you, to know that I am יהוה your Elohim." (The Scriptures)

We see in Ezekiel 20:12, 13 and 19-20 that Elohim's Sabbaths, in plural, are His sign or mark of His people, and when you read Exodus 13:9 you will see that the Feast of Unleavened bread is also His sign or mark upon His people.

"And it (the feast of Unleavened bread – verses 6 and 7) shall be as a sign to you on your hand and as a reminder between your eyes" (The Scriptures)

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However, the Seal of Yahuwah includes more than just His weekly and yearly Sabbaths as you will see from the following texts:



Let's go to Isaiah 8:16 RSB "Bind up the testimony, seal the law (#8451 – Torah) among my disciples."

Here is the same verse from "the Scriptures" "Bind up the witness, seal the Torah among my taught ones."

Here is the translation of the Jewish Translation Society Bible saying "Bind up the testimony, seal the instruction among My disciples."



The prophet Isaiah is turning to Yahuwah with the plea **to seal** the Torah, Yahwes instructions **and** the testimony **into the hearts of his disciples**, so that they can not be moved or be deceived by false doctrines and teachings but be able to stand firm.

As one binds and seals a scroll, so the Torah and testimony are kept safe in the hearts of His people! They are sealed. Torah becomes part of their life to guide their thoughts and actions.



The Torah (Yahuwah's instructions) should be thoroughly taught in order that His people are firmly grounded in the truth, so they can pass this knowledge on to others. While there are many antagonistic teachings and theories around, the Torah of Yahuwah is the only infallible guide, by which all opinions, teachings and theories must be examined and proved.

The word for "testimony", which is being used in this text is "H8584 from H5749 te'udah" in Hebrew and is found only three times in Scripture (Ruth 4:7; Isaiah 8:16 and 20) and means testimony, attestation, confirmation. We could say testimony is the prophetic word as a confirmation of the plan of salvation.

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Then we have the same instructions in Deuteronomy 6, 1-8, where it states: "Now these are the commandments, which Yahuwah your Elohim commanded to teach you, that ye might do them5. thou shalt love Yahuwah thy Elohim with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. 6. And these words, which I command thee tis day, shall be in thine heart

"These words" spoken of in verse six (6) is the whole Mosaic Law, called the Torah! It continues in verse 7: And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down and when thou risest up. 8. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes 9. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates." RSB



"The commandments, statutes and the judgments" mentioned in these verses is the Mosaic Law, the Torah, which is the seal of Yahuwah, being placed upon the foreheads of His people, just as we read in Revelation. Therefore, we should study the commandments, statutes and the judgments diligently to know what they are, since they all constitute the seal of Yahuwah!





Let's go to another verse in Scripture to Revelation 14:1. Here we read: "And I looked, and lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads." RSB Or Revelation 22:4 talking about the redeemed, states: "And they shall see his face and his name shall be in their foreheads." RSB

Some texts read: having His Name and His Father's Name.

These verses in Revelation tell us that those who receive Yahuwah's seal, have "HIS NAME" written in their foreheads and according to Exodus 3:15 His name is "YHVH".



Remember the promise of YHVH in Isaiah 52:6 "....My people shall know my name....!"


His name is not just a literal name, even though important, but it does have a deeper meaning as we can see in Exodus 34:5-7:



stood with him there and proclaimed the name of Yahuwah.
6. And Yahuwah passed by before him, and proclaimed,
Yahuwah, Yahuwah El, merciful and gracious, longsuffering,
and abundant in goodness and truth. 7. Keeping mercy for
thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin"







When we go to John chapter 1, we will discover that the Word is a person by the name of Yahusha!

John 1:1 and 14 (KJV) "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with Elohim, and the Word was Elohim. 14. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth."

Yahusha confirmed both His Father's literal name <u>and</u> His Father's character while on earth.

John 17:6 (The Scriptures) states: "I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word."

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In Exodus 23:21 we see a prophecy that the one sent to rescue Israel, and all of mankind as well, carries the Father's literal Name within his own name: "Be on guard before Him and obey His voice. Do not rebel against Him, for He is not going to pardon your transgression, for My Name is in Him." This can be easily seen in bellow's example!



As an example, if the Father's last name is Smith, so is the son's. The Heavenly Father and the Son also share the family Name, "Yah", in their own names.

By the way, Yahusha means: "Yahuwah is salvation!"

Another point or question is "How could the Father have a Hebrew name and His Son have a Greek name, which doesn't mean anything?" Think about it!



There is overwhelming proof, showing that the Name of Yahuwah has been completely erased from the Holy Scriptures, and from common knowledge and use altogether, because of the man-made traditions of our forefathers and rabbis. However, according to Isaiah 52:6 His people will know His name and His name will be in their forehead!

Besides having His Father's literal name incorporated into His name, Yahusha reflected the Father's character. He was the exact image of his Father in thinking and action and the same will be true with His followers.

They will know His name, call upon that name and reflect his character, which is outlined in his Torah with the statutes, judgments and commandments.

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The fundamental essence of Yahuwah's nature and character is "LOVE". It is His very being! The apostle John wrote in 1. John 4, 8 "Elohim (YHVH) is LOVE!" He started out the sentence by saying: "He that loveth not, knoweth not Elohim..." Such person does not know YHVH!



What does that mean?



If we do not know YHVH, he does not know us! That means He would not be able to seal us. That simply means salvation!" RSB

In the previous verse 7, John says: "Beloved, let us love one another for love is of Elohim, and everyone that loveth is born of Elohim, and knoweth Elohim."

The love towards **Elohim** is expressed only in obedience to His instructions and by loving our neighbor, each other!


Revelation 14:12 says "Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of Yahuwah, and the faith of Yahusha."

In the last days, Yahuwah will have a group of people that are following Torah with the statutes and judgments, which includes the weekly and yearly Sabbath days, as well as His literal name and they will reflect His character.

Yahuwah can and will <u>seal only those people</u> by His Holy Spirit <u>that bear a likeness to Yahusha in character</u>, those who overcome, the world, the flesh and the devil, those that obey His Torah with the statutes, judgments and commandments!



In Ezekiel 18, 5-9 is the proof, of who YHVH can and will accept as His own and will put His stamp of approval on, His seal: "...if a man be just, and do that which is lawful and right 6. And hath not eaten upon the mountains, neither hath lifted up his eyes to the idols of the house of Israel, neither hath defiled his neighbor's wife, neither hath come near to a menstruous women, 7. And hath not oppressed any, but hath restored to the debtor his pledge,



......hath spoiled none by violence, <u>hath given his bread to the hungry</u>, and hath covered the naked with a garment. 8. He that hath not given forth upon usury, neither hath taken any increase, that hath withdrawn his hand from iniquity, hath executed true judgment between man and man, 9. <u>Hath walked in my statutes and hath kept my judgments</u>, to deal truly, he is just, he shall <u>surely live</u>, saith my Sovereign Yahuwah." *RSB*



Let's see what some other translations have to say about the last sentence:

The Good News Bible: "He is righteous, and he will live," says the Sovereign LORD."


Elohim's Word: This person is righteous. He will certainly live," declares the Almighty LORD."

Contemporary English Version: "This man is good, and I promise he will live."

Does that sound like a sealing message?

The same is brought out in Psalm 15 (RSB):

- 1. Yahuwah, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? Who shall dwell in thy holy hill?
- 2. He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart.
- 3. He that backbiteth not with his tongue, nor doeth evil to his neighbor, nor taketh up a reproach against his neighbor.



Continuing Psalm 15 (RSB):

4. In whose eyes a vile person is contemned, but he honoureth them that fear Yahuwah. He that sweareth to his own hurt, and changeth not. 5. He that putteth not out his money to usury, no taketh reward against the innocent. He that doeth these things shall never be moved.



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In the Good News Bible the last sentence is translated as: "Whoever does these things will always be secure."

The Good's Word translation says: "Whoever does these things will never be shaken."

The International Standard Version states: "The one who does these things will stand firm forever."

The Modern King James Version says "He who does these things shall not be moved forever."


Does that sound like "being sealed"? Absolutely, but there is another condition!

In Matthew 10:22 Yahusha says (KJV) "but he that endureth to the end shall be saved."

BBE "but he who is strong to the end will have salvation."

Easy to Read Version: "But the one who remains faithful to the end will be saved."

1899 Douay – Rheims Bible: "but he that shall persevere unto the end, he shall be saved."







Therefore, the teaching "once saved, always saved" is not true, it is a lie! All one has to read is Ezekiel 18: 24 to 28!

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1. Timothy 4:1 states (KJV) "Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils."


The teaching "once saved, always saved" is one of those doctrines, telling people that are saved or sealed, when they are not! This is a false security!






Another false doctrine (a false security) is that all you have to do is believe on or in Yahusha (aka Jesus) to receive the benefit of all His promised blessings, including salvation, His Seal of acceptance! However, to believe doesn't only mean to recognize Yahusha Ha Mashiach as your Savior. Believing in the Messiahs also means accepting and obeying all of His Commandments, statutes and judgments.

Think about the words in 1. John 2, 3-4 "And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his (Torah) commandments. 4 He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him."






1. John 5:3 states: "For this is the love of Elohim, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous." KJV

James says in chapter 2, 19 and 20 "Thou believest that there is one Elohim; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

20. But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? "

Without works, NO SEAL!



We have several examples in Scripture of people, that were righteous before YHVH. One pf them we find in Luke 1, 6 with Zacharias and his wife Elisabeth. It says: "And they were both righteous before Elohim, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of Yahuwah blameless."



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1 like to remind us of the words of Samuel to Saul in 1. Samuel 15: 22-23 "And Samuel said, hath Yahuwah as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of Yahuwah? Behold to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.

23. For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of Yahuwah, he hath also rejected thee from being king." (RSB)



Without obedience to His Commandments, Statutes and Judgements, there will be no Seal of Acceptance, or salvation!



2. Timothy 2:19 (The Scriptures) "..... the solid foundation of Elohim stands firm, having this seal, " הוה knows those who are His," and, "Let everyone who names the Name of Messiah turn away from unrighteousness."

In order to receive the seal of Acceptance, Yahuwah's people MUST stay away from ALL unrighteousness and have nothing to do with it!

Paul states in 2. Corinthians 6:14-17 (The Scriptures) "Do not become unevenly yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness? And what fellowship has light with darkness? 15 And what agreement has Messiah with Beliya'al? Or what part does a believer have with an unbeliever? 16 And what union has the Dwelling Place of Elohim with idols? For you are a

dwelling Place of the living Elohim, as Elohim has said, "I shall dwell in them and walk among them, and I shall be their Elohim, and they shall be My people."

7Do not be unequally

What are the instructions for believers according to 2. Corinthians 6:17 (The Scriptures) "Therefore, Come out from among them and be separate, says יהוה and do not touch what is unclean, and I shall receive you."



In order to receive the seal of Yahuwah, the seal of Acceptance, His people must come out of the world, be separate and touch not anything unclean!

Leviticus 5:17 YHVH states (KJV): "And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of Yahuwah, though he wist it not, <u>yet is he guilty</u>, and shall bear his iniquity."

Here is the same verse in the NIV "If anyone sins and does what is forbidden in any of Elohim's commands, even though they do not know them, they are guilty and will be held responsible."



In proverbs 16, 25 it states (RSB): "There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death." Ignorance is no excuse for error or sin, when there is every opportunity to know the will of Yahuwah!



Let's take one example and read part of Jeremiah 10:1-4 and 15 "Thus says YHVH: "Do not learn the way of the Gentiles 3. For the customs of the peoples are futile; For one cuts a tree from the forest, 4. They decorate it with silver and gold; 15. They are futile; In the time of their punishment they shall perish." NIV




In the time of judgment, these idols will be destroyed and also the people that served them!

Why follow these customs, which are an abomination to Heaven?



Yahusha, our Savior confirms what we just read in Jeremiah. Here are His words in Mark 7:6-9 "..This people HONOURETH ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR FROM ME. 7. HOWBEIT NOTED THEY WORSHIP ME, TEACHING FOR DOCTRINES THE COMMANDMENTS OF MEN. 9...Full well ye reject the commandment of Elohim, that ye may keep your own tradition." RSB



When we follow the commandments of men instead of Yahuwah's instructions, our worship becomes vain, empty, hollow, and useless. That means our Father is displeased, we are not being sealed, that means "No Salvation"!





We read in Hosea 4:6 (KJV) "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the Torah (law) of thy Elohim, I will also forget thy children."

Ignorance is a playground for demons. 2. Corinthians 11:14 says: "Satan transforms himself into an angel of light."

Ignorance of the word of Yahuwah will set you up for deception.

Ignorance is one of the curses which comes upon people for failure to obey His Word.




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Deuteronomy 28:28 says, "Yahuwah shall smite thee with madness, and blindness, and astonishment of heart." RSB There are so many false doctrines in Christianity today, it would take a book to deal with them all. One of the biggest one is the replacement theology.



Colossians 2:8 RSB "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Messiah."


And 2. Peter 2, 1-2 RSB "But there were false prophets also among the people even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in destructive heresiesAnd many shall follow their pernicious ways, by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of."



It was Yahuwah's plan for His people to be in unity! There is only ONE body, ONE assembly! Our Messiah does not have many different bodies, like over 41,000 denominations, sects, churches, divided from each other!




Let's read 1. Corinthian 1;10 (The Scriptures) "....I appeal to you, brothers, by the Name of our Master יהושע Messiah, that you all agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be knit together in the same mind and in the same opinion."



What we just read in 1. Corinthians 1:10 condemns denominationalism as sin! This is not what I say, these are Paul's words and they agree with the prayer of Yahusha to His Father in John 17:21 "that they all might be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You, so that they too might be one in Us, so that the world might believe that You have sent Me."

There is no way that YHVH can and will bless such confusion and disunity and put HIS seal of approval on it, because He is not the author of confusion! (1. Cor 14:33)




Travel the same road, therefore we are commanded to prove ALL things and test the Spirits by a "Thus saith YHVH"!



Isaiah 59:14 says, "Truth is fallen in the street!" These are the words of Elohim and His condemnation of the nation of Israel, because they had left the truth. When truth is fallen or when truth is missing in action, then wickedness rules. That is our condition today, good is called evil and evil is called good!

What does Scripture say about that in Isaiah 5:20 KJV
"Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!"



We need <u>absolute biblical truth</u>, if we want to receive YHVH's seal of Acceptance. His instructions are vital and **they are not open to our interpretation**. This was the very first sin recorded in the Garden of Eden. Satan said to Eve "Has Elohim said you shall not eat of every tree"? In other wordsto question Yahuwah's authority is a very foolish thing to do!

This is happening all over Christianity!

Pews in churches are filled with people, who **practice** "religion" on weekends, but when they leave these buildings, they revert to their old ways of living the ways of the world.




Again, the question "what is the seal?"



In short "the Seal of YHVH is Truth" and according to Psalm 119:142 His instruction, called the Torah is the Truth, the spiritual manna from Heaven!

That is the written Torah with the commandments, statutes and judgments, which includes the weekly and yearly Sabbath days, His name and His son's name, the dietary laws etc. without the ordinances of the altar and the temple services, because Yahusha was the ultimate sacrifice!




"..thy Torah (law) is the truth."

Psalm 119:142 KJV

In addition, we have the living Torah, called Yahusha Ha Mashiach, as a SEAL. "He is the way, the truth and the life." (John 14:6 KJV)

John 3:36 states (The Scriptures) "He who believes in the Son possesses everlasting life, but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of Elohim remains on him."

"..thy Torah (law) is the truth." Psalm 119:142 KJV



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While here on earth, Yahusha, the living Torah, offered the enduring spiritual nourishment of truth. He communicated truth by accurately revealing His Father in His teachings, actions and person.




THENTHE QUESTION "WHO ONLY WILL BE SEALED?"

Only those will be sealed, who accept the Hebrew Yahusha as their Messiah, and humble themselves before Him, call upon His name, repent, confess their sins, be baptized in HIS name and walk in His footsteps, which means from now on obeying His commandments, statutes and judgments, which include His weekly and Yearly Sabbath days. They will obey and proclaim His authority, rather than the doctrines, teachings and commandments of man.



When we think about the Bible verses mentioned in this presentation, it should be absolutely clear, that our Heavenly Father can not seal anyone, accept him or her into His kingdom and give them eternal life that refuses to come under His

Torah with the statutes, judgments and commandments in this life and in the world to come.



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If you make the decision to follow Yahusha all the way, you may feel you are all alone, many of your supposed friends will leave you, but you are not alone, because YHVH made the promise in Isaiah 41:10:

"Fear thou not; for I [am] with thee: be not dismayed; for I [am] thy Elohim: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness." KJV



Shema in Hebrew means "Hear and Do!"

Deuteronomy 6, 4-9 (RSB)

- 1. Hear, O Israel: Yahuwah our Elohim is one Yahuwah:
- 5. And thou shalt love Yahuwah thy Elohim with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
- 6. And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart.



Shema in Hebrew means "Hear and Do!"

- 7. And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.
- 8. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.
- 9. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates.

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
