Prayer Needs


-For the student's hearts of the first discipleship training course to be open and ready to see God through a whole new way.

WDTC Construction Updates

The renovations for the training center have been coming along. New tile has been put in, bathrooms had a much needed redo, one large room has been divided into 3 rooms,



furniture has been built, and electrical has been upgraded. All improvements have been done by locals. Your contributions and support have created jobs and sustainability. The next hurdle is to furnish the training center. We have beds that need mattresses, a classroom that needs a table and chairs, and so on. Women's Bible Study Updates

One of the greatest needs for women in Haiti is having the resources to encourage them into a deeper relationship with their Heavenly Father. Between the lack of resources and their Pastors only "spoon-feeding" them the Word, they live each day with a spiritual void. This is NOT OK! This needs to be changed. Since ALOH has started producing Bible studies 2 years ago, there have been 3 Bible studies written and published in their native language. Word has spread like wildfire that these resources have become available and the demand has been overwhelming.
