Our Women's Ministry Director, Dieula, led our first class in the **NEW** discipleship training center on September 19, 2018! Seven women spent 3 months going through the training. Here are some quotes from Dieula about the experience:

"For the first couple of weeks we had some strong attacks from the evil one. I wanted to give up and felt that I wasn't strong enough to fight all the scary things about voodoo. I prayed and I knew the ALOH board was praying. I know that Jesus is stronger!"

"One of the things that made my heart happy was to hear the students say that our churches need to know about discipling and all the good things we are learning about here at the discipleship center. Discipleship was completely new to them because churches here don't do it"

"Some of the women were dealing with fear and trusting the power of God. This is the influence of voodoo in this country. One of the students was putting her trust in her mother, who practices voodoo, thinking she would be protected. By the end of the training I watched her heart change and she no longer called to her mother, but to Jesus for protection! This is why discipling is so important for the change of Haiti. There can be a revival if Haitians start discipling Haitians. They need to know that Jesus is the mighty one and that HE is greater than voodoo!"
