Civil unrest in Haiti

All of us at ALOH covet your prayers for the country of Haiti. The country is in a time of agony as they try to navigate their way through the deadlock. A political uproar between oppositions has caused the country to come to a halt. The political opposition of the president is paying gangs and thugs to riot, manifest and completely block roads in an extreme attempt to throw out the president. These actions have created an unstable country that is hanging on by hope. Businesses are closing, basic food prices have tripled, fuel is sparse on the island, school has been out for 9 weeks, the fragile healthcare is slowly shutting down, and that's some of the issues. Thankfully through this, the ministry has been able to continue with classes. It is uncertain how long this will endure and what the catastrophic magnitude this will have on Haiti.

Women's Discipleship Training Center

ALOH is currently running its 3rd Discipleship Training class. There are five women enrolled and they range in age from in their 20's to 50's. Seeing the intergenerational class come together as one force for His Kingdom, is paramount to awakening revival in their country. A country run by a corrupt government and power, that is in the middle of its worst civil unrest. These classes work to equip and train indigenous female leaders. Leaders who will continue to forward the Kingdom movement in their families, churches and communities. Along side the Discipleship Essentials workbook, the women have learned the art of crochet as a business and baking/cooking skills. They also participate in an in-depth study on prayer and the Holy Spirit. Over the final month of class they will learn how to make an all purpose liquid soap, goat farming, women's health, leadership skills and business management. Graduation is set to take place December 12 where there will be a celebration and commissioning.
