

Cold Comfort

Officer Gunnhildur, recently promoted from her post in rural Iceland to Reykjavík's Serious Crime Unit, is tasked with hunting down escaped convict Long Ommi, who has embarked on a spree of violent score-settling in and around the city. Meanwhile, she's also investigating the murder of a fitness guru in her own city-center apartment. As Gunna delves into the cases, she unearths some unwelcome secrets and influential friends shared by both guru and convict. Set in an Iceland plagued by an ongoing financial crisis, Gunna has to take stock of the whirlwind changes that have swept through the country—and the fact that at the highest levels of power, the system's endemic corruption still leads, inevitably, to murder.

Quentin Bates escaped English suburbia as a teenager, jumping at the chance of a gap year working in Iceland. For a variety of reasons, the gap year stretched to become a gap decade, during which time he went native in the north of Iceland, acquiring a new language, a new profession and a family...

He is the author of a series of crime novels set in present-day Iceland – and as a translator he has worked with some of Iceland's coolest writers, including Lilja Sigurðardóttir, Sólveig Pálsdóttir, Stella Blómkvist, Einar Kárason, Ragnar Jónasson, Jónína Leósdóttir, Óskar Guðmundsson and more.



Norway has the World's Longest Undersea Road Tunnel

The Ryfylke Tunnel in Norway is the world's longest and deepest undersea road tunnel, stretching 14.4 km and reaching a depth of 292 meters below sea level.



- It is part of the Ryfast tunnel system, connecting Stavanger with Ryfylke, significantly reducing travel time and eliminating the need for ferries.
- Construction began in 2013, and the tunnel officially opened on December 30, 2019, as a key infrastructure improvement for the region.


