




President's Column



MEMBERSHIP MATTERS by Floyd Downs, Membership Secretary

LAST CALL REMINDER!!!!



After recently reviewing our Desert Fjord membership list I noted that several of our members

can expect dues reminders coming from SON Headquarters during the remaining months of 2017. Therefore in the spirit of "membership matters" I am beginning this month's message by repeating what I wrote last June, to wit:

"To all members receiving news from SON-Minneapolis that dues payment is coming due in 2017, be sure to make renewal payment promptly, but especially before December 31st, because on January 1, 2018 the dues structure changes. The membership fee for an individual, now \$52.50, rises to \$60, and the spousal fee, currently \$40.50, will be included in the new category of Family Membership with a fee of \$95. This will include the individual member, spouse and other family members. Thus the current "family fee" totaling \$93 will see a small rise to \$95."

Good news! We have three new members this month. Dr. Kristin Hanson of Phoenix has signed in as a SON member, and the Bergo's grandchildren, Hannah Bergo and Nicholas Bergo are now Desert Fjord members. Although Hannah and Nicholas, both in their teens, live with their parents in California, we welcome them to our lodge here in Arizona.

Several of our lodge members have volunteered to represent the five SON AZ lodges at the MIM (Musical Instruments Museum) in Phoenix the first weekend in December. We thank them all for coming forth in response to Coordinator Ed Bergo's call. Ross Berg and I, as in past years, will help in organizing the presentation table.

Please keep spreading the news of the benefits of Sons of Norway via Desert Fjord membership to all those of Scandinavian heritage. Yes, we accept the Swedes, the Finns, and any other friendly folk who wish to join with us.

As I've noted previously, keeping our own databases current is an ongoing challenge, especially when members do not report changes directly to us or if some of their incoming e-mail messages may be deleted or allocated to spam. This includes telephone number changes. I've heard that some phone numbers as currently listed in the SON membership roster are no longer valid. A similar reminder pertains to postal addresses. Please let us know of any changes so that we can maintain effective communication with you.
