



A Book Review by Jan Johnson

When the Devil Holds the Candle

By Karin Fossum



When the theft of a purse from a stroller results in an infant's death, two teenagers are in trouble. Unaware of the enormity of their crime, Zipp and Andreas are intent on committing still another. They follow an elderly woman home, and Andreas



enters her house with his ever-reliable switchblade. Motionless in the dark, Zipp waits for his friend to come out.

Inspector Konrad Sejer and his colleague Jacob Skarre see no connection between the infant's death and the reported disappearance of a local delinquent. And so while the confusion in the world outside mounts, the chilling, heartstopping truth unfolds inside the old woman's home.

Unflappable as ever, Sejer digs below the surface of small-town tranquillity in an effort to understand how and why violence destroys everyday lives. Another

brilliantly observed, precisely rendered psychological mystery from the highly acclaimed Karin Fossum.

Born on 6 November 1954 in <u>Sandefjord</u>, in Vestfold county, Norway, Karin Fossum currently lives in <u>Sylling</u>, near Oslo. She debuted as a poet with Kanskje i morgen, her first collection published in 1974 when she was just 20. It won Tarjei Vesaas' debutantpris. For a time she worked in hospitals, nursing homes and assisted with rehabilitation of drug addicts. She is often referred to as "the Norwegian queen of crime".


