Protecting your private information is our priority.

This Statement of Privacy applies to <u>www.ipermit.biz</u>, or i-Permit, LLCApps and governs your data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to i-Permit, LLC mobile app.

We have developed this policy in order for you to understand how we collect, use, communicate and make use of your Personal information. The following outlines our privacy policy. Pursuant to the effect of Article 13 of the New European Regulation 2016/679 concerning the protection of individuals with regards to the processing of personal data (GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION – GDPR).

As required by the General Data Protection Regulation of the European Union (GDPR 2016/679, Article 13), before proceeding with processing, the interested party (User of the website www.ipermit.biz and I-Permit, LLCapp) is informed that personal data collected through the website/app are subject to processing by the Company through IT and/or telematics tools, for the purposes indicated in this policy.

SERVICE DESCRIPTION

i-Permit It's a mobile parking app, where customers pay an hourly daily or monthly rate a based on the location. They are required to register vehicle year make model and tag number and park at i-Permit approved location

1. INTRODUCTION

This is a notice to inform you of what I-Permit, LLCpolicy is about, and all information that we record about you. It sets out the conditions under which we may process any information that we collect from you, or that you provide to us. It covers information that could identify you ("personal information") and information that could not. In the context of the law and this notice, "process" means collect, store, transfer, use or otherwise act on information.

- 1. We regret that if there are one or more points below with which you are not satisfied, your only recourse is to refuse to use the application.
- 2. I-Permit, LLCtakes seriously, the protection of your privacy and confidentiality. We understand that all users of our website/ app are entitled to know that their personal data/information will not be used for any purpose unintended by them, and will not be sold or provided to any third party.
- 3. I-Permit, LLCtakes responsibility to preserve the confidentiality of all information that is provided to us.
- 4. The law requires us to inform you of your rights and our obligations in regards to the processing and control of your personal data.
- 5. Except as set out below, we do not share, or sell, or disclose to a third party, any information collected through our website and app.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. By using our website/mobile app, subscribing to the newsletter, submitting a complaint, withdrawing from the contract or simply contacting us, you provide us your personal data and we guarantee that your data will remain confidential, secure and will not be available to any third party without your permission.
- 2. We entrust the processing of personal data only to verified and trusted entities providing services related to the processing of personal data.
- 3. We use a Google Analytics tool that collects information about your website visits, such as the subpages that you have viewed, the time you spent on the website, and the transitions between individual subpages. For this purpose, cookies files are used for the Google Analytics service. As part of the mechanism for managing cookie settings, you have the option of deciding whether we will be able to use marketing functions or not as part of the Google Analytics service.
- 4. We use our own cookies for the proper functioning of the site.

3. LEGAL BASIS AND PURPOSE OF PROCESSING

The personal data provided by the User when browsing the website or using our mobile app are processed by the Data Controller in accordance with the current regulations for the protection of personal data.

The legal basis of the processing is identified in the provision of its services by the Company, in the management and facilitation of the website/app, as well as in the establishment, execution and possible termination of online contract concluded between the parties, and in the obligations of the same contract connected either directly and/or indirectly deriving from it.

The processing of your personal data is aimed at pursuing the following purposes:

4. SUBSCRIPTION TO THE NEWSLETTER:

If you want to subscribe to the newsletter, you must provide us with your e-mail address. The data provided to us when subscribing to the newsletter is used to send you a newsletter, and the legal basis for their processing is your consent (art. 6 (1) letter and GDPR) when you subscribe to the newsletter. The data will be processed for the duration of the newsletter operation, unless you cancel your receipt earlier, which will delete your data from the database. At any time, you can correct your data stored in the newsletter database, as well as request their removal, giving up receiving the newsletter. You also have the right to transfer the data referred to in art. 20 GDPR.

5. WE MAY GATHER ADDITIONAL PERSONAL OR NON-PERSONAL INFORMATION IN THE FUTURE.

i-Permit, LLCencourages you to review the privacy statements of app or website you choose to link to from i-Permit, LLC so that you can understand how the app or website collect, use and share your information. i-Permit, LLC is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on app outside of the i-Permit app.

6. HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA:

In this Section we have described:

- (a)the general categories of personal data that we may process;
- (b)the purposes for which we may process personal data; and
- (c)the legal bases of the processing.
- 1. We may process data about your use of our website/app and services ("usage data"). The usage data may include [your IP address, geographical location, browser type and version, operating system, referral source, length of visit, page views and website navigation paths, as well as information about the timing, frequency and pattern of your service use]. The source of the usage data is our analytics tracking system. This usage data may be processed

for the purposes of analysing the use of the website and services. The legal basis for this processing is our legitimate interests, namely monitoring and improving our website and services.

- 2. We may process information contained in any inquiry you submit to us regarding goods and/or services ("enquiry data"). The inquiry data may be processed for the purposes of offering, marketing and selling relevant goods and/or services to you. The legal basis for this processing is the performance of a contract between you and us and/or taking steps, at your request, to enter into such a contract.
- 3. We may process any of your personal data identified in this policy where necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims, whether in court proceedings or in an administrative or out-of-court procedure. The legal basis for this processing is our legitimate interests, namely the protection and assertion of our legal rights, your legal rights and the legal rights of others.
- 4. We may process any of your personal data identified in this policy where necessary for the purposes of obtaining or maintaining insurance coverage, managing risks, or obtaining professional advice. The legal basis for this processing is our legitimate interests, namely the proper protection of our business against risks.
- 5. In addition to the specific purposes of which we may process your personal data set out in this Section 6, we may also process any of your personal data where such processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which we are subject, or in order to protect your vital interests or the vital interests of another natural person.

Please do not supply any other person's personal data to us, unless we prompt you to do so.

7. WHAT INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND WHY?

We may collect information about you directly from you, as well as automatically through your use of our Site or Services. We also may collect information about you as an individual through our customers' use of the AdBeacon technology.

- Information We Collect Directly from You. Certain areas and features of our site/app and Services require registration. To register you must provide your First name, Last name, email address and password. We may collect information directly from you as a data by asking you to register vehicle year make model and tag number and park at i-Permit approved location
- We may automatically collect the following information about your use of our Site via Google Analytics including the length of time you visit our Site and your movement through our Site.

• We also may collect the following information about your use of AdRemote: mobile device ID; location and language information; device name and model; operating system type, name, and version; your activities within AdRemote; and the length of time that you are logged into AdRemote.

Unlike information we receive through a customer's use of AdBeacon technology, we may combine this information above with other information that we have collected about you, including, where applicable, your user name, your full name and password.

INFORMATION RELATING TO YOUR METHOD OF PAYMENT

First option:

I-Permit, LLC uses any of the listed as payment methods; Stripe and Apple Pay. I-Permit, LLC doesn't store information about your payment method or other means of payment when you provide it in the app without your consent.

i-Permit stores this payment information [at your request] in order to make repeat purchasing of goods and services easier for future transactions.

[We also store it to help us prevent fraud.]

i-Permit takes the following measures to protect your payment information:

- a. We keep your payment information encrypted on our servers.
- b. We do not keep all your payment information so as:
- c. to prevent the possibility of our duplicating a transaction without a new instruction from you;
- d. to prevent any other third party from carrying out a transaction without your consent

EMAIL POLICIES

We are committed to keeping your e-mail address confidential. We do not sell, rent, or lease our subscription lists to third parties, and we will not provide your personal information to any third party individual, government agency, or company at any time unless strictly compelled to do so by law.

- We will use your e-mail address solely to provide timely information about.
- We will maintain the information you send via e-mail in accordance with applicable federal law.

E-MAIL CONTACT

By contacting us via e-mail, including by sending an inquiry via the contact us page, you naturally provide us with your e-mail address as the sender's address. In addition, you can also include other personal information in the body of the message.

Your data is processed in this case in order to contact you and the basis for processing is art. 6 par. 1 lit. a GDPR, or your consent resulting from initiating contact with us. The legal basis for processing after the end of the contact is a justified purpose in the form of archiving correspondence for internal needs (art. 6 (1) (c) of the GDPR).

The content of the correspondence can be archived and we cannot clearly determine when it will be deleted. You have the right to request a communication history that you carried out with us (if it was subject to archiving), as well as request its removal unless its archiving is justified due to our overriding interests, e.g. protection against potential claims on your part.

8. WE DO NOT SELL, RENT OR LEASE ITS CUSTOMER LISTS TO THIRD PARTIES.

- i-Permit may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name,) is transferred to the third party. I-Permit, LLCmay share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to I-Permit, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.
- i-Permit will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on I-Permit or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of i-Permit; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of i-Permit, or the public.

9. INFORMATION WE PROCESS BECAUSE WE HAVE A CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATION WITH YOU

When you use I-permit, the website or mobile app, and agree to our terms and conditions, a contract is formed between you and us.

In order to carry out our obligations under that contract we must process the information you give us. Some of this information may be personal information.

We may use it in order to:

- a. verify your identity for security purposes
- b. provide you with our services
- c. provide you with suggestions and advice on services and how to obtain the most from using our website/app

I-Permit processes this information on the basis there is a contract between us, or that you have requested we use the information before we enter into a legal contract.

Additionally, we may aggregate this information in a general way and use it to provide class information, for example to monitor our performance with respect to a particular service we provide. If we use it for this purpose, you as an individual will not be personally identifiable.

I-Permit, LLCshall continue to process this information until the contract between us ends or is terminated by either party under the terms of the contract.

10. INFORMATION WE PROCESS WITH YOUR CONSENT

Through certain actions when otherwise there is no contractual relationship between us, such as when you use our website / app or ask us to provide you more information about our business, including our services, you provide your consent to us to process information that may be personal information.

- Wherever possible, we aim to obtain your explicit consent to process this information, for example, by asking you to agree to our use of cookies.

- Except where you have consented to our use of your information for a specific purpose, we do not use your information in any way that would identify you personally. - If you have given us explicit permission to do so, we may from time to time pass your name and contact information to selected associates whom we consider may provide services or products you would find useful.

I-Permit continues to process your information on this basis until you withdraw your consent or it can be reasonably assumed that your consent no longer exists. You may withdraw your consent at any time by instructing us @ info@ipermit.biz. However, if you do so, you may not be able to use our app or our services further.

11. INFORMATION WE PROCESS FOR THE PURPOSES OF LEGITIMATE INTERESTS

I-Permit may process information on the basis there is a legitimate interest, either to you or to us, of doing so.

Where we process your information on this basis, we do after having given careful consideration to:

- a. whether the same objective could be achieved through other means
- b. whether processing (or not processing) might cause you harm
- c. whether you would expect us to process your data, and whether you would, in the round, consider it reasonable to do so

For example, we may process your data on this basis for the purposes of:

- a. record-keeping for the proper and necessary administration of our business
- b. responding to unsolicited communication from you to which we believe you would expect a response
- c. protecting and asserting the legal rights of any party
- d. insuring against or obtaining professional advice that is required to manage organizational or business risk
- e. protecting your interests where we believe we have a duty to do so

12. HOW WE SHARE INFORMATION

We may share your information, including personal information, as follows:

- a. **Business Transfers**. If we are acquired by or merged with another company, if substantially all of our assets are transferred to another company, or as part of a bankruptcy proceeding, we may transfer the information we have collected to the other company.
- b. **In Response to Legal Process**. We also may disclose the information we collect from in order to comply with the law, a judicial proceeding, court order, or other legal process, such as in response to a court order or a subpoena.
- c. To Protect Us and Others. We also may disclose the information we collect where we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the safety of any person, violations of our Terms of Service or this Policy, or as evidence in litigation in which I-Permit, LLCis involved.

13. COOKIES POLICY UNDER GDPR COMPLIANCE

The i-Permit website and mobile app uses cookies. They are placed by software that operates on our servers, and by software operated by third parties whose services we use.

14. WHY WE USE COOKIES ON OUR WEBSITE

Cookies are pieces of information that a website transfers to an individual's computer hard drive for record keeping purposes. Cookies make using our Site/app easier by, among other things, saving your passwords and preferences for you. These cookies are restricted for use only on our Site, and do not transfer any personal information to any other party.

Most browsers are initially set up to accept cookies. You can, however, reset your browser to refuse all cookies or indicate when a cookie is being sent. Please consult the technical information

relevant to your browser for instructions. If you choose to disable your cookies setting or refuse to accept a cookie, some parts of the Site may not function properly or may be considerably slower.

- a. I-Permit use cookies in the following ways:
- b. To track how you use our website.
- c. To record whether you have seen specific messages we display on our website.
- d. To keep you signed in our site.
- e. To record the conversation thread during a live chat with our support team.

15. SENDING A MESSAGE TO OUR SUPPORT TEAM

When you contact us, through our app or by e-mail, we collect the data you have given to us in order to reply with the information you need.

16. **COMPLAINING**

When we receive a complaint, we record all the information you have given to us. We use that information to resolve your complaint.

If your complaint reasonably requires us to contact some other person, we may decide to give to that other person some of the information contained in your complaint. We do this as infrequently as possible, but it is a matter for our sole discretion as to whether we do give information, and if we do, what that information is.

17. ACCESS TO YOUR OWN INFORMATION

At any time you may review or update personally identifiable information that we hold about you, by contacting us.

18. REMOVAL OF YOUR INFORMATION

Note: This may limit the service we can provide to you.

19. SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Email is not recognized as a secure medium of communication. For this reason, we request that you do not send any private information to us by email. However, doing so is allowed, but at your

own risk. i-Permit may use software programs to create summary statistics, which are used for such purposes as assessing the number of visitors to the different sections of our site, what information is of most and least interest, determining technical design specifications, and identifying system performance or problem areas.

For security purposes and to ensure that this service remains available to all users, uses software programs to monitor network traffic to identify unauthorized attempts to upload or change information, or otherwise cause damage.

20. COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW

Our privacy policy has been compiled so as to comply with the United States. If you think it fails to satisfy the law of your jurisdiction, we would like to hear from you. However, ultimately it is your choice as to whether you wish to use our app.

21. REVIEW/MODIFICATION OF THIS PRIVACY POLICY
