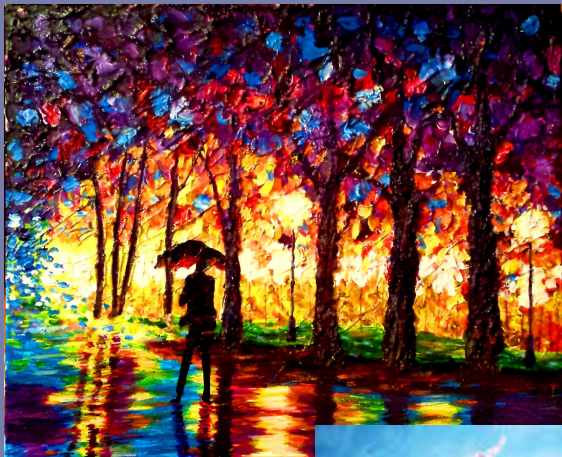
# *My* Influencer

# *Camille Clément*

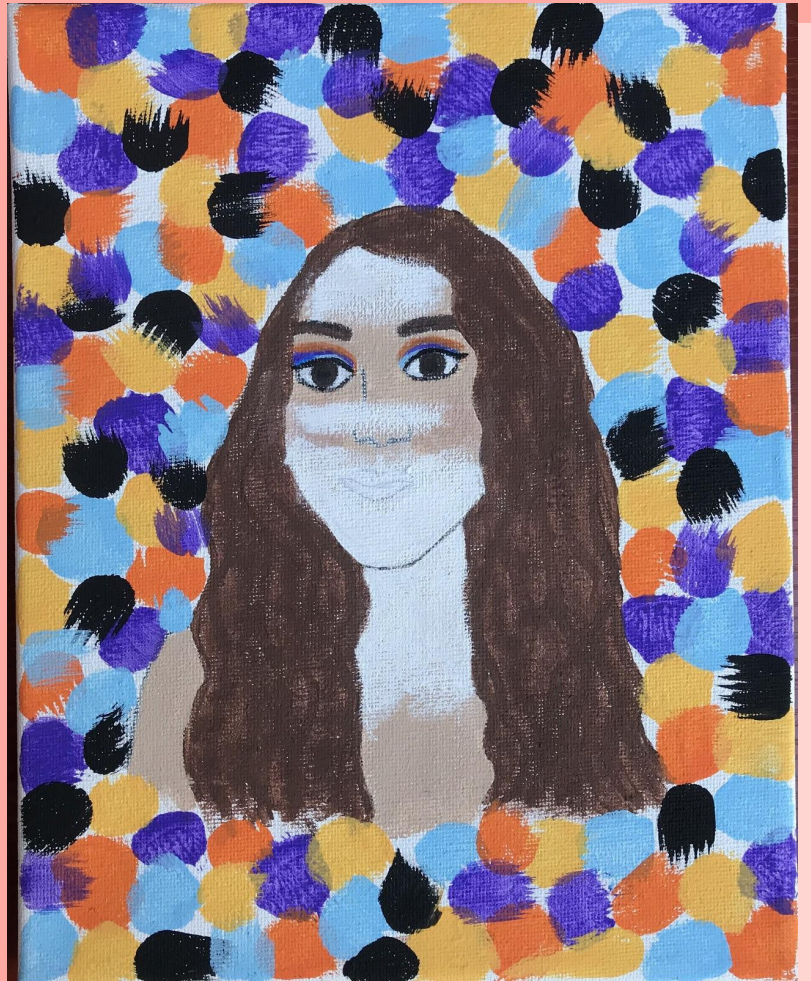

# *Unleashing My Inner Artist*

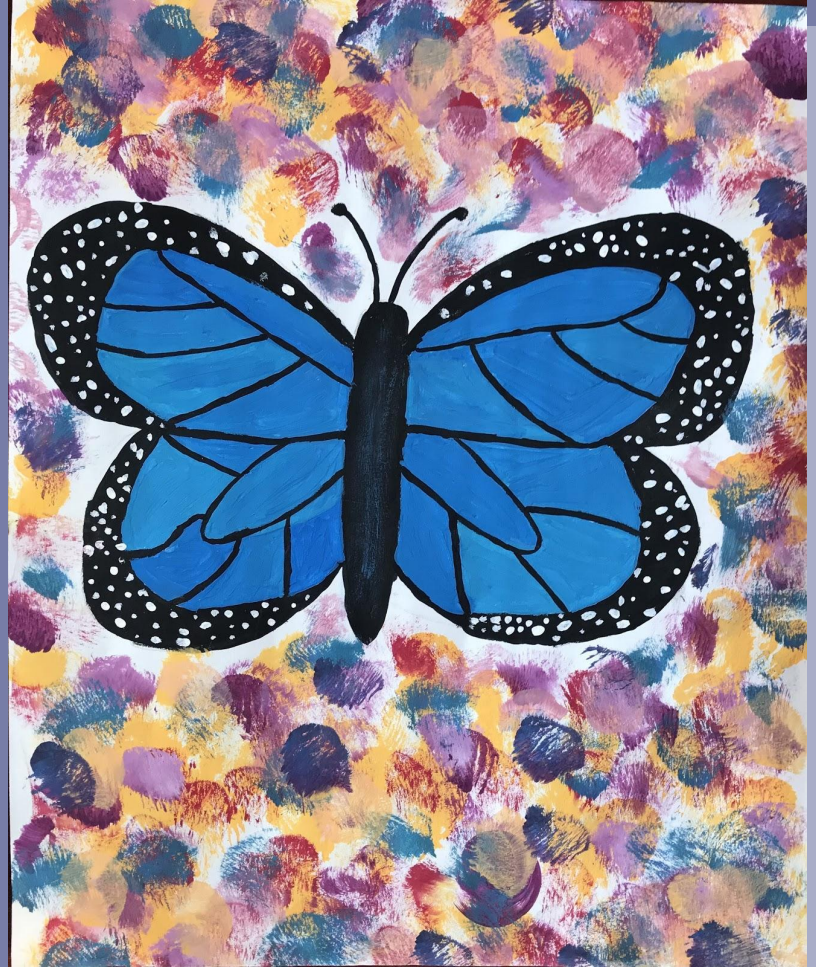

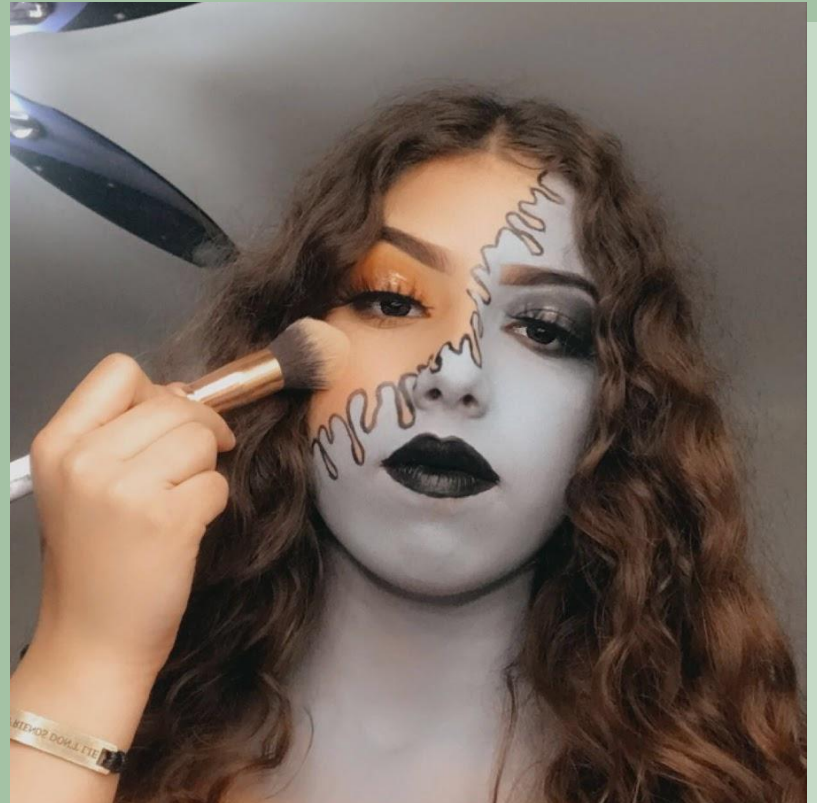
# *Pretty like a Butterfly*

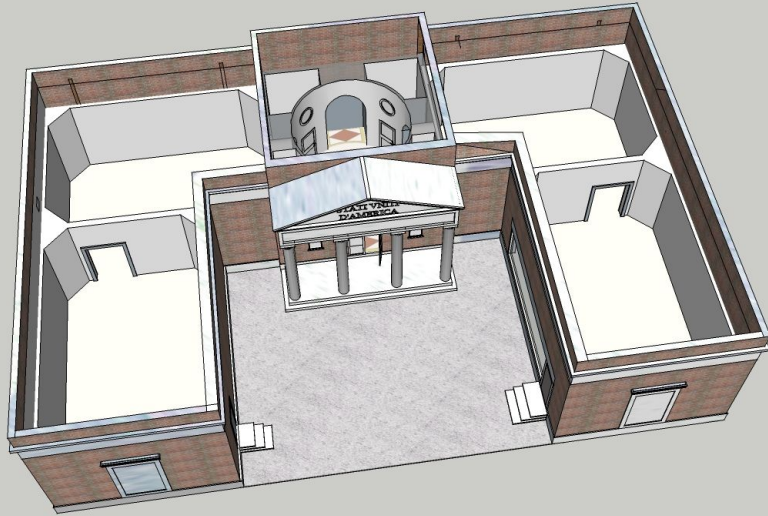

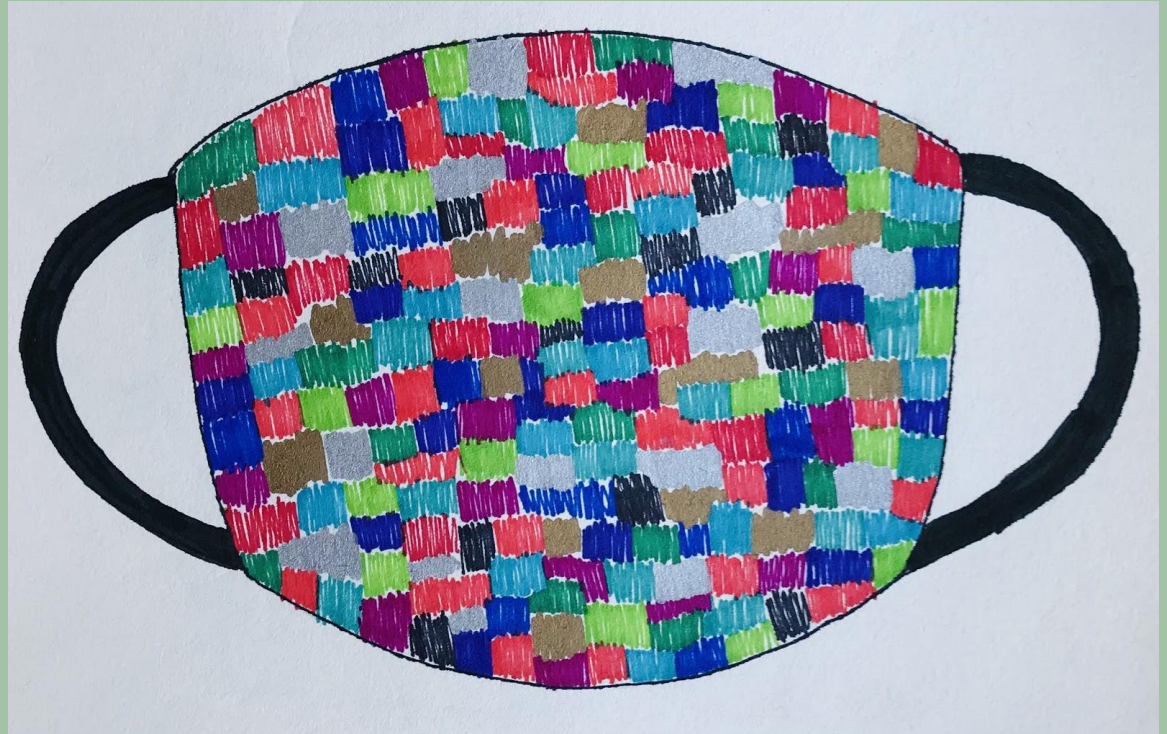
