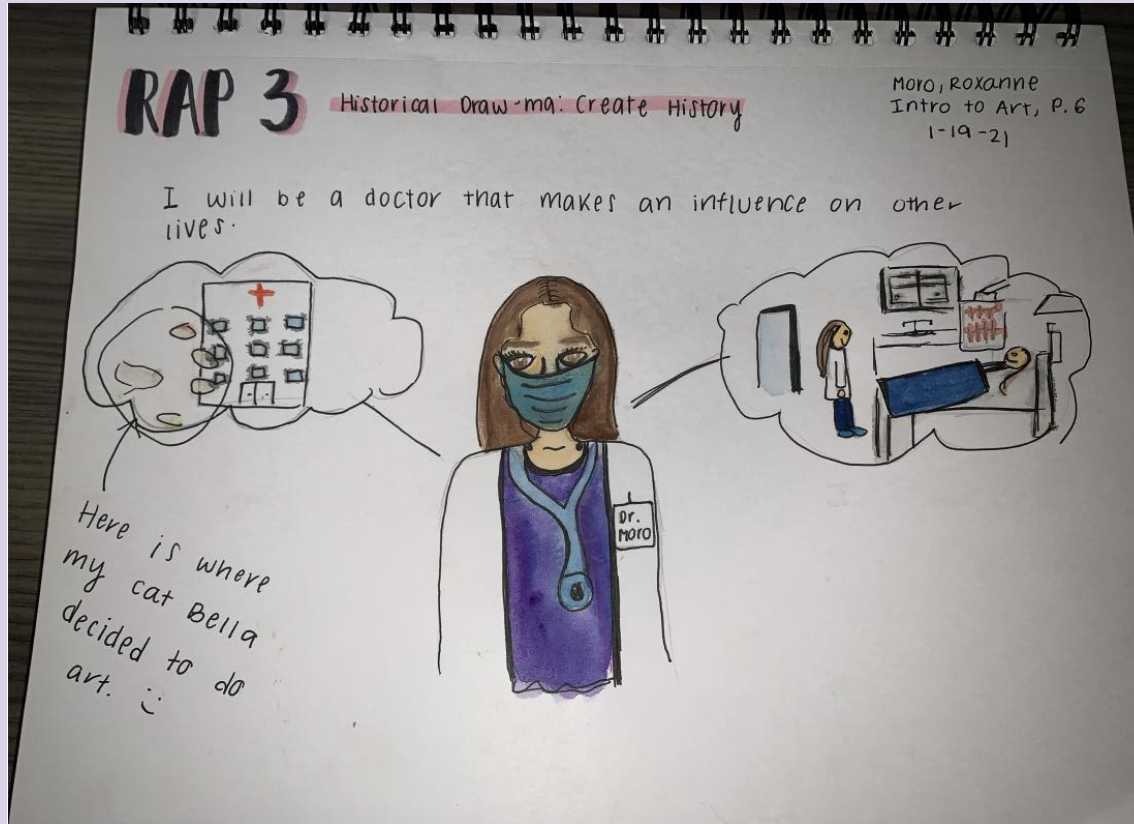

Description:

- painting
- oil and acrylic painting on linen
- size: 48" x 36"
- uses organic shape
- Description of axis: vertical
- Lines: vertical, squiggly
- the lines are thin but they help distinguish between the woman in the painting and the background
- the size of the shape, the woman is relatively large
- the woman in the painting is of color with a golden brown skin tone, brown hair, dressed in an American theme, with the colors red, white, and blue. She is wearing a white shirt with red stripes and a shawl of the American flag which drips red and blue. She has grey pants, black shoes, and a black belt as well.
- the back of the painting is a gradient, going from black to a very light grey
- there is a dripping effect done with the paint
- smooth surface

Analysis:

- this painting is of an American woman, thus the reasoning for her American shawl and color scheme.
- her American flag shawl drips red and blue to possibly signify the loss of blood.
- Her dark background and her looking into light could signify her stepping out of chaos and turmoil into a new light.
- her hair resembles the crown of the Statue of Liberty which represents freedom.

Judgment:

- This is good artwork. It shows meaning and is a powerful piece. The painting itself is beautiful and I've never seen anything quite like it.

Interpretation:

- I believe this art piece embodies America as a woman and the way she is illustrated shows the different components of it.

- I think an appropriate criterion is looking at how she used different tools, techniques, and how unique her piece is.

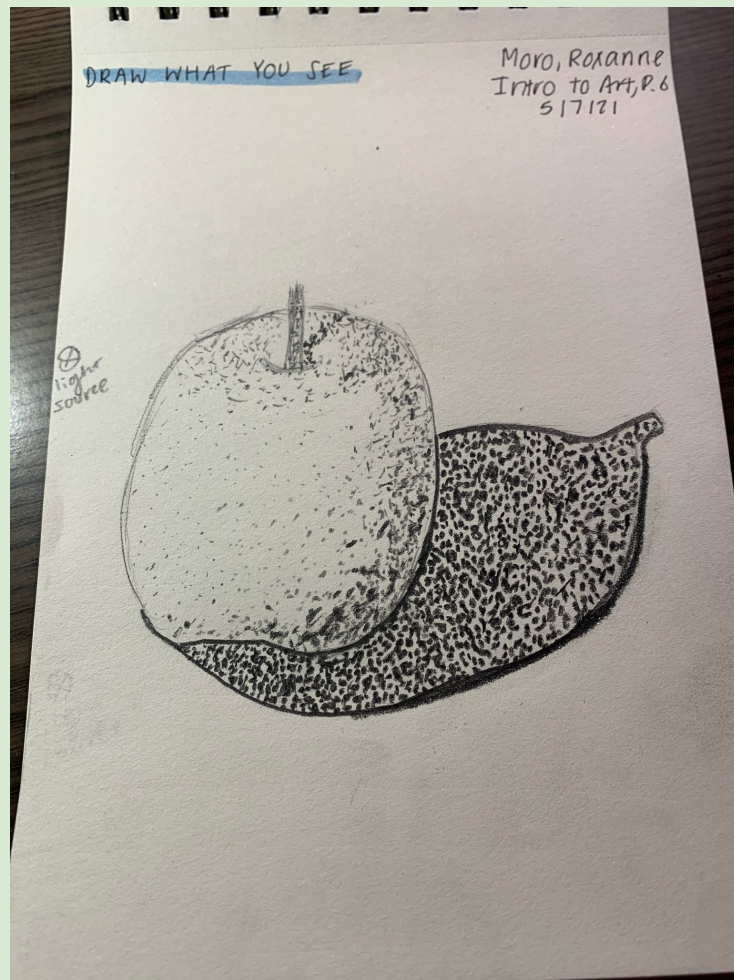
