## Rene Magritte (my influencer)


#### Biography:

Rene Magritte was born in Brussels Belgium, he's an artist who was known for his work with surrealism as well as his thought of provoking images. After attending art school in Brussels, he worked in commercial advertising to support himself while he experimented with his artworks. In the 1920s, he began to paint in the surrealist style and became known for his witty images and his use of simple graphics and everyday objects, giving new meanings to familiar things. With a popularity that increased over time, Magritte was able to pursue his art full-time and was celebrated in several international exhibitions. Magritte evoked themes of mystery and madness to challenge the assumptions of human perception.






- Butterfly






Two Sided Love



This artwork is also a representation of identity being hidden just like all the others, this artwork is a woman's face drawn with tree branches and leaves.


## Site Plan:
