Federal and state taxes were filed and paid. Some late payments, just awaiting delivery. \$9,500 was moved from savings and deposited into reserves. The size new cameras, two license plate readers, and new monitoring system was \$7,5000. IGCSA will be contributing to 'The Pot Hole Kids' donation fund. This monetary donation will contribute to the pool of donations to patch Sunnehanna.

**New Security System -** Bill Clay shared updates on the security system. Six new cameras, two new plate readers and a new monitor system have been purchased. The cameras will be placed at the front entrance and down Sunnehanna. The plate readers will be placed on either side of the of Sunnehanna to capture both sides of traffic. The new monitor system is vastly more capable than the outdated model. This will help improve with documentation and surveillance.
