

STAR TOWNSHIP CEMETERY POLICY

GROUNDS MAINTENANCE:

- A. Shrubs that currently planted must be pruned and the Grounds raked and cleaned up in May.
- B. Grounds are mowed once a month or as needed.
- C. No trees or shrubs will be allowed to be planted after May 1, 2006.
- D. Flowers and items left of grave sites:
 - 1. Must be placed near the monument to facilitate the mowing process.
 - 2. Groundskeeper may dispose of wilted flowers.
 - 3. Memorial Day: decorations may be put out no earlier than 20 days Prior to and must be removed be October 1st.
 - 4. No Glass conatiners are allowed.

MARKERS AND BASES:

- A. Tombstones and flat markers are allowed in any part of the Cemetery.
- B. Tombstones and markers must have a 4-6" base border to facilitate mowing.
- C. No gravel or decorative rock is allowed around grave markers.
- D. Must be set on foundations and set so tops are level with the sod.
- E. Must be made of granite, marble or other suitable material approved by the caretaker.
- F. Must be installed under supervision of the caretaker.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIIONS:

- A. No winter burials will be made between the dates of November 1st and April 1st, unless Cemetery Sexton deems conditions are favorable.
- B. No snowmobiles or recreational vehicles are allowed.
- C. No benches are allowed.
- D. Pets must be on a leash at all times.
- E. No mowers, trimmers, or snow blowers are allowed in the Cemetery or driveways at any time.
- F. The Cemetery is closed during the winter months.
- G. Hours the cemetery is open will be dawn to dusk only.
- H. Violations of any of the above will mean a call to the Sheriff Dept.

This Cemetery Policy was made on May 3, 2006 and revised on May 1, 2013 by the Star Township Board.
