Dynamic Urban Opportunities Foundation High School Academic Scholarship Details

The Dynamic Urban Opportunities Foundation High School Academic Scholarship consists of at least two \$2,500 non-renewable scholarships for female high school graduating seniors with academic achievement and community service. The purpose of the scholarship program is to encourage and enable female students of Black/African descent to attend college to achieve their future goals. Scholarship recipients should have a strong desire to succeed, as well as meet all the requirements outlined below. **A complete application packet must be submitted for consideration.**

Scholarship Requirements

To be eligible for the Dynamic Urban Opportunities Foundation High School Academic Scholarship, each applicant must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Must be a Black/African descent female student
- Must be currently enrolled and attending as a full-time high school senior in King or Snohomish County with an expected graduation date no later than June 30, 2022
- ✓ Demonstrate academic achievement by having a minimum 2.7 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) upon high school graduation
- ✓ Must be accepted and enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university for the 2022-2023 academic year
- ✓ Must be involved in at least one extracurricular, civic, or community activity while in high school
- ✓ Possess leadership qualities
- ✓ Show financial need
- ✓ Submit a completed application form
- ✓ Meet submittal date requirement

Award Disbursements

The scholarship award will be paid to the recipients' college or university upon receipt of enrollment verification (student must provide address where funds should be sent as well as enrollment verification).

Application Process Timeline

All applications must be submitted electronically or postmarked no later than **June 15, 2022**. Scholarship finalists will be notified by email in June 2022 with further instructions.

Pending Washington state guidance of group gatherings, awardees of the scholarships are expected to attend an award ceremony and will be notified of the date and location as more is known.

Dynamic Urban Opportunities Foundation High School Academic Scholarship Application Packet Guidelines

Each application packet must include the following information:

1. Completed Application Form

Applications must be typed or handwritten clearly. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

2. Transcript

Applicants must submit an **official transcript** from their high school with cumulative GPA listed (mailed transcript must be **sealed and unopened**). **Official transcripts** will also be accepted electronically directly from school administration. Please have your administrator email your transcript to <u>DUOFIncOrg@gmail.com</u> or mail to the attention of DUOF by **June 15, 2022**.

3. Enrollment Verification

Applicants must provide proof of enrollment as a full-time student to an accredited four-year college or university for the 2022–2023 academic year (this must be provided prior to payment of the scholarship).

4. Recommendations

Applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation describing their character and potential from the following individuals: High School counselor, current teacher, former teacher or counselor, minister, coach, community activity director, employer, etc.

These letters should be from individuals who can attest to your character, interpersonal relationships, and academic achievements and should not come from family members or peers (each recommendation should be on an official letterhead that contains an address and phone number).

5. Essay

Applicants must submit an original minimum 500-word personal statement essay responding to the questions (attach separate document: 2-4 pages in length, double-spaced, typewritten, max 12pt font):

- "Describe who has been influential in your life and that relationship has helped shape you as an individual?
- Why is college important to you and what do you hope to gain from your college experience?"
