REGISTRATION:

- Registration will begin at 9:30 a.m. Please enter Central High School through the Madison Avenue entrance (660 Madison Avenue). There will be a registration table that will have your wrist bands for all of your participants.
- Once you receive your wrist band you will be guided to your spot.
- The parade is scheduled to kick off at 11:00 a.m. from Lincoln Boulevard, turn onto Taft Avenue and then onto Park Avenue leading into Seaside Park.
- -Please remember that you CANNOT throw items from your vehicles. You can pass out information by handing it out.
- -Remember to pack sun block, pack your coolers with plenty of water and snacks.

PARKING:

- -No vehicles will be permitted to be parked and left at Central High School, as the school gates are closed promptly at 11AM). Please park at the horseshoe on Marina Circle. (Take Park Avenue South and turn right on Waldemere Avenue, just before the arches. A shuttle will pick up participants and drop you off at Central High School from 8:30-10:30AM only.
- -Please print out the parking pass and put it on the dash board so that you will be allowed entrance to park on Waldemere. Please only print out for members of your group who are participating with you.
- -If your vehicle is part of the parade, please proceed to Central High School

PROFESSIONAL BOND FLOATS:

-Once you arrive at Central High School, someone will guide you to your float. All floats will have generators. It is your responsibility to provide equipment for music
