

The Heat Is Coming!

Yes, I know the temperatures are starting to creep up but it's not really hot yet. But the thing is, even if it's 73 degrees outside, the sun coming

in through the window is amazingly warm. Now



HOT ITALIAN SANDWICHES **SAUCE**

8 oz can (1 cup) tomato sauce 1/4 teaspoon of basil leaves 1/8 to 1/4 teaspoon of crushed red pepper

1/8 a teaspoon of garlic powder **SANDWICH**

1 lb Italian pork sausage

1 medium onion, thinly sliced

8 slices of French bread, cut diagonally, 3/4 inch thick

6 ounces of mozzarella cheese, sliced

2 tablespoons of margarine or butter, softened

In a small saucepan, combine sauce ingredients. Bring to a boil; simmer 15 minutes, stirring occasionally.

Shape pork sausage into four large thin oval patties, about 4

1/2 inches long. In large skillet, fry over medium heat about 10 minutes or until done, stirring frequently; remove sausage patties from skillet. In same skillet, cook onion until tender, set aside; remove all grease and drippings from skillet.

To assemble sandwiches, top each of four slices of bread with 1/4 of the cheese slices, one sausage patty and 1/4 of the cooked onion. Cover with remaining slices of bread. Spread margarine on outside of each sandwich. Place in skillet over medium heat. Grill sandwiches on both sides until bread begins to brown and sandwich is thoroughly heated. Serve each sandwich with about 1/4 a cup of sauce for dipping.






