

Thank you Jesus for your sacrifice.











If you're not sure, try fostering an animal. This can be either temporary or permanent, yet the animal has a comfortable place to stay. It is a winwin situation.





#### FRICO (An Old-fashioned French-Canadien Stew)

A stewing chicken or rotisserie cooked chicken, boiled in a good sized heavy stewing pot until meat can be picked off the bones. After boiling, let cool and clean meat off chicken (making sure there are no bones in meat), return meat to the liquid.

Add 3-4 carrots cut into 1/2-3/4 inch circles, 2-3 large raw potatoes (cut into 1/2 inch cubes), and one medium onion chopped to cooking liquid. Liquid should be 1/2 inch above ingredients.

Add salt, pepper and summer savory (sage can be substituted) to taste (or just salt and pepper), let simmer until carrots are cooked through. You can add chicken stock if your cooking liquid is low, or chicken "Better Than Bullion" to up the flavor, but check the seasoning before you add salt if you use the bullion.

#### **FLUFFY DUMPLINGS**

1½ cups all purpose flour

2 teaspoons baking powder

½ teaspoon salt

2/3 cup milk

2 tablespoons vegetable oil'

1 egg, slightly beaten

In a medium bowl, combine flour, powder and salt; blend well. Add milk, oil and egg; stir just until dry ingredients are moistened. Drop dumpling dough by rounded tablespoons onto boiling stew mixture. Reduce heat; cover tightly and cook 13 to 16 minutes or until dumplings are fluffy and no longer doughy on the bottom. Makes 12 dumplings.

OR, add 2 cups of Bisquick with 2/3 cup of milk, mix lightly (do not overmix, or dumplings will be hard, not fluffy) and let sit 5-10 minutes before dropping by tablespoon on top of the simmering stew. Cover and cook 10-15 minutes until cooked through.

(My sister and I eat our dumplings with butter and molasses, but that's what we grew up with.)


