





HEALTH

- ☐ Have at least a month's supply of medicines on hand
- ☐ Make sure your pets shots and vaccinations ae up to date
- Reset your grooming habits. Regular brushing times prevents matting, hot spots and skin conditions.
- ☐ Schedule annual check ups at the vet for all your pets

SAFETY

- ☐ Make sure your pets' microchip and information is current
- ☐ Replace any worn out toys, they could be choking hazards
- ☐ Buy a Pet Rescue Sticker to alert first responders that you have pets in the house.
- ☐ Have your pet's documentation and medical records within reach.
- Inspect your pet's collars and leashes for wear and tear. Add new ones where needed.
- □ Never leave that pet or pets in your vehicle unattended. The heat will build more quickly in the vehicle. Keep in mind asphalt gets very hot. Carefully peel paper from cups. Store in refrigerator or freezer until ready to use. Fill with nuts, candy, or some other goodie.

DELICIOUS WHITE BREAD FROM SCRATCH

Ingredients



5 to 6 cups of all-purpose flour 3 tablespoons of sugar 2 teaspoons of salt 2 packages active dry yeast 2 cups of water

¼ cup oil or shortening, melted margarine or butter if desired.

Directions

Grease two 8X4 or 9X5 inch loaf pans.

In large bowl, combine 2 cups flour, sugar, salt and yeast, blend well.

In small saucepan, heat water and oil until very warm (120° to 130°F), add warm liquid to flour mixture. Blend at low speed until moistened; beat three minutes at medium speed.

By hand, stir in an additional 2½ to 3 cups flour until dough pulls cleanly away from sides of bowl.

On floured surface, knead in $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 cup flour until dough is smooth and elastic, about five minutes.

Place dough in greased bowl; and cover loosely with plastic wrap or cloth towel. Let it rise in warm place (80-85°F) until light and doubled in size, about 45 to 60 minutes. Punch down dough several times to remove all air bubbles. Divide dough in half, shape into balls. Shape into two loaves by rolling dough into 14 X 7 inch rectangles. Starting

ARE ALLIGATORS ABLE TO BREATHE UNDERWATER?

Believe it or not, but it is a question that many people have questioned for centuries. There is even research back as far as Aristotle, as they debated how long alligators can hold their breath.



There have been numerous experiments done by researchers and scientists to show how long alligators can stay underwater. The answer to this question is yes, but not for as long as you might think.

While it is true alligators

can hold their breath underwater for up to an hour, they spend most of their time on land. It is only when they're hunting or mating that they go underwater.

Their lungs are quite different from ours and cannot hold as much oxygen as human beings

> to. They contain large amounts of nitrogen, allowing them to stay underwater for

extended periods without feeling discomfort or pain.

They are comfortable in the water because it helps to regulate their body temperature since they are a cold-blooded reptile.

The average lifespan of an alligator is 30 to 50 years.

In the wild alligators often die young due to predation or disease. But in captivity, alligators can live for even longer. Some have been recorded living up to 80 years.

During mating season in the spring, alligators use infra-sound (sounds below human hearing level) to attract mates. Alligators lay eggs in nests built out of vegetation and mud. The female remains with her eggs until they hatch and then she carries her young to the water in her mouth. The young remain with her for up to two years.

Since alligators and crocodiles are very similar creatures, they cannot live together. The reason? There are several key differences.

For one, the crocodiles are much larger than alligators, with some growing as long as 20 feet. Alligators top out at about 14 feet, making sharing a space a challenge. Crocodiles also can live in regions where the temperature drops below freezing for part of the year. Alligators cannot survive in colder climates, So they stay with their own,

When alligators are hunting and they spot their prey at the water surface, they will wait for hours, sometimes even days. They swim very slowly allowing their bodies to remain completely motionless in the water. When prey approaches the alligator, he lunges forward and clamps down on his victim with strong jaws.

These massive reptiles have survived thousands of years. They are dinosaurs, and will probably outlive us as well

Uses for every day products

Aluminum foil scrubs pots clean: no scrub pad? Crumble a handful of aluminum and scour to polish stainless steel pots. May damage nonstick pots however.


