In medium saucepan, combine sugar, cornstarch, and salt. Stir

in milk. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until mixture boils and thickens. Remove from heat; stir in chocolate and margarine until melted. Stir in vanilla. Add egg yolks one at a time, beating well after each addition. In medium bowl beat the egg whites with cream of tartar until soft peaks form. Gently fold in chocolate mixture. Pour into prepared soufflé dish.

Bake at 350°F for 45 to 50 minutes or until knife inserted near center comes out clean. Remove foil band: immediately serve soufflé with whipped cream or topping. 10 servings
