

IT IS AGAINST THE LAW to leave your pets in your vehicle as it begins to get warmer and hotter.

There are many people who you may think are busy bodies, and want them out of your business, I am sure. The

thing is, there are a multitude of people more interested in an animal or a child dying of heat exhaustion than there are people that care what you think. This said, even if you are only going in a store for a minute, someone will call 911 on you.

Let's consider 'going in a store for a minute'. It never has and it will never happen that you can go in a store and be out in 60 seconds. If you can, you are one in a million. I know it seems short as you quickly walked to the door, run to the product you need to pick up, get in line to check out, and then walk back to the car. If you



actually looked at your watch when you stepped out of the car and checked it again when you got back, you would see that you were gone a few minutes not a few seconds.

Now rolling the windows down will make you feel better, but it does not matter because that car with Arizona sun coming in the window is going to become an oven very quickly. If you do not think this is true, I dare you to go out and set in your car in the sun with no air conditioning with the windows only half down for 10 minutes. You would be soaked with sweat. Keep in mind this animal is wearing a fur coat which is a lot thicker than a T-shirt, which is what most of us are wearing.

This being said, it does not take someone with a PhD to see that leaving the animal or the child in the car is not only uncomfortable, but can be deadly. 

Cover the slow cooker with a lid and cook until chicken is fully cooked, about eight hours on low heat or 4 hours on high heat. Using a fork, remove and discard bay leaves from the

soup. Using tongs transfer chicken to a medium bowl. Stir in the fresh or dried dill. Turn off heat but leave soup covered to keep warm. Let chicken cool and then cut into bite-size pieces. Meanwhile cook egg noodles according to direction on bag.







IS BLEACH DANGEROUS?

Sodium hypochlorite is the active ingredient in bleach. It is a strong corrosive that can damage skin and eyes and lungs. To protect your eyes and skin, wear wraparound safety goggles, long rubber gloves and old clothing.

With bleach more is not better. A higher concentration of it is ineffective and potentially harmful. Add no more than ½ a cup of bleach per gallon of water and use within 24 hours. Be extra careful when using bleach if you or family members have asthma or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). Open doors and windows, and turn on the fan to help the fumes dissipate quickly.

Don't mix bleach with other cleaners!

Ammonia - together bleach and ammonia create chloramine, a toxic gas.

Vinegar - when vinegar is combined with bleach, chlorine gas is created which can cause breathing problems, coughing and irritation.

Rubbing alcohol - when mixed with bleach creates chloroform, a colorless liquid that evaporates into toxic gas.

Don't use bleach on metal, or pour down the drain.


