	6	Jesus Calms the Storm	Mt. 8:23-27 Mk. 4:36-41 Lk. 8:22-25	Jesus was there when God created the world, now creation recognizes His voice and obeys!
	7	Transfiguration	Mt.16:13-20, 17:1-13 Mk. 8:27-30, 9:2-10 Lk. 9:18-20, 28-36	God wanted the disciples to know His Son. Jesus is greater than anyone and the one to <u>obey</u> .
	8	Jesus Heals a Leper	Mt. 8:1-4 Mk. 1:40-45, Lk. 5:12-14	Jesus is compassionate and caring.
	9	Healed 10 Lepers, One Thankful	Lk. 17:11-19	We should always give thanks to God for everything.
	10	Lazarus and the Rich Man	Lk. 16:19-31	There is a spiritual life after our physical death.
	11	Zacchaeus	Lk.19:1-10	We can learn more about Jesus also, if we just study our Bible.
	12	Friends at Bethany	Mt. 26:6-13, Mk.14:3-9 Luke 10:38-42, Jn. 12:1-8	We should give the best of what we have. Doing things to bring us closer to Jesus is best.
	13	Lazarus Raised	Jn. 11:1-46, 12:9-11	Stress the power of God and the compassion Jesus has.
	14	Triumphal Entry	Mt. 21:1-17; Mk. 11:1-11, 15-19; Lk. 19:29-48; Jn. 12:12-19	We are to praise Jesus today as our savior. Jesus is our King!
	15	The Last Supper	Mt. 26:17-35; Mk. 14:12-31; Lk. 22:7-38; Jn. 13:1-38; 14:1-6	We are to be humble and reverent as we worship God. This is also a good time to explain the Lord's Supper and what we should be thinking about during communion.
	16	The Garden of Gethsemane	Mt. 26:36-56; Mk. 14:32-52; Lk. 22:19-20. 39-54; Jn. 18:1-12	We should also go to God in prayer for any and everything! Explain that Judas allowed the Devil to enter his heart.
	17	The Judgment Hall	Mt.26:57-75; 27:1, 2, 11-30; Mk. 14:53 -15:19; Lk. 22:55 -23:25; Jn. 18:12 -19:16	Jesus never offered a defense. They didn't 'take' his life, Jesus "offered" it. We must be ready to defend Christ today.

2		The Resurrection	Mt. 27:57 – 28:15; Mk. 15:42 – 16:11 Lk. 23:50 – 24:12; Jn. 19:38 – 20:18	The resurrection is our hope of eternal life in heaven. Christ overcame death and is all powerful!
3		Road to Emmaus & Upper Room	Mk 16:12-14; Lk 24:13-45; Jn 20:19-31	This is our PROOF Jesus arose! Christ was alive and <i>IS ALIVE NOW!</i>
4		Jesus Prepared Breakfast	John 21	Jesus cared for his disciples just as He cares for us. Many people were with Jesus after His death on the cross.
5		The Ascension & Choosing A Replacement	Acts 1:1-26 We need to be ready to step up and take our place in the church work also.	Jesus has gone to prepare a place for obedient Christians!
6		Day of Pentecost & Peter Opens the Kingdom	Acts 2	Beginning of <i>The</i> church of Christ. The Holy Spirit was left to guide and comfort us!
7		Peter & John Before the Sanhedrin & Believers Pray	Acts 4	We must also have the courage to speak the truth and have faith in Good.
8		Choosing Seven & The Stoning of Stephen	Acts 6 -8:1	Stephen loved Christ enough to give up all for Him. Discuss martyrs. Stephen was the first Christian martyr.
9		Simon the Sorcerer & Philip and the Ethiopian	Acts 8:2 -40	We should keep the motives for our actions pure. We should go about teaching others also.
10		Saul Persecuting Christians	Acts 8:1-4, 9:1-25	Saul changed his ways and actions (obeying the Lord) and so can we!
11		Cornelius and Peter's Vision	Acts 9:42 – 11:18	God showed Peter HE was not a respecter of persons and that salvation is for anyone who obeys.
12		Apostle James Dies, & Peter's Great Escape	Acts 12:1 - 24	We also need to be willing to 'stand up' for God and Jesus.
13		Saul and Barnabas Begin Mission Work	Acts 11:19-30, 12:25 - 14:7	They obeyed Jesus' command in Mark 16:15-18 to preach the good news (gospel) to everyone. Notice Saul's name change to Paul
14		First Missionary Journey Continued	Acts 14:8 - 15:4	We too, are to be caring the gospel to all the world.
15		Macedonian Vision Begin 2 nd Journey	Acts 15:36 – 16:15	Paul did not leave the new Christians to wither and die. He took Silas and went back to strengthen them. We too, need to keep teaching new Christians.
16		Philippian Jailer	Acts 16:16 – 40	Even though they were put into jail, they still praised God in song and prayer.
17		Thessalonica, Berea, and	Acts 17:1 – 34	Paul went about preaching about Jesus and establishing new congregations where ever he went.

	3	Before Governors and Kings	Acts 23:23 – 35, Acts 24:1 – 26:32	Paul was a educated and brave man. He never quite teaching, even those with authority over life.
	4	Shipwreck!	Acts 27	Paul had faith that God would get him safely to Rome.
	5	Rome, at Last!	Acts 28	After a long and dangerous trip Paul is at last a prisoner in Rome. He wrote several letters from here.
