

Summary of Revenue Sharing Project

The State of Alaska Community Revenue Sharing Program provides funds each year to Alaska's boroughs, cities, and unincorporated communities to cover basic public services. The funds can be used at the discretion of the community for any public purpose which will benefit the community. Projects are to be submitted to the Chickaloon Community Council (CCC) Revenue Sharing Committee for screening and subsequent presentation to community members. Projects will be voted on by the community, either at CCC meetings (for projects totally less than \$2000) or twice a year by mail-in ballot vote.
