California AB 908 (Solache) Enforce LGBTQ+Inclusive Curriculum

What is AB 908?

AB 908 (Solache) strengthens enforcement of the FAIR Education Act by requiring the California Department of Education to monitor whether school districts are properly including LGBTQ+ history and contributions in their curricula. Although the FAIR Education Act already mandates inclusive instruction, implementation has been inconsistent across the state. This bill aims to ensure that existing requirements are actually followed.

Key Protections of the Bill

- Requires state-level monitoring of school district compliance with the FAIR Education Act.
- Ensures inclusion of LGBTQ+ individuals and other marginalized groups in history and social science education.
- Promotes consistent use of compliant textbooks and instructional materials.
- Reinforces accountability for school districts failing to meet legal requirements
- Supports safer and more inclusive school environments for LGBTQ+ students.
