California SB 934 (Wiener) Expanding Justice for Conversion Therapy

What is SB 934?

SB 934 (Wiener) expands on California's existing ban on conversion therapy for minors by giving survivors more time to pursue civil legal action. While conversion therapy is already prohibited, current statutes of limitations often prevent survivors from seeking justice once they are ready to come forward. This bill addresses that gap by allowing additional time for survivors to file claims.

Key Protections of the Bill

- Extends the statute of limitations for survivors of conversion therapy.
- Provides a clearer pathway for survivors to seek civil legal remedies.
- Holds licensed mental health providers accountable for harmful and unscientific practices.
- Recognizes the delayed impact of trauma and the time it can take for survivors to come forward.
- Supports access to justice and accountability for those harmed.

By giving survivors more time to seek legal recourse, the bill ensures they are not denied justice due to arbitrary deadlines.
