Subject: CalTrans, Division of Aeronautics, safety report.

As a real property owner with land abutting the Swansboro Airport, we need for you to have an official copy of the CalTrans State permit compliance inspection.

Your property may, or may not, have concerns addressed in the report. Regardless it is necessary that you have all pertinent information regarding this matter.

CalTrans has granted an extension till March 28, 2019 to respond to their report. Some properties may need to have brush, shrubs, and tree removal/trimming be done, others need to address variances approved decades ago and request those variances stand, others may need to seek a new variance. In any event all of these items have been determined to address safety, which is everyone's responsibility.

With the advent of the SCPOA board elections, occurring February 9th, timing to address any concerns will be something the new board will have to review and then proceed as they determine. A 'task group' was created at the special meeting of January 31st, and it is assumed that a new task force and possibly an airport committee will convene sometime after the election and take part in the process of addressing the CalTrans report.

Until that time please review the official CalTrans report and your property to see if any future action will be required for your property. SCPOA has begun the process to review its common area property, aka the airport, and will have the maintenance department begin work to correct any issues related to that common area.
