This is why you're booking a trip with us, rest assured we will make sure you know exactly when to be at the airport and what to have on hand. Once in Ireland, although you will have some free time, youll be updated daily to that days schedule and instructions such as "lets meet in front of the hotel at 8 am". I suggest making sure your phone is activated internationally so we can keep up with each other if needed, or if there is any questions

# How many people will be in our group?

The goal is to have 16-18 people total, including the 2 of us, not counting the driver. We will not share transportation with anyone outside of the group

### Will i get Jet Lag

YES!! We'll try to book the trip to be less than 20 hours one way. Ireland has a 6 hour time difference from us. After you book the tour we will give you tips and tricks how to reduce it



## Will we have alone time? or will we be with the group the whole time

We will be driving everyday together in our private transportation. Most locations are only 40-80 miles away from one hotel to the next. Driving in Ireland is slower though and we will also be taking plenty of stops to enjoy different sceneries. We will also be spending a few nights in Killarney. so if you decide to just do your own thing for those days you are welcome to do so. The days are not jampacked.

#### Is this just for couples?

# What is your refund policy?

Trip deposit (\$1000 per person) is nonrefundable and non-transferable. Any cancellation refunds will be processed on this timeline:

 If you cancel 30 days or less prior to trip date, the full tour cost is nonrefundable. Or you can try and sell it to someone else

# What if we have a family emergency and need to rush home?

Although we would not be able to refund you the remaining trip we will definitely help you get on a flight back in a timely manner

# What type of payment do you accept?

We accept most payments: Cash, checks, Zelle, ACH, wire transfers, and all major credit cards (a 3.5% processing fee applies).



# What currency is used in Ireland?

The local currency is the Euro, with a current exchange rate of 1 Euro = 1 USD. Most places do take credit cards, we recommend Chase sapphire preferred card for no international fees and good exchange rates. You can sign up for one here:

Make sure to call ahead and let your bank know that you'll be travelling. We also recommend getting Euros from your local bank or from a ATM debit machine as soon as we arrive in Ireland in order to have tipping money, and in case we go to a place that doesn't accept cards. They do not accept U.S. dollars.

### What Language do they speak?

The official language is Irish. although most people speak English but with an Irish Accent, so it can be hard to understand. They also use words that you may not be familiar with. It makes for great laughs and adventures.



# Do i have to have a valid passport to book?

You don't have to have one when you make your down payment. However, you definitely need one to travel. We would need your name exactly as it will appear on your passport at the time of booking.

Should you procrastinate and not get your passport in time we would not be able to issue you a full refund. We suggest applying for a passport at least 14 weeks in advance.
