Secretary's Report

Caretaker Feedback

• Feedback on the new caretaker has been excellent.

Maintenance & Repairs

- Additional issues are under review for preventative repairs.

Smoking Policy

Parking Lot Update

• The parking lot will receive a seal coat from June 30 to July 4, 2025.

Treasurer's Report

- An HOA fee increase will be required this year.
- No special assessment is planned.
- New HOA fee schedules have been printed.
- Major preventative maintenance projects are anticipated.

General Manager's Report

- Insurance premiums for common areas are increasing by approximately 50%.
- Recognition of Jill Bailey, new General Manager, for identifying gaps in the prior insurance policy—critical issues such as:
 - Snow-related slip and fall coverage
 - Plow damage
 - o Pool-related incidents
 - General officer liability
- Jill's leadership has resulted in significant cost savings:
 - Eliminated rug rental service, saving several thousand dollars
 - Replaced waste management with Harter's, achieving substantial savings
 - Engaged a new groundskeeping service with better service and lower-cost software
- Plunkett's Pest Control: Building One was historically overcharged for pest control and contractual services. A \$17,000 refund was deposited into the building account last week covering the past three years. Further investigation is underway.
- Historical Note: Building One turned 55 years old this year, making it one of Rochester's oldest condominium communities.
- Call for Participation: Owners are encouraged to consider serving on the board.
