Also need a water sensor so if it starts leaking you will know.

Cory/MC Outdoor: Motion was made and carried for \$2800 to dig under the sidewalk to install the drains for the downspouts.

Buckthorn issue being address through master board for Goat Dispatch out of Faribault.

Flower Wall-motion was made and carried for \$200 for perennial flowers so we do not have to plant flowers every year.
